Suspect arrested in killing of US activist Charlie Kirk

US authorities said yesterday they had captured the man accused of killing prominent right-wing activist Charlie Kirk after a family member helped to turn him in, ending a frantic manhunt. "We got him," Utah Governor Spencer Cox told a press conference.

Cox identified the suspect as Tyler Robinson and said the arrest was made after one of Robinson's relatives contacted a friend, who then contacted the police.

The 31-year-old was killed when hit by a single bullet in his neck while addressing a large crowd at Utah Valley University in the town of Orem.

Nepal ex-chief justice Karki becomes next PM

Nepal's former chief justice Sushila Karki was sworn in yesterday to lead the transition as the country's next prime minister after deadly anti-corruption protests ousted the government. The 73-year-old Karki, Nepal's first woman chief justice, was sworn into office by President Ram Chandra Paudel, after the previous prime minister quit Tuesday as parliament was set ablaze. The appointment of the judge, known for her independence, comes after two days of intense negotiations by army chief General Ashok Raj Sigdel and Paudel, including with representatives from "Gen Z".

HRH Crown Prince to visit Japan for talks, Expo 2025

As part of the programme, His Royal Highness will attend Expo 2025 Osaka, Kansai and the Kingdom of Bahrain's National Day celebrations, which will be held under the Crown Prince and Prime Minister's patronage

U.S. Ambassador hails C-SIPA anniversary, highlights stronger cooperation

U.S. Ambassador to Bahrain Steven C. Bondy has hailed the Comprehensive Security Integration and Prosperity Agreement (C-SIPA), saying it has opened possibilities for even stronger cooperation.

He was speaking on the occasion of the second anniversary of the U.S.-Bahrain signing of C-SIPA.

In a statement to *The Daily Tribune*, the Ambassador said:

"This year, during His Royal Highness Crown Prince and Prime Minister Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa's historic July visit to Washington, the agreement expanded to include the United Kingdom, opening possibilities for even stronger cooperation to build a more secure, prosperous, and interconnected future for our peoples and the region."



Moscow says peace talks frozen

Moscow said yesterday that peace talks with Kyiv were on "pause" as Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky warned that his Russian counterpart Vladimir Putin still had plans to try to capture the whole of Ukraine.

US President Donald Trump warned meanwhile that he was fast running out of patience with Putin, who has shown no intention of halting or slowing his ground offensive or barrage of aerial attacks on Ukrainian cities.

'Cowardly' attack: UAE

UAE summons Israel envoy over Qatar attack

● Statement warns any aggression constitutes an attack on the collective Gulf security framework

The United Arab Emirates said it summoned Israel's deputy ambassador yesterday, in a formal rebuke of his country's deadly attack against Hamas leaders in Qatar.

It issued sharp condemnations of Tuesday's deadly strike on Qatar. The move comes as US Secretary of State Marco Rubio, who is also President Donald Trump's national security advisor, is set to meet Qatar's prime minister Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdulrahman Al Thani at the White House, a State Department

Was the US not informed?

The White House said US President Donald Trump did not agree with Israel's decision to take military action. He said he was not notified in advance and when he heard, he asked his envoy Steve Witkoff to warn Qatar immediately -- but the attack had already started.

The UN Security Council on Thursday condemned strikes on Qatar and called for de-escalation, without naming Israel which carried out the attack. The Security Council "underscored the importance of de-escalation and expressed their solidarity with Qatar," said the statement, which required the agreement of all 15 council members, including Israel's ally the United States.

She used the meeting to "strongly condemn and denounce the blatant and cowardly Israeli attack that targeted the State of Qatar, as well as the hostile statements made by the Israeli Prime Minister, Benjamin Netanyahu," the statement said. "Any aggression against a GCC member state constitutes an attack on the collective Gulf security framework," she added, referring to the Gulf Cooperation Council regional bloc.

UAE's action also comes amid an emergency Arab-Islamic summit planned in Doha on Sunday and Monday to discuss a regional response to the attack.

Focus on two-state solution

UN General Assembly votes for Hamas-free Palestinian state

The UN General Assembly voted yesterday to back the "New York Declaration," a resolution which seeks to breathe new life into the two-state solution between Israel and Palestine -- without the involvement of Hamas.

