US warns of 'other options' against Iran

Washington

US Secretary of State Antony Blinken warned yesterday that Washington had "other options" if diplomacy failed on Iran's nuclear programme, as his visiting Israeli counterpart said they reserved the right to use force. Blinken told reporters that he had hoped for the success of talks with Iran, but "the runway that we have left to do that is getting shorter and shorter."

Referencing Israeli Foreign Minister Yair Lapid's threat to use force, Blinken said without elaborating: "We are prepared to turn to other options if Iran doesn't change course."

Reform centres, open prisons programme praised

Bahrain's pioneering initiative to adopt the reform centres and open prisons programme in accordance with well-defined regulations has earned praise.

The Arab Observatory for Human Rights of the Arab Parliament commended the directives of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, to start putting in place the necessary executive mechanisms for the programme.

It described the move as a reflection of the kingdom's keenness to protect and promote the human rights system and a "model to emulate" according to international standards.

In a statement, the group noted that the royal directives reflect the keen vision of HM the King to protect the Bahraini social texture.

It described the move as an extension of the success of the alternative penalties programme as a national, civilisational and humanitarian project.

The observatory also praised Bahrain's efforts and tireless en-

deavour to develop the criminal justice system and foster human rights.

It lauded the meeting of Interior Minister General Shaikh Rashid bin Abdullah Al Khalifa with heads and representatives of human rights institutions in the Kingdom and his directives to speed up the implementation of the executive mechanism of the open prisons programme.

Likewise, it stressed the importance of the move in rehabilitating the wrongdoers and reintegrate them in the community according to well-defined regulations.

'Bloodbath' in Yemen

More than 100 Houthi rebels killed in air strikes south of Marib: Saudi-led coalition

More than 100 Yemeni rebels have been killed south of Marib in Yemen, the Saudi-led coalition said yesterday, reporting a heavy toll for the third straight day in fighting for the strategic city.

The Iran-backed Houthis' latest casualties in the Abdiya district "exceeded 108", the coalition said, after announcing more than 156 dead on Monday and over 134 on Tuesday.

That brought the unconfirmed toll to about 400 in the area this week as an analyst said the rebels have made significant advances.

The coalition, which relies heavily on air strikes to combat the Houthis, did not reveal how it arrived at those figures. They could not be independently verified by AFP.

"We have conducted 19 operations targeting (Houthis) militia

members in the past 24 hours in Abdiya, destroying 12 of their military vehicles and their losses exceeded 108 members," the coalition said in a statement carried by state-run Al-Ekhbariya television.

Fighting for Marib, the inter-

nationally recognised government's last bastion in oil-rich northern Yemen, has left heavy casualties since the rebels renewed their campaign to seize Marib last month.

The Houthis said they were "on the edges of the city" in a

video statement on Tuesday.

Adam Baron, a political analyst focused on Yemen and the wider region, said the rebels had made "significant" territorial gains.

"The advances are quite significant on both a strategic and

psychological level -- these are areas that were seen as quite secure just a year or two ago," he told AFP.

Yemen has been devastated by a seven-year war pitting the rebels against the government supported by a Saudi-led military coalition.

The rebels overran the capital Sanaa, just 120 kilometres (75 miles) to the west of Marib, in 2014, prompting the Saudi-led intervention to prop up the government the following year.

Tens of thousands of people have been killed and millions have been displaced since then. Many fled to Marib, whose population has ballooned since the war began.

As well as the deaths in Abdiya, six people were killed in a car-bombing on Sunday that targeted the governor of Aden, the government's provisional seat of power. He survived the attack.

Article (1): The terms "Bureau" and "The Bureau" shall replace the terms "Bureau" and "The Bureau", respectively, whenever they appear in Edict (21) of the year 2020 on regulating shared financial services.

Article (2): Clause (2) of the first paragraph of Article (2) of Edict (21) of 2020 on regulating shared financial services shall be abrogated.

The Ministers, President of the Civil Service Bureau and those concerned, each within their capacity, shall implement the provisions of this Edict which takes effect upon its publication in the Official Gazette.

Last day today for Filipinos to register for overseas voting

Today is the last day for Filipinos in the Kingdom of Bahrain to register for overseas voting.

The Philippine Embassy is calling on Filipinos who would like to vote for the May 2022 Philippine national elections to visit its premises in Mahooz.

Personal appearance at the embassy is required for registration.

