His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa arrived in Egypt yesterday to lead Bahrain's delegation at the Sharm El Sheikh Summit for Peace. HM the King's participation comes at the invitation of Egyptian President Abdel Fattah El Sisi. The summit, hosted by Egypt, is being held to mark the agreement to end the war in Gaza. Upon departure from the Kingdom, HM King Hamad was bid farewell by His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister; H.E. Reham Abdulhamid Mahmoud Ibrahim Khalil, Ambassador of Egypt to Bahrain; and senior officials.

HM King Hamad sets national priorities as fourth legislative session opens

"We begin with focus on the national identity, including its moral principles and values. Foremost among these lessons is upholding national identity, strengthening unity among all components of society, and rejecting manifestations of fanaticism, hatred, and foreign allegiances," he said.

HM the King made the remarks as he inaugurated the fourth session of the sixth legislative term of the Shura and Representatives Councils at the Isa Cultural Centre, in the presence of His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and

Prime Minister.

Development

Innovation roots sustainability and growth

Human resources a core pillar of development

His Excellency Yousif bin Abdulhussain Khalaf, Acting Minister of Legal Affairs and Minister of Labour, affirmed that the Kingdom of Bahrain continues to strengthen its approach of investing in Bahraini human resources as a core pillar of national development.

He emphasised that this is achieved through promoting human development and expanding opportunities for citizens, ensuring their active integration into the labour market and enabling them to contribute to building a more competitive and sustainable national economy.

Government objects to proposal for Ministry-run kindergartens

A proposal to amend the Education Law would require the Ministry of Education to establish kindergartens, support private providers to set them up and oversee them on teaching and administrative matters.

The government has objected, saying the plan runs against Bahrain's education policy and common practice overseas.

The government says the bill's aim is to bring compulsory schooling into the early years by making kindergarten

provision a direct duty of the ministry.

Practice

It points to regional and overseas practice: most countries set six as the compulsory age to start school.

Bahrain does the same, fixing six as the legal age to begin basic education.

The government adds that the ministry already supervises kindergartens, encourages private providers to open them and offers direct and indirect support to institutions and staff to raise service quality and keep provision steady.

Social support 'top priority'

Government says existing aid schemes already meet living-cost goals

The government says its current support programmes for citizens and Bahraini families already achieve the aim of improving living standards, making a new allowance for private-sector workers and the self-employed earning BD1,500 a month or less unnecessary.

In a written reply to Parliament, it said social support remains a top priority, with help for low-income families and their basic needs placed at the centre of development plans.

Bahrain, it added, has long run schemes aimed at strengthening the role of the Bahraini head of household and providing a range of assistance and services to those eligible.

Existing aid covers widows, orphans, divorcees, people with disabilities and those unable to work, abandoned wives, the elderly, prisoners' families, sons



and unmarried daughters.

Households

For low-income households, the cost-of-living allowance is paid in three bands: BD55, BD77 and BD110 a month, depending on the total income of the head of household.

Those under the social security scheme receive additional cash support paid automatically to both individuals and families to help with daily needs.

Other schemes include cash paid in place of the former meat subsidy and a disability allowance of BD100 a month for all disability cases, rising to BD200 for severe cases.

Discounts

Social security beneficiaries also receive a monthly reduction on electricity and water bills, with discounts ranging from BD10 to BD20.

The government concluded

its response by saying it continues to provide the highest possible level of financial help to individuals and families struggling to meet living costs, adding that the objectives of the MPs' recommendation are already being met through existing support programmes.

Ten firms praised for top Bahraini hiring drive

The Ministry of Labour has thanked 10 Bahraini companies for recording the highest hiring of Bahraini staff in the third quarter of 2025, from 1 July to 30 September.

The firms named are Lulu Bahrain Hypermarket, Silah Gulf, McDonald's, Bapco Refining, Day to Day Discount Centre, Quick Zebra Services, Bahrain Airport Services (BAS), Star Manpower Supply, Gulf Air Group Holding and Hajeen food delivery.

According to ministry figures, these 10 companies together

hired 1,453 Bahrainis between January and the end of September 2025.

