## Ramadan's full moon eclipse casts crimson glow over the Kingdom

A rare cosmic spectacle unfolded yesterday as a total lunar eclipse

coincided with Ramadan's full moon, casting a deep crimson hue over Bahrain's night sky.

Astronomy researcher Mohammed Redha Al Asfoor explained that skywatchers across North America, Central America, western South America, and

parts of Antarctica were treated to the full sequence—from the Moon slipping into Earth's shadow to its transformation into a striking red before fading back into the night.

Elsewhere, observers in western Europe, Africa, and eastern

South America caught the early phases before the Moon set, while those in East Asia and

eastern Oceania witnessed the eclipse as the Moon rose.

For the Gulf states, however, timing was less favourable. The Moon reached peak fullness at 9:54 AM Bahrain time, well after daylight had erased any chance of viewing the celestial event.

### The countdown is on!

Bahrain's first locally built satellite, AlMunther, is set to be launched into orbit today.

Also known as Made in Bahrain, AlMunther will be delivered into orbit aboard SpaceX's Falcon 9 rocket from Vandenberg Space Force Base in California, United States, as part of the Transporter-13 mission.

A live webcast of the mission will begin approximately 15 minutes before liftoff and can be watched on X @SpaceX, and via the new X TV app.

AlMunther will share the mission with around 40 other payloads from various international entities.

The launch marks a historic milestone in Bahrain's journey towards innovation and space exploration.



# Gold on fire

Hits record \$3,000 as trade battles intensify

Gold surpassed \$3,000 for the first time Friday as US President Donald Trump's trade wars boosted demand for the safe-haven asset, while stock markets bounced on signs US lawmakers would avert a government shutdown.

Gold, a haven in times of uncertainty, rose as much as \$3,004 an ounce before paring back gains later in the day to trade just under \$3,000.

The precious metal was "boosted on increased haven demand amid trade war risks and recent stock market volatility", said Fawad Razaqzada, an analyst at City Index and Forex.com.

In the latest salvo, Trump threatened to impose 200 percent tariffs on wine, champagne and other alcoholic beverages from EU countries.

His threat came after the bloc's planned levies on American-made whiskey and other products in retaliation to US levies on steel and aluminium.

Trump said he would not row his plans for sweeping tariffs on countries worldwide that are to

kick in on April 2.

US shares rose in early deals after slumping in recent sessions while Asian equities ended the week on a positive note.

European stock markets were also given a lift in afternoon deals after Germany moved closer to approving a massive infrastructure and defence spending programme.

### US hails 'historic peace treaty' between Armenia, Azerbaijan

The United States yesterday hailed a "historic peace treaty" finalized by Armenia and Azerbaijan and called on both sides to follow through.

"This is an opportunity for both countries to turn the page on a decades old conflict," US Secretary of State Marco Rubio said.

"Now is the time to commit to peace, sign and ratify the treaty, and usher in a new era of prosperity for the people of the South Caucasus," he added. Azerbaijan and Armenia said that they had wrapped up talks aimed at resolving the Caucasus neighbors' decades-long conflict, with both sides agreeing on the text of a possible treaty.

### Hamas says ready to free Israeli-US hostage, four bodies

Hamas said yesterday it was ready to free an Israeli-American hostage and the remains of four others, after the Palestinian militants and Israel resumed indirect Gaza ceasefire negotiations.

However, Israel said Hamas had "not budged" following a proposal from US President Donald Trump's Middle East envoy Steve Witkoff.

The White House accused Hamas of making "entirely impractical" demands.

## 8,000 happy homes

Government finance scheme fast-tracks ownership

● **Four in five beneficiaries skip state waiting lists for immediate housing solutions**

More than 8,000 citizens have secured homes through a government-backed housing finance scheme, with four in five beneficiaries opting to buy rather than wait for state-built housing, Housing Minister Amna Al Rumaihi told Parliament.

Launched in 2022, the initiative provides a faster route to homeownership through mortgage-style funding. Buyers can receive up to BD 70,000, with additional support for those on lower incomes.

"The programme ensures buyers can secure the highest possible financial backing through a government-supported framework suited to their earnings and repayment capacity," Al Rumaihi said. Those unable to qualify for the minimum BD 40,000 threshold will have the shortfall covered as a non-repayable grant.

Borrowers can use the scheme to purchase, build, or extend properties rather than remain on the government's waiting list. The Tas'heel and New Mazaya programmes were introduced to make funding more immediate and flexible.

Since 2022, the finance programme has helped four in five participants move from state waiting lists to securing homes without delay.

To further expand housing options, the ministry has increased collaboration with private developers, making government land available for projects through a bidding system. New developments are underway in Madinat Salman, Buhair, Hoorat Sanad, and Khalifa City, the latter expected to deliver around 3,000 homes.

"This approach allows private firms to work alongside the government, increasing the supply of affordable homes," Al Rumaihi added.

