Several charged in US over Chinese student visa scheme Los Angeles, United States

Ceveral California resi-Odents were arrested yesterday in connection with a scheme to help Chinese nationals obtain student visas by hiring people to take English proficiency exams for the foreign students.

Federal authorities allege that those involved in the plot used counterfeit Chinese passports to impersonate 19 different students who were required to take the so-called TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) exam in order to get a US student visa. Six people have been named in a 26-count indictment handed down in the case.

Professors at various universities have complained at being faced with an increasing number of such students unable to handle college-level work in English. According to the University of California, which has 10 campuses across the state, there were 24,387 students from China enrolled at its schools in 2018, as opposed to 2,632 in 2008.
