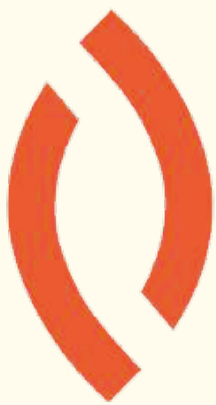

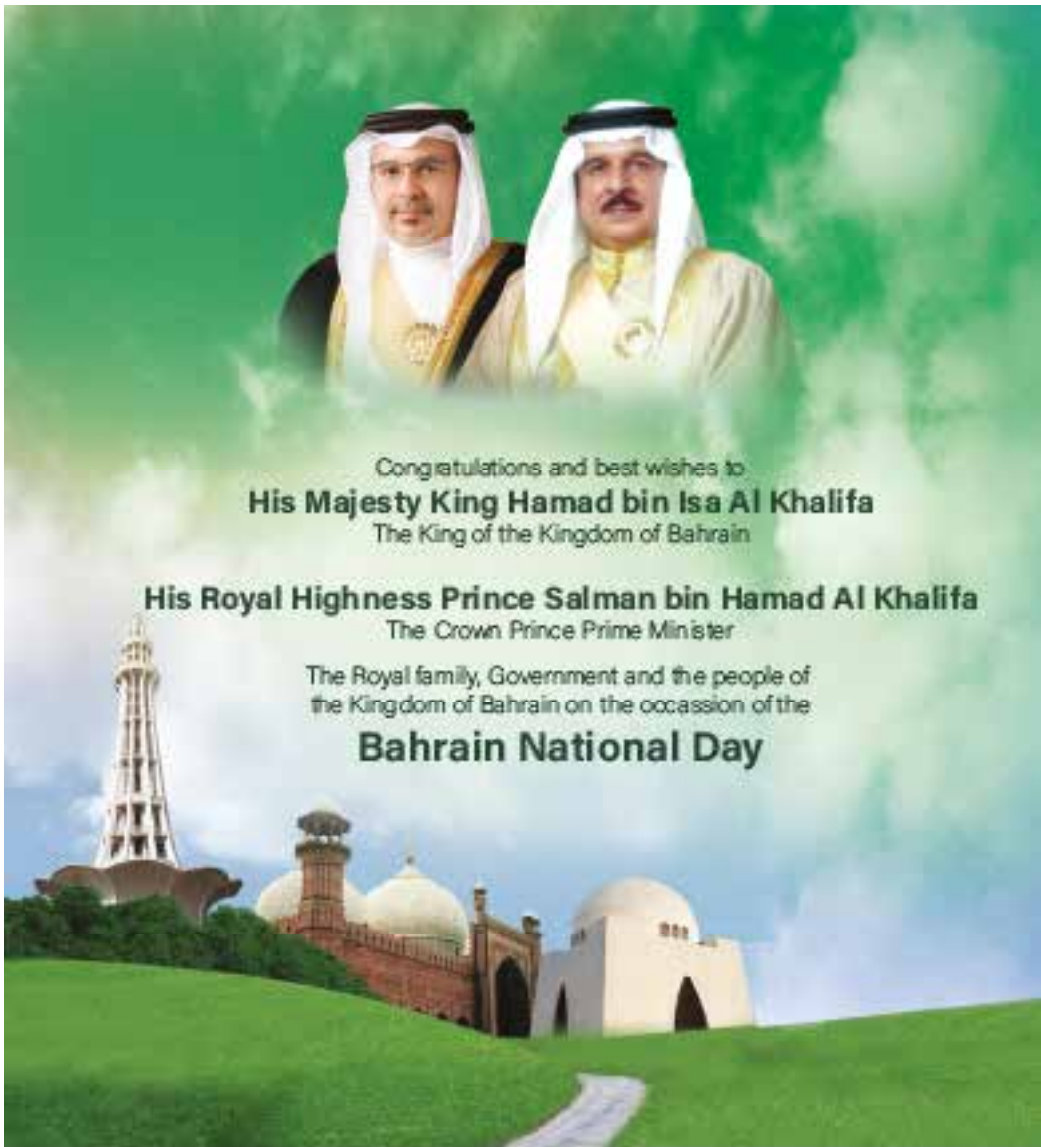

News in brief

◆ Iranian Nobel winner

Narges Mohammadi was taken to hospital twice after being violently arrested last week and appeared unwell in her first telephone contact since being detained, her supporters said yesterday. Mohammadi suffered “severe and repeated baton blows to the head and neck” during her arrest and in the call “her physical condition was not good, and she appeared unwell”, her foundation said in a statement. Iranian civil society activists, including prize-winning filmmaker Jafar Panahi, called for the “immediate and unconditional release” of Mohammadi and other campaigners arrested on Friday. Mohammadi, who won the 2023 Nobel prize, was detained after addressing a memorial ceremony in the eastern city of Mashhad for lawyer Khosrow Alikordi, who was found dead earlier this month. The foundation said Mohammadi was “taken to the hospital emergency room twice” following her arrest.

◆ Israeli army to demolish 25 residential buildings in West Bank camp: local authorities

Abdallah Kamil, governor of the Tulkarem governorate where Nur Shams is located, told AFP he was informed of the planned demolition by the Israeli defence ministry body COGAT. COGAT, which is in charge of coordinating civilian affairs in the Israeli-occupied Palestinian territories, did not respond to AFP’s requests for comment. Faisal Salama, head of the popular committee for Tulkarem camp, which is near Nur Shams, said the demolition order would affect 25 buildings holding up to 100 family homes.

◆ US negotiators still want Ukraine to cede control of the eastern Donetsk and Lugansk regions as a condition for peace talks with Russia, an official briefed on the discussions told AFP yesterday. Kyiv is pushing back against Washington’s demand that it pull troops from the two regions collectively known as Donbas, which Russia has been unable to capture since invading in February 2022. Russian President Vladimir Putin “wants territory,” the official told AFP, adding