Iran arrests Nobel-prize winning activist Narges Mohammadi: supporters

Iranian security forces yesterday "violently" arrested the 2023 Nobel Peace Prize winner Narges Mohammadi at a memorial ceremony for a lawyer who died earlier this month, her supporters said.

Mohammadi, who was granted temporary leave from prison in December 2024, was detained along with several other activists at the ceremony for lawyer Khosrow Alikordi, who was found dead in his office last week, her foundation wrote on X. Also writing on X, Mohammadi's Paris-based husband, Taghi Rahmani, said she had been arrested at the ceremony in the eastern city of Mashhad along with fellow prominent activist Sepideh Gholian.

Former Iraqi president Salih appointed new UNHCR chief

Former Iraqi president Barham Salih will become the next United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, a UN source told yesterday, taking over an agency tackling swingeing budget cuts.

Salih was president of Iraq from 2018 to 2022. He will take over as UN refugees chief next month from Filippo Grandi, who is leaving at the end of December after 10 years in the post.

Germany blames Russia for cyberattack

Germany yesterday accused Russia of a cyberattack targeting its air traffic control and spreading disinformation ahead of February's general election, charges dismissed by Russia as "absurd" and "baseless".

A German foreign ministry spokesman said security services had proof that hacker groups run by Russia's military intelligence service GRU were responsible for the attack and influence operations.

Rehabilitation not employment

Government amendment replaces term 'employment'

● New amendment would make rehabilitation and training compulsor

● Draft covers civil liability for injuries or illnesses

● Cabinet approved the draft on 17 November 2025

Rehabilitation and training programmes could soon become compulsory for prisoners in Bahrain, under a new government-drafted amendment now before Parliament.

The proposed change replaces the previous term "employment" with "rehabilitation and training", signalling a shift in focus from prison labour to structured, skills-based programmes

Under the United Nations Standard Minimum Rules for the Treatment of Prisoners (the Mandela Rules), rehabilitation is considered a core purpose of imprisonment. The UN emphasises that prisons should not simply detain people but must actively prepare inmates for reintegration through education, vocational training and personal development programmes.

aimed at reintegration.

The Foreign Affairs, Defence and National Security Committee has been assigned as the main panel to review the amendment, while the Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee will also provide input.

Under the new text, all inmates would be required to take part in rehabilitation and training programmes, except for remand detainees and those

whose medical conditions prevent participation. Where possible, the programmes should match an inmate's existing craft or professional background.

Executive regulations would define the types of programmes offered, their duration, maximum working hours, allowances and eligibility criteria. They would also outline the conditions for training conducted outside correctional centres,

in coordination with relevant authorities.

The draft further addresses civil liability, stating that inmates would be protected in cases of occupational injuries or professional illnesses arising during participation in rehabilitation and training activities.

A memorandum from the Legislation and Legal Opinion Commission links the amendment to remarks from the International Labour Organization's expert committee, which had raised concerns about provisions that could amount to compulsory labour when imposed alongside imprisonment. The memo notes that Bahrain, which joined the convention on the abolition of forced labour in 1998, is responding to those concerns through the proposed changes.

The Cabinet approved the draft for referral to the legislative authority on 17 November 2025. If passed by both chambers and ratified, the amendments would take effect the day after their publication in the Official Gazette.

Israel bans mobile phones in primary schools

Israel will ban children from using mobile phones in primary schools from February, the education ministry's website said Friday, emphasising the devices' "negative effects" on students.

In implementing the ban, Israel will join a growing number of countries moving to prevent children from accessing their phones while in educational establishments.

"From February 2, a new policy will be implemented in primary schools: children will be prohibited from using mobile phones on school premises," the education ministry said in a statement.

Messi to unveil 21-metre statue of himself on India 'GOAT' tour

Lionel Messi will unveil a 21-metre (70-foot) statue of himself in India today as he embarks on a three-day tour of the country that has sparked a fan frenzy.

The iron sculpture in Kolkata, which shows Messi holding aloft the World Cup, is part of a so-called GOAT Tour that will take in four Indian cities and a possible meeting with Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

The 38-year-old Argentina and Inter Miami superstar will unveil the monument virtually rather than in person for security reasons.

Bahrain set for rain, thunder and a sharp winter chill

Bahrain is gearing up for an unsettled stretch of weather, with scattered rain, gusty winds, thick clouds

and a noticeable drop in temperatures expected over the coming days.

Several parts of Muharraq, the Northern Governorate, Riffa and

Sitra were splashed by light to moderate showers yesterday, as a low-pressure system tightened its grip on the kingdom. Its impact became more pronounced



Similar weather across the GCC

Saudi Arabia, the United Arab Emirates and other Gulf Cooperation Council member states are also experiencing similar turbulent weather patterns.

Saudi Arabia's National Centre for Meteorology (NCM) has forecast moderate to heavy thunderstorms capable of triggering flash floods, accompanied by hail and strong winds. Regions including Makkah, Madinah, Qassim, Riyadh, the Eastern Province and the Northern Borders are expected to be affected. Wind speeds could reach 40km/h and occasionally touch 50km/h.

In the UAE, residents have been alerted to prepare for a week of shifting weather as cloudy skies, scattered rainfall and gusty winds take hold. The NCM said the country is entering a spell of unstable conditions driven by surface and upper-level low-pressure systems.

Qatar Meteorology reported that cloud cover is expected to increase across the country from Friday, December 12, continuing through next week—signalling more unsettled weather in the region.

Kuwait, in its latest update, said it too would see scattered rainfall over the weekend, along with the possibility of evening fog.