Details or biometrics will be captured and those who want to register must bring along a photocopy of valid passport. For seafarers, seaman's book is required aside from a copy of the Philippine passport.

The embassy is urging eligible Filipino voters to come forward and exercise their right and duty to choose future leaders before overseas voting registration comes to a close.

The next Philippine general elections – set to take place

on May 9, 2022 – will select the successor of current President Rodrigo Duterte, as well as the next vice-president, 12 senators and a party-list representative.

Overseas voters may cast their votes at the embassy from April 10 to May 9 next year.

Meanwhile, the embassy has stressed the importance of strictly following safety precautions and health protocols against the coronavirus (COVID-19) within its premises.

Review

The Council reviewed the latest developments in the implementation of the education and training programmes listed on the unified framework of government priorities, noting that

60% of them have been achieved and that two major goals in infrastructure development and e-learning have been completed.

It also reviewed the latest developments in the restructure of the Ministry of Education that includes 17 initiatives to improve its operations and education outputs. The achievement rate has reached 83%.

The Council discussed the proposal for the national curriculum and national standards

that harmonise the educational process and teaching with the requirements of the labour market and make it periodically consistent with the changes in the required job skills.

It reviewed the draft of the 2021 report of the Education and Training Quality Authority, and the proposal for a review date for the authority to obtain recognition from the World Federation for Medical Education.

Results

It also discussed the results of the review of three academic programmes in higher education institutions and decisions to include national qualifications in the National Qualifications Framework.

HH Shaikh Mohammed and the Council congratulated Dr Jawaher Shaheen Al Mudhahki on her appointment by HM the King and commended her efforts during her presidency of the Education and Training Quality Authority and the role of the authority in developing education and training.

Proposals

Higher Education Council Secretary General Dr Shaikha Rana bint Isa Al Khalifa presented proposals to review higher education policies and legislation to expand its scope and present options to individuals to move between academic, technical and applied streams and the labour market, expanding life-long learning and employability.

Dr Shaikha Rana also presented a proposal to establish a national portal for admission to higher education institutions that would develop mechanisms to boost efficiency and effectiveness, standardise procedures,

reduce costs for students in the short term, and align the financing of the higher education sector with the national strategy and long-term labour market needs. She also put forward a detailed proposal for the implementation and timeframe for the proposed initiatives.

Expansion

Dean of the Bahrain Teachers College Dr Ted Purinton updated the Council on the plan for the expansion of the Btc to achieve the government goals to enable it to meet 80% of the Ministry of Education's needs of teachers by 2030. He also briefed the Council on the preparations by the college for the new academic year.

Tender, Auction Board opens envelopes for project bids

The Tender and Auction Board, the independent regulatory body tasked with supervising government bidding and bidding practices, has opened the envelopes of 64 bids for 10 bids and one auction offered from seven managing authorities.

The agenda of the Al-Fath Committee included the opening of a tender and an auction for the Ministry of Youth and Sports.

The tender was on the effectiveness of the youth market, and six bids were received for this tender. As for the bidding, it was for the investment of the fitness hall in Al Najma Club, and only one bid was received for this bid.

The Committee also opened two tenders for the Electricity and Water Authority, the first tender for the purchase of insulating parties for the Department of Electricity Transmission, and one bid was received for this tender.

Closing arguments set for today on BD1.5m money-laundering case

Closing arguments will be heard today in the case of a 37-year-old Bahraini man who laundered BD1.5 million in collaboration with an Arab man.

The defendant is said to have embezzled BD1.5 million from 23 men after he deceived them that he had companies specialised in providing commercial and technological consultancies.

The Arab man was living in his home country and he had a company, whose bank account was used to launder the money that the Bahraini man received from his victims.

The pair signed a recruitment agreement, according to which the money was transferred from Bahrain to the Arab country.

According to court files, the

victims of the pair were all occupying high positions.

“The defendant came to me

and requested me to lend him BD13,000, although I didn't know him. He managed to convince me that my father was his friend and he was trustworthy. After three days, I agreed to give him BD3,000 only,” one of the defendants said.

“After a few days, he came back to me and gave me the BD3,000 back, but he offered me to invest the money with great returns. This time I gave him BD84,000. It was a trap,” he added.

The defendant did the same with his victims as the total amount of the money he embezzled from his victims hit BD1.5 million.

He was arrested and he confessed to collecting money without a license. It was discovered that the defendant was running the fraud scheme from his home.