the United States was demanding that Ukraine “withdraw” from the regions and that Kyiv was refusing. “It’s a bit striking that the Americans are taking the Russians’ position on this issue,” the official added. Moscow controls almost all of the Lugansk region and about 80 percent of the Donetsk region, according to the US-based Institute for the Study of War.

Japan’s only two pandas to be sent back to China

Two pandas at a Tokyo zoo will be returned to China in January, the Tokyo government said yesterday, potentially leaving Japan without the beloved animals for the first time in half a century.

Loaned out as part of China’s “panda diplomacy” programme, the distinctive black-and-white animals have symbolised friendship between Beijing and Tokyo since the normalisation of diplomatic ties in 1972.

Japan currently has only two pandas, Lei Lei and Xiao Xiao, at Tokyo’s Zoological Gardens in the Ueno neighbourhood.

But the twins are now set to be repatriated a month before their loan period expires in

February, said Tokyo Metropolitan Government, which operates the Ueno zoo.

Tokyo’s regional government has been asking for the immensely popular mammals to remain at the zoo -- where they attract huge crowds -- but China didn’t agree, according to the Nikkei business daily.

In September last year, animal lovers in Tokyo bid farewell to the parents of Lei Lei and Xiao Xiao who returned home.

Just before they left, thousands of tearful fans came out to catch a final glimpse and take photographs of the beloved bears.

The Asahi Shimbun reported that Tokyo is seeking the loan of a new pair, although their arrival before the return of Lei Lei and Xiao Xiao is seen as unlikely.

A Sydney man said he had received death threats and was “terrified” to leave his home yesterday after his photo was widely shared online as the gunman responsible for the Bondi Beach shooting.

A father and son duo opened fire on a Jewish festival at Australia’s best-known beach on Sunday evening, killing 15 people, including a child, and wounding 42 more.