Wind: Variable mainly Northerly 7 to 12 knots with gusts may reach 25 knots by afternoon.

Sea State: 1 to 3 feet rising up to 6 feet offshore during gusts.

Temperature: Maximum 27°C, Minimum 29°C.

Humidity: Maximum 85%, Minimum 45%.

last night and is set to continue today.

According to the Meteorological Directorate at the Ministry of Transportation and Communications, thunderstorms accompanied by strong gusts of wind are possible, with skies turning partly cloudy to overcast. Residents are advised to brace for a chill as temperatures dip through the weekend, with partly cloudy conditions expected until tomorrow. Chances of scattered rain are set to linger into Monday as well.

Municipal councils and municipalities say they are on full alert, coordinating with relevant authorities and preparing for any contingencies to ensure smooth traffic flow and safeguard lives and property.

The Coast Guard Command has urged sea-goers to exercise caution amid rain and winds, while the General Directorate of Traffic is calling on motorists to drive carefully, maintain safe distances, follow proper lane discipline and avoid distractions on the road. Forecasters say temperatures will begin sliding from Saturday, with a cold wave arriving on Monday. During this period, temperatures could fall below 16°C, paired with humidity levels climbing above 95%.

Faulty custom furniture?

Consumers now have the right to refuse and refund

- Buyers can file complaints legally
- They may demand a refund
- Law requires suppliers to comply
- Civil code protects consumer rights

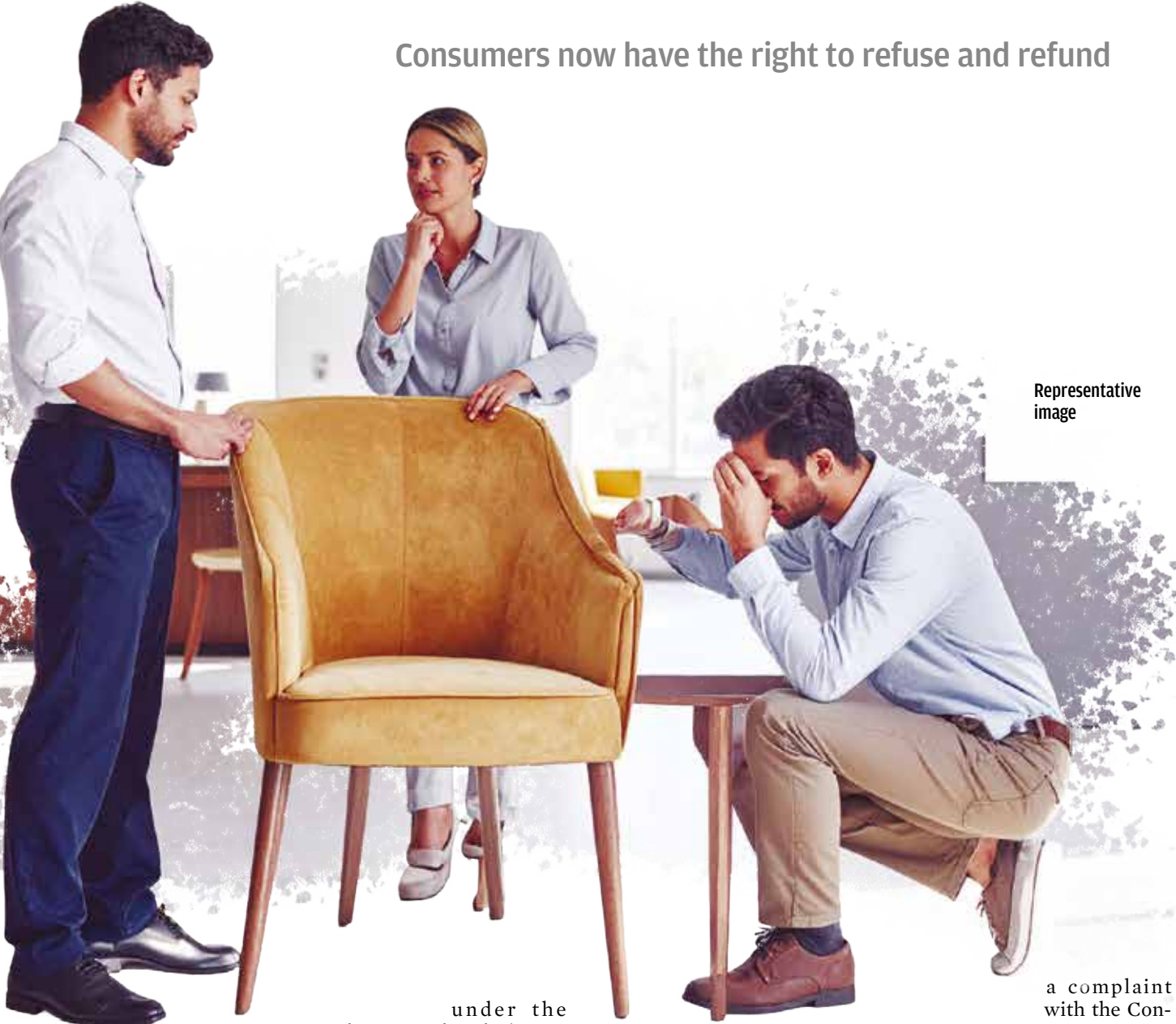

Shoppers ordering custom-made furniture have a clear right to reject the final product and claim a refund if the delivered item differs significantly from what they paid for, lawyer Jassim Al Essa has told The Daily Tribune.