Lulu Bahrain Hypermarket led the first nine months with 244 Bahraini recruits. McDonald's was next with 220, followed by Silah Gulf with 186.

Gulf Air Group Holding placed fourth with 141 Bahraini hires. 6-Pence HR Solutions ranked fifth with 121, the same number as Bapco Refining (Employees' Branch) in sixth. Bahrain Apparel Trading came seventh with 119. BAS was eighth with 109, Zain Bahrain ninth with 96 and Day to Day Discount Centre tenth with 96.

Road Rage Law Tested

Court to weigh provocation defence

- Student challenges 3-year jail term
- Case rekindles debate on road rage
- Appeal hearing fixed for October 19

A Bahraini student jailed for three years over a violent road-rage incident will return to court this month, in what legal observers say could test how far the law recognises ‘provocation’ as a defence in assault cases.

The High Criminal Court of Appeal has set October 19 for the hearing of the 24-year-old, who was convicted earlier this year for punching another motorist after an argument sparked by what he called ‘prolonged honking’.

Appeal spotlight

The First Instance Court had



sentenced the defendant to three years in prison and fined him BD 50 for damaging the victim’s car. Prosecutors said the assault left the other driver with a five-per-cent permanent disability after suffering a fractured nasal septum.

According to testimony, the confrontation began in the busy Souq Waqif area when the victim honked to alert the student to move his vehicle. The exchange quickly escalated - the defendant allegedly insulted the victim, struck him in the face and kicked his car, shattering the windshield.

Provocation argument

In court, the defendant admitted striking the driver but claimed he acted in anger after being provoked by the continuous horn. A passing police officer testified that he saw the victim bleeding before stepping in to restrain the attacker.

The upcoming appeal is expected to clarify whether such ‘loss of temper’ defences can influence sentencing in violent

traffic disputes.

The Appeal Court’s ruling later this month will decide whether the original sentence stands or if provocation can temper punishment in one of Bahrain’s most talked-about road-rage trials this year.

Verdict Set in BD192k Case

Public funds misuse trial nears conclusion

The First High Criminal Court will deliver its verdict on October 28th in the case of a director of a centre affiliated with the Ministry of Social Development accused of embezzling more than BD192,000, laundering part of the funds, and committing several administrative violations including unlicensed fundraising and contract forgery.

According to the Public Prosecution, the defendant, a public employee, unlawfully seized BD192,351.242 belonging to the ministry by issuing cheques in the names of good-faith individuals before appropriating the funds for himself. He allegedly collected monetary and in-kind donations, such as coupons and Ramadan food baskets, without the required licence or notification to the ministry, diverting part of the donations for his personal benefit.

BD78,188.750 in deposits and transfers through the centre’s accounts and a marked rise in the defendant’s personal transactions compared with his declared income.

The prosecution charged him with aiding a co-defendant, the owner of a labour supply firm, in falsifying contracts for cleaning workers. The forged deal indicated a BD520 monthly rate while the worker’s actual salary was BD140, with the difference allegedly pocketed by the director. The investigation also found he withheld employee wage subsidies during the COVID-19 pandemic, despite ministry funding covering staff salaries.

Misused donations

Auditors discovered that the director had channelled donations to pay bonuses, gifts, and event expenses at the centre, as well as to offer informal loans to social cases. The total value of cheques issued by him reached BD157,256.542, highlighting the alleged scope of embezzlement.

Systematic scheme

Investigators said the director followed a calculated method by signing blank cheques in advance, later issuing them to drivers or staff who withdrew the cash and handed it over to him, after which he deposited the money into his personal bank accounts. Financial analysis between January 2019 and July 2024 showed

Authorities concluded that the accused exploited his official position, misused the centre’s accounts, and conducted unauthorised financial operations outside legitimate ministry oversight. The court is expected to announce its final verdict in the case on October 28th.

Bahrain steps up preparations for Asian Youth Games

“All finals and the opening and closing ceremonies will be broadcast live,” Hussain added, noting that the broadcasting plan follows the highest professional standards to ensure every Bahraini home can share in the Games.

The Asian Youth Games are expected to draw thousands of young athletes from across the continent, turning Bahrain into a regional hub of sporting spirit and media excellence.

