Saudi King Salman undergoes medical tests: royal court

Saudi Arabia's 90-year-old monarch King Salman is undergoing medical tests at a hospital in capital Riyadh, the kingdom's Royal Court said yesterday.

"The Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques -- may God protect him -- is undergoing medical examinations today... at King Faisal Specialist Hospital in Riyadh," the court said in a statement shared on state media.

In 2024, the Royal Court said he suffered from lung infections, which he recovered from.

He was hospitalised in May 2022, when he went in for a colonoscopy and stayed for just over a week for other tests and "some time to rest", the official Saudi Press Agency reported at the time.

He was also admitted to hospital in March 2022 to undergo what state media described as "successful medical tests" and to change the battery of his pacemaker.

In 2020, he underwent surgery to remove his gall bladder.

India looks to finalise 'mother of all deals' with EU

A trade deal between India and the European Union will be the "mother of all deals", Delhi's Commerce Minister said yesterday, as both sides seek to overcome the final sticking points.

The EU and India's trade chiefs said last week they were getting closer to reaching a deal after days of talks in Brussels.

"This (India-EU trade pact) will be the mother of all deals," Commerce Minister Piyush Goyal said, according to the Press Trust of India news agency. The leaders of the EU and India are expected to hold a summit at the end of January.

Pakistani President departs Bahrain following official visit



His Excellency Asif Ali Zardari, the President of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, departed Bahrain yesterday, concluding an official visit, during which he held talks with His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa. The discussions addressed the close relations between the two countries, as well as regional and international developments of common interest. At Bahrain International Airport, the Pakistani President was seen off by Abdullatif bin Rashid Al Zayani, Minister of Foreign Affairs; Amna bint Ahmed Al Rumaihi, Minister of Housing and Urban Planning; Jassim bin Mohammed Al Ghatam, Deputy Governor of Muharraq Governorate; Saqib Rauf, Ambassador of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan to the Kingdom of Bahrain; Mohamed Ebrahim Mohamed Abdulqader, Ambassador of the Kingdom of Bahrain to the Islamic Republic of Pakistan; along with a number of officials.

Bahrain, EU discuss strengthening ties and regional stability

Abdullatif bin Rashid Al Zayani, Bahrain's Minister of Foreign Affairs, held a phone call with Kaja Kallas, EU High Representative and European Commission Vice-President, and Constantinos Kombos, Foreign Minister of the Republic of Cyprus, which currently holds the Presidency of the Council of the European Union.

The discussions focused on Bahrain-EU relations and ways to advance cooperation between the European Union and the Gulf Cooperation Council, particularly during Bahrain's current GCC presidency.

Officials also addressed regional and international developments, emphasising the need to reduce tensions, promote dialogue and diplomatic solutions, and support initiatives that enhance regional and global security and stability.

Sparks fly over Expat ID validity bill

Proposal caps Expat ID validity at residency length

● Government says IDs are already deactivated

● Ministry warns of cost and operational issues

A contentious bill that could fundamentally alter how Expat ID cards are issued has put lawmakers and authorities at loggerheads, as parliament prepares to debate the measure on Tuesday.

If passed, the amendment would stipulate that "in all cases, the ID card for a non-Bahraini shall be valid for

a period not exceeding the duration of his residence in the Kingdom of Bahrain"—effectively tying the card's validity strictly to the holder's lawful residency.

The Parliament's Foreign Affairs, Defence and National Security Committee has already urged MPs to reject the proposal in principle, underscoring deep divisions ahead of the debate.

Supporters argue the change would strengthen controls on overstays, curb access to ID-linked services and transactions, and increase fee revenue.

The government, however, dismisses the proposal as redundant, stressing that ID cards are already automatically deactivated once residency expires, immediately cutting off access to government services, banking and other dealings that require an active card.

The Ministry of Interior added that individuals leaving Bahrain are granted a 30-day grace period to settle their affairs before their ID cards are deactivated.

It also warned that tying card validity to residency periods would create operational complications, as residence permits vary widely in length, including long-term categories such as the Golden Residence. The ministry further cautioned that the amendment would place added strain on public finances, noting that issuing an ID card costs 14 dinars, while foreign nationals pay 10 dinars under a five-year renewal model.

The National Institution for Human Rights said the proposal does not, in principle, breach equality or directly infringe



A national identity card (CPR) – including for expatriate residents – is generally valid for five years from the date of issuance (and ten years for those aged 70 and above) before it must be renewed. This validity period is not tied to other documents such as a passport or driving licence.

rights and freedoms, but called for a legal mechanism to address humanitarian cases where access to essential services depends on holding a valid ID card.

