ahrain continued their unbeaten run in the 44th William Jones Cup with an 81-69 win over Malaysia on Monday morning in New Taipei City, improving their record to 3-0. The result follows back-toback wins over Japan U25 (85-69) and Chinese Taipei White

After a tight first half in which Bahrain trailed by three late in the second quarter, a 25-point third period shifted momentum decisively. Mustafa Rashed led Bahrain's scoresheet with 23 points on 7-of-12 shooting, including five threes, while Jakarr Sampson added 22 points and 7 rebounds.
