Nationals crash out of AFC U23 championship despite draw

The Bahrainis needed nothing less than a victory to have any chance of advancing past the group stage of the continental competition.

They had their opportunities to claim the full three points and battled hard until the final whistle, but they were unlucky not to score and the Aussies did well to preserve the deadlock

Following the result, Australia went through to the quarter-finals along with hosts Thailand, who drew 1-1 with Iraq in yesterday's other Group A clash.