The Bahrain Bar Society raised no objections, while the Legislation and Legal Opinion Commission recommended leaving ID validity periods to executive regulations for greater flexibility, warning that the proposed change could lead to operational difficulties.

Trump threatens tariffs on countries that don't back Greenland takeover plan

"I may put a tariff on countries if they don't go along with

Greenland, because we need Greenland for national security," Trump said at a health roundtable at the White House.

"I may do that," added Trump.

Trump compared the possible Greenland tariffs to those that he threatened on France and Germany last year over the price of pharmaceutical products.

88% of public hospital doctors are Bahraini

Bahrain is pushing ahead with a phased plan to increase the number of Bahraini doctors in government hospitals, where nationals currently account for 637 of the total 726 doctors.

The Ministry of Health outlined the strategy in a parliamentary

mentary reply to First Deputy Speaker Abdunabi Salman, emphasizing that Bahraini doctors remain the first choice across the health system. Medical education in the country extends from board training to fellowships and subspecialty programmes, both locally and abroad, ensuring a steady pipeline of qualified national doctors.

Primary health-care centres have already reached 100 per cent Bahrainisation, and new hospital projects are expected to create

additional posts. Government hospitals are expanding specialist training, creating clearer career paths for new graduates, and aligning appointments with the specific needs of each facility.

The phased replacement plan also includes sending Bahraini doctors abroad for fellowship training while carefully balancing shortages in some specialties, available vacancies, job ceilings, and funding requirements. Non-Bahraini doctors are recruited only in areas where qualified Bahraini doctors are not yet available.

In the private sector, the Supreme Council of Health is working with Tamkeen to help Bahraini doctors pass board exams through residency training programmes in needed specialties. The initiative also supports medical and dental fellowships abroad, enabling Bahrainis to complete practical training and qualify for consultant-level

roles.

Cabinet-backed measures further support education and career development, including loans of up to BD30,000, wage support for newly graduated doctors and dentists, and incentives for private hospitals that prioritise Bahraini hires. Wage support covers 70 per cent of the first-year salary, 50 per cent in the second year, and 30 per cent in the third, with a minimum of BD800. Additional measures aim to boost pay and help doctors acquire advanced clinical skills in demand.



As of the latest health sector data, Bahrain has 10 government hospitals and 24 private hospitals, giving a combined total of 34 hospital facilities across the kingdom.

Government hospitals and primary health-care centres in Bah-



rain recorded 1.2 million patient visits in 2025, the Ministry of Health told Parliament.

In a written reply to MP Jaleela Al Sayed, the ministry said government hospitals alone handled 538,308 visits across outpatient clinics and medical and surgical specialties. The hospital workforce includes 191 consultants in medicine and dentistry, 323 doctors and specialists, and 211 trainee doctors, including residents and senior residents. Between 2024 and 2025, 207 doctors were promoted under approved procedures, with pay grades from the fifth to tenth level, including E6, based on qualifications, experience, and assigned duties.

Primary healthcare centres recorded 707,651 visits between January and November 2025 and have reached 100% Bahrainisation across all medical posts. Staffing includes 584 doctors, comprising 473 women and 111 men, including consultants,

family doctors, general practitioners, dentists, and trainees. Promotions for eligible doctors are underway, with some completed in November 2025 and the remainder expected in early 2026.

On clinic capacity, the Bahrain and Kuwait Health Centre in Hidd has the most general medicine clinics (31), followed by Yousif Abdulrahman Engineer Health Centre (26). Other clinics are spread across 27 health centres and a coastal clinic.

The ministry said estimates of doctor requirements are linked to the Health Insurance Law rollout and are reviewed regularly, taking into account specialty, service demand, staffing ceilings, and budgets. Future staffing needs are met through approved fellowship and subspecialty programmes, allowing doctors to train and progress according to professional requirements, with timelines varying by specialty.

Pakistan, Bahrain pledge closer cooperation on security and drug enforcement

Asif Ali Zardari, President of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, held talks yesterday with General Shaikh Rashid bin Abdullah Al Khalifa, Bahrain's Interior Minister, on strengthening bilateral ties and enhancing cooperation in security and drug enforcement.

The two sides agreed to continue coordinated efforts to combat the threats posed by organised crime and drug trafficking, building on the long-standing partnership between the two nations.

