casion "embodies the spirit of pride and honour in the long history of the Bahraini police and their sincere sacrifices in protecting lives and property, as well as in preserving the security, stability and civilizational gains of the homeland."

The Minister underscored the pivotal role of the Ministry of Interior and its agencies, describing them as "a safety valve and a source of reassurance and safety for citizens, residents and visitors, and a fundamental pillar for supporting the comprehensive and sustainable development process."

He noted that the police have excelled across multiple areas, including civil defense, traffic security, protection of land, sea and air ports, digital transformation, cybersecurity, crime prevention, counter-terrorism, crisis management, and law enforcement.

Contributions

Policy scrutiny

Shura Council to review unemployment insurance accounts and labour permit cap bill

The Shura Council will review today the audited 2023 accounts of the Unemployment Insurance Fund and discuss a proposed amendment to the Labour Market Law, which a Shura committee has opposed in principle.

Members will consider the Financial and Economic Affairs Committee's report on the audited report and financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2023, after the Board of Directors of the Social Insurance Organisation approved it.

The committee recommended approving the audited report.

The committee said the papers are being submitted to the legislative authority for the first time under paragraph (e) of Article 9 of the Decree-Law on Unemployment Insurance.

Amendment

This follows a 2023 amendment introduced after a legislative initiative aimed at strengthening cooperation between the legislative and executive branches.

In its notes, the committee said that almost 20 years after



the account was created, and as it continues to meet the aims it was set up for, it is time to review how it works and how it is used.

The committee added that consideration should also be given to whether its scope can be widened, while maintaining its original goal of providing social protection for citizens as a key support for social stability.

The committee said the 2023 figures point to a healthy position, with contributions exceeding benefits by about BD54.4 million, compared with about BD51.3 million in 2022.

Presentation

It also called for clearer presentation in the statements, recommending that assets be shown as current and non-current in the statement of net assets, in line with International Financial Reporting Standards.

This, the committee said, would improve financial analysis, enhance disclosure and transparency, and make comparisons with similar statements easier for decision-makers and stakeholders.

The committee added that the audited statements were miss-

ing a statement of comprehensive income, often referred to as the profit and loss statement, and said it should be included as part of audited financial statements.

In the same sitting, the Council is due to examine the Services Committee's report on a draft law amending Article 4 of Law No. 19 of 2006 on regulating the labour market, drawn up on the basis of a proposal submitted by Parliament.

Approval

The committee recommended, in principle, that the draft law should not be approved.

The Services Committee said the proposed wording would reduce the law's flexibility and make it harder to respond to economic shifts, arguing that a fixed numerical cap would limit powers and add extra steps without meeting its stated aim. Keeping the rule in permissive form, it said, leaves room to act when needed.

It also said a cap would not necessarily cut work permits in practice, arguing that bodies tasked with national plans could set the ceiling high enough to cover expected and unexpected needs over a four-year plan, leaving the limit as a paper rule.

Policy

The committee said workforce replacement works best through joined-up policy, including targeted training, ongoing skills building, wage support and incentives, and pointed to programmes intended to raise Bahrainisation rates on a balanced footing.

It added that a strict cap would also affect the legal right of Bahraini employers to apply for permits they see as needed to raise output and expand their businesses, in a way that serves economic growth and sustainable development goals.

# Comprehensive Report to Mark Bahrain Police Day: Bahrain Police Force moves confidently towards the future, loyalty and dedication are its mission, and modernisation is its approach

The Bahraini police force remains committed to its steadfast principles and rules. Loyalty and dedication form the core of its mission, while development and modernisation underpin its progress. The Bahraini police force takes pride in the support of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, and the ongoing attention of His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister.

The crime rate in Bahrain has fallen to unprecedented levels, providing the strongest on-the-ground evidence that the Kingdom's security and stability system is becoming increasingly well established. This is due to the implementation of the security strategy launched by His Excellency Minister of Interior General Shaikh Rashid bin Abdullah Al Khalifa, which adopts community partnership as its guiding principle.

During 2025, the Ministry of Interior was consistently engaged in all regional and international security co-operation. It actively took part in the joint international operation led by the International Security Alliance, targeting traffickers of narcotics and psychotropic substances. The Ministry of Interior also participated in numerous joint exercises and in the exchange of information and expertise. This involves expanding the use of modern technologies, artificial intelligence applications, and technological innovations to combat organised crime.

This presence in international security cooperation was only possible due to a security approach grounded in community partnership and the Ministry of Interior's development and modernisation strategy, some aspects of which we present below.

## Integrated series of security and community projects

Advanced security performance and efficient and accurate services have become among the most vital features of the Ministry of Interior's work system. Consequently, several directorates received gold and platinum ratings in the fifth Government Service Centres Evaluation Programme. In this context, the Emergency Centre (999) received over 2 million calls from January to the end of last November. Operations patrols handled 27,229 cases, and 9,695 community services were provided.

In 2025, electronic reporting was launched via the "MyGov" application, enabling easy use and rapid response

without the need to visit police stations.

For its part, the General Directorate of Civil Defence handled 13,838 cases up to last November. Awareness efforts and training programmes reached 511 activities. The Special Security Force also focused on improving performance across operational and training aspects. Police directorates across the governorates continued their security operations to maintain public order and improve services, handling nearly 70,000 cases from the beginning of the year to mid-October.

The ongoing efforts involve equipping the Police Aviation with modern helicopters to enhance its technical capabilities and capacity for public safety, emergency medical services, and law enforcement. The Police Aviation carried out 557 flights, amounting to 392 flight hours.