Trump issues order to pay military as US shutdown drags on

President Donald Trump said Saturday he had issued an order for the military to be paid next week despite the ongoing government shutdown during which many civil servants are working without salaries. Trump said he had ordered Pentagon chief Pete Hegseth "to use all available funds to get our

Troops PAID on October 15th" as he again blamed Democrats for the funding deadlock now in its second week. "I will not allow the Democrats to hold our Military, and the entire Security of our Nation, HOSTAGE, with their dangerous Government Shutdown," he wrote on his Truth Social platform. With no end in sight for the

shutdown, both political parties are blaming the other for the crisis, and Trump's message Saturday was another salvo in the political feud. The standoff means that hundreds of thousands of government workers have been put on temporary unpaid leave or deemed essential and ordered to work without pay. About 1.3 million active-duty

military personnel had been set to miss their pay next Wednesday -- something that has not happened in any of the US government shutdowns through modern history. Trump's announcement on ensuring military pay came after the White House said Friday it had begun mass layoffs of federal workers, as the president sought to amp up pressure on

Democrats. Trump's budget chief Russ Vought said the administration was following through on threats to fire some of the 750,000 public servants placed on enforced leave. It plans to lay off some 4,000 workers across several government agencies, according to a court filing seeking to block the action. "Republicans would rather

see thousands of Americans lose their jobs than sit down and negotiate with Democrats to reopen the government," top US Senate Democrat Chuck Schumer said. Unions representing 800,000 government employees asked a federal judge in San Francisco for an emergency order to halt the firings, ahead of a hearing set for October 16 on their legality.

‘Watch’ your time to
make progress

The fact that exhibitions of luxury goods and high fashion items couple diamonds, precious gems and jewellery with watches and timepieces should give us all an indication of the value people place on these symbols of aspiration. Often costing the price of a small apartment in a busy metropolis, a top-brand luxury watch is the prism through which many wearers and owners reiterate their self-worth and that's what makes these watches a huge status symbol.

I was quite surprised, therefore, to read of a case where a UAE resident coming to his home country (India) was slapped with a hefty fine by customs officials and his single top-brand wrist watch was valued as being of ‘commercial quantity’ instead of as a personal belonging. The case even went to court but the owner did have to pay a ‘redemption fee’ to get his confiscated time-piece back.

It is understandable that watches designed as items of beauty and precision are regarded as potential heirlooms and even included in inheritances. The Delhi customs was not entirely wrong, in my opinion, in classifying even one highly expensive watch as commercial quantity. After all that watch was worth about BD 5,500 and that sort of money goes a long way in India. Why, even in Bahrain, there is a brisk and legal (if shadowy) trade in gifted luxury watches and older branded watches being sold to make way for trending models.

At the end of the day, though, what matters is not the type of watch you wear or can afford but whether you are a master of managing time. If you cannot plan your time properly and are always turning up late or forgetting meetings, the whole purpose of owning a timepiece, however valuable or humble, will be lost.

Remember every person on this planet has the same 24 hours to achieve his or her goals. How one does it and progresses is governed by how you manage the most finite of resources: your time.

News in brief

◆ **Israel has released** the five remaining Spanish detainees from flotillas it blocked while they were carrying aid and pro-Palestinian activists to devastated Gaza, sources at Spain's foreign ministry said yesterday. Israel has this month intercepted in international waters two flotillas aiming to break its blockade of Gaza, where the United Nations has declared a famine after two years of brutal conflict. Israel arrested the crews, with Swedish climate campaigner Greta Thunberg among the dozens of activists of various nationalities, sparking huge protests in Europe. Israel has been releasing them over recent days, with Spanish foreign ministry sources saying: “The last five members of the flotilla held by Israel are now on their way to Spain.” Among them is a member of the first flotilla who was not included in a first wave of releases after allegedly biting an Israeli prison officer. “There are no more Spaniards from the flotilla detained in Israel,” the ministry sources added. Almost 50 other Spanish flotilla members had returned home during the past week. The activists have complained of mistreatment during their detention in Israel. Israeli authorities have denied the allegations.

Hamas said it had finished preparations for freeing its remaining living hostages, which Israel expects to take place early today, fulfilling a key step in Donald Trump's Gaza plan hours before he hosts a peace summit in Egypt.