President Zardari praised HM the King's wise leadership and his role in deepening the close relations between Pakistan and Bahrain.

In response, the Interior Minister welcomed the positive outcomes of President Zardari's visit, noting that the meeting between HM the King and the Pakistani President highlighted the historical ties and close cooperation between the countries. He also expressed gratitude to President Zardari for his commitment to enhancing collaboration and joint action in key areas.

Parliament to debate specialist sports coaches for public schools

A proposal to appoint a specialist sports coach in every public school will be debated and voted on in Parliament Tuesday, after unanimous backing from the Services Committee.

Submitted by MPs Dr Mahdi Al Shuwaikh, Abdunabi Salman, Mamdouh Al Saleh, Hassan Ebrahim, and Dr Hisham Al Ashiri, the plan aims to identify and develop pupils with sporting talent.

Dr Al Shuwaikh said: "Specialist coaches will nurture athletically gifted students and refine their skills."

The Services Committee recommended approval, citing public-interest grounds.

The Ministry of Education

said it supports nurturing student talent but argued that existing PE teachers and school competitions already achieve this. PE curricula cover team and individual sports, and teachers have the expertise to spot and develop promising athletes.

The ministry highlighted Bahrain's 2024 International School Games, where students won 66 medals, ranking fourth among Arab nations and 13th globally, and success at the Gymnasiade international school championship.

It added that school sports will continue to expand, encouraging participation and supporting talented students, and said it remains ready to provide further clarification to Parliament.

Café worker jailed for three years for throwing hot water at colleague

The High Criminal Court sentenced a café worker to three years in prison for throwing hot water at a colleague, leaving her with a 5% permanent disability.

Court records show the man, in his 20s, argued with his Asian

co-worker over handling an order, which escalated into a physical altercation. He hit the woman, knocking her to the floor, before other delivery workers intervened.

Prosecutors said the defendant then stood behind the woman, called her by name, and threw hot water at her from a drink-preparation container,

causing burns confirmed in a forensic report.

The victim told the court she had asked for his help that morning, which he ignored. After opening her account on the cash register and closing his, he attacked her, hitting her and throwing her down. Even after co-workers intervened and she contacted the manager, he fol-

lowed her and poured hot water over her face, striking her again on the head.

During the investigation, the defendant admitted to the assault. He was charged with deliberately causing permanent disability, assault by beating and choking, and continuing the attack after the first confrontation was broken up.

Fire engulfs restaurant in Arad, no injuries reported

A fierce fire broke out at a restaurant inside a building in the Arad area, causing extensive damage but no injuries, authorities said. The Ministry of Interior said Civil Defence teams were dispatched immediately after the incident was reported. Fire-

fighters carried out evacuation procedures, brought the blaze under control and conducted cooling operations to prevent it from reigniting. The fire sent thick black smoke billowing into the sky and damaged a neighbouring building as well as several parked vehicles. The ministry did not identify the site, but local media reports

said the blaze struck the mini heritage village in Arad. Eyewitnesses described flames engulfing parts of the complex as smoke spread across the area, with strong winds helping the fire spread rapidly. Images released by the Police Media Centre showed Civil Defence crews battling towering flames as thick black smoke rose

high above the site, partially obscuring nearby buildings. Fire engines were positioned along the roadside while firefighters in protective gear worked at close range, directing powerful water jets at the burning structure. The photographs revealed extensive destruction, with sections of the building reduced to charred frames and

collapsed walls. Burnt debris, twisted metal and scorched wooden beams were scattered across the ground, highlighting the intensity of the blaze. Hoses snaked across wet road surfaces as crews continued cooling operations amid lingering smoke. Other images showed firefighters assessing the damage after the flames were brought

under control, while several onlookers stood at a distance watching the operation unfold. Parked vehicles near the site appeared damaged, underscoring the fire's impact on the surrounding area. Authorities confirmed that no one was injured and said an investigation is under way to determine the cause of the fire.

Lawmakers are considering the roll-out of artificial

intelligence (AI) across government ministries, from automating services to smarter oversight of public spending.

The proposal, introduced by MP Hassan Ebrahim alongside Dr Hisham Al Ashiri, Jaleela Alawi, Dr Ali Al Nuaimi, and First Deputy Speaker AbdulNabi Salman, will be discussed in Parliament on Tuesday.

“This initiative would develop services, speed up transactions, reduce administrative and financial burdens, and enhance accuracy and transparency in government work,” said MP Ebrahim. “AI offers unprecedented capabilities in data analysis and decision-making.”