His comments come amid rising complaints from customers who say finished pieces often don't match the specifications, design or quality they agreed to.

According to Al Essa, the key issue is the extent of the mismatch and whether it undermines the purpose of the purchase—especially in cases where the shop refuses to redo the work. “In such situations, the buyer can insist that the contract be fulfilled as agreed, or move to terminate it and seek compensation for any damages,” he explained.

He pointed to Article 8 of the Consumer Protection Law (Law No. 35 of 2012), which obliges

suppliers to replace defective or non-conforming goods—or take them back and refund the full price—at no extra cost to the consumer.

Al Essa added that custom-made furniture orders fall

under the Bahraini Civil Code (Law No. 19 of 2001), either as a contract for work or as a sale of goods to be delivered later according to a set description. In both cases, the seller is legally required to provide items that match the agreed specifications, and major deviations amount to a serious

breach. If faced with a faulty delivery, the buyer should formally notify the seller that the goods are being rejected due to non-conformity and request a full refund. Should the seller fail to respond, the consumer can file a complaint with the Consumer Protection Directorate.

For those pursuing civil action, Al Essa cited Article 140/A of the Civil Code, which allows the non-breaching party to ask the court—after proper notice—to enforce the contract or rescind it, with compensation

where applicable. Buyers may send notice through registered mail with proof of receipt, giving the seller seven days to reply before proceeding to court.

If the contract is rescinded, Articles 142/A and 147 require both parties to be restored to the positions they held before the agreement, in line with the Civil Code's rules on termination and rescission.

Police have arrested two more Chinese nationals aboard a flight that was about to take off, in connection with a gold jewellery theft at a private residence in Bahrain valued at approximately BD 50,000.

The arrests followed after police recovered more stolen gold jewellery from suspects initially arrested. The Ministry of Interior confirmed the arrests, stating that the General Directorate of Criminal Investigation and Forensic Science continued its investigation following the first apprehensions at Bahrain International Airport. The detainees have been referred to the Public Prosecution for further action.

October imports top 2.65 billion kg, valued at **BD 520 million**

Bahrain imported over 2.65 billion kilograms of goods in October 2025, with the total value reaching approximately BD 520 million, according to data from the Bahrain Open Data Portal released by the Information and eGovernment Authority.

In US dollars, the import bill for the month stood at around \$1.388 billion, offering a snapshot of the wide-ranging trade flows entering the country during the period.

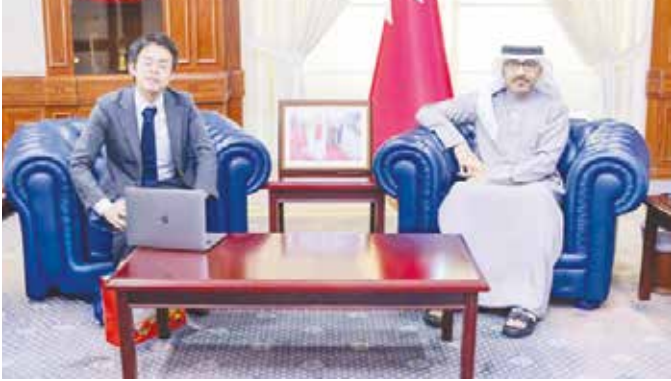
The recorded imports spanned more than 2,315 billion



units, covering a diverse mix of goods, including raw materials, industrial products, and food items. Key trading partners listed for October included Belgium, France, the Sultanate of Oman, and Somalia, among others.

Notable imports for the month included livestock and specialty animals such as sport horses, cows, and goats. The shipments also featured iron and steel products, mixed fruits and vegetables, household and institutional electrical appliances, plastic goods, decorative items, and jewellery, reflecting Bahrain's varied import needs.

14th GCC-EU Economic Dialogue



Dr. Mohammed Ali Behzad, Ambassador of Bahrain to Belgium, led the Kingdom's delegation at the 14th GCC-EU Economic Dialogue, convened yesterday at the European Commission in Brussels. The GCC Secretariat's delegation was headed by Dr. Abdulaziz bin Hamad Al Owaishek, GCC Assistant Secretary-General for Foreign Affairs, Political Affairs, and Negotiations. The EU side was led by Annika Ericsgård, Director for International Economic and Financial Relations and Global Governance, with participation from senior experts and officials from both the GCC and the European Union. Dr. Behzad noted that the dialogue has become an important forum for deepening cooperation between the GCC and the EU, particularly as both sides look to address shared economic pressures, support sustainable growth and identify new areas for partnership in trade, investment and clean energy.

Tenders opened for school repairs, power station upgrade, and classroom furniture

Five public tenders have been opened by the Tender Board, drawing 22 bids in total. One of them, from the Ministry of Works, seeks a full overhaul of Dair Primary Intermediate Girls School. The minis-

try said the job covers civil and building work such as internal and external painting, repairing cracks, fixing ceilings and floors, repairing or replacing doors and windows, and refurbishing bathrooms.

It said the package also includes mechanical work to upgrade water networks and

replace water tanks, alongside electrical work to refurbish the electrical room, replace distribution boards and lighting, and renew the fire system. Six bids were received, with the lowest at BD491,000.

The Electricity and Water Authority has also put out a tender to upgrade a 66kV feed-

er relay panel at main power transmission stations that have been running for more than 20 years. Four bids were received, with the lowest at BD253,000.

In a second tender, the authority's General Services and Central Stores Directorate is seeking the supply of water fittings (bend, tee and

puddle flange). Two bids were submitted, with the lowest at BD138,000.