Tiananmen statue creator accuses HK university of 'mafia' tactics

The Danish sculptor of a statue that commemorates pro-democracy protesters killed during China's Tiananmen Square crackdown in 1989 has accused a leading Hong Kong university of "mafia" style tactics over its order to have it removed.

Jens Galschiot loaned the eight-metre high, two-tonne copper sculpture called "Pillar of Shame" to a local civil society group, the Hong Kong Alliance in Support of Patriotic Democratic Movements in China, in perpetuity.

After the group disbanded last month with some members accused of national secu-

rity offences, the University of Hong Kong sent a letter to the alliance last week requesting it remove the statue from the campus by 5 p.m. (0900 GMT) on Wednesday. "These people are in jail. And they say within four days you should take it down," Galschiot told Reuters via Zoom, referring to some of the group's members who are in prison over anti-government protests in 2019.

"So I think this is a warning, that we want to destroy this sculpture if you don't pull it down. So this is a kind of mafia. I am really shocked."

The University of Hong Kong said in an email response to Reuters it was still seeking legal advice regarding the management of the sculpture and was "working with related parties to handle the matter in a legal and reasonable manner".

US hopes Abraham help Israeli-Pales

The United States is working to expand normalisation agreements between Israel and Arab nations, known as the Abraham Accords, and hopes restoring such ties can be leveraged to advance progress on the Israeli and Palestinian conflict, senior State Department officials said on Tuesday.

In a briefing with reporters previewing US Secretary of State Antony Blinken's meetings yesterday with his Israeli and Emirati counterparts, officials repeated that the Abraham Accords were not a substitute for the two-state solution between Israelis and Palestinians.

"We continue to welcome the economic cooperation between

Israel and all countries in the region. We hope that normalisation can be leveraged to advance progress on the Israeli-Palestinian tracks," a senior State Department official, speaking on the condition of anonymity said.

Christmas isn't cancelled despite choked port, Britain says

Britain said yesterday that people should buy normally for Christmas and there would be no shortage of gifts after shipping containers carrying toys and electrical goods were diverted from the country's biggest port because it was full.

Maersk, the world's largest container shipping company, has diverted some vessels from Felixstowe port in eastern England because a lack of truck drivers means there is nowhere left to stack containers at the port.

"I'm confident that people will be able to get their toys for Christmas," Conservative Party co-Chairman Oliver Dowden

told Sky. He said he was sure Christmas gifts would be delivered this year.

Dowden, who is a cabinet minister without portfolio in the Cabinet Office, said the issues at the port were easing and the supply chain problems facing the world's fifth largest economy were global - such as a shortage of truckers and port congestion.

"The situation is improving," Dowden said, referring to Felixstowe, which handles 36% of the country's containerised freight.

Asked whether people should start to buy now for Christmas, he said: "I would say just buy as you do normally."

He said Prime Minister Boris Johnson, who is on holiday abroad, was very much engaged with domestic and international issues. "He's very much engaged with the job."

Britain is short of about 100,000 truckers, leading to queues at gas stations and worries about getting food into supermarkets, with a lack of butchers and warehouse workers also causing concern.

Tension over Beirut blast probe nudges Lebanon into new crisis

Growing tension over a judicial probe into last year's Beirut port blast threatens to push Lebanon into yet another political crisis, testing Prime Minister Najib Mikati's new government as it struggles to dig the country out of economic collapse.

More than a year since the explosion ripped through Beirut, killing more than 200 people, Judge Tarek Bitar's efforts to hold senior officials to account for suspected negligence are facing mounting political push-back. Ministers aligned with the politicians Bitar has sought to question were expected to press the demand for his removal at a cabinet meeting on Wednesday, after the subject disrupted a stormy session on Tuesday.

But the session was postponed until a framework as to how best to tackle the row over Bitar would be agreed, an official source told Reuters.

It is a big distraction that risks undermining Mikati, who took office last month after more than a year of squabbling over cabinet seats as Lebanon sank deeper into one of the world's worst economic depressions, analysts say. The row has also underlined the major sway of the heavily armed, Iran-backed

U.S. State Department spokesperson Ned Price on Tuesday accused Hezbollah of threatening Lebanon's judiciary, and being more concerned with its own and Iran's interests than with those of the Lebanese people.

Shi'ite group Hezbollah, which has called for Bitar to be replaced, accusing him of conducting a politicised probe picking on certain people.

