Young man dies in Samaheej house fire

A 23-year-old man died of suffocation after a fire broke out in a house in Samaheej yesterday.

Civil Defence teams rescued six other individuals from the scene, the Ministry of Interior confirmed.

The victim, Fouad Mahdi Abdullah Daif, who suffered severe smoke inhalation, was rushed to hospital by the National Ambulance service, but efforts to save his life proved unsuccessful.

Authorities said investigations are underway to determine the cause of the blaze.

His Majesty calls for Arab solidarity amid Israeli strike

His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa affirmed the Kingdom of Bahrain's strong condemnation of the Israeli attack on Qatar, describing it as "a violation of sovereignty, security, and stability, as well as of international law and the Charter of the United Nations."

In a speech delivered on his behalf by His Highness Shaikh Abdullah bin Hamad Al Khalifa, Personal Representative of

HM the King, at the Emergency Arab-Islamic Summit in Doha, HM the King expressed the Kingdom's solidarity with Qatar and called on Arab and Islamic nations to intensify collective efforts to end the Palestinian-Israeli conflict.

"The Kingdom of Bahrain affirms its steadfast position calling for an immediate end to the war, the protection of civilians, prevention of displacement, the prompt release of hostages and detainees, and unimpeded delivery of humanitarian aid to the people of the Gaza Strip," HM King Hamad said.

Condolences

His Majesty extended condolences to the Amir of Qatar, His Highness Sheikh Tamim

bin Hamad Al Thani, following the deaths of Qatari National Security Force members in the Israeli attack.

He praised Qatar's mediation efforts, alongside Egypt and the United States, to secure a ceasefire and the release of hostages.

United stance

Warning that the aggression "poses a grave threat to regional stability and undermines peace efforts," HM the King stressed the need for a united Arab and Islamic stance.

"Our nations are called upon to stand in solidarity with the State of Qatar, unite their voices, and urge the international community to uphold its responsibilities," he said.

port for the two-state solution, His Majesty welcomed the UN General Assembly's adoption of the "New York Declaration" on Palestine.

Direct negotiations

HM the King said: "The Palestinian cause remains central to resolving the conflict in the Middle East. This necessitates direct negotiations leading to a just settlement and the establishment of an independent, viable Palestinian state alongside Israel, as stipulated in the Arab Peace Initiative of 2002."

Unity Rising

Cabinet backs Doha summit

- Cabinet condemns Israeli aggression
- Full solidarity with Qatar
- Delegation to represent Kingdom

Bahrain's Cabinet has reaffirmed the Kingdom's solidarity with Qatar, condemning the recent Israeli attack on Doha and backing the extraordinary Arab-Islamic Summit being held in the Qatari capital.

Chairing the weekly meeting at Gudaibiya Palace, Deputy Prime Minister Shaikh Khalid bin Abdulla Al Khalifa said Bahrain supports the summit, which was convened to discuss the aggression against Qatar.

The Cabinet stressed that Bahrain's participation, through a delegation led by His Highness Shaikh Abdullah bin Hamad Al Khalifa, Personal Representative of His Majesty the King, reflects the Kingdom's commitment to Arab and Islamic solidarity.

Ministers described the Israeli strike as a violation of Qa-

tar's sovereignty and international law. They extended condolences to Qatar's leadership and people over the death of a member of its Internal Security Force, while reiterating full support for measures taken to protect the country's security.

Regional diplomacy

The Cabinet also welcomed the UN General Assembly's adoption of the New York Declaration on a two-state solution for Palestine, noting the roles of Saudi Arabia and France in advancing the resolution.

In addition, ministers highlighted the recent meeting between His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and His Highness Sheikh Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, President of the UAE, as an example of strengthened coordination amid regional developments.



The first Arab-Islamic Summit was held in 1969 in Rabat, Morocco, after an arson attack on Al-Aqsa Mosque, setting a precedent for extraordinary summits during regional crises.

Other Cabinet items included welcoming the launch of the Arab Shipbuilding and Repair Yard's solar energy project, commending Bahrain's hosting of the Second Global Water, Energy and Climate Change Congress, and approving a memorandum on restructuring government agencies to improve performance.

But the central message from the Cabinet meeting was clear - Bahrain stands firmly with Qatar as the Doha summit convenes, voicing unity against aggression and underscoring shared regional security.

Shielding Bahrain

Nationwide drive shields economy and society

- 1,133 inspections conducted
- 154 violators deported
- Joint campaigns across governorates

Bahrain's labour market regulator carried out 1,133 inspections in one week, detaining 20 irregular workers and deporting 154 violators in a drive it says is designed to protect the Kingdom's economic and social security.

Safeguarding stability

The Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) said the inspections, conducted from September 7 to 13, also monitored violations related to provisions of regulating laws, especially labour market and residency regulations. Legal measures were taken regarding the observed violations.

Coordinated enforcement

According to LMRA, 1,120



inspection visits were carried out at various shops across the governorates, alongside 13 joint inspection campaigns. These included four campaigns in the Capital Governorate, four in Muharraq, two in the Northern Governorate and three in the Southern Governorate.

The Ministry of Interior, represented by the Nationality, Passports and Residence Affairs (NPRA) and the governorates' police directorates, along with the Social Insurance Organiza-

tion, took part in the operations.

The authority affirmed that coordination with government agencies will continue to intensify inspection campaigns and address any practices that could undermine the labour market or affect Bahrain's stability and security. It renewed its call for public support by urging residents to report violations through its website, the call centre on 17506055, or the government's Suggestions and Complaints System (Tawasil).