The General Directorate of Criminal Investigation and Forensic Science managed numerous criminal cases. By the end of October, 1,733 drug control cases were reported. The Anti-Narcotics Directorate ranked first in the category of best field cooperation in information and operations at the Arab level. Meanwhile, the number of human trafficking cases this year reached 39, and Bahrain retained its Tier 1 status in fighting human trafficking for the eighth consecutive year, according to the US Department of State's report. The Coast Guard strengthened maritime security and safety through an integrated fleet of modern

vessels equipped with the latest technology to support maritime control and sur-

veillance. The Coast Guard launched 617 search-and-rescue operations, respond-

ed to accidents and distress calls, and tackled 787 maritime violators, while the num-

ber of inspection and awareness campaigns reached 34.

In combating economic crimes, the number of reports handled from the beginning of the year through the end of November reached 4,286. The Anti-Cyber Crimes Directorate received 1,661 cases. The Anti-Corruption Directorate handled 193 cases as of the beginning of this month. The Child Protection Unit in Cyberspace handled 326 cases this year. The National Ambulance Centre received 55,388 cases by the end of last November. It earned accreditation for excellence from the International Academies of Emergency Dispatch.

The Alternative Sentencing Project reflects the humanitarian values embedded in HM the King's vision. As of the beginning of December 2025, approximately 10,170 individuals have benefited from alternative sentencing since the law's implementation in May 2018. This year, a series of events and programmes was organised to reinforce the programme's objectives. Meanwhile, the "Fael Khair" initiative supported approximately 817 people, with a total value of BD3,620,000.

## Traffic begins to enforce the latest amendments to enhance road safety

# Alternative Sentencing maintains its successful approach, with the number of beneficiaries exceeding 10,000 and charitable donations surpassing BD3 million

has adopted a comprehensive set of rehabilitation programmes, underscoring its commitment to strengthening the national approach to upholding human rights.

On another front, the General Directorate of Traffic continued its efforts to improve road safety. It began implementing the latest amendments to the Traffic Law and introduced modern patrols to enhance road safety. Traffic patrols responded to 80,167 traffic accidents up to last October, including 464 fatalities and serious injuries. The total number of traffic violations recorded during the same period reached 289,683, mostly involving speeding, running red lights, and using a mobile phone while driving. This coincided with an increase in licensed vehicles to 780,592. The General Directorate of Traffic also launched 506 awareness projects, lectures, programmes, and events to promote road safety, benefiting around 30,000 people. Additionally, it won the Best Practice in e-Participation Award at the 2025 e-Government Excellence Awards.

### Strategic initiatives in passport development and ambitious customs projects

The Nationality, Passports and Residence Affairs' (NPRA) institutional transformation plan, comprising 25 strategic initiatives, continued to achieve a 100% completion rate. To date, more than 300,000 electronic passports have been issued, and passport delivery services are available both within and outside the Kingdom. Bahrain ranked fifth in the Arab world and 59th globally in the Henley Passport Index. Additionally, the "Smart Travel" system was implemented, utilising artificial intelligence to analyse passenger data and proactively monitor risks, thereby optimising the balance between procedural speed and security efficiency. Between January and October 2025, over 32 million travellers entered and exited Bahrain, with the majority travelling via the King Fahd Causeway.

On another front, Customs Affairs continued its modernisation initiatives and projects to enhance control methods and provide high-quality customs facilities and infrastructure to accommodate 14 million vehicles and 350,000 trucks. This reduced the average waiting time from 45 minutes in 2023 to 21 minutes this year. Customs at the airport recorded 228 seizures, and truck traffic in the third quarter of 2025 reached approximately 313,409 entries and

exits. The Customs Affairs also managed 6,117 smuggling cases.

The Financial Investigations National Centre has made significant progress in combating terrorist financing and money laundering. This year, HE the Minister of Interior and Chairman of the Committee for Combating Extremism, Terrorism Financing, and Money Laundering, introduced the National Strategy for Combating Money Laundering, Terrorism Financing, and the Proliferation of Weapons, marking an important step in bolstering Bahrain's financial and economic security.

### Training Programmes at the Royal Academy of Police

This year, the Royal Academy of Police participated in organising and implementing 22 events to promote and raise awareness of the National Human Rights Plan, benefiting 761 individuals. In a related context, the Training Directorate organised approximately 685 internal and external training courses from January to September 2025, benefiting 10,353 ministry personnel and contributing to improved performance, enhanced security readiness, and the provision of distinguished services.

### Security awareness and education projects

Security awareness and education projects have remained a vital part of the Police Media Centre, providing professional media content and high-level security awareness. The number of followers of the Ministry of Interior's social media accounts reached approximately 838,000 by last November. The Police Media Centre issued approximately 103,000 reports, news, and monitored materials. The Radio and Television Affairs Division produced 4,196 materials, including coverage, reports, video and audio clips, and more. In ad-

dition, the monthly and quarterly "Al Amn" and "Watani" magazines continued to be published to raise national awareness among children.

### Six years since the launch of "Bahrainouna"

The National Plan to Promote the Spirit of Belonging to the Nation and Reinforce the Values of Nationalism (Bahrainouna) has undergone several stages since its launch six years ago. In May, an exhibition was held to showcase the finalists' entries in the "Generations Challenge" competition, presented in an interactive format to enhance community awareness. In September,

the Executive Office organised interactive, innovative platforms that reflect national values and encourage community participation.