Demand has surged since the scheme's launch, aided by a series of housing finance

exhibitions where buyers can compare options from developers, estate agents, and banks.

To streamline the process, the ministry, in partnership with Eskan Bank, has introduced Baiti, a real estate platform allowing buyers to review financing options, browse properties, and complete transactions online.

Al Rumaihi reaffirmed the ministry's commitment to working with Parliament to meet demand and expand housing options for citizens.

# Murder not over parking, but years of torment

Family reveals abuse behind brutal Shakhura killing

● Authorities have since confirmed the arrest of a 47-year-old suspect

New revelations have shattered social media claims that a recent killing in Shakhura was a mere parking dispute gone wrong.

The victim's family has spoken out, revealing that the murder was not a spontaneous act but the violent climax of years of harassment and abuse.

The chilling details come as speculation spread online that the fatal attack stemmed from a minor argument over parking. However, the victim's family

has dismissed these claims, stating that their loved one endured relentless intimidation and assaults at the hands of the accused long before the

tragic night. Authorities have since confirmed the arrest of a 47-year-old suspect in connection with the killing, which took place in the parking lot of a resi-

dential building in the Northern Governorate. The General Department of Criminal Investigation and Evidence announced that all legal procedures have been followed, and the case has now been referred to the Public Prosecution.

Amid their grief, the victim's family has expressed gratitude to the Minister of Interior for his attention to the case and to all those who have offered their condolences. However, they stress that justice must be served, reaffirming their trust in the authorities to uncover the full truth and hold the perpetrator accountable.

As the investigation unfolds, the harrowing details behind this crime continue to send shockwaves through the community, challenging the initial perception of a petty dispute and revealing a far more sinister history of violence.

### Bahrain's Fintech Leaders

• **Tarabut** (Ranked 25) – An open banking and embedded finance platform operating in the U.A.E., Bahrain, and Saudi Arabia. In September 2024, it acquired Vyne, a London-based real-time account-to-account (A2A) payments platform. Founded by Abdulla Almoayed in 2018, the company reported a 4.5x year-on-year revenue growth in 2024.

• **Eazypay.com** (Ranked 26) – A payment services provider with a partner-

ship with Binance, allowing cryptocurrency payments. It processed \$4.2 billion in transactions in Bahrain in 2024 and operates in Bahrain and Switzerland, with plans to expand into the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) and Europe. Founded by Nayef Al Alawi in 2016, Eazypay.com was valued at \$300 million as of February 2025.

• **CoinMENA** (Ranked 29) – A cryptocurrency platform founded by Talal Tabbaa and Dina Sam'an in 2021, allowing users to buy, sell, and store digital assets. Licensed by the Central Bank of Bahrain

and Dubai's Virtual Assets Regulatory Authority, CoinMENA operates in 45 countries, including all GCC markets. By the end of 2024, it reported a 430% year-on-year increase in trading volume and surpassed \$2 billion in fiat-to-crypto transactions.

• **Rain** (Ranked 32) – A virtual assets platform

operating in Bahrain, the U.A.E., and Türkiye, offering over 50 cryptocurrencies. It has processed over \$8.3 billion in trading volume since 2019 and had 1.5 million signups as of 2024. Founded in 2017 by Abdullah Almoaiqel, Yehia Badawy, Adam Nelson, and Joseph Dallago, Rain is applying for a local li-

cense in Türkiye.

### Fintech Trends in the Middle East

Payment solutions and buy-now, pay-later (BNPL) services continue to dominate the region. Tabby, a Saudi-based shopping and financial services app, secured \$160 million in a Series E funding round in February 2025, boosting its valuation to \$3.3 billion, making it the region's most valuable fintech startup and earning it the top spot on the Fintech 50 list.

Following Tabby, Egyptian e-payment giant Fawry ranked second, boasting 53.1 million customers, while Saudi Insurtech and banking solutions firm Rasan placed third after going public on Tadawul in 2024, reaching a market cap of \$1.9 billion by February 2025.

Forbes was founded in 1917 by B.C. Forbes, a Scottish financial journalist. The magazine's original motto, "The Capitalist Tool," reflected its focus on business, finance, and entrepreneurship. Today, Forbes is known for its influential rankings, including The World's Billionaires, 30 Under 30, and the Fintech 50.

# Man on trial for setting dumpster fire near mall

A man has been brought to court after allegedly setting fire to a dumpster near a mall in the Kingdom, police confirmed. Authorities identified the suspect through CCTV footage, which also revealed that he is a repeat offender.

A mall worker who witnessed the incident told police that he had seen the suspect loitering near the bins shortly before the fire broke out. Strangely, the same individual was later spotted helping others extinguish

the flames. The incident was reported to the Interior Ministry, leading to the suspect's arrest. Further investigations uncovered his criminal history, confirming previous charges for similar offences.