Bahrain-Jersey cooperation



His Excellency Shaikh Salman bin Khalifa Al Khalifa, Minister of Finance and National Economy, met with Senator Ian Gorst, Minister for External Relations of the Bailiwick of Jersey, on the occasion of his visit to the Kingdom of Bahrain. Shaikh Salman bin Khalifa reviewed relations between both sides, particularly in the financial and economic domains, highlighting the importance of advancing progress to further developing cooperation for the benefit of both countries and their peoples. Forged school invoice scheme

A Ministry of Education employee, who investigators say admitted contracting with his wife's company, will stand trial with two Asian nationals on 22 September over an alleged forged-invoice scheme tied to a school's budget.

Prosecutors have sent the trio to the High Criminal Court on charges that include seizing and helping to seize public funds, altering data in the ministry's electronic system, and forging and using private documents.

The case began after the ministry filed a complaint based on an administrative inquiry at a school.

Bills

The committee found suspect bills attributed to commercial entities that trade with the school and said the school's head of administrative and financial affairs had tampered with the ministry's finance system and falsified invoices.

The Financial Crimes and Money Laundering Prosecution took testimony from the inquiry chair and asked the National Audit Office (NAO) to check if the school's contracts followed proper steps, to assess any loss to school funds, and to identify who was responsible and how the papers were forged.

Prosecutors also obtained an order to lift bank secrecy.

Bahrain Achieves Record Compliance

Inspections and awareness drive boost worker safety

● 35,050 inspections conducted

● Only 10 firms violated ban

● First three-month extension enforced

Bahrain has wrapped up its extended midday work ban with an unprecedented compliance rate of 99.97 percent, underscoring the Kingdom's drive to safeguard workers during the harsh summer season.

High compliance

The Ministry of Labour announced yesterday the end of the enforcement period for Ministerial Resolution No. 3 of 2013, as amended by Resolution No. 11 of 2025. The regulation barred outdoor work from noon to 4 pm between June 15 and September 15. For the first time, the ban stretched across three months instead of two, reflecting heightened concern over

extreme heat and humidity.

Enforcement drive

His Excellency Yousef bin Abdulhussein Khalaf, Minister of Labour, said the policy shift forms part of efforts to align national labour practices with international standards. During the three-month period, inspectors carried out 35,050 visits across the Kingdom. Only 10 establishments were found in breach, with violations involving 18 workers.

Awareness push

Alongside enforcement, the Ministry mounted awareness campaigns, workshops and training sessions for occupational safety supervisors in the private sector. A hotline was also made available to the public to report violations, reinforcing the protective framework.

H.E. Khalaf praised the cooperation of employers, describing the high level of adherence as proof of a shared commitment to "a safe and healthy produc-

tion environment." He said the ban carried humanitarian value by shielding workers from heat stress, sunstroke and other summer-related illnesses.

The campaign concluded on September 15, but officials stressed that the Kingdom remains committed to developing its labour laws to ensure worker safety in all seasons.

Three on trial for smuggling marijuana

The High Criminal Court has opened the trial of three Asian nationals accused of attempting to smuggle more than three kilograms of marijuana into Bahrain by concealing the drugs inside a suitcase.

The hearing was adjourned to September 22 to allow the court to hear the defendants' pleas.

According to case files, customs officers at Bahrain International Airport intercepted a suspicious suitcase belonging to the first defendant.

The bag, which had been delayed for eight days after his arrival, contained green herbal material later confirmed through forensic analysis to be marijuana.

Investigations indicated that the defendant had been recruited by the second and third accused, alleged members of an organised drug trafficking network overseen by an individual based in another Asian country.

Customs officers testified that the suitcase appeared suspicious during scanning, and upon inspection, more than three kilograms of marijuana were discovered.

The Public Prosecution said the first defendant admitted to possession of the drugs, with laboratory tests confirming traces of cannabis in his system. Images of suspected narcotics were also retrieved from his mobile phone.

MP backs Tamkeen plan and digital programme

Ebrahim said the launch of the 'Digital Enablement Programme' adds a new strand to help local institutions meet the demands of the digital age.

He added that the programmes led by HH Shaikh Isa place investment in Bahraini talent at the centre and keep the private sector as a main partner in long-term growth.

Court reviews appeal in COVID-19 forgery case

The First High Criminal Court has begun hearing the appeal of a 36-year-old Asian woman sentenced to one year in prison, fined BD500, deported, and stripped of the forged document after being convicted of falsifying a COVID-19 medical certificate to miss work for 14 days.

The court adjourned the case to September 21 to appoint a defense lawyer.

During the hearing, the defendant admitted to the charg-



es, citing financial hardship and emotional distress.

She told the court she had not received her salary for over a month and had fallen into depression following the death of her daughter.

Prosecutors charged the woman with forging an official

electronic record by fabricating a COVID-19 isolation certificate allegedly issued by the Ministry of Health.

The case surfaced when her Bahraini employer, who owns a beauty supply shop, received a WhatsApp message from the defendant on December 23 claiming she had tested positive for the virus.

The message included images of a positive test result and an isolation notice.

Suspicious of the documents, the employer contacted the health hotline and was informed they were falsified.

57% of Bahraini Women Set to Launch Businesses

- Bahrain Ranks 7th Globally as Women Drive Entrepreneurial Growth
- First National GEM Report Reveals Thriving Women-led Startups

Bahrain is witnessing a remarkable surge in women-led entrepreneurship, with 57% of Bahraini women planning to launch their own businesses within the next three years, a rate higher than that of men.

This was revealed at the launch ceremony of Global Entrepreneurship Monitor (GEM) Bahrain National Report 2024/2025 and the Special Report on Women's Entrepreneurship 2024/2025.

