After a few years the school was upgraded to secondary level education following affiliation with the Federal Board, Islamabad, Pakistan.

## Pakistan School Shines in TIIMS 2023 Assessment



Pakistan School has achieved remarkable results in the TIMSS 2023 (Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study), showcasing strong academic performance in both Grade 4 and Grade 8. Following is a glimpse of these results:

**In Grade 4 Mathematics:**

- Pakistan Average is: 506

- Bahrain Average is: 462
- International Average is: 503
- Pakistan School is 44 Points higher than Bahrain and 03 Points higher than International.
- In Grade 4 Science:
  - Average is: 512
  - Bahrain Average is: 475
  - International Average

is: 494. Pakistan School is 37 Points higher than Bahrain and 18 Points higher than International.

**In Grade 8 Mathematics:**

- Pakistan Average: 546
- Bahrain Average: 426
- International Average: 478
- Pakistan School is 120 Points higher than Bahrain and 68

Points higher than International.

**In Grade 8 Science:**

- Pakistan Average: 556
- Bahrain Average: 452
- International : 478
- Pakistan school is 104 points higher than Bahrain and 78 points higher than International.