Authorities have condemned the attack as an act of terrorism, though they have not named the



Mass shootings have been rare in Australia since a lone gunman killed 35 people in the tourist town of Port Arthur in 1996. The so-called “Port Arthur massacre” led to sweeping reforms but Albanese said tougher gun laws may be needed after the latest attack.

Australia hails ‘hero’ who stopped gunman in his tracks

Australians are hailing a “hero” whose daring struggle with a gunman Sunday led to the disarming of an attacker during the country’s worst mass shooting in years.

He even earned a shout-out from US President Donald Trump, who said the man’s brave actions “saved a lot of lives” during a shocking assault on a Jewish gathering to celebrate Hanukkah.

Following the deadly shooting on Sydney’s Bondi Beach, footage emerged on social media of a man risking his own life by grabbing one of the gunmen as he fired on people who were out of view of the recording.

The man then wrestles the gun out of the attacker’s hand, before pointing the weapon at the assailant who backs away.

Local outlet 7News identified him as 43-year-old Ahmed al Ahmed, a fruit seller, and reported he had suffered two gunshot wounds. The outlet spoke to a man called Mustapha who said he was his cousin.

“He’s in hospital and we don’t know exactly what’s going on inside,” he said.

“We do hope he will be fine. He’s a hero 100 percent,” he said.

two shooters -- one killed at the scene, and the other now in hospital.

However, Australian public broadcaster ABC said the alleged assailant was Naveed Akram from the western Sydney suburb of Bonnyrigg, quoting an anonymous official, and other local media reported that police had raided his home.

Photos of a beaming man in a green Pakistan cricket jersey pinged across social media.

Some of the posts were shared thousands of times, drawing vitriolic comments.

But the photo was taken from the Facebook profile of a different Naveed Akram, who pleaded Monday for people to stop the misinformation in a video published by the Pakistan Consulate of Sydney.

“Per media reports, one of the shooters’ name is Naveed Akram

The startling footage of the encounter has gone viral, and Ahmed was feted online for his bravery and lifesaving quick thinking, with many people saying he likely saved several lives.

Prime Minister Anthony Albanese hailed him and others as “heroes”, as did Premier Chris Minns of New South Wales, the state where Bondi Beach is located.

“In all of this evil, in all of this sadness, there are still wonderful, brave Australians that

are prepared to risk their lives to help a complete stranger,” Minns told a press briefing late Sunday.

At the White House, Trump offered his own praise and “great respect” for the man who disarmed a gunman.

“It’s been a very, very brave person, actually, who went and attacked frontally one of the shooters, and saved a lot of lives,” the American president said, adding the man “is right now in the hospital, pretty seriously wounded.”

and my name is Naveed Akram as well,” he said in the video.

“That is not me. I have nothing to do with the incident or that person,” he said, condemning the “terrible” Bondi Beach shooting.

“I just want everyone’s help to help me stop this propaganda,” he said, asking for users to report accounts that misused his photo, which he had shared in a 2019 post.

‘Life-threatening’

The 30-year-old, who lives in a northwestern suburb of Sydney, told AFP he first heard around 9:30 pm on Sunday that he had been falsely identified as the shooter.

“I could not even sleep last night,” Akram told AFP by phone, adding he deleted all the “terrible” messages he got.

“I’m terrified. I could not go outside, like it’s a life-threaten-

ing issue, so I don’t want to risk anything... my family is worried as well, so it’s quite a hard time for me.”

He asked the Pakistan Consulate to put out the video because relatives in the country’s Punjab province were getting phone calls as well.

“It was destroying my image, my family’s image,” he said.

“People started to call them. They were worried, and they have told the police over there.”

The Pakistan native moved to Australia in 2018 to attend Central Queensland University and later did a masters at Sydney’s Holmes Institute.

Today he runs a car rental business, and he said Australia is “the perfect country”.

“I love this country. I have never had any safety issues here, like everyone is so nice, the people are so nice here,” Akram said.

Flash floods kill 37 in Moroccan coastal town

The death toll from flash floods that hit the Moroccan coastal town of Safi over the weekend rose to 37, local authorities said yesterday.