Contribution

The Royal University for Women (RUW), in collaboration with the Ministry of Industry and Commerce, has launched reports, marking Bahrain's first contribution to GEM's internationally benchmarked research.

The reports provide unprecedented insights into Bahrain's entrepreneurial ecosystem, revealing that the Kingdom has achieved 7th place out of 56 global economies in the National and Global Entrepreneurship Index.

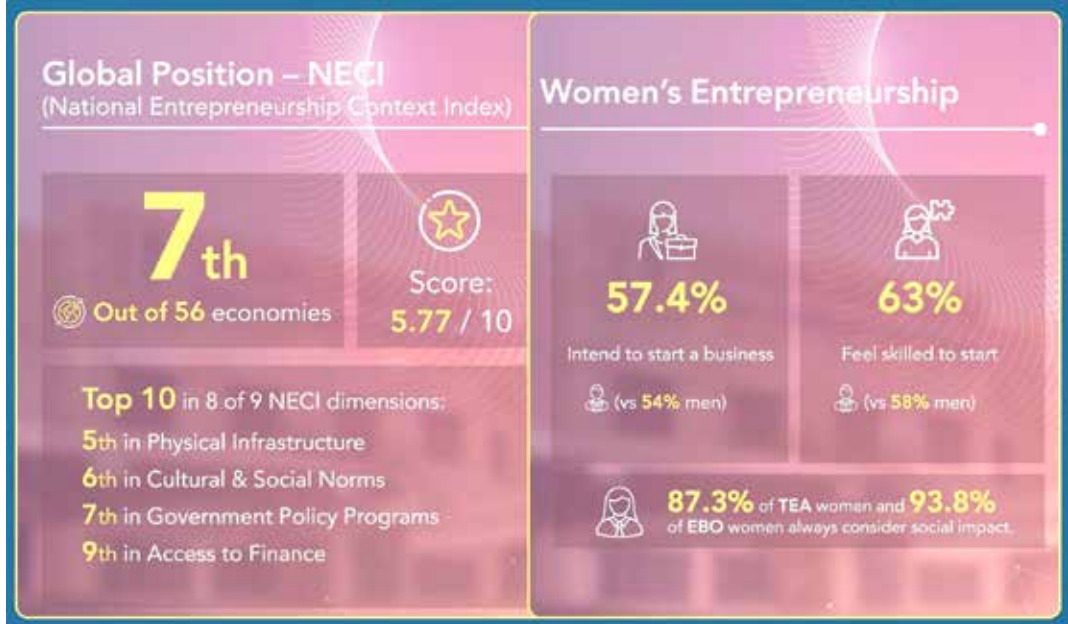
Bahrain exceeded the global average in 10 out of 13 key pillars, scoring highest in physical infrastructure and cultural and social standards.

Proud

"This shows that Bahrain not only keeps pace with global de-

velopments but also excels in many areas. We are especially proud that 57% of Bahraini women plan to launch their own businesses within the next three years, a rate higher than that of men," said Professor Riyad Hamzah, President of RUW.

RUW has played a central role

in preparing these landmark studies through its College of Business and Law and the pioneering Women's Research Centre, the first of its kind in the region.

Entrepreneurship study

Dr. Christelle Comair, Head of the Women's Research Centre,

told The Daily Tribune, "The center was established two years ago to conduct studies based on evidence-based data. The entrepreneurship study is one of the most important studies we've done. Researchers and policymakers need reliable data, and that's why it's so important to Bahrain."

The reports provide unprecedented insights into Bahrain's entrepreneurial ecosystem, revealing that the Kingdom has achieved 7th place out of 56 global economies in the National and Global Entrepreneurship Index.

The GEM reports provide internationally comparable data across 56 economies, measuring both the National Entrepreneurship Context Index (NECI) and key indicators from the Adult Population Survey (APS), offering insights into entrepreneurial perceptions, intentions, and activities.

Bahrain's participation in this global study highlights a strong and promising entrepreneurial ecosystem, with women at the forefront of innovation and growth.

RUW will continue to lead the Global Entrepreneurship Observatory project next year, building a long-term database to monitor trends and opportunities in entrepreneurship.

India, US to hold trade talks amid tariff storm

India and the United States are set to hold trade discussions in the capital New Delhi today, officials and Indian media reports said, as the two countries seek to resolve a tariff row. The world’s most populous country currently faces steep US tariffs on most of its exports and has so far failed to clinch a trade deal that will ease this burden. US President Donald Trump’s decision to bump up tariffs on India to 50 percent last month in retaliation for New Delhi’s continued purchases of Russian oil as he seeks to pressure Moscow over the war in Ukraine has also strained ties between the two nations.



But despite the diplomatic chill, the leaders of both countries said recently that they remain committed to continuing negotiations. Officials will hold in-person discussions on trade on Tuesday, The Indian Express newspaper reported, citing remarks made by commerce ministry official Rajesh Agarwal at a briefing on Monday. Broadcaster NDTV said Brendan Lynch, assistant trade representative for South and Central Asia, will be part of the US delegation and noted that the talks would



merely be a “precursor” to an eventual full-fledged round of negotiations. The discussions come a week after Trump announced that talks would continue between New Delhi and Washington to address trade barriers. “I feel certain that there will be no difficulty in coming to a successful conclusion for both of our Great Countries!,” he said in a post on his Truth Social platform last week, without offering further details. Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi, in response, said the two nations were “close friends and natural partners” and that teams were working to conclude discussions “at the earliest”.