A medical committee examined the suspect and ruled out any concerns regarding his mental state. The Public Prosecution has charged him with arson, stating that his actions endangered lives and property.

The First High Criminal Court has scheduled a ruling on 25 March, with the suspect remaining in custody until then.


# Trapped and exploited

Woman forced into unpaid labour as employer pockets wages

She landed in the Kingdom dreaming of a better life. But fate had other plans.

Endless work, meagre

pay, and no way out.

She had few options to pursue, as her passport had been confiscated by her employer, a woman in her 50s.

Police said the woman had to work for around nine households without receiving full wages, leaving her physically exhausted and mentally drained.

The suspect, who is accused of running an unlicensed manpower agency and employment office, has been remanded in custody, with her trial postponed to Sunday for a hearing of prosecution witnesses.


The victim, 25, said she came to Bahrain on a visit visa to work as a housemaid for BD120 a month. Instead, she claimed, she was passed between nine households without receiving her full wages, while the accused withheld her passport to keep her trapped in the job.

The Interior Ministry flagged the case as potential human traffick-

ing, finding that the accused withheld the victim's earnings, handing over just BD200 for the first two months. A witness backed the claims, saying the accused had sent voice messages threatening the worker with violence.

Prosecutors said the accused admitted to running a recruitment agency and employment office without a proper licence. Investigators recovered audio recordings containing threats against the victim, and the Labour Market Regulatory Authority pushed for legal action over her dealings.

The charges allege that between 2024 and 2025, the accused, along with another unidentified person, exploited the victim by recruiting, moving, housing, and forcing her into labour. Prosecutors argue that, given the coercion, deception, and threats used, any supposed consent from the victim was meaningless. The accused allegedly placed her in several homes, collected her wages, and pocketed the proceeds, in condi-



tions that violated labour laws.

She is also charged with stealing an official document belonging to an Asian country—specifically, the victim's identification papers, which had been left in her care. Prosecutors say she ran an unlicensed manpower agency and employment office, breaking multiple regulations.

## Mechanic lands in jail for stealing lawyer's car, forging documents

A mechanic who stole a lawyer's car by forging documents has been jailed for three years, after the High Criminal Appeals Court reduced his original five-year sentence.

The case began when the lawyer's son took the car to the mechanic's garage for repairs following an accident. The insurance company had written off the vehicle, but the lawyer chose to proceed with repairs and left the car in the mechanic's care.

Weeks passed without any updates, and when the lawyer's son visited the garage, he was told the car had been moved elsewhere for electrical and programming work. Each time the family asked about the vehicle, the mechanic gave vague excuses.

Growing suspicious, the family filed a legal complaint, leading to an investigation. The court found that the mechanic had lied, falsely claiming the lawyer's son had already collected the car. To support his deception, he forged a document with a fake signature and submitted it to authorities.

He also fabricated another document, purportedly from

a company, stating that the car had been taken in for programming work at the insurer's request. The document falsely claimed the vehicle had been collected before the lawyer's son even inquired about it. To further cover his tracks, the mechanic forged company employees' signatures.

Prosecutors charged him with forgery, using fake documents, and theft under false pretences.

The lower court sentenced him to five years—three for forgery and using fake documents, and two for theft. However, on appeal, the sentence was reduced to three years.

# Five new schools, major revamp planned for public education

Education Minister Dr Mohammed bin Mubarak Juma has announced plans to build five new schools and four academic buildings as part of the upcoming budget. Additionally, 80 public schools will undergo major upgrades, including renovations, deep cleaning, and new furniture to enhance learning environments.

The ministry is also advancing efforts to introduce the International Baccalaureate (IB) programme in public schools, with an IB Organisation delegation set to visit Bahrain in April.

The programme aims to provide Bahraini students with an internationally recognised academic pathway.

To strengthen the teaching workforce, 600 Bahrain Teachers' College graduates will be recruited across 2025 and 2026.

Meanwhile, a new cohort will begin a four-year degree in education, ensuring a steady pipeline of trained teachers for public schools.

Infrastructure planning is being coordinated with Housing and Urban Planning to integrate schools into new residential areas and meet population growth demands.

Curriculum updates are also in progress, with improvements in English, Arabic, maths, and science. Question banks will be expanded to help students prepare for exams, and the ministry is working with Bahraini and international experts to refine teaching methods. Quranic stud-



ies will be strengthened, and a new subject on Bahraini folk culture will be introduced in 2025, covering the nation's customs and traditions.

Bahrain continues to participate in global academic assessments, including TIMSS (maths

and science for Years 4 and 8) and PIRLS (reading for Year 4), to evaluate curriculum effectiveness.

For students with disabilities, 13 additional classrooms will be added, and the ministry is working with an American university to implement improved assessment methods for students with special needs and autism, aiming to enhance their learning experience.