The text was adopted by 142 votes in favour, 10 against -- including Israel and key ally the

United States -- and 12 abstentions. It clearly condemns Hamas and demands that it surrender its weapons.

Formally called the New York Declaration on the Peaceful Settlement of the Question of Palestine and the Implementation of the Two-State Solution, the text states that "Hamas must free all hostages" and that the UN General Assembly condemns "the attacks committed by Ha-

mas against civilians on the 7th of October."

It also calls for "collective action to end the war in Gaza, to achieve a just, peaceful and lasting settlement of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict based on the effective implementation of the Two-State solution."

The declaration, which was already endorsed by the Arab League and co-signed in July by 17 UN member states, includ-

ing several Arab countries, also goes further than condemning Hamas, seeking to fully excise them from leadership in Gaza.

"In the context of ending the war in Gaza, Hamas must end its rule in Gaza and hand over its weapons to the Palestinian Authority, with international engagement and support, in line with the objective of a sovereign and independent Palestinian State," the declaration states.





Hidden in bedcovers

Court to rule on drug parcel case

The High Criminal Court is set to deliver its verdict on 30 September in a case in which authorities seized 850 grammes of a powdered substance and arrested two men suspected of involvement in a 'dead mail' drug network.

Customs officers discovered the drugs hidden inside bedcovers during an X-ray scan of incoming post. The Anti-Narcotics Directorate was alerted, and a controlled handover was arranged using the phone number on the package and a shared location pin.

A man arrived to collect the parcel and was detained. He told investigators that he was acting on someone else's instructions to deliver the package to their family in Bahrain. Under supervision, he contacted the intended recipient and arranged a meeting at a restaurant.

At the location, two men took possession of the package and were immediately arrested by officers. A search of the first man uncovered 27 A4 sheets soaked in a substance described as CBD, while the

second man was found with two boxes containing the same material. Subsequent searches of their homes revealed additional drugs and tools used for dividing the consignments.

Investigators said the operation appeared to be part of a network led by an unknown organiser, with the two men responsible for receiving, storing, portioning, and passing on the drugs via 'dead mail'.

During questioning, the second man admitted importing and selling the drugs, receiving them from the first man and distributing them under prior instructions. The first man said he collected parcels and left them in pre-arranged locations on the organiser's orders.

Phone checks revealed messages, videos, and images of money transfers on the second man's device, while the first man's search history included queries about empty perfume bottles in Bahrain and CBD oil.

Both men, along with an unidentified person, were charged with importing and possessing narcotic and psychotropic substances with intent to trade. They remain in custody pending the court's ruling.

Youth put the pedal down on Bahrain's auto growth

Car imports accelerate 8.8% on youthful demand, strong market

Bahrain's car imports rose 8.8% in the first eight months of 2025, driven by younger buyers and a buoyant local market, official data shows. From January to August, 29,150 vehicles were imported, up from 26,796 during the same period last year. The growth reflects steady population gains, expanding housing projects, wider consumer lending and bank finance, and stable logistics through Khalifa Bin Salman Port, the country's main vehicle gateway. The first half closed with 22,226 vehicles, a 15% year-on-year increase, with demand staying firm until midsummer before easing slightly in July and August. January recorded the highest monthly total at 5,365 units, while May marked the seasonal low at 2,453. The monthly run was 3,132 in February, 3,870 in March, 3,472

in April, 3,934 in June, 3,597 in July and 3,327 in August. Car imports have rebounded strongly since the Covid-19 downturn, climbing from 27,262 in 2020 to 44,216 in 2024 — the highest since 2017. The upward curve highlights Bahrain's resilience and the growing influence of younger consumers on the automotive market. Bahrain records about 28,000 to 35,000 new-car sales each year, dealer figures show, alongside an active market for used imports from the United States, Japan and South Korea.



In 2023, Bahrain had nearly 0.47 vehicles per person across its population, with about 747,350 vehicles registered nationwide. This high vehicle density underscores the strength of demand in the car market.

Bahrain puts AI in Space Spotlight

Kingdom urges guardrails for emerging tech

- AI reshaping space security
- Legal guardrails highlighted
- Bahrain backs cooperation

Artificial intelligence is racing into orbit, and Bahrain is warning that without legal guardrails it could deepen the very risks it promises to solve.

