BD15 monthly transport plan for private-sector workers

Private-sector workers would receive a monthly transport allowance of at least BD15 under a draft amendment to the Labour Law, with employers exempt where transport to and from the workplace is already provided.

The plan mirrors the public sector, where a minimum BD20 allowance is paid.

The proposal, filed by MP Jalal Kadhem, seeks to add a transport prices. clause to Law No. 36 of 2012 cases where the employer supplies transport.

Kadhem said the move is



guaranteeing the allowance for 2012 now requires employers to private-sector staff except in provide "appropriate means of intended to improve living contransport" in work areas named by ministerial decision.