Dr Juma described the IB programme as one of the ministry's most ambitious initiatives, with further discussions planned during the April visit to Bahrain's secondary and intermediate schools.

MPs Dr Munir Seroor and Ali Saqer, argues that AI is no longer an emerging trend but a fundamental part of education, technology, finance, and trade. Other countries are already moving fast, and Bahrain must act now to stay competitive.

"Artificial intelligence is taking root across all areas of life," Dr Seroor said. "Governments worldwide are laying strong foundations, and Bahrain should

do the same. We have the talent and ambition, but firms need support to develop AI applications and attract expertise to train our people."

Tamkeen, which already funds digital upgrades through schemes like 'Start Your Business' and 'Business Growth,' acknowledges AI's growing role. The fund's CEO, Maha Mufeez, highlighted AI's potential to drive investment and job crea-

tion, both locally and internationally.

"The speed of change in artificial intelligence is striking," she said. "Tamkeen continues to support businesses adopting AI tools and expanding training programmes, in line with its role."

Parliament's Services Committee has unanimously backed the motion, citing public interest as a key reason for approval.

# MPs push to Bahrainise tour guide jobs

**M**Ps will vote next Tuesday on a proposal to Bahrainise tour guiding jobs by limiting foreign hires. The plan, backed by Parliament's Services Committee, also covers fields such as engineering, media, security, administration, and hospitality.

Leading the push is Mohammed Al Olaiwi, with support from Services Committee Chairwoman Jaleela Alawi and three other MPs. Bahraini tour guides argue that their role is more than just providing information—it is about representing the nation's history, customs, and identity.

They cite UN tourism guidelines and a 2005 government rule requiring licensed guides to be Bahraini.

"A tour guide is a cultural ambassador, someone who speaks with authority about Bahrain's history because it is their own," said Mirza Al Nasheet, president of Dilmun Friends at The Bahrain Historical and Archaeological Society.

Local guides have called for

training programmes to address language barriers, noting that many Bahrainis already speak multiple languages but remain underrepresented in the industry. Government figures show that 60% of trained guides are non-Bahraini, though industry insiders claim the actual number is higher.

The Ministry of Labour acknowledged the importance of Bahrainisation but highlighted existing wage subsidies, training programmes, and hiring incentives under the 2023-2026 National Labour Market Plan, which aims to create 20,000 jobs annually. It also stressed the need to assess whether all listed professions, including

tour guiding, are attractive to Bahraini jobseekers.

Meanwhile, the Bahrain Chamber of Commerce and Industry has rejected the proposal, warning that rigid Bahrainisation policies could disrupt businesses and limit hiring flexibility. It insists that employment should be driven by supply and demand rather than quotas.

# MPs push for tighter oversight on expatriate business registrations

**P**arliament is investigating a surge in business registrations by expatriates with no clear economic purpose, as MPs call for stricter oversight to prevent misuse of commercial licences.

A proposal by MPs Jalila Alawi, Dr Hisham Al Ashiri, Mohsen Al Asbool, Hassan Ebrahim, and Mohammed Al Olaiwi urges the Ministry of Industry and Commerce to monitor high-demand business sectors, identify underlying trends, and close loopholes that enable abuse.

MPs argue that the sharp rise in registrations, particularly in certain industries, suggests that licences are being obtained for purposes unrelated to genuine trade.

"The sudden rush for licences, especially among certain expatriate groups, raises concerns," said Jalila Alawi.

"There's no clear legal or economic reason behind it. The ministry must investigate these patterns and act if necessary."

Parliament's Financial and Economic Affairs Committee has unanimously backed the proposal, saying tighter scrutiny of registrations would help prevent exploitation of the system.

# EU parliament bars Huawei lobbyists over graft probe

**T**he European Parliament said Friday it has barred Huawei representatives from its premises, a day after police made a series of arrests in a probe into suspected corruption on behalf of the Chinese tech giant.

Later, a spokesperson for the European Commission said Huawei lobbyists have also been barred from accessing its offices.

Several people have been detained for questioning following coordinated raids in Belgium and Portugal, for alleged involvement in "active corruption within the European Parliament, as well as for forgery and use of

forgeries".

A spokesperson for the parliament said it had decided "as a precautionary measure, to suspend the access to parliament of representatives attached to the Huawei company with immediate effect." The EU's legislative has premises in Brussels and Strasbourg, France.

Huawei has nine representatives accredited to the parliament, according to the EU transparency register.

Thursday's raids came less than two years after the "Qatar-gate" scandal, in which EU lawmakers were accused of being paid to promote the interests of Qatar and Morocco -- something

both countries deny.

Transparency campaigners, who have accused the EU parliament of resisting reform after the 2022 scandal, called on it to immediately investigate the latest claims.

The parliament has said it is fully cooperating with the Belgian authorities.