Under the US president's proposal, once the Palestinian group have handed over the hostages, Israel is expected to begin releasing around 2,000 detainees in exchange.

But negotiators were still wrangling Sunday over the final arrangements, with two Hamas sources telling AFP the group was insisting that Israel include seven senior Palestinian leaders on the list of those to be released.

Shosh Bedrosian, a spokeswoman for Israeli premier Benjamin Netanyahu's office, said the hostage release “will begin early Monday morning”, with Israel “expecting all 20 of our living hostages to be released together at one time”.

Trump is set to arrive in Israel shortly after the expected release, and will address the Israeli parliament before heading to Egypt to host a meeting of world leaders to back his plan to end the two-year-old Gaza war and promote Middle East peace.



A Gaza ceasefire was holding for a third day, ahead of a US-proposed hostage-prisoner exchange and a summit aimed at charting a path to peace after two years of war.

Israel vows to destroy Gaza tunnels

Israel plans to destroy what remains of Hamas's network of tunnels under Gaza, working with US approval after its hostages are freed, it said yesterday.

Defence Minister Israel Katz said the operation would be conducted under an “internal

mechanism” led by the United States, sponsor of the three-day-old Gaza ceasefire.

“Israel's great challenge after the hostage release phase will be the destruction of all Hamas terrorist tunnels in Gaza,” Katz said in a statement.

“I have ordered the army to prepare to carry out this mission.”

‘Completed all preparations’

“Palestinian prisoners will be released once Israel has confirmation that all of our hostages set to be released are across the border into Israel,” Bedrosian said.

During a previous truce, the identification of deceased hostages was only confirmed after autopsies at Israel's Abu Kabir Forensic Institute.

Two Hamas sources, meanwhile, told AFP the group was insisting Israel free seven prominent Palestinian figures as part of the exchange -- at least one of whom Israel has previously rejected.

“Hamas insists that the final list include seven senior leaders, most notably Marwan Barghouti, Ahmad Saadat, Ibrahim Hamed, and Abbas Al-Sayyed,” one source said, a claim confirmed by the other. Both spoke on condition of anonymity.

The source said that the group and its allies had nevertheless

“completed all preparations” for handing over to Israel all the living hostages held in Gaza.

Under the terms of the plan, Hamas is to release the remaining 47 hostages -- living and dead -- who were abducted on October 7, 2023, during the brutal cross-border Hamas assault that left 1,219 people dead, most of them civilians, and triggered Israel's devastating campaign in Gaza.

Hamas is also expected to hand over remains of a soldier killed in 2014 during a previous Gaza war.

Among the Palestinian prisoners to be released, 250 are security detainees, including many convicted of killing Israelis, while about 1,700 were arrested by the Israeli army in Gaza during the war.

After his Israel visit, Trump and Egyptian President Abdel Fattah al-Sisi will chair a summit of leaders from more than 20 countries in the Egyptian Red Sea resort town of Sharm el-Sheikh.

Meanwhile, unconfirmed reports said prominent Palestinian journalist and social media reporter Saleh Aljafrawi was shot dead in Gaza City on Saturday.

More than 200 trucks carrying aid destined for Gaza, including six diesel fuel trucks and five carrying cooking gas, were unloaded on Sunday at the Kerem Shalom crossing with the Palestinian territory.

HAMAS ATTACKS

On October 7, 2023, hundreds of Hamas fighters storm southern Israel, killing 1,219 people and seizing 251 hostages. Israel says 47 remain, many likely dead.

GROUND OFFENSIVE

Israel besieges Gaza and begins a ground invasion on October 27. Nearly all Gazans are displaced. Over two years, at least 67,183 people are killed, more than half women and children, according to Gaza's health ministry.

TRUCE AND HOSTAGE SWAP

A week-long truce from November 24 sees Hamas release 105 hostages for 240 Palestinian prisoners before fighting resumes in southern Gaza.

REGIONAL ESCALATION

Iran attacks Israel with drones in April 2024. Israel retaliates across Lebanon, Yemen and Iran, killing Hezbollah leader Hassan Nasrallah and Hamas's Ismail Haniyeh. Iran responds with 200 missiles on October 1.

