Bahrain condemns deadly terrorist blasts in Pakistan

The Kingdom of Bahrain condemned and denounced the bombing that took place in Pakistan.

The attacks targeted a court building in the capital, Islamabad, and a cadet college in the Wana district of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province in the northwest of the country, resulting in the death and injury of several innocent people.

A statement issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs extended Bahrain's condolences and sympathy to the government and people of Pakistan, as well as to the families of the victims, and wished a speedy recovery to those injured.