Huawei declined to comment on the access ban, referring to an earlier statement where the firm said it takes the graft allegations "seriously" and would "urgently communicate with the investigation to further understand the situation".

"Huawei has a zero tolerance policy towards corruption or

other wrongdoing, and we are committed to complying with all applicable laws and regulations at all times," the company said Friday.

## Seals and denials

Belgian prosecutors said the alleged corruption dated from 2021 to the present and took "various forms".

These included "remuneration for taking political positions or excessive gifts such as food and travel expenses or regular invitations to football matches" as part of a bid to promote "purely private commercial interests" in political decisions.

The alleged kickbacks were

concealed as conference expenses and paid to various intermediaries, the office said, adding it was looking at whether money laundering had also been involved.

Belgian authorities did not disclose the exact number of arrests, nor the identity of those held.

On Thursday, seals were placed on the doors of several offices used by parliamentary assistants in Brussels and Strasbourg.

Among them were offices used by the staff of lawmakers with Italy's Forza Italia party.

**Duterte attends ICC hearing over drug war by video link** ◆ Former Philippines president Rodrigo Duterte failed to show in person at the International Criminal Court yesterday at the opening of his crimes against humanity hearing over his deadly crackdown on narcotics. The 79-year-old, the first ex-Asian head of state to face charges at the ICC, was following by videolink during a short hearing to inform him of the crimes he is alleged to have committed, as well as his rights as a defendant. Sounding frail and wearing a blue suit and tie, he spoke briefly to confirm his name and date of birth. The presiding judge allowed him to follow proceedings in absentia due to his long flight to The Hague.

◆ The prestigious Johns Hopkins University said Thursday it is being forced to lay off more than 2,000 employees in the aftermath of the Trump administration's massive reduction in foreign aid funding. "This is a difficult day for our entire community. The termination of more than \$800 million in USAID funding is now forcing us to wind down critical work here in Baltimore and internationally," the school, a leading institution of scientific research, said in a statement. Hopkins, in Maryland's largest city an hour's drive north of the US capital, is eliminating more than 2,000 positions - 1,975 in projects across 44 countries and 247 jobs in the United States.

◆ Iran yesterday slammed what it called US "hypocrisy" after President Donald Trump's administration announced new sanctions on its oil minister Mohsen Paknejad. Foreign ministry spokesman Esmail Baqaei said in a statement the move demonstrates US "hypocrisy", as Washington has repeatedly called for nuclear talks with Tehran. He added the sanctions serve as "another clear proof of the falsity of these statements and another sign of its hostility to development."

Stargazers marvel at 'Blood Moon', rare total lunar eclipse

Stargazers across a swathe of the world marvelled at a dramatic red "Blood Moon" during a rare total lunar eclipse in the early hours of yesterday morning. The celestial spectacle was visible in the Americas and Pacific and Atlantic oceans, as well as in the westernmost parts of Europe and Africa. The phenomenon happens when the Sun, Earth and Moon line up, causing our planet to cast a giant shadow across its satellite. But as the Earth's shadow crept across the Moon, it did not entirely blot out its white glow -- instead the Moon glowed a reddish colour. This is because the only sunlight that reaches the Moon is "bent and scattered" as it goes through Earth's atmosphere, said Daniel Brown, an astronomer at Britain's Nottingham Trent University. It is similar to how the light can become pink or red during sunrises or sunsets on Earth, he added. The more clouds and dust

Trump urges Putin to spare troops

US President appeals to Russia to protect encircled Ukrainian soldiers amid ceasefire talks

● Trump calls Moscow talks "very productive"

US President Donald Trump pleaded yesterday with Russian counterpart Vladimir Putin to spare the lives of Ukrainian soldiers on the front-line, after what he called "very good and productive" ceasefire discussions in Moscow.

Trump's comments came after his special envoy held talks with Putin in Moscow to discuss details of a plan for a 30-day ceasefire between Russia and Ukraine after three years of war. "We had very good and productive discussions with President Vladimir Putin of Russia yesterday, and there is a very good chance that this horrible, bloody war can finally come to an end," Trump said on his Truth Social network.

White House Press Secretary Karoline Leavitt later clarified to reporters that Trump himself had not spoken to Putin on Thursday night. She said no call was scheduled yesterday "but that could obviously change." Trump said last week he had spoken to Putin "numerous" times since returning to office,

and apart from the one officially announced call in February that led to the current ceasefire push. In his post yesterday, Trump also issued an unusual appeal to Putin over what he said were "thou-sands" of Ukrainian troops who were "completely surrounded by the Russian military, and in a very bad and vulnerable position."

Kyiv quickly denied Trump's claim. "I have strongly requested to President Putin that their lives be spared. This would be a horrible massacre, one not seen since World War II. God bless them all!!!" Trump wrote. Moscow has in the past week been driving much of Ukraine's forces out of Russia's Kursk region, parts of which Kyiv ocu-

pled last year. Kursk was one of Kyiv's few bargaining chips in swapping land with Russia, which has occupied around a fifth of Ukraine since it took Crimea in 2014 and launched its full-scale invasion in February 2022.