The proposal highlights AI's potential to support internal audits, detect unusual financial patterns, and track performance by analysing complaints and enquiries from the

public. It also suggests systems to monitor operations, flag irregularities, and ensure optimal use of public funds.

Daily-life applications are included, such as smart cameras and visual analysis for public areas, and AI-driven traffic systems to monitor vehicle flows and optimise signal timings.

Sponsors emphasise the need for training government staff, attracting specialist expertise, and partnering with universities and research centres to develop AI tools tailored to Bahrain's needs.

The Nasser Centre for Science & Technology backed the initiative, noting that automating routine tasks can increase output, reduce errors, and free staff for higher-value work. AI-driven data analysis can guide service improvements, reduce costs, and support decision-making through insights and forecasts.

The centre highlighted prototypes tested over three years, including smart financial-audit systems, staff performance and training assessment tools, customer-service platforms, legal-text search tools, complaint

analysis systems, and data retrieval tools for various ministries and agencies.

The Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee recommended approval, with all members agreeing that the proposal serves the public interest.



Governments worldwide are increasingly using artificial intelligence to improve public services, with around 40% of government AI projects focused on enhancing service delivery and operational efficiency, including automating routine tasks, fraud detection, and citizen engagement.

‘Future Consultants’ scheme to Bahrainise legal advisory roles set for debate

A ‘Future Consultants’ scheme to train Bahrainis for legal advisory roles will be debated in Parliament on Tuesday, following MP Hanan Fardan's warning that over 1,900 law graduates are unemployed, according to the National Audit Office's 2023 report.

The plan aims to prepare graduates for public and private sector legal work, bridging the gap between entry-level skills and employer expectations. Fardan said it draws on the successful

‘Future Judges’ model.

A joint committee from the Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee and the Services Committee recommended approval, citing public-interest benefits such as increasing Bahrainisation and creating a skilled pool of Bahraini consultants.

The Ministry of Justice, Islamic Affairs and Waqf would lead the programme, in coordination with the Ministry of Labour and Tamkeen, recruiting and training graduates. The Labour Ministry highlighted existing initiatives, including trainee placements in law

firms with allowances, Polytechnic training, and language courses.

The Ministry of Justice noted new specialist roles such as private enforcement agents and private notaries, alongside training through the Judicial and Legal Studies Institute. The Civil Service Bureau stressed that Bahrainis are prioritised in government hiring, with expatriates only employed when necessary and required to train nationals.

The proposal will be debated in Tuesday's parliamentary session.

Parliament set for new vote on advertising law preamble

A narrow dispute over the preamble of a bill regulating advertising in Bahrain will go to a new vote in Parliament, while the main clauses remain agreed.

The draft law, amending Decree-Law No. 14 of 1973, requires prior approval for advertisement content, empowers municipal authorities to inspect and remove adverts that breach the law, and allows licence suspension or withdrawal. Offenders may face fines of 1,000–20,000 dinars, imprisonment, or both, with each violating advert attracting additional penalties. Courts can also order site restoration at the advertiser's expense.

The disagreement concerns how the preamble references Decree-Law No. 47 of 2002, with the Shura Council updating wording to include electronic media, while the lower house cited only press, printing, and publishing. The Public Utilities and Environment Committee recommended backing the Shura Council version.

Other amendments clarify ministry responsibilities, allow task delegation, repeal an obsolete committee article, and confirm implementation by the Prime Minister and ministers.

Gold bullion drives Bahrain's re-export trade

Gold bullion topped Bahrain's re-export trade in November 2025, with shipments worth 8.3 million dinars, almost all sent to the UAE, according to monthly trade data.

The figures also show outward sales of gold jewellery to several markets, with Saudi Arabia and the United States among the main destinations, alongside import flows that fed

re-export activity during the same month.

Bahrain exported gold bullion worth 11.1 million dinars to the UAE in



November. Exports of gold jewellery, ornaments and parts reached 3.5 million dinars to Saudi Arabia, while the United States and the UAE each received 1.4 million dinars. Other destinations included Italy, worth 212.5 thousand dinars, and Kuwait, worth 119.1 thousand dinars, with additional markets recorded.

On re-exports, bullion was the largest item across all goods at 8.3 million dinars, with nearly the entire amount shipped to the UAE. Bahrain also

re-exported gold jewellery, ornaments and parts worth 3.5 million dinars to Saudi Arabia, 309.7 thousand dinars to the United States, 212.5 thousand dinars to Italy, and about 134 thousand dinars to the UAE.