That was the message from Dr. Mohammed Ibrahim Al-Asiri, CEO of the Bahrain Space Agency, as he addressed the UNIDIR International Space Security Conference 2025 in Geneva. He told global delegates that space safety now hinges on aligning advanced technologies with diplomacy and law - a role Bahrain is positioning itself to champion.

AI at the core

Al-Asiri stressed that emerging



technologies such as AI and quantum communications are reshaping the global debate on orbital security. While they can optimize satellite

operations and improve decision-making, he said they also bring new vulnerabilities if not governed by shared rules.

Guardrails and cooperation

Sessions at the two-day conference tackled mounting threats from space debris, anti-satellite weapons, cyberattacks, and the growing overlap of civilian and military space use. Al-Asiri underscored that Bahrain's engagement is about

unifying perspectives, pressing for adoptable understandings, and safeguarding assets through cooperation.

Future-focused vision

He concluded that Bahrain's participation reflects its drive to build advanced national capabilities in space security and to promote frameworks that ensure outer space remains safe, peaceful, and sustainable for future generations.

The hearing into a BD192,000 embezzlement case, in which a government director stands accused, will continue on 14 September.

The defendant is alleged to have stolen funds from the Ministry of Social Development and laundered part of the money.

Prosecutors allege that the defendant, while in public service, issued cheques in the names of individuals and withdrew the cash for personal use, seizing a total of 192,351 dinars and 242 fils. He is also accused of misappropriating cash and in-kind donations collected by the centre, including vouchers and Ramadan baskets, part of which were meant for social cases, staff bonuses, and centre events.

The case involves a second defendant, the owner of a labour-supply company, who allegedly helped falsify con-

er received only 140 dinars. He is also accused of receiving Covid-19 wage-support funds without passing them on to staff.

Investigators highlighted the use of pre-signed blank cheques, which were later withdrawn by staff and deposited into the director's personal accounts. Financial analysis from January 2019 to July 2024 showed deposits and transfers into the centre's accounts of 78,188 dinars and 750 fils, with patterns inconsistent with his declared income.

Cheques issued by the director totalled 157,256 dinars and 542 fils. The forged documents were used to justify withdrawals and reimbursements, facilitating the alleged embezzlement. The second defendant is charged with participating in the forgery of cleaning-worker contracts and cash-receipt slips.

Small investors step back as gold bars and silver see record demand

Gold prices in Bahrain have jumped, with a gram of 21-carat gold now around BD39, while smaller pieces under a gram are selling above BD55. Some shoppers have stepped back, unhappy with prices and making charges, while others are turning to gold bars as a safer way to preserve value. Jewellers say the surge has been rapid. A 10-tola bar that cost around BD4,000 a year ago is now over BD5,000, a gain of

roughly BD1,000 in less than twelve months. Silver has risen as well, trading at about BD525–BD540 per kilogram, with one-ounce pieces near BD1,400. Traders link the rise to external tensions, increased global demand, and weaker currencies

in some countries. They note this pattern is familiar: demand dips temporarily, then trade stabilizes. Local buying remains uneven. Wedding season has brought a slight lift, yet activity is still below levels seen two years ago.

Many buyers now prefer bars to preserve savings, while some start with silver if gold is out of reach. Making charges vary by design and craft, currently around BD4–BD5 per gram. Retailers report a common market trend: interest rises with

the price and eases when it falls. Sales of used jewellery are quiet, while bar purchases account for most of the activity. Traders say all age groups are participating, including early-twenty-somethings buying gold as a haven. Today, 21-carat gold stands

near BD39 per gram, and silver at roughly BD525 per kilogram. Many had expected BD37 to be the ceiling, but prices have overshot that mark. Demand for bars has cooled at these levels, though long-term savers, including families and parents, continue buying.



Gold has historically been seen as a “safe haven” investment during times of economic uncertainty. In fact, during the 2008 global financial crisis, gold prices jumped more than 25% as investors sought to protect their wealth.

The Gulf Complications Cases Show, Imaging and Physiology (GIS CompEdge 2025) was inaugurated yesterday morning, in the presence of Major General Dr. Fouad Abdelqader Saeed, Managing Director of the Mohammed bin Khalifa bin Salman Al Khalifa Cardiac Center. Organized by the Gulf Intervention Society (GIS) and managed by ICOM, the event—held on September 12 and 13—brought together more than 100 leading specialists and experts in the field.