US announces 'framework' TikTok deal with China

The United States announced yesterday a “framework” deal with China to resolve their dispute over TikTok, as a deadline looms this week for the Chinese-owned app to be sold or face a US ban. In a social media post, US President Donald Trump said -- without directly naming the

social media giant -- that a deal was reached with a “certain company that young people in our Country very much wanted to save. They will be very happy!” Trump added on his Truth Social network that he would speak to Chinese President Xi Jinping on Friday. US Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent announced the agree-

ment after a second day of talks with Chinese Vice Premier He Lifeng in Madrid, which also includes discussions about the wider US-China trade dispute. “We have a framework for a TikTok deal,” Bessent told reporters, adding that Trump and Xi will speak on Friday to “complete” the agreement. TikTok is owned by China-based internet company By-

tedance. A federal law requiring TikTok’s sale or ban on national security grounds was due to take effect the day before US President Donald Trump’s inauguration on January 20. But the Republican, whose 2024 election campaign

relied heavily on social media and who has said he is fond of TikTok, put the ban on pause. In mid-June Trump extended a deadline for the popular video-sharing app by another 90 days to find a non-Chinese buyer or be banned

in the United States. That extension is due to expire on Wednesday. While Trump had long supported a ban or divestment, he reversed his position and vowed to defend the platform -- which boasts almost two billion global users -- after coming to believe it helped him win young voters’ support in the November election.

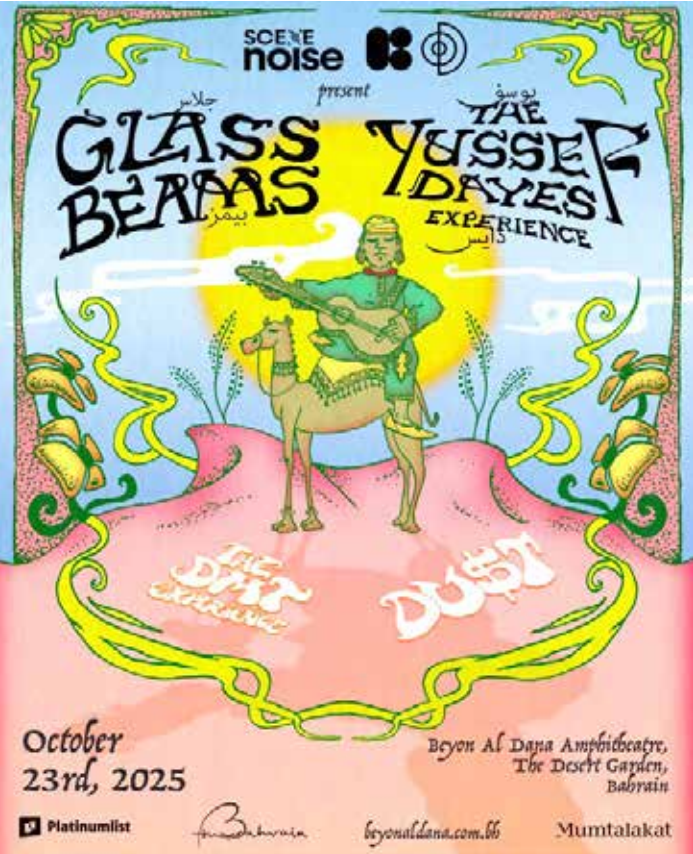

Stocks push higher ahead of expected **US rate cut**

London, United Kingdom

Stock markets mostly rose yesterday as traders geared up for an expected interest rate cut by the US Federal Reserve this week.

Sentiment was also boosted by news that the United States and China have reached a framework for a deal over their TikTok dispute, which the US side said will be finalised by President Donald Trump and Chinese leader Xi Jinping on Friday.

Equities have enjoyed a strong run-up over recent weeks as a string of data on jobs and inflation are seen as having provided the US central bank with enough leeway to resume its rate reductions.

Wednesday's policy decision follows figures showing the labour market continuing to soften, while prices have not spiked as much as feared in the wake of Trump's tariff war.

The Fed is expected to lower borrowing costs by 25 basis points, although some observers predict it could go to 50 points.

The dollar slid against its major rivals.

"That sort of language would be music to the ears of dollar bears, and it wouldn't take much to send the greenback tumbling," he said.

The central banks of Canada, Britain and Japan are also due to meet this week.

Prospects for defusing trade tensions between the world's top two economies improved

as US Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent said Monday that a "framework" for a deal to settle their dispute over TikTok had been reached with China.

He was speaking after a second day of talks with Chinese officials in Madrid that include discussions on the US-China trade dispute.

Trump said the talks were going "VERY WELL" in a Truth Social post, adding that he will speak to Xi on Friday.

Trade tensions between Beijing and Washington escalated

sharply earlier this year, with tit-for-tat tariffs reaching triple digits and snarling supply chains.

Both governments later agreed to lower their punitive tariffs, with the United States imposing 30% duties on imports of Chinese goods and China hitting US products with a 10% levy, but the temporary truce expires in November.

"This trade news is sounding like good news," said Briefing.com analyst Patrick O'Hare, although he noted China had announced semiconductors probes against the United States.

Wall Street's main indices opened higher, with the S&P 500 and Nasdaq Composite both setting new all-time highs.

Paris and Frankfurt stock markets advanced in afternoon trading, while London dipped.

Shares in Nvidia shed 1.3% after China said an investigation found US chip giant Nvidia had run afoul of the country's antitrust rules, and vowed an additional probe.

Asia fluctuated, with Shanghai edging down after data showed further weakness in China's economy, with growth in retail sales and industrial production much slower than forecast.

UK, US to sign deal to fast-track nuclear power projects

London, United Kingdom

Britain and the United States will sign an agreement to speed up development of new nuclear power projects during President Donald Trump's state visit, the UK government said Monday.