The Ministry of Education, meanwhile, is seeking durable, high-quality classroom furniture, saying the request covers all classroom furniture and related items and must meet the technical specifications and

safety standards in the tender conditions. Five bids were received, with the lowest at BD69,000.

Bapco Refining has also floated a tender to buy column trays for the 4ACDU unit for maintenance and inspection work in 2027. It received five bids, with the lowest at BD62,000.

EU agrees three-euro **small parcel tax** to tackle China flood

Last year, 4.6 billion small retail packages entered the European Union

EU finance ministers agreed yesterday to impose a three-euro duty on low-value imports into the bloc from July 2026 to help tackle a flood of small parcels ordered via the likes of Shein and Temu. Last year, 4.6 billion small retail packages entered the European Union -- more than 145 per second -- with 91% originating in China and their numbers expected to keep rising. Starting at three euros, the new fee will apply once per item in cases where packages contain different products, but only once if they contain multiples of the same item, a spokesperson for

the European Council told AFP. The move comes a month after the EU agreed to scrap a duty exemption for parcels worth less than 150 euros (\$174) imported directly to consumers in the 27-nation bloc, in many cases via Chinese-founded platforms. The levy will be introduced on a temporary basis starting July 1, staying in place until the bloc can settle on a permanent solution for taxing such imports. "This temporary measure

responds to the fact that such parcels currently enter the EU duty free, leading to unfair competition for EU sellers, health and safety risks for consumers, high levels of fraud and environmental concerns," the Council,

which represents EU member states, said in a statement.

'Major victory'

European retailers argue they face unfair competition from overseas platforms, such as AliExpress, Shein and Temu, which they claim do not always comply with the EU's stringent rules on products.

Key EU power France has made the matter a priority, given the around 800 million such packages shipped to the country last year and strong domestic pressure to take action.

French Finance Minister Roland Lescure welcomed the flat tax as "a major victory for the European Union".

"Europe is taking concrete steps to protect its single market, its consumers and its sovereignty," he said.

The move comes as the EU strives to bolster the continent's competitiveness by making the lives of European businesses easier through slashing red tape.

Alongside ending the duty exemption, the EU executive in May proposed a small package handling fee worth two euros.

EU member states have yet to agree on the level of that fee, but hope it will apply from late 2026.

Fed up with waiting, some states have already moved forward with their own plans, including Romania, which has imposed a five-euro fee on small parcels.



Global parcel shipments have exploded in recent years – the world now sends over 170 billion parcels a year, and this volume is expected to surpass 250 billion parcels annually by 2027, driven largely by e-commerce and same-day delivery services.

Europe agrees recycled plastic targets for cars

Carmakers will have to meet the target in 10 years

Car manufacturers in Europe will have to include more recycled plastics in new vehicles under new EU rules agreed on by the bloc's countries and lawmakers yesterday.

European Union governments and parliament representatives reached an early morning deal to mandate that at least 25 percent of plastics used in cars, trucks and motorcycles has been recycled.

Carmakers will have to meet the mandatory target in 10 years, with an intermediate 15 percent goal in six years, according to the European Council representing member states.

At least 20% of the recycled materials will have to be sourced from old, scrap vehicles.

"This provisional agreement marks a significant step towards a circular economy for the European automotive sec-

tor," said Magnus Heunicke, environment minister for Denmark, which holds the EU's rotating presidency.

Vehicle manufacturing accounts for 10% of the EU's overall consumption of plastics, and is responsible for 19% of demand for the bloc's steel industry, according to Brussels.

The deal is provisional and needs to be officially endorsed by the European Council representing member states and the parliament before it is formally adopted. It also instructs the European Commission to set future targets for recycled steel, aluminium, magnesium and critical raw materials and bans the export of old vehicles that are no longer roadworthy.

Musk signals plan to launch IPO for SpaceX

AFP | New York, United States

Elon Musk has signaled plans to soon seek a public stock listing of SpaceX, confirming a report that links the strategic shift to a near-term need for more capital.

Musk, who is also the CEO of Tesla among other ventures, described as "accurate" a report in online publication Ars Technica outlining the controversial billionaire's embrace of a public listing as a way to access capital to finance the building of artificial intelligence data centers in space.

Ars Technica characterized the embrace of an IPO as a "major change in thinking" for Musk, who had previously resisted a public listing for SpaceX.

His comment comes on the heels of recent reports in US media that SpaceX stands poised in 2026 or 2027 for a record-setting initial public offering valuing the company at \$1.5 trillion.

Musk had previously op-

posed an IPO for SpaceX because "he has not enjoyed the public scrutiny of Tesla, and feared that shareholder desires for financial return were not consistent with his ultimate goal of settling Mars," wrote Ars Technica senior space editor Eric Berger in a December 10 article.

"As usual, Eric is accurate," Musk posted later Wednesday on X, another part of the tech mogul's business empire.

SpaceX is moving ahead with an IPO that would seek to raise "significantly more than \$30 billion," Bloomberg reported on Tuesday, citing unnamed sources.

OpenAI beefs up GPT models in AI race with Google

San Francisco, United States

OpenAI released its latest artificial intelligence models on Thursday, shrugging off worries about how it will cash in on massive spending in its technology race with Google.

The San Francisco-based AI superstar touted GPT-5.2 Pro and GPT-5.2 Thinking as its best models yet for handling math or science work.

"Strong mathematical reasoning is a foundation for reliability in scientific and technical work," OpenAI said in a blog post. "These capabilities are also closely tied to progress toward general intelligence."

