Saudi Arabia held to goalless draw by Palestine in landmark West Bank World Cup qualifier

🗖 audi Arabia's football team played Palestine in the occupied West Bank for the first time yesterday. The two met in a qualifier for the 2022 World Cup at the Palestinian national stadium in Al-Ram, playing out a 0-0 draw.

Cheered on by a packed and vociferous home stadium, Palestine frustrated their more prestigious guests and came close multiple times, but neither side were ultimately able to make the breakthrough.

With significant excitement over the match, all tickets at the 8.000 stadium were given away free on the day, with thousands in often disorderly queues to get in.

Hundreds of others watched from windows or roofs of buildings overlooking the stadium, which is only a few meters from the Israeli barrier that cuts off it. the West Bank from occupied Jerusalem.