ICC WARRANTS

The UN accuses Israel of “genocidal” warfare in November 2024. The ICC issues warrants for Netanyahu, Gallant and Hamas commander Mohammed Deif.

CEASEFIRES AND PEACE PLAN

A truce on January 19, 2025, frees 33 Israeli hostages for 1,800 Palestinians. Israel later halts aid. After a brief Israel-Iran war in June, Trump announces a peace deal on October 8, 2025, involving hostage releases, Israeli troop redeployment and aid access to Gaza.

Palestinian prisoners to be **freed** after all Gaza hostages in Israel

Israel will begin releasing Palestinian prisoners once it has confirmation that all hostages held in Gaza have arrived in the country, a spokeswoman for the prime minister said Sunday.

"Palestinian prisoners will be released once Israel has confirmation that all of our hostages set to be released tomorrow are across the border into Israel," Shosh Bedrosian told journalists.

During previous ceasefires, the remains of some hostages were identified by forensic experts after their return to Israel.

Bedrosian said that pending the identification, the Palestinian prisoners would be on buses ready to depart.

"As soon as we have confirmation that they (hostages) have entered Israeli territory, those buses will depart and begin their journey," she said.

She said the release of all hostages held in the Gaza Strip for more than two years was expected to begin early Monday morning.

Under the terms of the plan, Hamas is to release by Monday noon the remaining 47 hostages (living and dead) who were abducted on October 7.

It is also expected to hand

over the remains of a soldier killed in 2014 during a previous Gaza war.

During the last truce, the identification of deceased hostages was only confirmed after autopsies at Israel's Abu Kabir Forensic Institute.

"We are expecting all 20 of our living hostages to be released together at one time to the Red Cross and transported among six to eight vehicles," Bedrosian said.

"The hostages will then be driven to forces inside of Israeli-controlled parts of Gaza and then transferred to the Reim base in southern Israel, where they will then reunite

with their families." They will then be taken to "one of three main hospitals".

"Ten hostages will be sent to Sheba Medical Center, five hostages at Beilinson, and five hostages will receive treatment at Ichilov," Bedrosian said, referring to three hospitals in central Israel that have been equipped to receive the released captives.

As for the Palestinian prisoners to be released, 250 are security detainees, including many convicted of killing Israelis, while about 1,700 were detained by the Israeli military in Gaza after the war broke out.

China, Philippines trade blame over boat collision in disputed sea

The Philippines said a Chinese ship deliberately rammed one of its government vessels in the disputed South China Sea yesterday, although Beijing blamed Manila for the incident.

Confrontations between Philippine and Chinese vessels occur frequently in the contested waterway, which Beijing claims nearly in its entirety despite an international ruling that its assertion has no legal basis.

The Philippines said a Chinese coast guard ship "fired its water cannon" at the BRP Datu Pagbuaya, a vessel belonging to Manila's fisheries bureau, at 9:15 am (0115 GMT) on Sunday.

"Just three minutes later... the

same (Chinese) vessel deliberately rammed the stern" of the Philippine boat, "causing minor structural damage but no injuries to the crew", the Philippine coast guard said in a statement.

It said the incident took place near Thitu Island, part of the Spratly Islands where Beijing has sought to assert its sovereignty claims for years.

Iran says got message via Russia that **Israel not looking for new war**

Iran's foreign minister said on Saturday that Russia had relayed a message from Israel that it was not looking for a new war with the Islamic republic.

"Apparently three or four days

ago there was a telephone call between (Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin) Netanyahu and (Russian President Vladimir) Putin," Abbas Araghchi said. "Netanyahu emphasised that he had no intention of re-starting a war with Iran," he

said, adding that the message was relayed to Tehran's ambassador in Russia.

Iran and Israel fought a 12-day war in June that began when Israel launched unprecedented strikes on Iranian nuclear and military installations.

Fruit for Thought!

It was a hectic trip and a long vacation away from Bahrain. All I wanted after landing was a quick nap at home. But as I reached my gate, there stood my neighbour and dear friend, Sunil George, smiling warmly — holding a large, golden mango in his hand.