### Projects and Awards

- **Maan (together)** programme against violence and addiction achieved further successes during 2025 as part of its pioneering role in protecting youth. Bahrain was designated a regional centre for the programme. It also won the Prince Naif bin Abdulaziz Security Research Award in the Leading Security Programmes category. Notably, the programme is implemented in 173 public schools and all private schools, benefiting more than 120,000 students.
- **Bahraini women, represented by the Women's Police, have strengthened their position and achieved success in community partnerships and social security initiatives.**
- **The Human Resources Directorate received the Diamond Certificate for its "Healthy Workplaces" project and two awards at the 2025 Government Human Resources Summit in Abu Dhabi.**
- **The sports teams of the Public Security Sports Association continued to achieve successes and honourable accomplishments in sporting events.**
- **This year, the Permanent Tennis Committee at the Ministry of Interior continued its activities, building on the successes of the Bahrain Ministry of Interior Tennis Challenger.**
- **Among the governorates' achievements, the Southern Governorate launched a video call service for customers. The Northern and Muharraq Governorates received accreditation certificates from the World Health Organisation as healthy governorates, and the Muharraq Governorate received the Community Commitment Leadership Award from the Bahrain Society for the Care of Parents.**

In conclusion, on Bahrain Police Day, the Ministry of Interior, on behalf of all its members, renews its pledge of allegiance and loyalty to HM and reaffirms its commitment to remain under his leadership as King and leader of the nation.

## Non-Bahrainis in government jobs down 29% since 2019

Non-Bahrainis working in government jobs have fallen by 29 per cent over about six years, dropping from 7,582 employees in 2019 to 5,361 to date, the Civil Service Bureau has said.

In a written reply to a parliamentary question by MP Dr Hisham Al Ashiri, the bureau put the change down to ongoing work with ministries and other bodies covered by the Civil Service Law.

It said it supplies a qualified Bahraini candidate whenever one is available, while keeping public services and day-to-day performance from being affected.

The bureau said ministries, authorities and public institutions hired 3,884 new staff from January 2023 to date, with Bahrainis making up 95 per cent of appointments.

### Hires

Around 2,850 of those hires, about 73 per cent, were in the health and education sectors. Bahrainis accounted for 93 per cent of appointments in those two areas, it added.

Recruitment in the civil service is mainly limited to Bahrainis, the bureau said, with scope to hire non-Bahrainis on short-term contracts when no suitably qualified Bahraini is available, under Article 11 of the Civil Service Law.

It said this is allowed on the condition that Bahrainis are trained during the contract period.

The bureau said the use of non-Bahrainis has been focused on specialist and rare fields.

These include consultant doctors, cardiac perfusion roles in intensive care units, neuro tests, genome science, prosthetics, and academic posts in higher education.

It also listed aviation security and safety, water geology, geophysics, marine and air surveying, wells and groundwater, plant protection, and bridge and infrastructure projects, adding that most of these posts sit in health, medical and education work.

Over the same period, the bureau said it published six local job adverts through its official social media accounts, following requests from a number of government bodies.

It said hiring is based on an actual need to fill a vacancy, after checks that the post exists within the approved structure, staffing ceiling and budget, and matches the job descriptions and standards used across the civil service.

The bureau said it handles vacancy adverts, nominations and the running of interviews, working with government bodies, including those governed by special rules.

### Vacancies

It said the bodies themselves must notify it of vacancies they want to fill, while the bureau decides how posts are advertised, locally or overseas.

The bureau also referred to guidance issued on the rules and terms for hiring into government posts, aimed at unifying recruitment methods and strengthening fairness and openness.

It said each government body picks its preferred candidate after interviews held in the presence, and under the supervision, of a Civil Service Bureau representative.

### Roles

The bureau also pointed to an internal vacancy service, 'Shawagher', which allows government employees seeking better roles to apply through the bureau's online portal, alongside the 'GovEmployee' app.

This followed a Cabinet decision requiring vacancies to be advertised internally before seeking hires from outside government bodies.

It said 486 job announcements have been published through the 'GovEmployee' app since January 2023, as part of moves to support internal transfers and make use of Bahraini talent within the government workforce.

## MP proposes 2.5% minimum credit card payment from 5%

A proposal to cut the minimum monthly repayment on credit-card bills to 2.5 per cent, from 5 per cent, has been filed in Parliament by MP Mohammed Al Ma'refi, along with a plan to fix one statement date for all banks and licensed card issuers.

Al Ma'refi's proposal asks the government to direct the Central Bank of Bahrain to change the minimum payment for Visa and Mastercard statements so it matches the 2.5 per cent rate applied to retirees.

He said the change is aimed at easing monthly pressure on citizens and residents with financial obligations.

### Statements

He also wants all credit-card statements issued on the 20th of each Gregorian month, replacing the mix of dates used by different banks and firms.

Under his plan, the grace period would run from the 20th until the next month's statement is issued.

In the explanatory memorandum, Al Ma'refi said credit cards are among the most used banking tools in the local market and that some rules linked to them should be reviewed.

### Repayment

He said lowering the minimum repayment would give cardholders more room to manage monthly spending, especially low-income earners and households with fixed costs, as cards are being used more to cover basic needs.

He said applying the 2.5 per cent rate to all customers would extend a rate already used for retirees.

He also said a single statement date would reduce confusion linked to different issue and payment dates between banks, help monthly budgeting, and cut late payment and unintended default.