Imports during November included gold bullion worth 14.9 million dinars from the UAE, 4.5 million dinars from Switzerland, 392.5 thousand dinars from Australia, and 97.3 thousand dinars from South Africa.

Bahrain also imported gold jewellery, ornaments and parts

worth 9.8 million dinars from the UAE, 1.7 million dinars from India, 535.4 thousand dinars from Italy, and 494.8 thousand dinars from the United States. Further imports came from France at 216.8 thousand dinars, Thailand at 136.4 thousand dinars, and Switzerland at 128.5 thousand dinars, alongside other sources including China, Germany, Lebanon, Spain and Turkey.

The data also recorded imports of semi-worked gold from the UAE worth 66.7 thousand dinars in November.

Myanmar tells ICJ Rohingya
genocide claims 'unsubstantiated'



◆ Myanmar yesterday dismissed as “unsubstantiated” allegations that it committed genocide against its Rohingya minority, telling the International Court of Justice that its brutal crackdown was a “counter-terrorism operation.” Myanmar is defending itself at the United Nations top court from accusations brought

by The Gambia that its actions against the Rohingya breached the 1948 UN Genocide Convention. “This case will be decided on the basis of proven facts, not unsubstantiated allegations. Emotional language and blurry factual pictures are not a substitute for a rigorous presentation of facts,” Ko Ko Hlaing, a minister in the president’s office, told the court.

Australia warns of floods,
fires after cars washed away

Australia’s emergency services warned people yesterday to stay prepared for sudden downpours and dangerous bushfires in the country’s east after a flash flood swept cars into the sea.

Heavy rains on Thursday sent a deluge of water flowing through some parts of the eastern state of Victoria, which is still battling 10 major bushfires.

Photo and video images in local media showed one car rolling around in muddy waters as it was carried along the Wye River southwest of Melbourne.

Two cars were still partially submerged under the ocean waves yesterday, a few steps from the sandy coastline.

A local record of 186 millimetres (more than seven inches) fell in the 24 hours to yesterday morning in one spot, the state meteorology service said.

Most of that water fell on Thursday.

“We’ve seen severe-to-extreme heat wave, catastrophic bushfires and now extreme flash flooding in the southwest of the state,” Emergency Management Commissioner Tim Wiebusch told reporters.

“It really is a timely reminder that communities need to be prepared for all types of emergencies.”

The flash flood cut off the state’s Great Ocean Road and forced up to 300 people to flee, officials said. Many of them were reportedly holidaying at caravan camps. One child was injured and airlifted to hospital.

“It was raining, we were all in the tent playing cards with the gang, then we heard shouting,” camper Matthew Stanhope told The Age newspaper, saying he and his friends ran to a nearby hill.

“It was lightning fast and quiet too. There’s no noise, just all of a sudden the water is up.”

Iran protests subside
after ‘brutal’ crackdown

The protest movement in Iran has subsided after a crackdown that has killed thousands under an internet blackout, monitors said yesterday, one week after the start of the biggest protests in years challenging the Islamic republic’s theocratic system.

The threat of new military action by the United States against Iran has also appeared to have receded for the time being, with a Saudi official saying Gulf allies have persuaded President Donald Trump to give the Iranian leadership a “chance”.

Protests sparked by economic grievances started with a shutdown in the Tehran bazaar on December 28 but turned into a mass movement demanding the removal of the clerical system that has ruled Iran since the 1979 revolution.

People started pouring into the streets in big cities from January 8 but authorities immediately enforced a shutdown of the internet that has lasted over a week and activists say is

aimed at masking the scale of the crackdown.

The repression has “likely suppressed the protest movement for now”, said the US-based Institute for the Study of War, which has monitored the protest activity.

But it added: “The regime’s widespread mobilisation of security forces is unsustainable, however, which makes it possible that protests could resume.”

Norway-based rights group Iran Human Rights (IHR) says 3,428 protesters have been verified to have been killed by security forces, but warns this could be a fraction of the actual toll.

Its director Mahmood

Amiry-Moghaddam said authorities under supreme leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei have “committed one of the gravest crimes of our time”.

He cited “horrifying eyewitness accounts” received by IHR of “protesters being shot dead while trying to flee, the use of military-grade weapons and the street execution of wounded protesters”.

Lama Fakih, programme director at Human Rights Watch, said the killings since last week “are unprecedented in the country”.

