Khawaja, bowlers humble India as Australia complete turnaround to seal series win

From 0-2 down, Khawaja, Zampa, **Cummins and** Handscomb stun India

Australia won the five-match series 3-2

Khawaja and incisive ease to a 35-run series clinching Virat Kohli. win in the fifth one-day international vesterday.