## 15 held for drug smuggling



The Ministry of Interior announced the arrest of 15 individuals of various nationalities, aged between 21 and 33, for attempting to smuggle and possess narcotic substances weighing about 29 kilograms, with an estimated value exceeding BD135,000. The arrests were made in separate incidents as part of ongoing anti-drug efforts by the Anti-Narcotics Directorate of the General Directorate of Criminal Investigation and Forensic Science, in coordination with Customs Affairs and Air Cargo, to protect society from the dangers of drugs. The Directorate explained that, immediately upon receiving information about the incidents, investigations were initiated, resulting in the identification and arrest of the suspects. Legal proceedings were taken, and the case was referred to the Public prosecution.

# Hamala mall chaos

Family-friendly public space disrupted weekly by hundreds of unruly minors

What should be a relaxed, family friendly open air mall in Hamala has instead become a source of weekly frustration for visitors.

The mall, home to restaurants, cafés and a dedicated children’s play area, sees its atmosphere shift dramatically every Thursday and Friday.

Regular visitors estimate that between 200 and 300 minors, all believed to be under 18, gather at the mall during peak hours.

A space intended for dining, leisure and family outings is instead overwhelmed by noise, disorder and intimidation.

Teenagers are seen running through walkways, shouting loudly and seeking attention.

**Confrontations**

Verbal confrontations break out, foul language is used openly, and random visitors are targeted with loud remarks or awkward questions, often aimed at provoking reactions for amusement. The disruption extends beyond public walkways. During a visit to the mall, The Daily Tribune personally witnessed large groups entering a supermarket within the mall without any intention of shopping.

**Damage**

Glass cups displayed for sale were seen being broken, while food items, including chocolates, were taken without payment.

Families told the Daily Tribune that their primary concern is the impact on children. The repeated use of explicit language in open areas has left parents deeply uncomfortable. Several visitors said they no longer feel the mall is suitable for family outings. Some have already reduced their visits, while others are actively seeking quieter alternatives where visitors are not exposed to shouting, insults or aggressive behaviour.

**Responsibility**

Attention is now turning to mall management. Other malls across Bahrain faced similar challenges and acted by restricting entry for unaccompanied minors, restoring order and protecting family oriented environments. With many malls now enforcing such policies, visitors believe this mall has become a gathering point for teenagers barred elsewhere. Given its open air design and winter popularity, families are asking a simple question. When will the mall return to being the calm, safe and welcoming space it once was?

# Cultural renewal

BD680,000 Manama Souq revamp under way, Tourism Ministry tells Parliament

Manama Souq's historic quarter is being redeveloped under a plan overseen by a joint committee, with on-site work now under way on a first package of works worth about BD680,000 and an expectation that two early sites will be finished by the final quarter of 2026, the Tourism Ministry has told Parliament.

The details are outlined in a written reply from Tourism Minister, Her Excellency Fatima Al Sairafi, to MP Ahmed Al Salloom, who asked for the ministry's plan for the historic parts of the souq, the stages of the work, the start date, the budget, coordination with other bodies and how traders would be treated during construction.

The minister said the scheme follows a Royal Order calling for a plan to protect Bahrain's historic and cultural identity in buildings and cities, and directions from His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, to launch a full plan to redevelop Manama's historic area, including the souq.

## Plan

"A joint committee has been formed comprising the relevant bodies to prepare a plan to develop Manama's historic area, including the Manama Souq area," H.E. Al Sairafi said in her reply. She added the plan covers a guiding manual for building works in built-heritage areas,

cultural and heritage projects, new visitor stops and upgrades to the area's infrastructure.

H.E. Al Sairafi added that projects inside the market area are meant to follow one design language that matches the heritage and cultural character of the district.

## Tender

For the Bahrain Tourism and Exhibitions Authority's share of the works, the ministry said a tender was issued in April 2025 to redevelop the market's main entrance, known locally as Al Musaqqaf, the passage beside it leading towards the Kanoo Museum, and the Bab Al Bahrain Souq.

It said those points shape first impressions for citizens, residents and tourists. Bids were assessed and a contractor was appointed in July 2025, the reply said, adding that permits and approvals have recently been issued and works have begun.

H.E. Al Sairafi said planned works in the market area in-

clude above-ground upgrades, with some sites handled by government bodies and others by different developers.

## Sites

It named Al Musaqqaf and the Bab Al Bahrain Souq among the sites to be handled by the BTEA, while other sites would be announced once administrative and funding steps are completed and approvals are secured.

On funding, the reply said the budget for the first phase of the authority's sites is about BD680,000, based on the contract award.

On coordination, the ministry said work is guided through the joint committee framework, which includes BTEA and the Urban Planning and Development Authority.

## Progress

It said progress and work methods are reported to the committee on a regular basis.

On traders and shop owners, the ministry said meetings were

held with a number of traders in the area to brief them on the plan and stages of work, and to hear their comments.

"The Ministry of Tourism and the Bahrain Tourism and Exhibitions Authority look forward to completing the development works during the fourth quarter of 2026," H.E. Al Sairafi said, referring to Al Musaqqaf and the Bab Al Bahrain Souq.

She added that timeframes for other sites would be announced soon once their steps are completed and coordination is done to secure the required approvals.

On preserving the market's look and history, the ministry said the guiding manual is meant to set rules that protect Manama's heritage identity and keep the city's building style in mind, while striking a balance between modern development and the area's architectural heritage so the souq remains tied to its cultural and historic character.