Monitor Netblocks said that the “total internet blackout” in Iran had now lasted over 180 hours, longer than a similar

measure that was imposed during 2019 protests.

‘Give Iran a chance’

Trump, who backed and joined Israel’s 12-day war against Iran in June, had not ruled out new military action against Tehran and made clear he was keeping a close eye on if any protesters were executed.

But with the belligerent rhetoric on all sides appearing to tone down for now, a senior Saudi official told AFP on Thursday that Saudi Arabia, Qatar and Oman led “a long, frantic, diplomatic last-minute effort to convince President Trump to give Iran a chance to show good intention”.

Machado vows to be Venezuela
president ‘when the right time comes’

Venezuelan opposition leader Maria Corina Machado has insisted she will be elected president “when the right time comes” despite the United States sidelining her after overthrowing Nicolas Maduro.

President Donald Trump has backed Maduro’s former vice president Delcy Rodriguez as interim leader of the oil-rich country following the January 3 US military operation to seize Maduro.

“I believe I will be elected when the right time comes as president of Venezuela, the first woman president,” Machado told Fox News’s Fox & Friends show broadcast yesterday after she met with Trump in Washington.

Machado’s party has presented evidence that Maduro stole the

2024 election -- claims supported by Washington and much of the international community.

But Trump has said that Machado does not have enough support among Venezuelans, and

opted to stick with Rodriguez, so long as she toes the line on US access to Venezuela’s vast oil reserves.

“I want to serve my country where I am more useful. I got a

mandate, and I have that mandate,” Machado told Fox.

Nobel medal

Machado, 58, on Thursday presented her Nobel Peace Prize medal to Trump in a bid to win over the US president.

“He deserves it,” she said. “And it was a very emotional moment, I decided to present the Nobel Peace Prize medal on behalf of the people of Venezuela.”

It was not immediately clear if Trump kept the award following their White House lunch. The Norwegian Nobel committee says its prizes cannot be transferred.

Trump had campaigned hard to win last year’s Nobel Peace Prize for what he says are his efforts to stop eight wars.

Instead it went to Machado, who appeared in Oslo last month to collect her prize -- following a daring escape from Venezuela by boat.

Trump and Rodriguez had their first telephone call on Wednesday and the White House said he “likes what he’s seeing” from her.

Zelensky hopes for security guarantees plan in new US talks

● Zelensky targets Davos for peace signature

President Volodymyr Zelensky said yesterday that he hopes Ukraine will sign agreements with the United States next week on a plan to end Russia's invasion but lashed out at slow ammunition deliveries from abroad.

US President Donald Trump has been pushing for a halt to the war and has pressured Ukraine to accept peace terms that Kyiv has likened to capitulation to Russia.

Key sticking points remain between Kyiv and Washington, and Ukraine has been seeking clarity from allies about what security guarantees it will receive as part of the plan, which it believes are vital to deter Russia from invading again.

Zelensky told reporters -- including from AFP -- that Ukrainian negotiators were on their way to the United States for more talks.

"We hope there will be more clarity both regarding the documents we have already effectively prepared with the American side and regarding Russia's response to all the diplomatic work that is underway," he added.

"If everything is finalised and if there is agreement from the American side -- because on our side, in principle, I believe we're done -- then signing during

Davos will be possible," he added, referring to The World Economic Forum next week.

Air defence depleted

Zelensky also conceded problems with Ukrainian air defence systems at a critical moment in the war.

Some air defence systems supplied to Ukraine by Western allies had run out of ammunition amid a wave of Russian attacks that have devastated his country's energy infrastructure, he said.

Kyiv says more than 15,000 energy workers are racing in sub-zero temperatures to re-

store power plants and substations battered over recent days by hundreds of Russian drones and missiles.

Zelensky has repeatedly called on allies to beef up Ukraine's air defence systems to shield vital civilian infrastructure facilities from daily Russian bombardments.

"Until this morning we had several systems without missiles. Today I can say this openly because today I have those missiles," Zelensky told a press conference in Kyiv.

The attacks have spurred urgent humanitarian concerns, with millions of Ukrainians suf-

fering long periods without electricity and heating during a cold snap where temperatures have dropped to -20C in some parts of the country.

The Kremlin claims its forces only target military facilities.

When it has bombed Ukrainian power plants in previous years, it has blamed civilians' hardships on Kyiv and its refusal to accept Russian peace demands.

AFP journalists in Kyiv -- one of the worst hit cities -- have seen chaos at intersections where traffic lights are off, shops and restaurants closed, and residents warming up and charging phones in emergency tents set up by the

state.