The most senior politician Bitar has sought to question, former finance minister Ali Hassan Khalil, said all options

were open for political escalation when asked during an interview on Tuesday whether some ministers could quit.

Khalil is the right-hand man of Parliament Speaker Nabih Berri - the most senior Shi'ite in the state - and a close Hezbollah ally. Khalil told al-Mayadeen TV the path of the probe threatened to push Lebanon "towards civil strife".

Mikati has previously said Lebanon could not bear the loss of a second judge after the first investigator was removed in February when a court accepted a complaint questioning his impartiality.

What is necessary" after attacks by Syrian Kurdish YPG militia

guided missile attack on Sunday launched by the YPG, which Turkey says is a terrorist group. On Monday, shells believed to have been fired from a YPG-controlled area further east exploded in two areas of Karkamis in southern Turkey, Ankara said.

Turkey controls swathes of territory in north Syria with allied Syrian rebels, after carrying out three separate cross-border offensive into the region against Islamic State and the YPG. Ankara

has been infuriated by the U.S. support for the YPG and demands its NATO ally ceases its backing.

In separate agreements with Moscow and Washington in 2019, Turkey halted its offensive in northeast Syria in exchange for the withdrawal of YPG militants 30 km south of its border.

"The mode of execution and the diabolic plan of the accused to murder Uthra, his wife who was bedridden, makes it (the case) fall into the category of rarest of rare," said the public prosecutor, who had sought the death penalty.

Snake handler Vava Suresh said it was possible that Sooraj had "inflicted pain on the reptile to provoke it to bite", the Hindustan Times newspaper quoted him as saying.

Uthra was from an affluent family but her husband, a bank worker, was not well off.

The dead woman's parents became suspicious after Sooraj tried to take control of her property after the death.

Their marriage involved a big dowry including a new car and 500,000 rupees (around \$20,000).

According to media reports, Sooraj's family was charged with conspiracy after some of Uthra's gold was found buried near Sooraj's home days after the murder.

Countries call for urgent action on biodiversity with 'Kunming Declaration'

● Declaration urges countries to take rapid action on species loss


● China's willingness to protect 30% of its land still in question

● Declaration marred by wrangling over language

More than 100 countries pledged yesterday to put the protection of habitats at the heart of their government decision-making but they stopped short of committing to specific targets to curb mass extinctions.

Chinese Environment Minister Huang Runqiu told delegates to a UN Biodiversity Conference in the city of Kunming that the declaration they adopted was a document of political will not a binding international agreement.

The Kunming Declaration calls for "urgent and integrated action" to reflect biodiversity considerations in all sectors of the global economy but crucial issues - like funding conservation in poorer countries and committing to biodiversity-friendly supply chains - have been left to discuss later.

With plant and animal species loss now at the fastest rate in 10 million years, politicians, scientists and experts have been trying to lay the groundwork for a new pact on saving bio-

diversity.

In a previous agreement signed in Aichi, Japan, in 2010, governments agreed on 20 targets to try to slow biodiversity loss and protect habitats by 2020, but none of those targets was met.

At the heart of efforts to save nature is a call by the United Nations for countries to protect and conserve 30% of their territory by 2030 - a target known as '30 by 30', which the conference acknowledged though it was not clear to what extent host China backed it.

A first draft of the declaration, released in August, included political slogans associated with Chinese President Xi Jinping, which caused tension and underlined what some critics said was China's inexperience in shepherding international agreements through to conclusion.

After feedback from more than 40 countries, Xi's slogan "lucid waters and lush mountains" was removed from the text, though the Chinese concept of "ecological civilisation" was retained.



Dwayne Johnson talks possibility of political future

Hollywood star Dwayne "The Rock" Johnson, who has teased running for president in the past, in a new interview admitted he's taken his plans one step beyond that.

According to Fox News, while speaking to a magazine, the 49-year-

today," Johnson confirmed.

The 'Jungle Cruise' actor last spoke about his political aspirations back in April on the "TODAY" show. "I do have that goal to unite our country," he told host Willie Geist, adding "I also feel that, if this is what the people want, then I will do that."

Johnson went on to note that the ability to unify Americans is a necessity for the longevity of the

nation. "I am passionate about making sure that our country is united because a united country, as we know, is the strongest, and I want to see that for our country," he concluded.

Johnson also responded on social media to a poll that claimed he would have massive support from Americans if he actually established and ran a presidential campaign.