During the conference’s opening, Dr. Fawaz Al-Mutairi, President of the Gulf Intervention Society, delivered a speech in which he expressed his delight about hosting the conference in the Kingdom of Bahrain for the first time. He noted that the Society is eager for the conference to become an annual event for science and knowledge, where experts gather to discuss the latest developments and the most challenging issues in interventional cardiology.

Emphasizing the crucial role of the multi-disciplinary team, the focus is on enhancing patient outcomes and the success of therapeutic interventions. also to create a space for collective learning and collaborative problem-solving. He noted that, despite their difficulty, complications offer valuable opportunities to improve practices and enhance decision-making skills. Dr. Khalid bin Thani, Director of the Imaging & Physiology Program, stated that the program is an advanced platform that combines the latest diagnostic tools with top-notch clinical practice. He emphasized that technologies such as OCT, IVUS, FFR, and iFR are crucial in creating the most effective treatment plan. He also explained that the interactive sessions and hands-on cases will help participants better incorporate these technologies into their daily decisions. Dr. Raed Al-Kutshan, the Director of the Imaging & Physiology Program, emphasized that integrating the complications axis with the imaging and physiological measurements axis provides the conference with a unique advantage, as real-world challenges are addressed alongside cutting-edge technologies. He highlighted that this approach would open new opportunities for attendees and help strengthen Bahrain’s role as a regional scientific hub in interventional cardiology.

News in brief

China says newest aircraft carrier sailed through Taiwan Strait



◆ China said yesterday that its third and newest aircraft carrier, the Fujian, recently sailed through the sensitive Taiwan Strait to carry out “scientific research trials and training missions” in the South China Sea. Beijing has ploughed billions of dollars into modernising its military in recent years, a trend that has unnerved some governments in East Asia despite China insisting its aims are peaceful. China has two carriers in operation -- the Liaoning and Shandong -- with the Fujian currently undergoing sea trials. China’s navy said yesterday that undertaking cross-regional trials “is a normal part of the aircraft carrier’s construction process”.

◆ Russia and its key ally Belarus began major joint military drills early yesterday, putting NATO on edge days after Poland accused Moscow of escalating tensions by firing attack drones through its airspace. The “Zapad” exercises come as Russian forces grind across the sprawling front line in Ukraine and escalate aerial attacks on Ukrainian cities. The Russian defence ministry posted a video showing heavy military equipment -- including armoured vehicles, helicopters and navy ships -- taking part in the drills.

Death toll from Indonesia flooding rises to 23



◆ The death toll from the flooding that struck two Indonesian islands, including tourist hotspot Bali, rose to 23 yesterday, officials said, with five other people still missing. Torrential rain late Tuesday triggered floods and landslides across Bali, the National Disaster Mitigation Agency (BNPB) said, adding four more people have been found dead and two others are unaccounted for. The additional deaths come on top of 14 already reported on Bali and five on the island of Flores.

Japan centenarians reach record high at nearly 100,000

The number of people aged 100 or older in Japan has hit a record high of nearly 100,000, with almost 90 percent of them women, ministry data showed yesterday.

The figures underscore the demographic crisis gripping the world’s fourth-biggest economy as its population ages and shrinks.

As of September 1, Japan had 99,763 centenarians, up 4,644 year-on-year, with 88 percent of them women, the health ministry said in a statement.

Japan’s oldest person is 114-year-old Shigeko Kagawa in the Nara region near Kyoto.

She remained active past 80 years old as an obstetrician-gynecologist and a general doctor, according to the ministry.

“Walking extensively during house calls built strong legs, which are the source of my current vitality,” Kagawa was cited as saying in the statement.

She still has good eyesight so she spends the day watching

TV, reading newspapers and doing calligraphy.

The world’s oldest person is British woman Ethel Caterham, who turned 116 in August, months after the title passed to her following the death of Brazilian nun Inah Canabarro Lucas.

Japan is facing a steadily worsening population crisis, as its expanding elderly population leads to soaring medical and welfare costs, with a shrinking labour force to pay for it.

Official data last month showed that the population of Japanese nationals fell by a record amount -- more than 900,000 people -- in 2024.

Prime Minister Shigeru Ishiba has called the situation a “quiet emergency”, pledging family-friendly measures such as more flexible working hours and free day care to try and reverse the trend.