Ukraine relies on its Western partners for several vital advanced air defence systems -- including US-made Patriot batteries.

But Zelensky said during a press conference with Czech President Petr Pavel that all of those units "require constant supplies of missiles".

He urged both European allies and the United States to up deliveries.

"We received a substantial package in the morning. It's in Ukraine now and we can talk about it.

"But it comes at such cost -- through effort, blood, people's lives," the Ukrainian leader added.

Syrians flee Kurdish-held area ahead of deadline

Civilians fled a Kurdish-held region of northern Syria yesterday before a deadline set by the army, which seeks to expand its control over the area after driving Kurdish forces from Aleppo.

The government is seeking to extend its authority nationwide following the ousting of long-time leader Bashar al-Assad in December 2024.

The US envoy for Syria, Tom Barrack, posted on X that he was working "around the clock" to prevent any escalation between

Kurdish fighters and government forces, both of which have US backing.

The army has massed significant reinforcements in Deir Hafer, some 50 kilometres (30 miles) east of Aleppo, and ordered the Kurdish-dominated Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) to evacuate an area between this region and the River Euphrates to the east.

Civilians have been fleeing the area since Thursday on back roads. AFP correspondents saw some using a rickety bridge to cross a branch of the Euphrates.

South Korean ex-leader jailed for 5 years in first martial law verdict

A South Korean judge sentenced former President Yoon Suk Yeol yesterday to five years in prison for obstructing justice and other crimes linked to his disastrous martial law declaration and in its chaotic aftermath.

It is the first in a series of verdicts for the disgraced ex-leader, whose brief suspension of civilian rule in South Korea on December 3, 2024 prompted massive protests and a show-down in parliament.

Now ousted from power, he faces multiple trials for actions taken during that debacle and in the turmoil that followed.

Yesterday, Judge Baek Dae-hyun at Seoul's Central District Court said he found Yoon guilty of obstruction of justice by blocking investigators from detaining him.

Baek said that Yoon abused his power by turning officials of the Presidential Security Service against the state and used them as his "personal guards" serving his "own safety and private interests".

Yoon was also found guilty of excluding cabinet members from a martial law planning meeting.

"Despite having a duty, above all others, to uphold the Constitution and observe the rule of law as president, the defendant instead displayed an attitude that disregarded the... Constitution," Baek said.

"The defendant's culpability is extremely grave," he said.

But Yoon was not guilty of

forging official documents due to lack of evidence, the judge said.

Yoon has seven days to appeal, he added.

Prosecutors had called for a 10-year prison term, while Yoon had insisted no law was broken.

After the verdict was announced, his supporters outside the court fell silent for several minutes before breaking into chants of "Yoon again!"

Actor McConaughey seeks to patent image to protect from AI

Actor Matthew McConaughey has filed recordings of his image and voice with US patent authorities to protect them from unauthorized usage by artificial intelligence platforms, a representative said Wednesday.

Several video clips and audio recordings were registered by the commercial

arm of the just keep livin Foundation, a non-profit created by the Oscar-winning actor and his wife Camila, according to the United States Patent and Trademark Office database.

Many artists are increasingly concerned about the uncontrolled use of their image via generative AI since the rollout of ChatGPT and other AI-powered tools.

Several US states have adopted legislation that serves as consumer

protection against certain AI systems and deepfakes, but much of this applies mainly to malicious use or commercial purposes.

Only a few, notably Tennessee's ELVIS Act passed in 2024, offer more targeted protections for artists against AI-generated cloning or impersonation.

A few actors have taken legal action to assert their rights. Among the most notable is Scarlett Johansson, who sued the image-generating app Lisa AI in 2023 for creating an AI-gen-

erated avatar in her likeness for an advertisement without her consent.

McConaughey's approach is novel in that he is taking the lead in protecting his image and voice.

The star of "Interstellar" and "Dallas Buyers Club" is no opponent of generative artificial intelligence.

He has acquired a stake in ElevenLabs, a startup specializing in AI voice modeling, and the company has created an AI audio

version of McConaughey -- with his permission.

Attorney Kevin Yorn, who represents McConaughey, said the aim of filing with the patent office was "to make sure that our clients have the same kind of protections that their businesses have."

"The second part is to make sure that our clients are able to capture some of the value that is being created with this new technology using their voice and likeness," he added.

She told the New York Times newspaper: "It was the first time in my professional life that I stopped."