The partnership promises faster regulatory approval and several new private sector investment deals for nuclear projects, as the UK strives to meet net zero and energy security targets.

The announcement comes as Trump arrives in Britain late Tuesday for a historic second state visit, having been hosted by Queen Elizabeth II in 2019 during his first term.

Under the agreement, Britain and the US will use each other's safety assessments on new reactor designs, a move expected to cut the time to obtain a nuclear project license to two years, down from three to four years.

Prime Minis-

ter Keir Starmer said the partnership sets the UK "on course to a golden age of nuclear".

The UK has refocused on shoring up nuclear power since the start of the war in Ukraine, in the name of energy security and faced with a fleet of ageing power stations.

Britain said the partnership agrees to "eliminate any last dependencies on Russian nuclear material by the end of 2028 -- further squeezing (Russian leader Vladimir) Putin out of the energy market."

Several commercial deals

were also announced Monday, including between US firm X-energy and British Gas owner Centrica to build up to 12 advanced modular reactors in Hartlepool, northeast England.

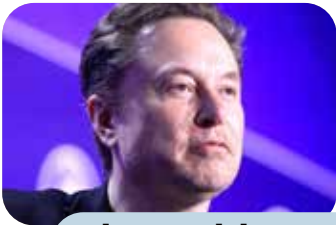
US firm Holtec, France's EDF and British firm Tritax are set to develop data centres powered by small modular reactors.

◆ CEO Elon Musk bought

about \$1 billion worth of shares in Tesla, according to a regulatory filing, sending the share price up six percent yesterday. According to the filing with the Securities and Exchange Commission, the billionaire, who also owns social media platform X and space company SpaceX, on Friday acquired 2.57 million shares at prices ranging from \$371 to \$396. The purchase came the same month Tesla unveiled a proposed compensation package for Musk that could top \$1 trillion if he delivers on his vision for stratospheric growth from new technologies. Tesla chair and close Musk associate Robyn Denholm has made several business media appearances in recent days, defending the pay package. "He is a generational leader," Denholm said Friday on Bloomberg TV. "There aren't any other people out there like Elon who can actually lead the company over the next decade or so."

UK says fighter jets to join NATO missions over Poland



◆ **UK fighter jets** will join a NATO operation over Poland to help defend the alliance's eastern flank after Russian drones entered Polish airspace last week, the defence ministry said yesterday. "British fighter jets will fly air defence missions over Poland to counter aerial threats from Russia, including drones, as part of NATO's Eastern Sentry mission," the ministry said in a statement, adding the missions by RAF Typhoons will start "in the coming days".

◆ **Sweden's government** said yesterday that it was boosting its defence budget by 26.6 billion kronor (\$2.9 billion) next year, putting defence spending at 2.8 percent of GDP. Prime Minister Ulf Kristersson told a press

conference the increase was "the next big step in the rearmament of the Swedish defence". In March, the government announced it would increase defence spending by about 300 billion kronor (\$31 billion) over the next decade, aiming to reach 3.5 percent of GDP by 2030. Kristersson noted that Sweden was "well on our way to make that a reality". Alongside fallout from the Russian invasion of Ukraine, US President Donald Trump has called on European NATO members to take spending to five percent of GDP. Sweden is one of many European countries to have boosted spending.

Trump heads for historic second UK state visit

President Donald Trump will get the red carpet treatment this week on an unprecedented second UK state visit, as Britain counts on royal pomp and circumstance to woo the unpredictable US leader.

From a flyby and carriage ride with King Charles III to a grand state banquet at historic Windsor Castle, Britain is pulling out all the stops to flatter Trump, who has long been fascinated with the monarchy.

The aim is to keep Prime Minister Keir Starmer on Trump's good side when they meet at the British leader's country residence for talks centered on trade, tariffs and the Ukraine war.

Starmer has unapologetically courted Trump since his return to power, even hand-delivering a letter from the king in the Oval Office in February,

inviting him to be the first US president to receive two state visits.

"President Trump is looking forward to his historic second base state visit to the United Kingdom," a senior US official told reporters including AFP on Monday.

The official added that when Starmer visited, "the prime minister called this visit truly historic and unprecedented -- which it is."

US officials said Trump and Starmer would also sign deals on tech worth at least \$10 billion dollars, while Trump's delegation will feature tech leaders reportedly including the CEOs of Nvidia and Open AI.

Trump will meanwhile be kept far away from crowds and protesters, with all the action taking place outside London, where a large demonstration against the 79-year-old Republican is set to take place.

Arab and Muslim leaders called yesterday for reviewing diplomatic and economic ties with Israel after its unprecedented attack targeting Hamas leaders in Qatar, according to a draft statement seen by AFP.

The summit in Doha adopted a joint statement that it has yet to make public, but in a draft seen by AFP, it called "upon all States to take all possible legal and effective measures to prevent Israel from continuing its actions against the Palestinian people, including by... reviewing diplomatic and economic relations with it, and initiating legal proceedings against it".

"We also expect our strategic partners in the United States to use their influence on Israel in order for it to stop this behaviour... They have leverage and influence on Israel, and it's about time that this leverage and influence be used," Gulf Cooperation Council Secretary General Jassem Mohamed Al-Budaiwi said in a press conference following a summit in Doha.

UN rights expert says complicity with Gaza 'genocide' 'shame of our time'

A UN rights expert reiterated yesterday that Israel was committing "genocide" in Gaza, slamming what she said was the "complicity" of other countries as "the shame of our time".