However, the government’s efforts to slow the decline and ageing of its population have yet to yield meaningful results.

Nepal ex-chief justice Karki becomes PM after protests

Former chief justice becomes transitional leader after deadly anti-corruption protests

● Karki sworn in as PM

● First woman to lead Nepal

● Youth movement demanded Karki’s appointment

Nepal’s former chief justice Sushila Karki was sworn yesterday to lead the transition as the country’s next prime minister after deadly anti-corruption protests ousted the government.

The 73-year-old Karki, Nepal’s first woman chief justice, was sworn into office by President Ram Chandra Paudel, after the previous prime minister quit Tuesday as parliament was set ablaze.

“Congratulations! We wish you success, wish the country success,” Paudel said to Karki after the small ceremony in the presidential palace, attended by diplomats and some former leaders.

The Himalayan nation of 30 million people was plunged into chaos this week after security forces tried to crush rallies by young anti-corruption protesters.

At least 51 people were killed in the worst violence since the end of a civil war and the abolition of the monarchy in 2008.

The military took back control of the streets on Wednesday, enforcing a curfew.

The appointment of the judge, known for her independence, comes after two days of intense negotiations by army chief General Ashok Raj Sigdel and Paudel, including with representatives from “Gen Z”, the loose umbrella title of the youth protest movement.

Thousands of young activists had used the online app Discord to debate the next steps -- and name Karki as their choice of next leader.

Karki, dressed in a red sari dress, took the oath but did not make a further speech. She smiled and bowed with her hands pressed together repeatedly in traditional greetings.

“It is a moment of victory... finally the power vacuum has ended,” said Amrita Ban, a Gen

Z protester. “We did it”, key youth protest

group Hami Nepal posted on Instagram, calling for unity.

“Honour the lives of those who sacrificed themselves for this moment”.

Presidential press advisor Kiran Pokharel said that “a council of ministers will be formed after, and other processes will be taken from there”.

Protests fed into longstanding economic woes in Nepal, where a fifth of people aged 15-24 are unemployed, according to the World Bank, with GDP per capita standing at just \$1,447.

At least 21 protesters were among those killed, mainly on Monday during the police crack-down on demonstrations against corruption and poor governance that was sparked by a ban on social media.

Brazil’s Bolsonaro given 27-year term for coup plotting

Brazil’s Supreme Court on Thursday sentenced fire-brand ex-president Jair Bolsonaro to 27 years in prison for coup plotting at the end of a landmark trial that divided the nation and drew US fury.

The sentence could see the 70-year-old far-right leader spend the rest of his days in jail.

Judges voted 4-1 to convict Bolsonaro of plotting to overthrow Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva following his October 2022 election defeat by the left-winger.

Prosecutors said the plan failed only due to a lack of support from military top brass.

Bolsonaro’s defense team called the sentence “incredibly excessive” and announced he would appeal, “including at the international level.”

Washington was quick to respond to the conviction of the man dubbed “the Trump of the tropics” on his election in 2019.

Secretary of State Marco Rubio said the United States “will respond accordingly” to what he called a politically motivated

“witch hunt.”

Brazil’s foreign ministry hit back, saying it would not be intimidated by Rubio’s “threats.”

A ‘good man’

Trump, who levied steep tariffs on Brazil as punishment over

Bolsonaro’s prosecution, labeled the verdict “very surprising.”

He praised Bolsonaro as a “good president” and “good man” and said his legal woes were “very much like they tried to do with me.”

While the Supreme Court had

already garnered the simple majority of three votes needed for his conviction at the fourth vote, it only became final after the last of the five judges issued his decision.

“An armed criminal organization was formed by the defendants, who must be convicted based on the factual circumstances I consider proven,” said the fifth judge, Cristiano Zanin, Lula’s former lawyer.

Bolsonaro’s seven co-accused, including former ministers and military chiefs, were also convicted.

The former army captain, who served a single term from 2019 to 2022, claims he is the victim of political persecution.

Speaking outside his father’s home in Brasilia, Bolsonaro’s lawmaker son Flavio Bolsonaro said the politician was “holding his head high in the face of this persecution, because history will show that we are on the right side.”

He added that his father’s allies would act with “all their might” to secure Congress’s support for an amnesty bill.