Artificial general intelligence has become a holy grail of sorts in the tech world, seen as a threshold where machines think the way people do or even better. The release comes on

the heels of OpenAI chief executive Sam Altman urging his team to strive to keep up with Google, the search engine juggernaut that has been relentlessly innovating in AI.

While Google can tap into its massive online ad revenue to invest in AI, OpenAI has been committing tens of billions of dollars to computing infrastructure while having yet to turn a profit.

North Korea’s Kim vows to root
out ‘evil’, scolds lazy officials

North Korean leader Kim Jong Un has vowed to root out “evil” and scolded lazy officials while praising his troops fighting with Russia against Ukraine, state media said yesterday, capping a major meeting of Pyongyang’s top brass.

The three-day meeting of the regime’s central committee discussed key policy issues as well as plans for a congress of its ruling party, expected in early 2026 -- North Korea’s first in five years.

Wrapping up the meeting on Thursday, Kim condemned “the wrong ideological viewpoint and inactive and irresponsible work attitude” of some officials, the state-run Korean Central News Agency (KCNA) said.

He called on officials to have “greater confidence in and courage for the future of our cause and struggle”.

State media did not offer specifics, though it did say the ruling party had revealed nu-

merous recent “deviations” in discipline -- a euphemism for corruption.

The North Korean leader reserved praise for Pyongyang’s soldiers fighting against Ukraine alongside Russia, of whom at least 600 have died and thousands more sustained wounds, according to South Korean estimates.

Their work, Kim said, “demonstrated to the world the prestige of our army and state as the ever-victorious army and genuine protector of international justice”.

Analysts say Pyongyang is receiving financial aid, military technology, food and energy supplies from Russia in return for sending troops.

Kim’s mention of the troops “signalled Pyongyang’s intention to maintain that deployment”, Ahn Chan-il, a researcher originally from North Korea, told AFP.

“North Korea is also highly likely to seek a role in post-war reconstruction in Russia once... the conflict ends,” he added.

Ukraine’s EU bid gains US backing: official

US-led peace plan could see Ukraine join the European Union as early as 2027

Ukraine could join the European Union as early as January 2027 under the latest US plan to end the war with Russia, a senior source familiar with the matter said yesterday.

The complicated EU accession process usually takes years and requires a unanimous vote from all 27 members of the bloc, and some countries, most notably Hungary, have consistently voiced opposition to Ukraine joining.

The idea of a speedy accession is included in the latest version of a US-led plan to end the war, which would also see Ukraine cede land to Russia, and has triggered a diplomatic frenzy across Europe in recent weeks.

“It’s stated there but it’s a matter for negotiation, and the Americans support it,” the senior official, speaking on condition of anonymity, said, referring to the US plan.

Washington has the leverage needed to convince leaders opposed to Ukraine’s membership to change their stance, President Volodymyr Zelensky told journalists, including AFP, on

Thursday.

“The United States can take steps to unblock our path to the European Union,” he said, adding that “the US president has various levers of influence and that this will have an effect on those who are currently blocking Ukraine.”

Kyiv has long strived for EU membership and has been implementing reforms since a pro-European 2014 revolution but has struggled to eradicate endemic corruption -- a core prerequisite for joining the bloc.

After completing a diplomatic tour across Europe last week, Zelensky was due in Berlin on

Monday for more talks on the plan, full details of which have not been released.

“If the security situation allows, he’ll be there”, the senior official said.

Moscow yesterday indicated it was suspicious about the efforts to amend the US plan, which it has largely been supportive of and heeded to most of its core demands.

“We have an impression that this version, which is being put forward for discussion, will be worsened,” Kremlin foreign policy aide Yuri Ushakov told the Kommersant business daily.

Nobel laureate Machado feared for her life leaving Venezuela

Venezuelan opposition leader Maria Corina Machado, winner of the 2025 Nobel Peace Prize, feared for her life during her secret journey from Venezuela to Norway to receive the award, she said yesterday.

“There were moments when I felt that there was a real risk to my life, and it was also a very spiritual moment because, in the end, I simply felt that I was in God’s hands and that whatever would be, would be,” she told reporters in Oslo.

She declined to give precise details about how she managed to leave Venezuela, where she has lived in hiding since last year, to protect those involved -- following dramatic accounts of her journey in US media.

“We did get support from the United States government to get here,” Machado told a press conference on Thursday, when asked by AFP about whether Washington had helped.

The Wall Street Journal reported this week that she wore a wig and a disguise on the high-

risk journey, leaving her hide-out in a Caracas suburb on Monday for a coastal fishing village, where she took a fishing skiff across the Caribbean Sea to Curacao.

The newspaper said the US

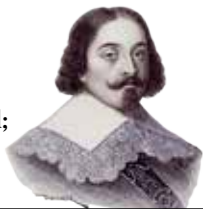

US slaps sanctions on Maduro relatives as war fears build

Washington expands pressure campaign with sanctions, naval actions and tanker seizure

● Six Venezuelan oil shippers blacklisted

The United States imposed sanctions against relatives of Venezuelan leader Nicolas Maduro and six companies shipping the South American country’s oil.

The move came as the White House said it will bring an oil tanker seized by American forces off the Venezuelan coast to a port in the United States, adding to growing fears of open conflict between the two countries.

President Donald Trump’s administration has been piling pressure on Venezuela for months, with a major naval buildup in the region that has been accompanied by deadly strikes on alleged drug-trafficking boats, killing nearly 90 people.

In a dramatic raid this week that Homeland Security Secretary Kristi Noem said was aimed at Maduro’s “regime,” Washing-

ton took control of the tanker, with US forces roping down from a helicopter onto the vessel.

