Teenage sensation Fati leads Barca thrashing of Valencia

Barcelona's 16-year-old forward Ansu Fati continued his explosive start to life in the first team by scoring and providing an assist as the La Liga champions thrashed Valencia 5-2 on Saturday.

Fati, who became Barca's youngest ever goalscorer two weeks ago by netting at Osasuna, struck his first goal at the Camp Nou to give Barca the lead with less than two minutes on the clock by smashing a pass from Frenkie de Jong into the net.

The teenager then returned the favour by dashing into the area from the left wing and Barca came flying back at them teeing up Dutchman De Jong after the interval. to score his first goal for the club in the seventh minute.