## East Sitra Housing Project third phase completion hits 23%



Project timeline on track

Construction work on the third phase of the East Sitra Social Housing Project has reached 23% completion.

This was announced by Her Excellency Amna bint Ahmed Al Rumaihi, Minister of Housing and Urban Planning.

Infrastructure works stand at 29%, while 16% of the 1,269 housing units have been built.

The minister said the progress reflects adherence to the project's timeline, with allocation procedures for eligible beneficiaries scheduled to begin in 2026.

## Partnership

She noted that the third phase, implemented in partnership with China Machinery Engineering Corporation (CMEC), includes housing construction and full infrastructure services such as main and internal roads, sewage and rainwater networks, and street lighting.

It is the largest phase of the project, spanning 670,000

square metres.

The phase also includes 51,300 square metres of green spaces, 1,780 drainage openings, 23.6 kilometres of roads, and 27,600 metres of rainwater lines to ensure a fully operational urban environment once completed.

Al Rumaihi said the ministry will continue to monitor progress closely to maintain momentum and deliver the project on schedule.

Service facilities planned as part of the phase include three schools, a police station, six telecom towers, seven parks and playgrounds, and three community centres.

The Bahrain Authority for Culture and Antiquities (BACA) participated in the official opening of the Zayed National Museum in Abu Dhabi, as part of the ongoing cultural collaboration between the Kingdom of Bahrain and the United Arab Emirates.

The Authority was represented by Dr. Salman Ahmed Almahari, Director General of Archaeology, and Haya Ahmed Al Sada, Director of Museums.

The Bahrain National Museum loaned 19 distinguished archaeological artefacts from the

Dilmun and Tylos civilisations, carefully selected to represent Bahrain's rich heritage within the museum's exhibition galleries.

The collection includes pottery, copper and steatite vessels, Dilmun seals, locally minted Greek silver tetradrachm coins, and glass vessels dating to the Tylos period.

It represents the largest Bahraini loan to a museum institution outside the Kingdom during this period, reflecting the significance of the Bahrain National Museum and the richness of its collections.



# Pay protest

Unpaid three-month salaries push engineering staff to take collective action

What began with quiet patience has now turned into open resistance.

Workers at a private engineering services firm in the Al Budaiya area have stopped work after allegedly labouring for three months without receiving their salaries, a delay that has pushed families into deep financial and emotional strain.

Information shared with The Daily Tribune by one of the affected employees reveals a growing sense of urgency and despair.

According to the worker, repeated requests to management for overdue wages were met with silence, leaving employees with no option but to take collective action in an effort to reclaim income they say they earned through months of work.

## Necessity

For many of those affected, income is not a monthly convenience but a daily necessity.

The absence of pay has been immediate and unforgiving.

Rent deadlines have passed, grocery bills have piled up and medical needs have been postponed.

## Stress

What should have been routine salary payments instead became weeks of uncertainty and stress, felt most sharply inside workers' homes.

The employee described families slipping steadily into debt, with breadwinners unable to



provide despite continuing to report to work.

Beyond the financial hardship, the emotional toll has been heavy, marked by anxiety, exhaustion and a growing sense of helplessness.

## Failure

Attempts to resolve the issue internally have failed, workers say.

No clear explanation, reassurance or payment schedule has been communicated, deepening frustration and eroding trust.

The lack of transparency has left employees feeling abandoned and insecure about their future.

## Final option

Workers insist the strike is not an act of defiance, but a final option.

They say it was taken only

after all other avenues were exhausted, driven by the simple demand to be paid what they are owed.

The workers are now calling for urgent intervention from the relevant authorities, urging decisive action to protect their rights and secure the immediate release of long-overdue salaries.

## Public attention

They believe public attention may be the only way to break the deadlock and prevent further harm.

Labour observers warn that prolonged delays in wage payments often carry serious social and psychological consequences, particularly for low-income workers with no financial safety net.

At the time of publication, no official response had been issued regarding the workers' claims.

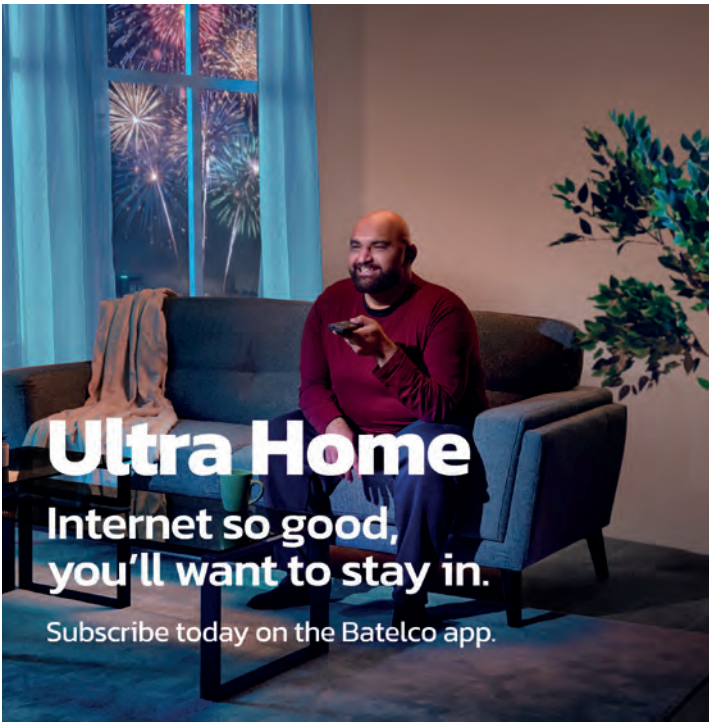

# US envoy to meet Zelensky in Berlin

- Discussions focus on a US-led peace plan
- Russia launches massive energy strikes

US President Donald Trump's special envoy will meet with Volodymyr Zelensky and other European leaders in Berlin this weekend, the White House said, as Washington presses for a plan to end Russia's war with Ukraine.