Kremlin says Putin sent 'additional' signals to Trump on ceasefire

Russia yesterday said President Vladimir Putin had sent "additional" signals to counterpart Donald Trump about a Washington-proposed ceasefire in Ukraine, adding it was "cautiously optimistic" about the prospect of a deal.

US envoy Steve Witkoff met Putin late Thursday to lay out the details of the joint US-Ukrainian plan, which envisages a 30-day pause in hostilities between Moscow and Kyiv after three years of fighting. The Kremlin said Putin conveyed "additional" signals to Trump via Witkoff, and that the two leaders could speak once Trump had been briefed on these messages.

"When Mr Witkoff brings all the information to President Trump, we will determine the timing of a conversation," Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov told reporters. "There is an understanding on all sides that such a conversation is needed."

US National Security Advisor Mike Waltz said in a Fox News interview that the US had "some cautious optimism" after Witkoff's visit. Commenting on Waltz's remarks, Peskov said yesterday: "There are reasons to be cautiously optimistic." "There is still much to be done, but the president has nevertheless identified with President Trump's position."

Putin said Thursday he backed the idea of a truce with Ukraine, but said he had "serious questions" about how it would be implemented that he wanted to discuss with Trump.

Mark Carney sworn in as Canada Prime Minister

Mark Carney was sworn in as Canada's prime minister yesterday, taking charge of a country rattled by a breakdown in US relations since President Donald Trump's return to power.

The ruling Liberal Party overwhelmingly backed Carney to replace Justin Trudeau, betting his experience leading two central banks through historic crises will re-assure Canadians facing a potentially devastating trade war.

Carney, who turns 60 on Sunday, is a political novice who has never won an elected public

office but his campaign skills will be tested soon with Canada likely headed for a general elec-

tion in weeks. The threats posed by Trump are expected to dominate the vote. The US president has sought to bludgeon Canada, imposing sweeping import tariffs and threatening further levies while claiming the country is not "viable" on its own and should be annexed by Washington. Carney, who was sworn in as Canada's 24th prime minister at a ceremony in Ottawa, has described Trump's stance as the most serious challenge Canada has faced in a generation. "Everything in my life has prepared me for this moment," Carney said Sunday after winning the Liberal Party leadership race.

China urges end to 'illegal' sanctions as it hosts Iran nuclear talks

China urged an end to "illegal" sanctions on Iran as it hosted Iranian and Russian diplomats yesterday for talks Beijing hopes will restart long-stalled negotiations on Tehran's nuclear programme.

The United States withdrew from a landmark 2015 deal, which imposed curbs on Tehran's nuclear development in return for sanctions relief, during US President Donald Trump's first term.

The Republican president has called for a new nuclear deal with Iran since his return to the White House in January but Tehran says no such agreement is possible so long as punishing sanctions remain in place.

The effort to secure a pact was given new urgency last month when the UN nuclear watchdog said Iran had significantly increased its stockpile of highly enriched uranium.

Fire aboard US airliner after diverted to Denver, 12 injured

An American Airlines Boeing jet caught fire after landing at Denver International Airport in Colorado on Thursday, the US Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) said.

There were 172 passengers and six crew members aboard, the airliner said, according to local media.

All passengers were safely evacuated from the plane but 12 people were taken to hospitals with minor injuries, Denver International Airport said in a post on social media platform X.

Dramatic video images widely shared on social media showed billowing smoke around the jet on the ground near the terminals and passengers standing on a wing as emergency services arrived.

The FAA said the Boeing 737-800, flying from Colorado to Dal-

las-Fort Worth, diverted to Denver International Airport after the crew reported experiencing "engine vibrations."

"After landing and while taxiing to the gate an engine caught fire and passengers evacuated the aircraft using the slides," the FAA said in a statement.

The latest incident comes amid safety concerns after a series of incidents and attempts by US President Donald Trump's administration to cut costs at US aviation agencies.

The FAA said it will investigate the latest incident.

Hamas says ready to free Israeli-US hostage, remains of four others

Hamas yesterday said it was ready to free an Israeli-American hostage and the remains of four other dual nationals, after the Palestinian militants and Israel gathered for indirect Gaza ceasefire talks. The first phase of a truce between Hamas and Israel in the Gaza Strip ended on March 1 without agreement on the next stages. A senior Hamas official said on Tuesday fresh talks had begun in Doha, with Israel also sending negotiators.

"Yesterday, a Hamas leadership delegation received a proposal from the brotherly mediators to resume negotiations," the Islamist movement said in a statement. It added that its reply "included its agreement to release the Israeli soldier Edan Alexander, who holds American citizenship, along with the remains of four others holding dual citizenship."