Caracas condemned the raid as “an act of international piracy.”

Russian leader Vladimir Putin expressed support on Thursday during a phone call with his ally Maduro, but with Moscow’s forces tied down in a grinding war in Ukraine, its capacity to provide aid is limited.

The US Treasury announced

sanctions against three nephews of Maduro’s wife Cilia Flores, labeling two of them “narco-traffickers operating in Venezuela”.

“Nicolas Maduro and his criminal associates in Venezuela are flooding the United States with drugs that are poisoning the American people,” Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent said in a statement.

Six companies shipping Venezuelan oil were also slapped with

sanctions.

White House Press Secretary Karoline Leavitt told journalists that the seized tanker “will go to a US port and the United States does intend to seize the oil”.

“We’re not going to stand by and watch sanctioned vessels sail the seas with black-market oil, the proceeds of which will fuel narco-terrorism of rogue and illegitimate regimes around the world.”

The tanker was expected to dock in Galveston, Texas, two unnamed US officials told NBC News, adding that the crew would be released upon arrival.

‘Blatant theft’

Noem told a congressional hearing earlier on Thursday that the tanker operation was “pushing back on a regime that is systematically covering and flooding our country with deadly drugs” -- a reference to US allegations of narcotics smuggling by Maduro’s government.

A video released Wednesday by US Attorney General Pam Bondi showed American forces descending from a helicopter onto the tanker’s deck, then entering the ship’s bridge with weapons raised.

Bondi said the ship was part of an “illicit oil shipping network” that was used to carry sanctioned oil.

White House blames Trump’s bandaged hand on handshakes

The White House said the high volume of handshakes by President Donald Trump explains the adhesive bandages he has worn on the back of his right hand in recent days.

His spokeswoman Karoline Leavitt reiterated a response she gave months ago after the 79-year-old president was seen with a bruise on his right hand covered by a thick layer of make-up.

“As for the bandages on the hand, we’ve also given you an explanation for that,” Leavitt told reporters.

“In the past, the president is literally constantly shaking hands,” she said.

“He’s also on a daily aspirin regimen, which is something his physical examinations has said in the past as well, which can contribute to the bruise that you see,” she added.

As the oldest president ever elected in the United States, Trump has fiercely defended his personal health, contrasting that with his predecessor Joe Biden, whom Trump claims was losing his faculties to the point of being unable to govern by the end of his term.

Trump posted a long message defending his health on his Truth Social platform on Tuesday night, calling investigations by news organizations into his physical fitness as equivalent to “sedition, maybe even treason.”

Germany blames Russia for cyberattack on air safety, election interference

Germany on Friday accused Russia of a cyberattack targeting its air traffic control and spreading disinformation ahead of February’s general election, charges dismissed by Russia as “absurd” and “baseless”.

A German foreign ministry spokesman said security services had proof that hacker groups run by Russia’s military intelligence service GRU were responsible for the attack and influence operations.

“Based on comprehensive analysis by the German intelligence services, we have been able to clearly identify the handwriting behind it and prove Moscow’s responsibility,” said the spokesman.

“We can now clearly attribute the cyberattack against German Air Safety in August 2024 to the hacker collective APT28, also known as Fancy Bear,” he told a regular press briefing.

“Our intelligence findings prove that the Russian military intelligence service GRU bears responsibility for this attack,” added the spokesman.

He also said Russia had sought to influence February’s parliamentary election, which was won by the conservatives of Chancellor Friedrich Merz,

with the far-right AfD scoring its best-ever result in second place.

“Second, we can now state definitively that Russia, through the Storm 1516 campaign, sought to influence and destabilise the most recent federal election,” he added at a press conference.

The spokesman said a GRU-supported Moscow think tank and other groups had spread artificially generated or deepfake images and other content, and that the goal was to divide society and “undermine trust in democratic institutions”.

The Russian embassy in Ber-

lin said in a statement sent to AFP that it “categorically rejected” that Russia was behind any of the activity.

“The accusations of Russian state structures’ involvement in these incidents and in the activities of hacker groups in general are baseless, unfounded and absurd,” the statement said.

According to security sources, much of the material spread by the Storm 1516 campaign involved spurious claims about Merz and other prominent politicians such as former foreign minister Annalena Baerbock and former vice chancellor Robert Habeck, both prominent Greens party members.

make.

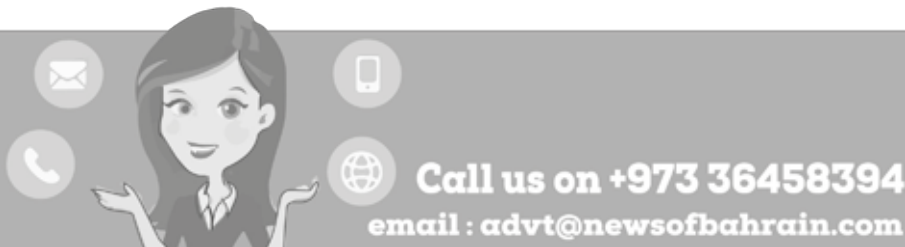
He said: “At the end of the song, I

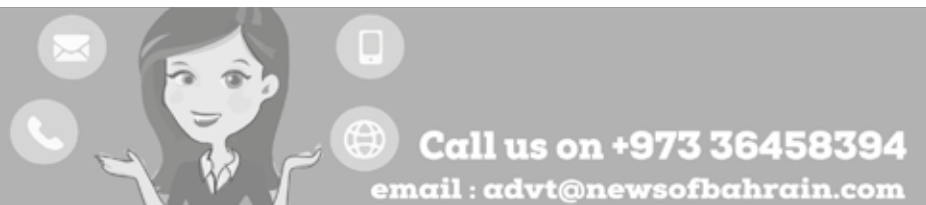

Messi to unveil 21-metre statue of himself on India ‘GOAT’ tour

Tour includes four cities, meetings with celebrities, and a possible PM meeting

Lionel Messi will unveil a 21-metre (70-foot) statue of himself in India on Saturday as he embarks on a three-day tour of the country that has sparked a fan frenzy.