"Far too many states continue to look away, normalise the suffering and even profit from it," Francesca Albanese, the United Nations special rapporteur on the situation of human rights in the occupied Palestinian territories, told reporters in Geneva. "Arms trade and diplomatic

engagement with Israel continue unabated," she said.

"This is not just morally wrong, this is unlawful," she insisted, demanding "accountability (for) the very people who have been giving orders to continue trade and arms transfers toward Israel".

UN special rapporteurs are independent experts

who are mandated by the UN Human Rights Council but do not speak on behalf of the UN.

The Italian expert has faced harsh criticism by Israel and some of its allies over her relentless criticism and long-standing accusations that Israel is committing "genocide" in Gaza.

Crime scene DNA in Kirk murder matches suspect: FBI

Washington, United States

DNA found at the scene of the murder of US conservative influencer Charlie Kirk has been matched to suspect Tyler Robinson, FBI Director Kash Patel said yesterday.

Robinson, 22, was arrested Thursday after a 33-hour manhunt and is expected to be formally charged in the murder later this week.

Kirk, a close ally of US President Donald Trump, was shot Wednesday during a speaking event on a Utah university campus. He was the founder of the hugely influential conservative youth political group Turning Point USA.

Authorities said the suspect used a sniper rifle to shoot Kirk with a single bullet to the neck from a rooftop.

"I can report today that the DNA hits from the towel that was wrapped around the firearm and the DNA on the

screwdriver are positively processed for the suspect in custody," Patel said on Fox News Monday morning, referring to a screwdriver recovered from the scene.

Patel also discussed a note that Robinson is believed to have written before the crime.

The note is "basically saying... 'I have the opportunity to take out Charlie Kirk, and I'm going to take it' That note was written before the shooting," Patel said.

He added that note was left at

the suspect's family home.

"Even though it has been destroyed, we have found forensic evidence of the note," the FBI director said.

Kirk, a father of two, used his audiences on TikTok, Instagram and YouTube to build support for conservative talking points, including strong criticism of the transgender rights movement.

He often posted carefully edited clips of his interactions during debates at his many college events.

Spain cancels major Israel arms deal amid Gaza backlash

The Spanish government has cancelled a contract worth nearly 700 million euros (\$825 million) for Israeli-designed rocket launchers, according to an official document seen Monday by AFP. The move comes after Prime Minister Pedro Sanchez announced last week that his government would "consolidate in law" a ban on military equipment sales or purchases with Israel over its offensive in Gaza. The contract, awarded to a consortium of Spanish companies, involved the purchase of 12 SILAM rocket launcher systems derived from the PULS platform made by Israeli firm Elbit Systems, according to the International Institute for Strategic Studies' Military Balance.

Qatar's emir accused Israel of trying to derail Gaza ceasefire efforts with its attack on Hamas in Doha, as Arab and Muslim leaders held emergency talks yesterday to discuss a unified response.

The joint Arab League and

Organisation of Islamic Cooperation summit was called by Qatar to pile pressure on Israel, which has been facing mounting calls to end the war and humanitarian crisis in Gaza.

Hamas says top officials survived last week's air strike in Doha, which killed six people

and triggered a wave of criticism, including a rebuke from US President Donald Trump.

Qatar has been a key mediator in talks to end the war in Gaza -- alongside Egypt and the United States -- and the Israeli strike came as Hamas officials were discussing a new US proposal.

“Whoever works diligently and systematically to assassinate the party with whom he is negotiating, intends to thwart the negotiations,” Qatari Emir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al Thani said in his opening remarks.

“Negotiations, for them, are merely part of the war.”

The emir also said Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu “dreams of turning the Arab region into an Israeli sphere of influence, and this is a dangerous illusion”.

A draft final statement from the summit seen by AFP warned that Israel's “brutal” aggression “threatens all that has been

achieved on the path toward establishing normal relations with Israel, including existing and future agreements”.

Israel and its main backer the United States have been trying to expand the Abraham Accords, which established ties with the United Arab Emirates, Bahrain and Morocco in 2020.

According to the draft statement, the nearly 60-country grouping in Doha will also emphasise “the concept of collective security... as well as the necessity of aligning together to face common challenges and threats”.

Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman, Saudi Arabia's de facto ruler, was among those present, as were Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian, Iraqi Prime Minister Mohammed Shia al-Sudani, Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan and Palestinian president Mahmud Abbas.

Jordan's King Abdullah II and Pakistani Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif also attended.

Rubio promises ‘unwavering support’ for Israel in Gaza goals

US Secretary of State Marco Rubio said yesterday that Washington was steadfast in its support for its ally Israel's pursuit of the Gaza war and called for the eradication of Hamas.

“The people of Gaza deserve a better future, but that better future cannot begin until Hamas is eliminated,” Rubio told reporters at a joint press conference with Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu in Jerusalem.

“You can count on our unwavering support,” he said.

Netanyahu said Rubio's visit was a “clear message” the United States stood with Israel and praised President Donald Trump for his backing, calling him the “greatest friend that Israel has ever had”.

Rubio criticised plans by Western nations to recognise a Palestinian state, saying they “emboldened” Hamas. “They're largely symbolic... the only impact they actually have is it makes Hamas feel more emboldened,” he said.

Rubio had said he would discuss with Netanyahu Israeli plans to seize Gaza City, the territory's largest urban centre, as well as the government's talk of annexing parts of the occupied West Bank in hopes of precluding a Palestinian state.

He had also said Trump wanted the Gaza war to be “finished with” -- which would mean the release of hostages and ensuring Ha-

mas is “no longer a threat”.

But talks were made more difficult last week when the Trump administration was caught off guard

by an Israeli attack in Qatar against Hamas leaders.

