This is SMBC Aviation Capital's first deal with Gulf Air and follows a competitive tender process.

Delivery of Gulf Air's Airbus A320neo aircraft commenced from August 2018. The airline currently serves all its destinations with a combination wide and narrow body fleet and has orders for 39 new Boeing and Airbus aircraft with delivery having by end-2018 the arrival of 5 Boeing commenced in early 2018.