A Hamas official, Taher Al-Nounou, said that "the five individuals that Hamas agreed to release under the new American proposal are Israeli prisoners holding American na-

mediated and took effect on January 19.

Despite the expiry of the first phase, the ceasefire has largely held. Israel's military on Thursday said it carried out an air strike targeting armed men who were planting explosives in central Gaza, the latest such strike.

Israel halted aid flows into Gaza 13 days ago over the truce impasse. At the weekend, it also cut off the electricity supply, which largely halted output from Gaza's main water desalination plant.

On Thursday Hamas renewed a demand for Israeli troops to withdraw from south Gaza, accusing Israel of seeking to breach the ceasefire in talks on the next phase of the accord. Hamas spokesman Hazem Qassem said that Israeli forces should have pulled out of a strip of land along the Gaza-Egypt border under the first phase.

Hamas has accused Israel of keeping troops in the strategic Philadelphia corridor. Israel has insisted it needs to maintain control of the corridor to prevent weapons smuggling into the Palestinian territory from Egypt.

Saudi crown prince tells Putin he supports 'all initiatives' to end Ukraine war

Saudi Arabia's de facto ruler told Russian President Vladimir Putin that the kingdom supports "all initiatives" to end the Ukraine war, a statement said yesterday, after US-Ukraine talks in Jeddah proposed a 30-day ceasefire.

Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman reaffirmed Saudi Arabia's "commitment to facilitating dialogue and supporting all initiatives aimed at achieving a political resolution" in a phone call with Putin, a foreign ministry statement said.

On Thursday Putin said he had "serious questions" about the ceasefire plan, which was announced after talks in the western Saudi city on Tuesday.

Washington also agreed to resume military intelligence and intelligence sharing with Ukraine, which it shut off after

President Volodymyr Zelenskyy's White House row with President Donald Trump. US Secretary of State Marco Rubio, speaking in Jeddah after the talks, said the "ball is now in (Russia's) court".

According to a Kremlin

statement, Putin told Prince Mohammed that he "noted the importance of resolving the Ukrainian crisis and expressed readiness to continue to contribute in every possible way to the normalisation of Russian-American relations".

# Ramadan fasting: Spiritual practice yields health benefits

Dates, a staple of iftar meals, are rich in carbohydrates, fiber, and minerals, making them a quick source of energy while supporting digestion and brain function. Fresh fruits, such as melons, pomegranates, and bananas, offer hydration and vital nutrients. Meanwhile, lean proteins like fish and chicken provide a fulfilling yet light source of nourishment, preventing sluggishness and digestive issues. Lentils, commonly found in Ramadan soups and stews, are packed with protein and fiber, promoting gut health and prolonged energy release.

## Breaking Bad Habits

Beyond its dietary benefits, Ramadan serves as a chance to abandon harmful habits, such as smoking and excessive sugar consumption. Many Muslims find it easier to quit smoking after fasting for a month, as research has shown that the structured discipline of Ramadan can help curb nicotine cravings.

In 2015, an experimental smoking cessation program during Ramadan demonstrated the effectiveness of faith-based interventions. The initiative, which incorporated religious teachings and behavioral sup-

## Ramadan Recipe

## Chicken fattoush

Serves: 4  
Time: 15 mins

This healthy Middle Eastern salad topped with sumac-sprinkled pitta bread is a quick and easy lunch or supper

### Ingredients

- juice 2 lemons
- 2 tbsp olive oil
- 1 Cos lettuce chopped

- 2 tomatoes chopped into chunks
- small pack flat-leaf parsley chopped
- ½ cucumber chopped into chunks
- 200g pack cooked chicken pieces (or leftover cooked chicken)
- 2 spring onions sliced
- 2 pitta breads

1-2 tsp ground sumac

### Method:

1. Pour the lemon juice into a large bowl and whisk while you slowly add the oil. When all the oil has been added and the mixture starts to thicken, season.
2. Add the lettuce, tomatoes, pars-

ley, cucumber, chicken pieces and spring onions, and stir well to coat the salad in the dressing.

3. Put the pitta breads in the toaster until crisp and golden, then chop into chunks. Scatter the toasted pitta pieces over the salad and sprinkle over the sumac. Serve straight away.





# Guardiola relishing 'big fight' for Champions League spot

● **Man City boss remains optimistic despite challenging season and fifth-place battle**

Pep Guardiola said he is not deflated at having to battle for a place in next season's Champions League and believes doing so would be a "huge success" in a difficult season for Manchester City.

Premier League winners for the past four seasons and in six of the previous seven, Guardiola's men sit fifth with 10 games to go.

A fifth-placed finish will now almost certainly secure Champions League football next season thanks to the strong performance of English sides in European competition this season.