“We sent a message to terrorists: you can run but you cannot hide,” Netanyahu said.

The “raid didn't fail.”

Rubio said Washington would continue to tell Qatar to continue its “constructive role” as an intermediary in the Gaza war.

A US official later said Rubio will travel on Tuesday to Qatar, where Arab and Muslim leaders gathered Monday to pile pressure on Israel after the attack.

First objects retrieved from Titanic’s sister ship in Greece

The HMHS Britannic was one of three transatlantic passenger lines built at the Harland and Wolff shipyard in Belfast, the first of which was the infamous RMS Titanic.

Deep-sea divers have retrieved a first batch of objects from the the Titanic’s sister ship that sank off the coast of Greece in 1916, the Greek culture ministry said yesterday.

The ministry said a research programme in May involved “the retrieval of objects from the wreck site (of the HMHS Britannic) for the first time, from

depths exceeding 120 metres (394 feet).”

The HMHS Britannic was one of three transatlantic passenger lines built at the Harland and Wolff shipyard in Belfast, the first of which was the infamous RMS Titanic.

Requisitioned by the British Admiralty to be converted into a floating hospital during World

War I, it struck a German mine in November 1916 while sailing off the Greek island of Kea.

The vessel sank in less than an hour. Of the 1,065 people on board, 30 died when the ship’s propellers snagged two lifeboats, the culture ministry said.

The project to document the wreck and its contents was car-

ried out by an 11-member team composed of professional deep-sea divers, using closed-circuit diving equipment.

The research was organised by British amateur historian Simon Mills, founder of the Britannic Foundation, and supervised by Greece’s Ephorate of Underwater Antiquities.

“Conditions at the wreck site

were particularly challenging due to currents, depth, and low visibility,” it said, adding that certain objects initially selected could not be retrieved due to their location and preservation status.

The retrieved objects include the ship’s observation post bell, the portside signal lamp, various items of portable equipment

from first and second class, ceramic tiles that had decorated a Turkish bath and a pair of binoculars.

They were transported to the ephorate’s laboratories in Athens for further conservation and are set to feature in a permanent exhibition at a new museum of underwater antiquities currently under construction in Piraeus, the ministry said.

The third vessel of the group, the RMS Olympic, sailed from 1911 t

US cos should not have to report quarterly: Trump

Washington, United States

US President Donald Trump on Monday called for publicly listed US companies to no longer be required to report their earnings quarterly, shifting instead to a half-yearly model in line with the European Union.

“Subject to SEC Approval, Companies and Corporations should no longer be forced to ‘Report’ on a quarterly basis (Quarterly Reporting!), but rather to Report on a ‘Six (6) Month Basis,’” he posted on his Truth Social platform on Monday.

Trump said the move would “allow managers to focus on properly running their companies.”

The US Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) has required quarterly reporting since 1970, but the debate over whether to move to a six-monthly system is not new.

Such a move would bring the United States in line with the European Union and United Kingdom. Many large EU companies continue to report quarterly, however.

Trump also proposed the move in his first term. Proponents of half-yearly reporting say the time frame allows managers to

focus on long-term growth rather than hitting short-term performance targets.

The SEC did not immediately respond to an AFP request for comment.

Moving to semiannual reporting would allow firms to dedicate fewer resources to the process, said Sam Stovall of CFRA Research.

“Certainly it could help companies save money,” Stovall told AFP.

He cautioned, however, that it “would probably increase volatility because you would have less guidance (and) resetting of expectations.”

UK aristocrat, partner get 14 years for baby daughter’s manslaughter

A British woman from an aristocratic family and her partner were Monday jailed for 14 years each for the manslaughter of their newborn daughter, who died while they were living off-grid in freezing temperatures.

Passing sentence Judge Mark Lucraft told Constance Marten, 38, and Mark Gordon, 51, that the way they treated their baby, Victoria, had been “neglect of the gravest and most serious type”.

The pair sat separately in the glass-fronted dock at London’s Old Bailey central criminal court, but had to be reprimanded by the judge for repeatedly gesturing and passing notes to each other, showing a “complete lack of respect” to the court.

They were arrested after a seven-week police hunt in January and February 2023 during which they spent time living in a tent.

A jury found them guilty in July after a previous jury was unable to reach a verdict on the manslaughter charge.

Marten and Gordon went on the run to try and keep their daughter after authorities took their four other children into care due to the couple’s

lifestyle, saying their attitude posed a “significant risk” to the youngsters, the court heard.

They were eventually arrested two months later, in Brighton on England’s southern coast.

Days afterwards, baby Victoria’s badly decomposed body was found in a shopping bag on a vegetable patch.

Marten told police Victoria died when she fell asleep on her in the tent, but the judge said he believed she died from hypothermia.

In a statement to the court, Marten’s mother, Virginie de Selliers said she had been “horrified” at how her daughter had been characterised, adding it did not reflect “the daughter I

remember”.

Her lawyer, Tom Godfrey, said Marten felt genuine “sadness and remorse” over Victoria’s death.

Philippa McAtasney, defending Gordon, said he had not been thinking “properly or rationally” when he decided to go on the run, but would have to live with the consequences of his actions for the rest of his life.

Born into a life of wealth and privilege, Marten grew up in a 25-room mansion on a vast estate in Dorset in southwest England.

Her aristocratic family had close links to the royal family.