Suspect arrested in Kirk killing

Authorities capture Tyler Robinson after family member helps end 33-hour manhunt

● Charlie Kirk shot dead Wednesday

● Rifle recovered near crime scene

● Trump vows to attend funeral

US authorities said yesterday they had captured the man accused of killing prominent right-wing activist Charlie Kirk after a family member helped to turn him in after a frantic manhunt.

“We got him,” Utah Governor Spencer Cox told a press conference.

Cox identified the suspect as Tyler Robinson and said the arrest was made after one of Robinson’s relatives contacted a friend, who then contacted the police.

The arrest raised a bitterly divided country’s hopes of finding answers to the shocking political murder on Wednesday.

The 31-year-old was killed after being hit by a single bullet in his neck while addressing a large crowd at Utah Valley University.

Kirk was an electrifying presence on the US far-right, with a talent for debate and a huge following that helped Trump build the youth vote in his election victory last November.

From the moment of the shooting, Trump has treated the event as a matter of top national importance.

Trump first announced that Kirk had died from his wound, and yesterday it was Trump again who took to Fox News -- ahead of the press conference by law enforcement -- to say that the main suspect was in custody.

The Republican president has ordered flags at half-mast and said he will attend Kirk’s funeral.

Breakthrough in manhunt

Authorities quickly found the alleged murder weapon, a high-powered hunting rifle, and released photos of a young man dressed in a baseball cap and casual clothing.

However, after detaining, then

releasing, two people who turned out to be unconnected to the case, the police and FBI appeared to struggle.

Late Thursday, officials in Orem released more details about the suspect’s clothing and initial movements after the shooting, pleading with the public to help identify him.

FBI Director Kash Patel said the arrest was finally made at 10:00 pm Thursday -- 33 hours after the shooting.

Cox credited assistance from the alleged killer’s own family.

“On the evening of September 11th, a family member of Tyler Robinson reached out to a family

friend, who contacted the Washington County sheriff’s office with information that Robinson had confessed to them or implied that he had committed the incident,” he said.

Students at the university on Thursday described their shock and their broader fears as political divisions deepen across the country.

Dave Sanchez said witnessing the killing made him “sick to my stomach.”

“We watch him all the time and so it really does feel like one of your own family members, your own brother’s been killed,” said Sanchez, 26.

Robinson’s capture was made possible by a relative who reached out after his confession, making this high-profile case a rare instance where family intervention directly ended a national manhunt

In Orem Park, several hundred people wearing red MAGA caps and holding American flags attended a vigil on Thursday evening, where they prayed and held a moment of silence.

“It still feels insane that this happened,” Jonathan Silva, 35, said. “It’s totally surreal.”

Seeking death penalty

Cox said his state would pursue the death penalty against the suspect.

Trump said he would back such a move. “I hope he gets the death penalty,” he told Fox News.

Reflecting the highly political nature of the killing, Kirk’s coffin was transported to his home city of Phoenix on Vice President JD Vance’s official plane.

Footage showed Vance with his hands on the casket as it was carried to Air Force 2.

Rubio to offer Israel support despite Qatar strike

US Secretary of State Marco Rubio will leave Saturday on a trip to Israel to offer support before French-led moves to recognize a Palestinian state, the State Department said.

Rubio is going ahead with the visit despite President Donald Trump gently reprimanding Israel for a surprise attack on Hamas in Qatar, a key US partner.

Rubio will speak to Israeli leaders about “our commitment to fight anti-Israel actions including unilateral recognition of a Palestinian state that rewards Hamas terrorism,” State Department spokesman Tommy Pigott said in a statement.

Rubio will emphasize “the US commitment to Israeli security,” Pigott said.

“He will also emphasize our shared goals: ensuring Hamas never rules over Gaza again and bringing all the hostages home,” he said, adding that Rubio will meet families of hostages.

He said that Rubio would discuss Israel’s “operational goals and objectives” in its new offensive which includes a goal of seizing the already rubble-strewn territory’s main urban hub of Gaza City.

Kremlin says Ukraine peace talks frozen as Trump warns Putin

Moscow said yesterday that peace talks with Ukraine were on “pause” as US President Donald Trump again warned he was fast running out of patience with his Russian counterpart Vladimir Putin.