"Fourteen people are currently being treated at Mohammed V hospital in Safi, including two in intensive care," local authorities added in their statement.

Search and rescue operations continued yesterday, after the

deadliest such severe weather event in Morocco in over a decade.

Images on social media showed a torrent of muddy water sweeping cars and rubbish bins from the streets in Safi, which sits around 300 kilometres (186 miles) south of the capital Rabat.

Severe weather and flooding are not uncommon in Morocco, which is struggling with a severe drought for the seventh consecutive year.

The General Directorate of

Meteorology (DGM) said 2024 was Morocco's hottest year on record, while registering an average rainfall deficit of -24.7 percent.

Son arrested after Rob Reiner and wife found dead: US media

Police took Rob Reiner's son into custody after the Hollywood director of hits including "When Harry Met Sally" and his wife were found dead in their Los Angeles home, US media reported yesterday.

Networks CBS and ABC said Nick Reiner was arrested, and the Los Angeles Times reported he was booked into the Los Angeles County jail on suspicion of murder, citing jail records.

Los Angeles deputy police chief Alan Hamilton had said earlier they were seeking to interview "every family member" of the 78-year-old actor-director and his wife, Michele Singer Reiner.

The bodies were discovered Sunday and police said they were treating the case as an "apparent homicide."

As tributes poured in for Reiner, Donald Trump unleashed a crude broadside on the Hollywood icon, appearing to blame the deaths on the director's "raging" criticism of the US president.

Several US news media cited police sources as saying the couple were stabbed, while celebrity news website TMZ, which first broke the story, reported that their throats had

been cut by a family member during an argument.

Reiner directed classic films including 1984's rock music mockumentary "This Is Spinal Tap," fantasy gem "The Princess Bride" from 1987, and the 1992 courtroom drama "A Few Good Men."

His films spanned everything from laugh-out-loud comedy to searing drama and earned him a global following.

Reiner was politically active and an outspoken supporter of progressive causes -- potentially a reason for the extraordinary statement by Trump on Monday less than a day after

the killings.

While movie fans around the world grieved, Trump claimed Reiner died "reportedly due to the anger he caused others through his massive, unyielding, and incurable affliction with a mind crippling disease known as TRUMP DERANGEMENT SYNDROME."

"He was known to have driven people CRAZY by his raging obsession of President Donald J. Trump, with his obvious paranoia reaching new heights as the Trump Administration surpassed all goals and expectations of greatness," the president posted.

North Korean leader's sister sports Chinese foldable phone

The North Korean leader's powerful sister Kim Yo Jong has been spotted with a likely Chinese-made foldable phone, as Pyongyang's elite skirt sanctions to get their hands on the latest gadgetry from abroad.

Images released by state media on Sunday showed Kim holding the phone in her right hand during a trip to a hospital opening alongside her brother Kim Jong Un.

Although the brand name cannot be seen in the picture, the phone closely resembles the Chinese brand Honor's

"Magic" line, advertised as "the world's thinnest foldable smartphone".

The V3 model of the phone sells for around \$1,379 -- well out of range of the average North Korean, who analysts say typically earn up to three dollars a month in state-run industries.

Kim's family is known for their love of gadgets.

Leader Kim Jong Un has been pictured using Apple products, including iPads and MacBooks, at high-profile events.

In 2023, he also sported a foldable smartphone during a missile launch.

New US presidential planes delayed again until 2028

The delivery of a new Boeing jet to be used by the US president, famously known as Air Force One, has been delayed once again by at least a year. According to an updated timeline by the US Air Force, the first of two new specially equipped Boeing 747-8 aircraft, known as the VC-25B, will not enter service until at least 2028.

"On Dec 12, 2025, the US Air Force awarded a \$15.5 million modification to its existing contract with The Boeing Company for the VC-25B program," an Air Force spokesperson told AFP on Sunday.