"This is the last one," he said. "I was waiting for you to come back."

In our compound, everyone keeps an eye on Sunil's backyard — not for gossip, but to catch a glimpse of that little mango tree that defies the desert odds. Every year, it gifts him nothing less than 30 to 50 mangoes, each one juicier than the last.

I always thought the bigger the mango, the less the taste. But Sunil proved me wrong — it was full of flavour, soft, and so sweet that one fruit was enough for two people.

Sunil spends much of his free time tending to his plants after work. On Fridays, while I'm still resting, I often see him through my French window — busy with his domestic assistant, watering, trimming, and caring for his plants. He even once managed to grow a coconut tree in his old compound. When the villa was demolished for redevelopment, his greatest worry wasn't about the house — it was about losing that coconut tree that stood tall and greeted every guest.

That night, as I cut the mango before heading to bed, one thought kept circling in my mind — if Sunil can do this, why not others? Bahrain's climate may be challenging, but with care and patience, it rewards those who try.

Imagine if our municipalities and corporate houses joined hands to create fruit corridors — stretches of roadside land or open spaces filled with mango, papaya, banana, guava, pomegranate, fig, and lemon trees. Even small vegetable patches featuring cherry tomatoes, carrots, or brinjals could make our city greener and happier.

Each section could be adopted by a company and cared for as part of its social responsibility. The Agriculture Ministry could even introduce an annual award for the best plantation project. It would be a refreshing sight — fruit-bearing trees offering shade, beauty, and joy to residents and tourists alike.

If we can create even 10 kilometres of such a fruit and vegetable corridor in Bahrain, it could become a unique tourist attraction — a living symbol of sustainability and community spirit.

There may be thousands like me waiting to taste those fruits — but what we truly need are more people like Sunil to make it happen.

Automated border checks **start in Europe**

The aim of the new system is to eventually replace the manual stamp on passports

From Sunday, non-EU travellers entering Europe's Schengen open-borders zone will be photographed and fingerprinted at border crossings, as the European Union rolls out its much-delayed automated border checks.

The aim of the new system is to eventually replace the manual stamp on passports and secure better information-sharing between the bloc's 27 states.

The border-check system will allow authorities to know when

people entered and exited a country, with the goal of better detecting anyone overstaying and people refused entry.

Hotly debated for nearly a decade, the system has raised concerns among transport providers and passengers, who fear it could lead to longer queues at airports and train stations.

To limit disruptions, there will

be a phased rollout.

The first phase begins on Sunday.

Non-EU nationals arriving for short stays in EU countries -- except Cyprus and Ireland -- will be asked for their passport number, to provide fingerprints and have their photo taken at automated kiosks.

The same requirements will

apply in Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway -- members of the European Economic Area including the EU -- and Switzerland.

Phased-in

The bloc's biggest countries, including France and Germany, will initially carry out only limited checks in a bid to avoid huge queues at airports.

Some smaller member states have the system fully in place from Sunday.

The member states will have until mid-April to use automated checks for all passengers at their borders.

All eyes will be on the UK border as British nationals -- no longer EU citizens after Brexit -- will also be subject to the new checks.

UK authorities have already warned Britons each passenger will have to wait a few extra minutes before they can enter Schengen territory.

The Channel Tunnel's operator Getlink and train service Eurostar had expressed confidence they were ready and the system would run smoothly.

Checks were being carried out for passengers in Britain before they cross the border, especially at London's St Pancras station and the port of Dover. Terminals had already been installed.

ETIAS scheme coming

The EU executive has said there will be information campaigns to streamline the implementation of the Entry/Exit System (EES).

"EES will contribute to prevent irregular migration and help protect the security of everyone living in or travelling to Europe,"

it said.

The next phase in the EU's border overhaul will be the launch of an electronic travel authorisation document, known by its acronym ETIAS, similar to the United States' ESTA or its British equivalent.

Under ETIAS, citizens of visa-exempt countries travelling to the EU would have to complete an online form and pay a small fee -- whose amount is still under discussion.