Ahead of the meetings, Zelensky warned on Saturday that Russia "still aims to destroy" Ukraine, as Kyiv said "massive" Russian strikes on energy facilities overnight had left thousands without power across the country.

A Turkish-owned cargo ship was damaged by a Russian airstrike in Odesa just hours after President Erdogan met Vladimir Putin, adding new urgency to Ankara's push for a limited Black Sea ceasefire

Russia said it had hit Ukrainian facilities with hypersonic ballistic missiles, in what it called retaliation for Ukrainian attacks.

"It is important that every-

one now sees what Russia is doing -- every step they take in terror against our people... for this is clearly not about ending the war. They still aim to destroy our state and inflict maximum pain on our people," the Ukrainian president said on X.

An 80-year-old woman was killed when a Russian shell hit a residential building in Ukraine's northeastern Sumy region, said the regional governor.

Trump has been stepping up pressure on Kyiv to reach an agreement since revealing a plan to end the war last month that was criticised as echoing Moscow's demands, including Ukraine ceding crucial territory.

The 28-point proposal has triggered a flurry of diplomacy between the United States and Ukraine's European allies, with Kyiv officials recently saying they had sent Washington a revised version.

## Democrats release new cache of Epstein photos

Democratic lawmakers released a new cache of photos on Friday from the estate of convicted sex offender Jeffrey Epstein that includes images of US President Donald Trump and former president Bill Clinton.

Other high-profile figures in the published pictures include former Trump advisor Steve Bannon, former Clinton treasury secretary Larry Summers, director Woody Allen and the ex-prince now known as Andrew Mountbatten-Windsor.

Also pictured are Microsoft's Bill Gates and the Virgin Group's Richard Branson.

Epstein's association with the individuals in the pictures was already widely known and the undated photographs do not appear to depict any unlawful conduct.

But Democrats on the House Oversight Committee said "these disturbing images raise even more questions about Epstein and his relationships with some of the most powerful men in the world."

Indonesia flood death toll passes 1,000 as authorities ramp up aid



Indonesia, rescuers said Saturday as the Southeast Asian nation grapples with the huge scale of relief efforts. The disaster, which has hit the northwestern island of Sumatra over the past fortnight, has also injured more than 5,400, the National Disaster Mitigation Agency said. The deadly

torrential rains are one of the worst recent disasters to strike Sumatra, where a tsunami wreaked havoc in 2004 in the northern tip of the island..

North Korea sent troops to clear mines in Russia's Kursk region earlier this year, leader Kim Jong Un said in a speech carried on Saturday by state media, a rare acknowledgement by Pyongyang of the deadly tasks assigned to its deployed soldiers. North Korea has sent thousands of troops to support Russia's nearly four-year invasion of Ukraine, according to South Korean and Western intelligence agencies. Analysts say Russia is giving North Korea financial aid, military technology, food and energy supplies in return, allowing the diplomatically isolated nation to sidestep tough international sanctions on its nuclear and missile programmes.

# Thailand says 4 soldiers killed in Cambodia conflict, denies Trump truce claim

Bangkok said Cambodian forces killed four Thai soldiers on Saturday, after the prime minister denied US President Donald Trump's claim that a truce was agreed to end days of deadly fighting.

Violence between the Southeast Asian neighbours, which stems from a long-running dispute over the colonial-era demarcation of their 800-kilometre (500-mile) border, has displaced around half a million people on both sides.

At least 24 people have been killed this week, including four Thai soldiers the defence ministry said died in the border area on Saturday.

Each side blamed the oth-

er for reigniting the conflict, before Trump said a truce had been agreed.

But Thai Prime Minister An-

utin Charnvirakul said Trump "didn't mention whether we should make a ceasefire" during their Friday phone call.

The two leaders "didn't discuss" the issue, Anutin told journalists on Saturday.

Trump had hailed his "very good conversation" with Anutin and Cambodian Prime Minister Hun Manet on Friday.

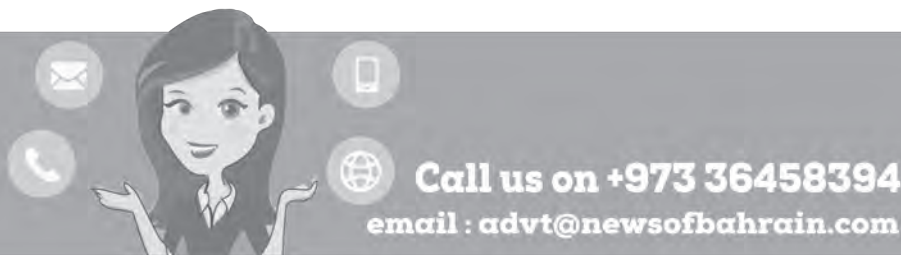
"They have agreed to CEASE all shooting effective this evening, and go back to the original Peace Accord" agreed in July, Trump wrote on his Truth Social platform.

The United States, China and Malaysia, as chair of the regional bloc ASEAN, brokered a ceasefire in July after an initial five-day spate of violence.