The spokesperson said the costs were related to the "integration of new communica-

tions" capabilities that "can be accomplished within the current program schedule with the projected delivery date for the first VC-25B aircraft in mid-2028."

Previously, the US Air Force had said that the first aircraft would be delivered in 2027.

No reason for the delay was announced. When contacted by AFP, Boeing referred any questions about the program to the US Air Force.

The US aerospace giant has faced repeated delays and financial losses related to its fixed-price contract to replace Air Force One. Signed in 2018 during President Donald Trump's first term, the contract aimed for initial delivery of a plane by the end of 2024.



US-Ukrainian talks resume in Berlin with territorial stakes unresolved

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky pushed on with high-stakes talks in Berlin yesterday with US President Donald Trump's envoys aimed at ending the war with Russia, but thorny territorial questions remained unresolved.

Trump's special envoy Steve Witkoff said on X that "a lot of progress" had been made during a meeting on Sunday that also involved the US president's son-in-law Jared Kushner. Ukraine, battling a gruelling war since Russia's invasion in February 2022, hopes

to convince the United States that a ceasefire must be agreed without prior territorial concessions to Russia.

However, an official briefed on the talks said that US negotiators still want Ukraine to cede control of the eastern Donbas region as a condition of peace talks with Russia, a red line for Kyiv. Russian President Vladimir "Putin wants territory," the official said, adding that the United States was demanding that Ukraine "withdraw" from the regions -- and that Kyiv was "not agreeing" to this demand.

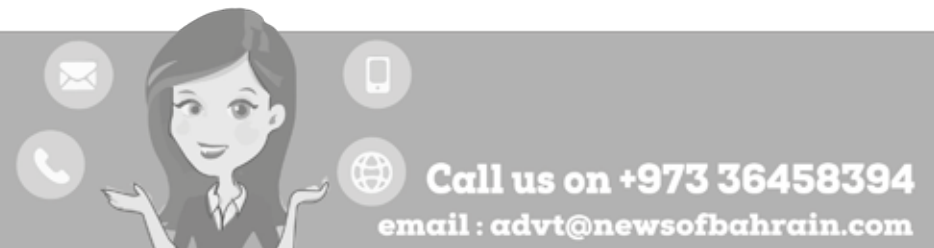

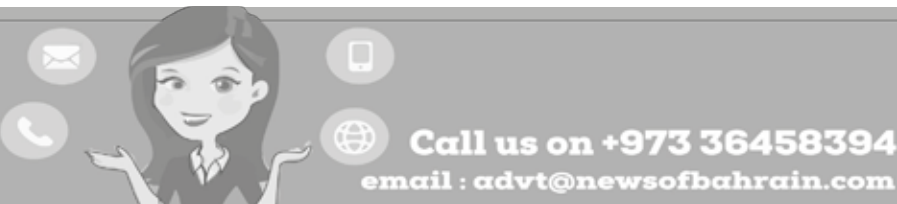

Arab Cup Finalists Confirmed in Doha

Atlas Lions and Hashemite Kings set up Lusail final clash

Morocco and Jordan secured their spots in the FIFA Arab Cup final last night with composed and clinical performances in Doha. The Atlas Lions made light work of the UAE with a 3-0 win at Khalifa International Stadium, while Jordan edged past Saudi Arabia 1-0 at Al Bayt Stadium, showing that efficiency and discipline can be just as decisive as flair in knockout football.

The Moroccans set the tone early at Khalifa International Stadium and took the lead in the 28th minute. Hamza El Moussawi delivered a superb cross from the left, and Karim El Berkaooui rose highest to power a header past Ruben Canedo and into the bottom corner, making him the joint top scorer of the Arab Cup.

The UAE came close to an instant reply after the restart. Ruben Canedo's effort was saved by Morocco's goalkeeper Mehdi Benabid, leaving Caio Lucas with a close-range sliding attempt that struck the post.

However, the assistant referee flagged Lucas offside, keeping Morocco in command.