Madagascar installs armed forces chief chosen by mutinying unit

Madagascar's armed forces minister on Sunday recognised as new head of the army an officer chosen by a military contingent siding with protesters demanding the departure of President Andry Rajoelina. General Demosthene Pikulas was installed as chief of the Army Staff during a ceremony at the army headquarters attended by armed forces minister, Manantsoa Deramasinjaka Rakotoarivelo.

in more than two weeks of anti-government demonstrations that erupted on September 25.

The unit, which played a major role in a 2009 coup that brought Rajoelina to power, on Saturday declared it would "refuse orders to shoot" on the demonstrators.

Soldiers then entered the city centre to meet several thousand protesters, who welcomed them with jubilation and praise. Yesterday morning they claimed in a video statement that "from now on, all orders of the Malagasy army -- whether land, air or the navy -- will originate from CAPSAT headquarters".

They named General Demosthene Pikulas as the head of the army, although it was not clear if the posting could be considered official. There was no immediate response from other units or the existing military command.

"We will prevail, because evil will not prevail in Madagascar," CAPSAT Colonel Michael Randrianirina said at prayers held later Sunday to remember people who died in the upheaval, including a soldier said to have been killed in clashes the previous day with the gendarmerie.

Afghanistan, Pakistan say forces killed dozens in border clashes

● **Pakistani military said 23 of its soldiers and more than 200 Taliban and affiliated troops were killed**

● **Taliban government spokesman said that 58 Pakistani soldiers were killed and around 30 wounded in the clashes**

● **Key border crossings between the countries were closed yesterday**

Afghanistan and Pakistan said yesterday they killed dozens of each other's troops during a night of heavy border clashes between the two countries.

Afghanistan's Taliban forces launched attacks on Pakistani troops along their shared border late on Saturday, in what it called "retaliation for air strikes carried out by the Pakistani army on Kabul" on Thursday.

Islamabad has not directly claimed responsibility for the strikes, but has repeatedly stated the right to defend itself against surging militancy that it says is planned from Afghan soil.

The two sides have repeatedly clashed in border regions since

the Taliban seized control of Afghanistan in 2021, but airspace violations deep into Afghan territory would mark a significant escalation.

Zabihullah Mujahid, the Taliban government spokesman, said yesterday that 58 Pakistani soldiers were killed and around 30 wounded in the clashes, while nine Taliban forces were killed.

The Pakistani military, meanwhile, said 23 of its soldiers and more than 200 Taliban and affil-

iated troops were killed.

AFP was unable to independently verify the casualty figures.

Afghan Foreign Minister Amir Khan Muttaqi said on Sunday the "situation is under control".

"Our operation last night achieved its objectives. And then our friends like Qatar and Saudi Arabia appealed that war must stop now, and the war is ceased right now," he said during a visit to India.

An Afghan military unit described Thursday's blasts in the capital as "air strikes", but Mujahid instead said the incident was an "airspace violation", adding that no damage had been found.

'Strong' response

Pakistan Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif said yesterday he "strongly condemns provocations" by Afghanistan.

"There will be no compromise on Pakistan's defence, and every provocation will be met with a strong and effective response," Sharif said in a statement, accusing Taliban authorities in Afghanistan of allowing their land to be used by "terrorist elements". The Afghan military said on Saturday night that Taliban forces were engaged "in heavy clashes against Pakistani security forces in various areas".

Several border security officials told AFP that no further clashes had been reported at major crossings on Sunday morning.

Key border crossings between the countries were closed on Sunday, officials said.

Extra troops have been sent to the major border crossing at Torkham, which sits on the frontier between Kabul and Islamabad. Pakistani officials at Torkham, who requested anonymity, told AFP there had been no casualties on their side of the border crossing and that no further clashes had been reported in the area on Sunday morning.