The iron sculpture in Kolkata, which shows Messi holding aloft the World Cup, is part of a so-called GOAT Tour that will take in four Indian cities and a possible meeting with Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

The 38-year-old Argentina and Inter Miami superstar will unveil the monument virtually rather than in person for security reasons.

A “Hola Messi” fan zone has also been set up in Kolkata where on display is a life-sized replica of Messi sat on a throne.

The hall also recreates his Miami home, complete with mannequins of his family members.

Football fan Samir Nandy said it would be “a dream come true” to catch a glimpse of his idol.

“Legends are not made by success alone. It is his resilience that made me believe in him,” Nandy, 64, said in Kolkata.

“The statue is a fitting tribute

to him.”

Monti Paul, the statue’s main sculptor, said the structure was built inside 40 days.

“It’s a matter of pride to build the sculpture of Messi. It’s the tallest statue I have made,” he said.

The eight-time Ballon d’Or

winner will also meet Bollywood superstar Shah Rukh Khan and former India cricket captain Sourav Ganguly during his whirlwind trip to Kolkata.

Ahead of his arrival, Messi said it was an honour to visit India and interact with the fans.

“India is a very special coun-

try and I have good memories from my time there 14 years ago -- the fans were fantastic,” Messi said in a statement.

“India is a passionate football nation and I look forward to meeting a new generation of fans while sharing the love I have for this beautiful game.”

After Kolkata, where Messi will play a short friendly match, he will head to Hyderabad, Mumbai and New Delhi.

In Hyderabad he will attend a concert in his honour and play another friendly.

He is reportedly scheduled to meet Modi in the capital.

Messi won his second consecutive Major League Soccer Most Valuable Player award this week after propelling Inter Miami to the MLS title and leading the league in goals.

The former Barcelona and Paris Saint-Germain attacker will spearhead Argentina’s defence of the World Cup in June-July in North America.

Wilde and Waugh crowned T100 triathlon world champions in Qatar

New Zealand’s Hayden Wilde and Britain’s Kate Waugh were crowned T100 Triathlon World Champions after triumphing at the Qatar T100 World Championship Final in Lusail yesterday.

Wilde completed a perfect season with his sixth consecutive victory, finishing in 3 hours, 6 minutes and 8 seconds. The Olympic bronze medallist dominated from start to finish, controlling the race after a powerful bike leg to seal the 2025 men’s title and a \$200,000 championship bonus.

His flawless season comes just months after a serious crash in Japan that left him with multiple injuries, including a punctured lung and broken ribs. “It’s been a long year, but finishing fit and healthy is more meaningful than any trophy,” Wilde said.

Waugh claimed her first world crown in dramatic fashion, collapsing to her knees from exhaustion as she crossed the line in 3:31:30. The 26-year-old led from the opening stages and held off Britain’s Georgia Taylor-Brown to seal victory and the women’s championship title.

“It had it all — I cried on the bike and barely made it to the finish,” Waugh said. “It’s completely overwhelming but the perfect end to a hard season.”

The Qatar finale concluded the 2025 T100 Triathlon World Tour season, with Wilde and

Mohammed Ben Sulayem re-elected unopposed in contentious FIA election

Mohammed Ben Sulayem was re-elected as president of motorsport’s governing body the International Automobile Federation (FIA) yesterday in an election in which he faced no challengers.

The Dubai-born 64-year-old was the only candidate in the vote held in Tashkent in an election that has been contested in the courts.

Two would-be candidates, Swiss national Laura Villars and American former FIA steward Tim Mayer, were denied the chance to run against Ben Sulayem due to FIA rules.

Under the Paris-based FIA election regulations, candidates are required to appoint vice-presidents from each of the six global regions, chosen from a list approved by the

But there is only one vice-president listed from South America, Brazilian Fabiana Ecclestone -- the wife of ex-Formula One supremo Bernie Ecclestone -- and she gave her backing to Ben Sulayem.

A Paris court last week decided not to suspend the election but ordered a trial to examine the electoral process after hearing an urgent application from Villars, a 28-year-old Swiss driver.

Liverpool boss Slot to hold talks with unhappy Salah

Conversation to determine if Salah plays after his explosive public criticism

- Meeting will decide Salah's availability for Brighton
- Slot wants forward to stay

Liverpool boss Arne Slot said he would speak to Mohamed Salah yesterday morning before deciding on the forward's availability for this weekend's match against Brighton.

The Egypt international accused Liverpool of throwing him "under the bus" after he was left on the bench for last week's 3-3 draw at Leeds -- the third match in a row that he did not start.

Salah also said he had no relationship with the Dutch manager, when he spoke to reporters after the match at Elland Road.

The 33-year-old was left out of the squad for Tuesday's Champions League match at Inter Milan, which Liverpool won 1-0, posting a picture on social media of himself alone in a gym at the club's training ground.

"I will have a conversation with Mo this morning -- the outcome of that conversation determines how things will look tomorrow," Slot told his pre-match press conference.

