he country's liquefied natural gas (LNG) terminal will be supplied with its first cargo from Abu Dhabi National Oil Company (Adnoc), the Minister of Oil and Chairman of the board of directors in National Oil and Gas Authority (NOGA) Shaikh Mohammed bin Khalifa bin Ahmed Al Khalifa has said.

He said that negotiations with the Abu Dhabi National Oil Company has come to a conclusion as the company offered "the best price"


"We have an LNG terminal in Bahrain that is going to be commissioned next year and our first commissioning cargo is going to