In October, Trump backed a follow-on joint declaration between Thailand and Cambodia, touting new trade deals after they agreed to prolong their truce.

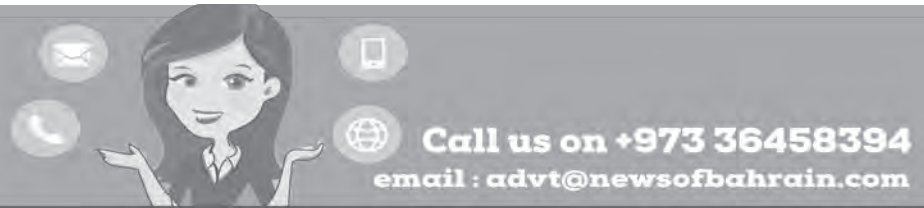

and Eduardo Camavinga.

Fran Garcia, Alvaro Carreras and Endrick are also suspended. Defender Dean Huijsen is likely to return for the clash at Alaves which could define Alonso’s future.

“Evidently despite the players we’ve got out we have strong enough players and a strong enough team,” continued the coach.

Alonso said he hoped Madrid’s current struggles, lying four points behind La Liga leaders Barca, could make them stronger.

“We are having difficulties but we can grow, if we can get past these tough times, change the dynamic, maybe in a few weeks we’ll look back and think ‘we went through a lot but it made us stronger’.”

## France set up World Cup warm-ups with Brazil and Colombia

France will play Brazil and Colombia in the United States in March as part of their build-up for the 2026 World Cup finals, coach Didier Deschamps said on Saturday.

“It’s always good to go the place where the event takes place, and it’ll be very good to play Brazil and Colombia,” Deschamps said.

France will take on five-time world champions Brazil in Boston, where Les Bleus are likely to be based for next year’s tournament, and play Colombia in Washington.

France were finalists in the last World Cup in Qatar and champions in 2018 in Russia.

They have been drawn in Group I along with Senegal, Norway and the winner of a play-off involving Iraq, Bolivia and Suriname.

Deschamps will announce his World Cup squad in mid-May. He will step down after the tournament, with Zinedine Zidane the favourite to take over as France coach.

# Fans vandalise India stadium after Messi’s abrupt exit

Angry spectators broke down barricades and stormed the pitch at a stadium in India after football star Lionel Messi, who is on a three-day tour of the country, abruptly left the arena.

As a part of a so-called GOAT Tour, the 38-year-old Argentina and Inter Miami superstar touched down in the eastern state of West Bengal early Saturday, greeted by a chorus of exuberant fans chanting his name.

Hours later, thousands of fans wearing Messi jerseys and waving the Argentine flag packed into Salt Lake stadium in the state capital Kolkata, but heavy security around the footballer left fans struggling to catch a glimpse of him.

Messi walked around the pitch waving to fans and left the stadium earlier than expected.

Frustrated fans, many having paid more than \$100 for tickets, ripped out stadium seats and hurled water bottles onto the track.

Many others stormed the pitch and vandalised banners and tents.

“For me, to watch Messi is a pleasure, a dream. But I have missed the chance to have a glimpse because of the mismanagement in the stadium,” businessman Nabin Chatterjee, 37, told AFP.

Before the chaos erupted, Messi unveiled a 21-metre (70-foot) statue which shows him holding aloft the World Cup.

He was also expected to play a short exhibition game at the stadium.

Another angry fan told the Press Trust of India (PTI) that people had spent “a month’s salary” to see Messi.

“I paid Rs 5,000 (\$55) for the

ticket and came with my son to watch Messi, not politicians. The police and military personnel were taking selfies, and the management is to blame,” Ajay Shah, told PTI.

Javed Shamim, a senior police official in the state, told reporters that the event’s “chief organiser” had been arrested, without giving any further details.

“There is total normalcy,” he said, adding that authorities would look into how organisers could refund money to those who bought tickets.

State chief minister Mamata Banerjee said she was “disturbed” and “shocked” at the mismanagement.

“I sincerely apologise to Lionel Messi, as well as to all sports lovers and his fans, for the unfortunate incident,” she said in a post on X, adding that she had ordered a probe into the incident.

# Salah sets up goal on return to Liverpool action

Forward sets up goal off bench as champions ease turmoil at Anfield

- Salah provides key second-half assist
- Liverpool climbs to sixth in the table

Mohamed Salah set up a goal in Liverpool's 2-0 win against Brighton on Saturday as he returned to action after an explosive outburst cast doubt over his future at the Premier League champions.

The Egypt forward, the subject of intense scrutiny in the build-up to the game at Anfield, came off the substitutes' bench to huge cheers in the 26th minute, replacing injured defender Joe Gomez.

The home team, whose title defence has collapsed after a shocking run of results, were leading 1-0 at the time, with France forward Hugo Ekitike on the scoresheet after just 46 seconds.

Brighton squandered a number of opportunities to level and Ekitike scored again with half an hour to go to give Liverpool breathing space.

Salah accused Liverpool of throwing him "under the bus" after he was left on the bench for last week's 3-3 draw at Leeds -- the third match in a row that he had been named among the replacements.

He also said that he had no relationship with manager Arne Slot.

Salah was omitted from the midweek Champions League trip to Inter Milan, which Liv-

erpool won 1-0, posting a picture on social media of himself alone in the gym.

Slot said at Friday's pre-match press conference that he would speak to the forward later in the day, adding: "I have no reasons (in) not wanting him to stay."