Trump’s efforts to bring the three-and-a-half-year conflict to an end have faltered in recent weeks, with Russia digging into its hardline demands and refusing to halt its ground and aerial attacks.

The new standoff came as Russia’s army staged major military drills with its key ally Belarus on NATO’s border, exercises that have spooked the alliance’s eastern flank after the downing of Russian drones in Polish airspace this week.

Three rounds of direct peace talks between Russia and Ukraine, as well as a summit between Trump and Putin in Alaska, have failed to make any progress towards ending the fighting.

Moscow’s army is grinding forward on the battlefield and Putin has vowed to carry on fighting if his demands for peace -- including Ukraine ced-

ing yet more land -- are not met.

“Our negotiators have the opportunity to communicate through channels. But for now, it is probably more accurate to talk about a pause” in talks with Kyiv, Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov told reporters in a telephone briefing.

“You can’t wear rose-tinted glasses and expect that the negotiation process will yield immediate results,” he added.

Trump has repeatedly threatened Moscow with additional sanctions if it does not halt its offensive but has failed to fol-

low through, frustrating Kyiv.

“It’s sort of running out and running out fast, but it does take two to tango,” Trump told the Fox television when asked if his patience was being taxed by Russia’s refusal to end the conflict.

“It’s amazing. When Putin wants to do it, (President Volodymyr) Zelensky didn’t. When Zelensky wanted to do it, Putin didn’t. Now Zelensky wants to and Putin is a question mark. We’re going to have to come down very, very strong,” he added.

Having boldly declared his intention to create "history" at Liverpool, the 25-year-old trained with his new teammates for the first time this week and is expected to make his debut at Turf Moor.

Reds boss Slot has an embarrassment of riches in attack after a spending spree and it will be fascinating to see how he fits Isak into a forward line already featuring Mohamed Salah, Florian Wirtz, Hugo Ekitike and

Cody Gakpo.

Chasing a record 21st English crown, Liverpool are already top of the table again with three successive victories, making Isak's arrival on Merseyside a daunting proposition for their title rivals.

Postecoglou in Forest hot seat

Just three months after he was unceremoniously sacked by Tottenham, Postecoglou will be back in north London on Saturday as the Nottingham Forest boss takes charge of his new team against Arsenal.

Postecoglou was hired by Forest this week following the dismissal of Nuno Espirito Santo.

The engaging Australian's welcome return to the Premier League comes possibly tinged with a hint of schadenfreude.

Postecoglou was axed by Tottenham chairman Daniel Levy despite winning the Europa League last season to end the club's 17-year trophy drought, so it will not have escaped his attention that Levy was forced to step down from his role last week.

However, Forest's volatile owner Evangelos Marinakis could prove even more demanding to work for than Levy.

Nuno impressively steered Forest to their first European campaign for 30 years but paid the price for a deterioration of his relationship with Marinakis.

Marinakis immediately piled pressure on Postecoglou, who presided over Tottenham's worst top-flight finish since 1976/77 last season, as he claimed Forest were in a position to challenge for major trophies.

Philipsen wins Vuelta stage 19 for treble

Belgian sprinter claims third stage victory while Vingegaard gains crucial bonus seconds

Jasper Philipsen edged a bunch sprint to claim Vuelta a Espana stage 19 victory yesterday racking up his third stage win of the race.

General classification leader Jonas Vingegaard extended his lead on Joao Almeida by four seconds to 44 seconds overall as he claimed a bonus on the intermediate sprint.

After an individual time trial on Thursday that was shortened for security reasons, riders travelled a flat 162 kilometres from Rueda to Guijuelo, past vineyards and quiet countryside.

Cycling's third-biggest grand tour has been heavily affected by pro-Palestinian protests, mainly targeting the Israel-Premier Tech team, but this was a calm day's racing.

Jakub Otruba and Victor Guernalec formed the day's two-man break, with the peloton letting them go during a relaxed start.

Otruba dropped Guernalec and pushed on alone, into a headwind, around four minutes ahead of the peloton.

Vingegaard grabbed four bonus seconds in the intermediate sprint as he edged Mads Pedersen, with UAE Team Emirates and Almeida caught on their heels.

With around 50km remaining the peloton, who travelled in unison towards Guijuelo, jostling for position ahead of the expected bunch sprint finale.

