

Gadeha Junior celebrates first graduation

500 participants complete youth training camp

The Gadeha “Up to the Challenge” Junior Training Camp held a graduation ceremony for its first batch at Exhibition World Bahrain, attended by the participants’ parents and families.

The first batch included 500 of the 2,000 young participants enrolled in the camp. The ceremony marked the completion of several days of training and challenges designed to develop participants’ skills while promoting values including discipline, commitment, teamwork and responsibility.

The camp is held under the directives of Lieutenant General His Highness Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa, National Security Advisor and Royal Guard Commander, as part of His Highness’s commitment to supporting the development of Bahrain’s youth.
