

# New sports hall @ Budaiya Club, football courts for Hamad Town

The Ministry of Youth and Sports Affairs is planning to construct a new sports hall at Budaiya Club.

According to a tender board document, the sports hall will be inside the plot of Budaiya Club.

Budaiya Club is a football club based in Budaiya that competes in the Bahraini Premier League. They play their home games at the Hamad Town Stadium.

The tender is for conducting civil, architectural, mechanical, electrical, interior and exterior works of the hall.

A successful contractor should complete all related works, including excavation, carpentry, metal works as per drawing and specification provided by the ministry.

To participate, make bids before the 8th of September 2021, with a BD4,000 bond and BD100 fee.

A tender document says the



football courts should have a playing area of 68 meters width and 105-meter length.

The natural grass court will have a grandstand and service building, says the tender description.

it is looking forward to developing sports facilities at various locations to accommodate further players and visitors.

A tender issued says the ministry wants to replace waterproofing systems at various locations in compliance with site conditions.

The tender board will receive bids until the 8th of September 2021. Make bids with a BD1000 bond and BD50 fee.

## Ministry developing Isa Sporty City

The Ministry of Youth is also developing the facilities of Isa Sports City.

According to a tender document, the ministry is also developing football grounds and the irrigation system of all existing playgrounds.

A tender issued calls for constructing a new pump room, rerouting existing pole lights, and fixing interlock pavings, amongst other works.

Make bids before the 1st of September 2021, with a BD1000 bond and BD50 fee.

# BAC offers a four-year contract for bottled water

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Bahrain Airport Company is to buy bottled drinking water, water cooler dispensing systems, and disposable paper cups for its headquarters and Bahrain International Airport.

A tender launched by BAC says they are looking for a contractor to supply them "in a timely and efficient manner" for four years.

Those having a minimum of three years of experience in manufacturing and supplying purified bottled drinking water could make their bids.

Bidders should submit a sample of the bottled drinking water with a BAC logo.

If interested, make bids through the tender board before the 8th of September 2021, with a BD500 bond and BD30 fee.

The product, the tender description says, should be as per the specifications given by BAC.

An automated external defibrillator (AED) is a medical device designed to analyze the heart rhythm and deliver an electric shock to victims of ventricular fibrillation to restore the heart rhythm to normal.

The municipality plans to instal illuminated models and lights for palm trees at the intersections of Airport street and Shaikh Issa Bridge for four months.

Suppliers are also required to remove the materials and fixtures after the contract expires.

# Sewerage for housing scheme

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Work Ministry has launched a tender for providing sewer connections to various housing schemes.

The connection is for 43 properties in block number 557.

According to the tender document by the Ministry of Works, Municipal Affairs and Urban Planning, the works comprises constructing a new uPVC sewer main pipeline of 200mm diameter for a total

length of 395 m, and a pipeline of 250mm diameter for 132.5 m.

The tender requires constructing 44 Type E, 9 Type H, and 6 Type F 'manholes' with heavy-duty and medium covers and asphalt reinstatement.

The works should complete in eight months.

Qualified contractors should bid before the 15th of September 2021, with a BD1,000 bond and BD100 tender fee.

# 16 companies bid for sewerage cleaning in Northern Municipality

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Sixteen companies are competing to bag the contract for cleaning the sewerage tanks in the Northern Area Municipality.

Sphinx services, Nidukki Trading company, Al Door Excavation & Building Contracting, and Down Town Construction Company are some of the companies in the fray.

Their bids range between BHD 990,580.000 and BHD 3,033,412.800.

The tender board document shows MC6 Industrial Services as the lowest bidder.

The contract requires a successful bidder to provide sewerage trucks, tanks with 5,000-gallon capacity, manpower, and emergency sewerage work, among others, according to the tender description given by the Northern Area Municipality.

The works should complete in eight months.

Qualified contractors should bid before the 15th of September 2021, with a BD1,000 bond and BD100 tender fee.

The contract for supplying security guards for building and gardens in the municipality for four years received ten bids.

The bids ranged between BHD 16,233.000 and BHD 1,012,891.200.

Basma Security made the lowest quote. However, as announced by the tender board, the lowest price bidder is not necessarily awarded the tender. It depends on the bidder passing the technical and other criteria, following which price becomes a criterion.