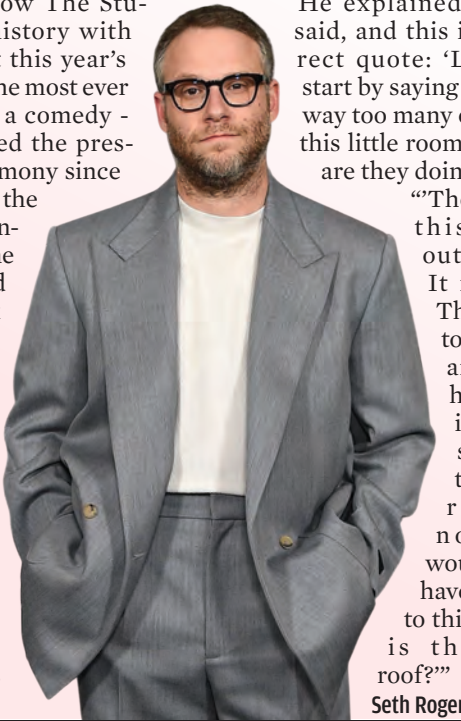
Seth Rogen 'banned' from hosting Emmy Awards and he knows why

In her interview with host Zane Lowe, Taylor also discussed how her music often reflects her personal state of mind.

She said: "Often-times, an album is a really, really wild way to look at yourself.

What you're going through in your life is going to affect whether you relate to the music that I'm putting out at any given moment."

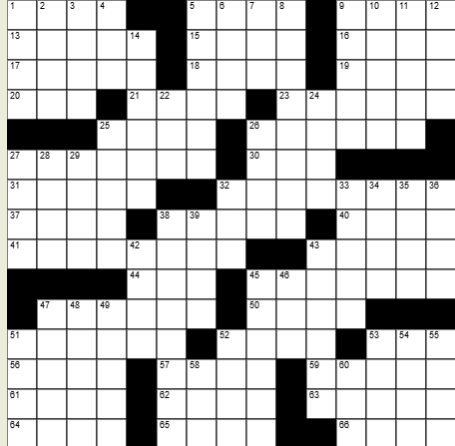

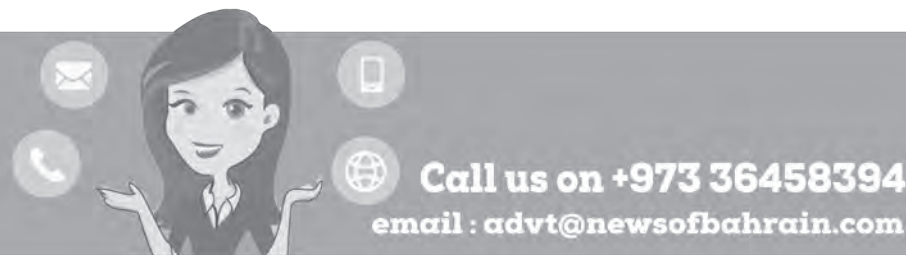

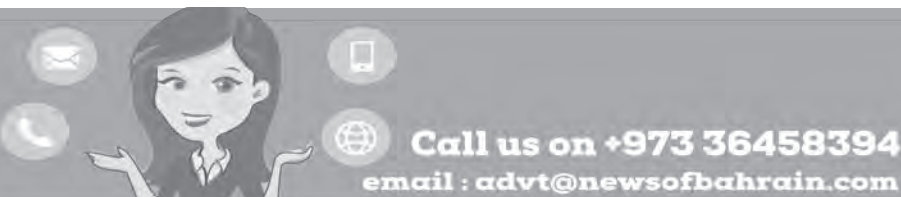

Originally scheduled for 2017 in Hambantota, Sri Lanka, they were re-awarded to Jakarta, Indonesia, but eventually cancelled by the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA). The 2021 edition, first awarded to Surabaya, Indonesia, and later to Shantou, China, was also cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Uzbekistan was later awarded the Games for September 7-17, 2025, but withdrew in December 2024 due to infrastructure delays caused by the pandemic. 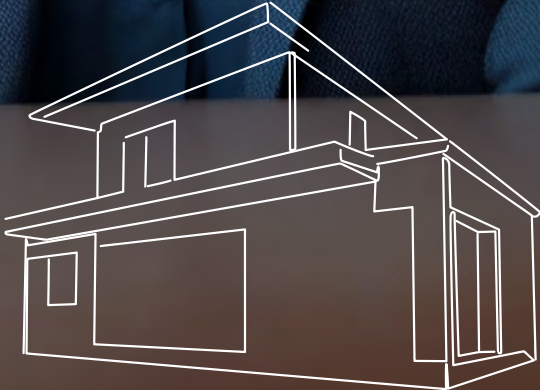