Pedersen went early but Belgian Philipsen held him off comfortably to complete a Vuelta hat-trick, following the Alpecin-Deceuninck rider's triumphs on stages one and eight. Orluis Aular came in third behind Pedersen.

On Saturday riders face the daunting final mountain stage, running 166km from Robledo de Chavela to Bola del Mundo, where the general classification battle between Vingegaard and Almeida will be resolved.

Newcastle's Howe says Isak relationship was 'difficult' before Liverpool move

Newcastle boss Eddie Howe has revealed his relationship with Alexander Isak deteriorated after the Sweden star went on strike in a bid to force through his British record transfer to Liverpool.

The 25-year-old missed Newcastle's pre-season tour to Singapore and South Korea due to what Newcastle said at the time was a minor injury.

Isak trained at his former club Real Sociedad while Howe's team were in Asia and then worked on his own as Newcastle prepared for the new season.

Howe was instrumental in Isak's rise to prominence after signing him from Sociedad, with the Swede's goals helping to end the club's 56-year trophy drought and secure Champions League qualification last season.

But Howe said their relationship soured once Isak refused to take part in the pre-season, which effectively ruled him out of Newcastle's first three Premier League games.

Chelsea's Delap out for up to three months: Maresca

Chelsea striker Liam Delap could be sidelined until December after injuring his hamstring before the international break, manager Enzo Maresca said yesterday.

Delap signed from Ipswich for £30 million (\$40 million) in June and has featured in all of Chelsea's three Premier League matches so far.

But he was forced off early in the 2-0 win against Fulham on August 30.

"Liam, I think it's around 10 to 12 weeks, so a long way to go," Maresca told reporters yesterday.

Chelsea recalled forward Marc Guiu from a loan spell at Sunderland to cover for Delap after Senegal striker Nicolas Jackson left the Blues for Bayern Munich on transfer deadline

day.

Maresca also has another forward option in Joao Pedro, who arrived at Stamford Bridge from Brighton in July.

But the Chelsea boss admitted Delap's injury left him short of forward options ahead of Saturday's west London derby at Brentford.

"We have the injury for sure now in this moment as a number nine," he said.

Liverpool's Slot urges patience with 'best striker' Isak after record move

Arne Slot yesterday described Anew signing Alexander Isak as "maybe the best striker in the world" but warned he would be eased into action gradually after a disrupted pre-season.

The Premier League champions signed the Sweden forward from Newcastle on transfer deadline day for a British-record fee of £125 million

(\$169 million), adding further firepower to their impressive squad.

Isak's arrival after a protracted chase was part of an eye-catching splurge of more than £400 million in the summer transfer window, though a deadline-day move to sign Crystal Palace and England defender Marc Guehi collapsed.

"A lot of things happened on the last day (of the transfer window), which is not always the situation, because last season we hardly did anything during the whole window," Slot said yesterday.

"But the thing that pleases me most, of course, is us getting the deal for Alex over the line."

The Dutchman praised Sweden manager Jon Dahl Tomasson for the way he handled Isak's workload during the international break.

The 25-year-old, who has not played any club football this season, was on the bench for Sweden's 2-2 World Cup qualifying draw against Slovenia and was brought on as a late substitute in the 2-0 defeat against Kosovo.

"He gets one of the best, maybe the best striker in the world, and needs to play two very important games for his country, but understands that if

he would play him twice for 90 minutes, then probably the player would have been injured," Slot said.

"And that's not always easy for a manager, that he takes care of the interest of a player, so he deserves a big compliment for that. And we will treat Alex the same as they did, so don't expect him to be every single game 90 minutes on the pitch."

"That's definitely not going to happen in the upcoming weeks. He missed a proper pre-season, I think he missed three or four months of team sessions, so now we have to build him up gradually, with us playing so many games, hardly any training time."

Isak criticism

Slot, speaking ahead of Sunday's match against Burnley, brushed off criticism that Isak received after he agitated to leave Newcastle, where he still had three more years to run on his contract.

"Sometimes people cheer for you, so I think after he won the League Cup (trophy last season), everyone was really happy with him," he said.

"And in other moments you get criticised -- this is part of his life, my life, our jobs. Now he's a player for us and I'm really happy with that."

Slot, whose team have won all three of their Premier League matches so far this season, admitted he had been keen to sign Guehi but would not be drawn about any future bid.
