## **Termination without notice**

Court awards employee BD9,292 compensation

The Labour Court has ordered a private company to pay BD9,292 to an Arab man as compensation for dismissing him arbitrarily.

The court observed that the plaintiff was terminated from service in violation of Bahraini laws and hence deserves a severance package as well as compensation.

Court files say, the plaintiff served the company for six years from April 21, 2014, until April 20, 2020.