There was feverish speculation in the build-up to Saturday's match about what role Salah would play, with the winger named on the bench.

Liverpool, who had won just two of 10 Premier League matches before the Brighton game, made a lightning start, taking the lead in the first minute when Joe Gomez set up Ekitike, who thumped the ball past Bart Verbruggen.

Salah entered the fray about 20 minutes before half-time

when Gomez was withdrawn.

Brighton's Diego Gomez squandered a good chance to level early in the second half, striking the ball against the outside of a post, and Brajan Gruda also went close as the home crowd chanted Salah's name.

Liverpool doubled their lead in the 60th minute when Ekitike scored his second, nodding home Salah's corner.

Salah himself went close in stoppage time after he was set up by Federico Chiesa but he blazed over.

The win lifts Slot's men to sixth in the table ahead of the later kick-offs on Saturday, easing the pressure on the beleaguered manager.

## Palmer strikes as Chelsea return to winning ways against Everton

Cole Palmer returned with a much-needed goal as Chelsea beat Everton 2-0 in the Premier League on Saturday to end a run of four games without a win in all competitions.

Victory at Stamford Bridge lifted Chelsea back into the top four.

Injury-plagued attacking midfielder Cole missed Chelsea's loss away to Atalanta in the Champions League on Tuesday as part of his recovery from a two-month spell on the sidelines.

Palmer was initially troubled

by a groin problem and then fractured his toe after stubbing it on a door at home.

The 23-year-old made his first start for the Blues since September in last weekend's goalless draw at Bournemouth.

The England international broke the deadlock against Everton in the 21st minute at Stamford Bridge.

Malo Gusto played in Palmer with a fine pass and he beat fellow England international Jordan Pickford at the goalkeeper's near post.

Everton dominated possession, with Chelsea goalkeeper Robert Sanchez saving well from Jack Grealish.

## Atletico recover Liga momentum with battling win over Valencia

Atletico Madrid returned to winning ways in La Liga with a 2-1 victory over Valencia on Saturday, sealed by a fine Antoine Griezmann strike.

Goals by captain Koke and Griezmann brought Diego Simeone's fourth-placed side within six points of leaders Barcelona, who host Osasuna later on.

Atletico had muscled their way back into the Spanish title race after a slow start to the season, before suffering damaging consecutive Liga defeats by Barca and Athletic Bilbao at the start of December.

They followed up a Champions League victory at PSV in midweek with a solid display at their Metropolitano stadium against Los Che.

"We made a big effort in the Champions League, it was hard for us to find our rhythm, and in the end it was the sub-

stitutes who gave that spark and that speed, so that we could win today," Griezmann, brought on in the second half, told DAZN.

Valencia began well, Hugo Duro hitting the crossbar, but were undone by a scramble at a corner. Goalkeeper Julien Agirrezabala repelled one effort but was unable to do anything as Koke slid home the rebound.

The visitors thought they had levelled through Pepelu after 35 minutes but the goal was disallowed after a VAR review for offside against Duro in the build-up.

Target man Alexander Sorloth could have extended Atletico's lead before half-time after charging into the box but Agirrezabala denied him.

Valencia, 16th, pulled level soon after the hour, with Beltran's blast from distance catching out Atletico goalkeeper Jan Oblak.

# Manama Holds Off Nuwaidrat Comeback

Nowrooz stars as Manama stretches lead; Ettihad wins 81-72

Bahrain basketball fans were treated to an action-packed doubleheader last night in the Zain Basketball League, with Premier League leaders Manama edging Nuwaidrat 86-83 and Al Ettihad defeating Al Bahrain 81-72 in a League B match.

Manama's clash with Nuwaidrat proved to be a closely contested matchup. The home side jumped out to a 45-37 half-time lead, fueled by sharp shooting from Hassan Nowrooz and Ahmed Salman, but Nuwaidrat refused to fold. Midway through the third quarter, points from Hassan Abbas and Emran Hasan drew the visitors level, setting the stage for a tense final period. The quarter-by-quarter scores read: Nuwaidrat 15/19, Manama 18/30, Nuwaidrat 22/23, Nuwaidrat 19/23.

In the closing minutes, Manama's experience and composure

made the difference. Layups from Quinton Rose and timely free throws from Nowrooz and Ali Jaber kept the home side ahead, while Subah Hussain's defensive presence and energy off the bench helped them withstand Nuwaidrat's relentless push. Ahmed Salman led all scorers with 26 points, Nowrooz added 21, and both Sabah Hussein and Imran Ghazi contributed 14 points each. Nuwaidrat's efforts were led by Rosi with 25 points, Murtadha Salman with 15, and Hassan Abbas with 14, but their late rally fell just short.

With the win, Manama extended their winning streak to four games, bringing their total points to six, while Nuwaidrat now sits on five points after one win and three losses.

Earlier in the evening, Al Ettihad controlled their League B clash against Al Bahrain from start to finish, gradually building a comfortable lead through

balanced offense and disciplined defense. Dcarius Brooks led Al Bahrain with 18 points, including six of 11 from inside the arc, while Ali Baqer added 17 points, including three key three-pointers. For Al Ettihad, Romeo Enan dominated the boards with 20 rebounds

alongside 15 points, supported by Mohamed Ghazwan's 13 points and Fadhel Abdulelah's 18. In the final minutes, Al Ettihad stayed composed at the free-throw line and capitalized on second-chance opportunities, securing a well-earned win.