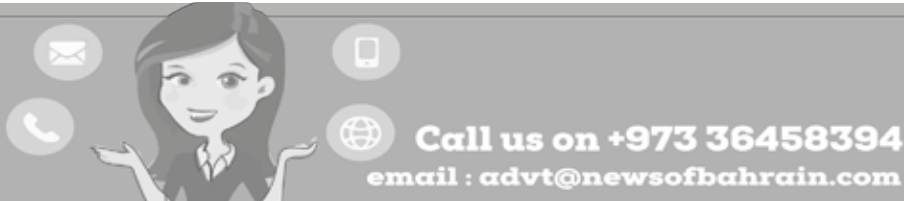

Bahrain's Winfred Yavi, the reigning world and Olympic champion in the women's 3,000m steeplechase, comfortably advanced to the final at the World Athletics Championships 2025 in Tokyo.

Racing in heat two at Japan's National Stadium, Yavi clocked 9:15.63 to secure automatic qualification (Q). The Bahraini star kept her composure throughout, running smoothly behind the leaders and ensuring her place in tomorrow's title decider, scheduled for 3:57 PM Bahrain time.

Yavi is chasing a successful defence of her global crown af-

ter winning gold at the 2023 World Championships in Doha, where she powered to one of the finest performances of her career. She added the Olympic title in Paris last summer, confirming her dominance in the event.

Strong Field Awaits

In total, 16 athletes advanced

across the three heats. Among the other big names through to the final are Peruth Chemutai of Uganda (9:07.68); Kenya's Doris Lemngole (9:08.97) and Faith Cherotich (9:13.95); Ethiopia's Lomi Muleta (9:12.20 SB) and Sembo Almayew (9:15.84); Germany's Lea Meyer (9:13.18) and two-time world medallist Gesa Felicitas

Krause (9:16.76 SB); as well as American pair Kaylee Mitchell (9:15.52) and Angelina Napoleon (9:18.03).

Meanwhile, Bahrain's Kemi Adekoya progressed to the semi-finals of the women's 400m hurdles, finishing fourth in her heat in 55.15s to take an

automatic qualifying spot. The semi-finals are set for tomorrow at 3:03 PM.

Bahrain's Salwa Eid Naser will also be in action today at 3:05 PM, competing in the semi-finals of the women's 400 metres at the World Championships after finishing with the fastest time across all heats on Sunday.

Mbappe not anxious over Champions League wait: Alonso

Real Madrid coach Xabi Alonso said yesterday superstar striker Kylian Mbappe feels no anxiety to win the Champions League for the first time as Los Blancos prepare to face Marseille.

Mbappe, 26, left Paris Saint-Germain last summer to join record 15-time winners Madrid, only to see his former club go on to lift the trophy for the first time in their history.

"He's not anxious, we all feel this is a project that's just starting," Alonso told a news conference ahead of Tuesday's opening match at the Santiago Bernabeu. "One of the objectives is to win the Champions League hopefully sooner rather than later, Kylian is part of the path to getting there, but I

don't think he's anxious.

"Today we spoke about what the Champions League means, but we were not talking about May (and the final), we were talking about the near future."

Mbappe faced his former club PSG for the first time at the Club World Cup this summer, with Madrid thrashed 4-0 in the semi-finals.

However the striker was not fully fit at the tournament in the United States because of a stomach bug and has hit the ground running with four goals in four La Liga games this season. "Gastroenteritis meant it was Kylian 'lite' at the Club World Cup," said Alonso.

"Without doubt (he's a leader), for his personality, experience, the influence he has on the others, he's one of them."

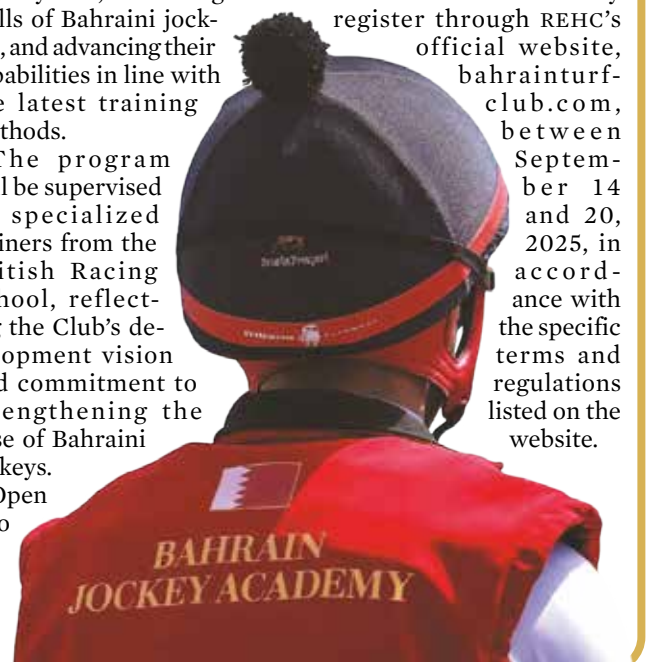
The initiative aims to promote horseracing by investing in youth, enhancing the skills of Bahraini jockeys, and advancing their capabilities in line with the latest training methods.

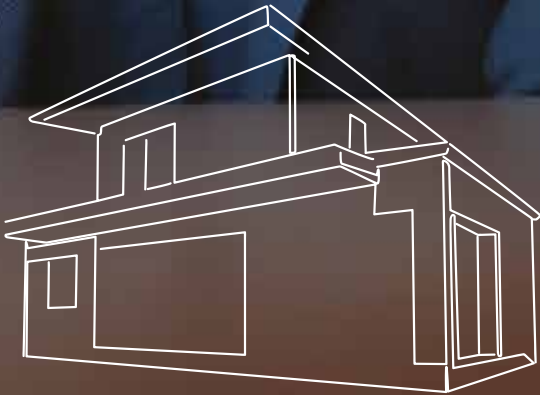