"I think the next time I speak about Mo should be with him

and not in here. You can keep on trying but there is not much more to say about it.

"After the Sunderland game (a 1-1 draw on December 3 in which Salah came on as a second-half substitute) there were a lot of conversations between his representatives and ours, between him and me."

Slot batted away further questions from reporters about the forward, but said: "I have no reasons not wanting him to stay, and that is a little bit of an answer to your question."

Salah, who signed a new two-year contract at Liverpool

in April which made him one of the highest paid players in the Premier League, is due to join the Egypt squad for the Africa Cup of Nations after Saturday's Brighton game at Anfield.

The length of his absence depends on how far Egypt go in the competition in Morocco, with the final taking place on January 18.

Salah, third in Liverpool's all-time scoring charts with 250 goals in 420 appearances, has won two Premier League titles and one Champions League triumph during his spell on Merseyside.

Fit-again Jesus can be Arsenal's number one striker, says Arteta

Mikel Arteta said Friday that Gabriel Jesus has the qualities to be Arsenal's first-choice striker following the return of the Brazil international after 11 months on the sidelines.

The 28-year-old on Wednesday played his first minutes for the club since suffering a knee injury in January, coming on as a substitute in the Gunners' 3-0 win against Club Brugge in the Champions League.

Jesus will have to compete with Viktor Gyokeres and Kai Havertz, currently sidelined with a knee injury, to be the focal point of Arsenal's attack.

Arsenal boss Arteta also has a host of other options in attacking positions including Bukayo Saka, Eberechi Eze, Gabriel Martinelli, Noni Madueke and Leandro Trossard.

The Spanish manager, whose team host bottom side Wolves on Saturday, was asked at his pre-match press conference whether Jesus could push to be the club's number one striker.

"Yes, a player of his quality, a player that has given us so much and he comes with the

energy that he came with the other day," he said.

"He's certainly a player that has to be pushing and aiming for that, that's for sure."

Arteta was also asked if he would think about selling the former Manchester City star, given his wealth of attacking options, but quashed the idea.

"Gabriel has a lot to offer to the team and he's proven that straight away in the first minute that he was available to play," he said. "He's put so much to be in this position again and now the focus is to be with us."

The Arsenal boss insisted the "goals will come" for struggling Gyokeres, who has scored just once in the Premier League since mid-September.

Arteta said the team and the 27-year-old forward, who joined the club from Sporting Lisbon in July, had to adapt to each other.

"We have to put the player in the best possible condition to explode and fulfil his potential, and then there are certain things that within the role, in the manner that we play, have to be fulfilled, and that's a combination of both," he said.

Arab Cup Chaos Sweeps Doha

Jordan and UAE join Morocco and Saudi in semi-finals

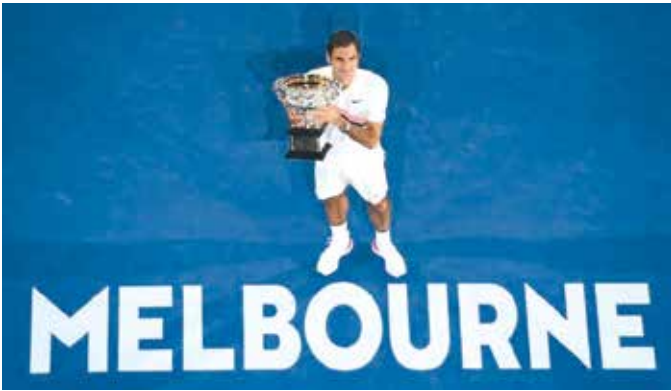
Meanwhile, at Al Bayt Stadium, the UAE and Algeria delivered a match packed with drama. Algeria took the lead in the 46th minute when Adil Boulbina finished a rebound

from a long-range strike by captain Yacine Brahimi. The UAE equalized in the 64th minute when Bruno Conceicao met a precise cross from Yahya Al Ghassani. Both sides threatened in the closing minutes -- Algeria hit the post, and the UAE's late penalty appeal was denied -- sending the game into extra time. Goalkeeper Hamad Al Meqbaali produced a stunning save to deny Zakaria Draoui's last-second volley, forcing a penalty shootout.

The shootout was a test of nerves, with Al Meqbaali's crucial stops helping the UAE prevail. They will now meet Morocco at Khalifa International Stadium on Monday, December 15, at 5:30 PM.

With the final four confirmed -- Morocco, Saudi Arabia, Jordan, and the UAE -- the stage is set for two semi-finals that promise more moments that could define the 2025 Arab Cup. Doha has already delivered unforgettable nights, and the best is yet to come.

Federer to headline launch of 2026 Australian Open

Roger Federer will return to the scene of some of his greatest triumphs in January when he headlines a "Battle of the World No.1s" to officially launch the 2026 Australian Open, organisers said.

The Swiss great will be back on Rod Laver Arena for the first time since he retired in 2022 as the Grand Slam at Melbourne Park introduces an inaugural "opening ceremony".

Held on the evening before the tournament starts on January 18, it will include a tribute to Federer, who won the Nor-

man Brookes trophy six times among his 20 major titles.

He will also join four-time Australian Open winner Andre Agassi and Australians Pat Rafter and Lleyton Hewitt for a star-studded match.

"It feels like a lifetime ago that I coined the phrase the 'Happy Slam' for the Australian Open, and it still makes me smile when I think about all the moments I've had there," Federer said.

"I've experienced so many emotions on Rod Laver Arena -- the joy of lifting 'Norman' six times, the honour of playing in front of Rod Laver himself.