However, that is far from guaranteed for City with five clubs down to Fulham in 10th within five points of the champions. City have struggled to match the high standards of Guardiola's glorious reign this season, losing nine of their last 19 league games.

"It's a big fight and not like a disappointment to be here. It's a challenge in that if we're able to achieve that and qualify for the Champions League, it'd be a huge success from my point of view," said Guardiola yesterday ahead of Brighton's visit to the Etihad.

"Sometimes there are seasons

in life and in sport where you have to live that.

"It's in our hands, it depends on us. We don't have to recover eight or ten points to go there and wait for the opponent to lose many games, it's just about us and depends on our behaviours and our foot-ball if we're there or not."

For the first time since the 2012/13 season, City were not involved in the Champions League last 16 this week.

phase as the 22nd best out of 24 qualifiers.

"I don't have any disappointment and regret, we don't deserve to be there," added Guar-

diola on watching the best of the action form afar this midweek.

"Nobody has to explain me how special is this competition but in this season we deserve to be on the sofa with a glass of wine.

"Hopefully we can do better, qualify for next season and do it better to be there on the pitch."

Brighton are one of those who pose a threat to City's Champions League hopes next season.

The Seagulls have won four consecutive top-flight games for the first time since 1981 to climb to seventh, just one point behind City.

"I think Brighton are one of the best clubs working on and off the pitch," said Guardiola.

## Fernandes sends Man Utd into Europa League quarters, Spurs advance

Rangers knocked out Jose Mourinho's Fenerbahce 3-2 on penalties as Chelsea saw out a 1-0 home win against Copenhagen to ensure their place in the last eight of the Europa Conference League.

Two spot-kicks and a late arrowed finish from Fernandes sent Man Utd into the quarter-finals by a 5-2 aggregate margin against 10-man Sociedad.

# Leclerc leads Melbourne practice

Ferrari's Charles Leclerc tops second practice as Verstappen struggles in seventh place

● **Leclerc sets fastest lap at 1:16.439 on soft tyres**

● **Piastrri second, Norris third for McLaren**

● **Hamilton finishes fifth as he adjusts to Ferrari**

Charles Leclerc powered to the quickest time ahead of Oscar Piastrri in second practice at the season-opening Australian Grand Prix yesterday, with Lewis Hamilton fifth and Max Verstappen only seventh.

Hamilton's Ferrari team-mate Leclerc blasted to a best lap round the Albert Park circuit of one minute 16.439 seconds on soft tyres, 0.124 clear of McLaren's Piastrri.

Leclerc set the pace with 25 minutes to go and no-one could catch him, with Piastrri's team-mate Lando Norris third ahead of surprise-package Yuki Tsunoda in an RB.

Seven-time world champion Hamilton was fifth as he gradually adjusts to life in a new car after his shock move to Ferrari from Mercedes after 12 years.

The Briton cautioned this week that everything at Scuderia was different and there could be a transition period while he settles in.

He was better than in first practice, where he came 12th, but still fourth-

tenths behind his teammate.

Rookie Isack Hadjar came sixth in the second RB ahead of world champion Verstappen, who never looked comfortable in his Red Bull, clocking 10 laps fewer than Leclerc as he pitted for fine-tuning.

Verstappen is chasing a second win in Australia after his 2023 victory to kickstart his bid for a fifth consecutive world title, a feat only Michael Schumacher has achieved.

But he said on Thursday that Red Bull was "not



the quickest at the moment".

The prediction appeared true, with his new teammate Liam Lawson, who took over from the axed

Sergio Perez, slumping to 17th.

Mercedes also struggled with George Russell 10th and Kimi Antonelli, who replaced Hamilton, 16th.

On a perfect Melbourne afternoon, Sauber rookie Gabriel Bortoleto led the way out of the pits as the lights went green, but it was Alpine's Pierre Gasly who set the opening time.

All the drivers started on medium tyres except Mercedes, who opted for hards, and Norris quickly surpassed Gasly to go top.

But that was soon bettered by Russell then Williams' Carlos Sainz as they jockeyed for places.

The times kept coming down

with Leclerc the first under 1:17 with a Ferrari 1-2 after 20 minutes after Hamilton surged second, before all the cars pitted.

Most teams came out on soft tyres and Norris again asserted control with Verstappen a lowly 15th at the halfway point.

But Leclerc pounced soon after to take the lead and despite Piastrri going close, he could not be toppled.

## Eventful first practice

In an eventful first practice that was red-flagged twice, Haas rookie Ollie Bearman smashed into the barriers and lost his rear right wheel in an accident that left debris littering the track.

He climbed out uninjured but the car was such a mess he failed to show for second practice.

There were several other minor mishaps in a reminder of the dangers of a fast and flowing track that has witnessed multiple crashes over the years.

Norris topped first practice ahead of Sainz, with Verstappen fifth.



## Bahrain's Mohsen wins bronze at Special Olympics Winter Games