Tarik Sektioui's men continued to dominate but missed opportunities to extend their lead. Morocco's Waleed Azaro had a golden chance when El Berkaooui turned provider with an inviting early ball, yet Azaro's diving header sailed over the bar.

The Atlas Lions eventually doubled their advantage in the 82nd minute. Abdelrazzaq

Hamdallah found Achraf El Mahdoui in acres of space inside the box, and the midfielder calmly slotted the ball into the bottom corner. A slight deflection off UAE's Richard Akon-nor ensured the goal went in. Morocco put the result beyond doubt in stoppage time with a third goal. Walid El Kartii, on as a substitute, lofted a ball into the box for right-back Mohamed Boulacsout, who cut it back to Hamdallah. The forward fin-

ished first time to complete a stylish team move and seal a 3-0 win.

Meanwhile, Jordan's clash with Saudi Arabia at Al Bayt Stadium was a more cagey affair. The Hashemite Kingdom largely controlled the first half but struggled to break down a disciplined Green Falcons defence. Their persistence finally paid off in the 66th minute when captain Mahmoud Al Mardi delivered a beautiful cross, allowing Nizar Al Rtshan to rise and head home the decisive goal. Saudi Arabia pressed in search of an equalizer, but to make matters worse for Herve Renard's side, Waleed Al Ahmed was sent off in the final seconds, leaving the Green Falcons to reflect on a narrow defeat and missed opportunity.

The Arab Cup final is now set for December 18 at Lusail Stadium, with Morocco facing Jordan at 7pm. Earlier, Saudi Arabia and the UAE will contest the third-place playoff at Khalifa International Stadium at 2pm, rounding off a tournament that has thrilled fans across the region.

Lyon poised to bounce back after surprise Brisbane omission

Nathan Lyon on Monday said he had nothing to prove after being surprisingly left out of the second Ashes Test, with the veteran Australia spinner expected to be recalled for the Adelaide encounter with England.

The 38-year-old was not included for a pink-ball Test against the West Indies in July, marking his first omission while fit in 12 years.

He played in the Ashes opener at Perth but was then overlooked for the day-night Test at the Gabba, where Australia again opted for an all-pace attack.

Lyon at the time said that missing out was "absolutely filthy".

But he will almost certainly be back for the third Test in Adelaide starting Wednesday with extreme heat expected and a dry wicket that will favour spin.

"I've played 140 Test matches. I feel like I don't have a point

to prove to anyone," said Lyon ahead of a Test that could see Australia wrap up the five-match series.

In the DD2 MAX class, Alfayez won his final in 13:28.045 after 15 laps. He had a huge gap of 16.149s from runner-up Abdulkader Qasem, while Talal Alattas came third 23.853s adrift.

In the BRMC’s third round, Enzo won the Micro MAX final in 9:24.272 after nine laps to complete his double. Rashid Almahroos came second 9.969s behind.

Tariq triumphed in the nine-lap Mini MAX final in 8:50.328. He enjoyed a comfortable 7.341s gap from Rhys, who was the runner-up, while Faisal came third 7.606s adrift.

Shaikh Ahmed secured his back-to-back wins after taking the Junior MAX final in 13:46.370 after 15 laps. Leopold was again



second 4.958s behind and Ryan third 11.085s back.

Houghton took the chequered flag in the 15-lap Senior MAX final in 13:28.211. Mohammed Alhasan followed 3.501s back and Najjar was third 5.493s adrift.

Alfayez won the DD2 MAX for the second straight round in 13:16.031 after 15 laps – 4.656s ahead of Qasem with Alattas in third 19.055s back.

The BRMC features a total of eight rounds in its 2025/2026 calendar. This past weekend’s double-header was the final action of this calendar year. The championship will resume in 2026 with round four on 10 January, followed by round five on 30 January. Round six is then set for 13 February, and then the seventh and penultimate round will be held on 28 March. That will pave the way for the championship final, scheduled for 18 April at BIKC.