"I had a full mental breakdown. It was almost as if the timing of the pandemic was bang on..."

"It forced me to answer some questions I probably could have put off answering for another 10 years..."

"[During the show] there was never any time to

stop and consider the meaning of it. I never had the foresight to think, 'You're going to take a minute.'"

The Last Christmas actress admitted she is unlikely to ever star in another fantasy project.

She said: "You're highly unlikely to see me get on a dragon, or even in the same frame as a dragon, ever again."

And Emilia was hesitant to take on her latest role, as Bea in spy series Ponies, because she was concerned about the "commitment".

She said: "I was definitely, like, 'A lead in a TV show? I know what that commitment feels like.'"

But the actress knew things would be different because she was given the choice of which of the two main characters she wanted to play.

She noted: "I felt like they were giving me a voice, which doesn't always happen."

Emilia admitted she felt she had very little control in the early days of her career.

- encouraged her to "shed that character" and move on.

Speaking on The Hollywood Reporter's Awards Chatter podcast, she said: "I've never talked about this, but actually Malcolm, whom you might know as Mac, encouraged me to be myself. "And that it was OK to kind of shed that character, and embrace my brown hair, and make R B-influenced pop music and separate and do the brave thing."

"I never said that. But it was a

great influence, I'm so very grateful for that."

"Nothing was more important. Talk about losing track of time and forgetting to eat, remind yourself to take care of yourself and be a person."

"He was a person who gave literally every single second of his thought and time and life to his music."

Ariana also pointed to the "many incredible and different bodies of work" he left behind.

She had previously reflected on the grief she felt when he passed, acknowledging that while their relationship wasn't "perfect", she still thought he was "the best person ever".

She told Vogue magazine in 2019: "By no means was what we had perfect, but, like, f***. He was the best person ever, and he didn't deserve the demons he had."

Sinner: Doping ban made me stronger

Jannik Sinner said yesterday a three-month doping ban last year made him stronger as a person and more relaxed on court as he prepares to defend his Australian Open title.

The 24-year-old arrived at Melbourne Park last year under intense pressure, not knowing his fate after a drugs scandal.

He managed to put aside the noise and win the title but his career was put on hold afterwards as he served the three-month suspension for twice testing positive for a banned anabolic steroid in 2024.

Sinner always maintained the product entered his system unintentionally through a massage from his physiotherapist, who had used a spray containing it to treat a cut.

While the World Anti-Doping Agency said Sinner did not intend to cheat, it ordered him to serve the ban as he was responsible for the actions of his entourage.

“Last year was definitely a much more difficult situation because in this moment last year I didn’t know exactly what’s going to happen,” he said.

“So I tried still to enjoy it when I went out on the court, but still had it in my head kind of.

‘Excited’ Alcaraz hungry to break Australian Open title drought

Carlos Alcaraz warned yesterday that he was “hungry” to break his Australian Open title drought and become the youngest man to complete a career Grand Slam, calling it his primary target in 2026.

The world number one from Spain is the title favourite along with two-time defending champion and great rival Jannik Sinner.

The Melbourne Park crown is the only one of the four majors that Alcaraz has never won, his best performance the quarter-finals in 2024 and 2025.

If he goes all the way this year he will surpass fellow Spaniard Rafael Nadal as the youngest man to win all four majors. Nadal was 24 when he achieved the feat.

The 22-year-old Alcaraz, who begins his title assault against Australia’s 79th-ranked Adam Walton, said he could not wait to get going.

“I think this is my main goal for this year,” said Alcaraz, whose only warm-up was a win against Italy’s Sinner in a light-hearted exhibition match in South Korea.

“So it’s going to be really interesting for me how I prepared, which I think I just made a really good pre-season, just to be in a good shape.

“I’m just hungry for the title, hungry to do a really good result here. I’m just getting ready as much as I can.

“I’m really excited about the tournament beginning.”

Osaka to be ‘aggressive’ in bid for third Australian Open title

Naomi Osaka said yesterday she wants to leave the Australian Open with no regrets and will go on the attack as she attempts to win the title for a third time.

The former world number one from Japan has struggled for form, fitness and consistency since the last of her four Grand Slam titles five years ago.

Osaka, the Melbourne champion in 2019 and 2021, said: “I just hope to be able to look back on this tournament however it ends and not have any regrets.”

Osaka, who faces Croatia’s Antonia Ruzic in the opening

Three-time World Champion Michael van Gerwen wins maiden Bahrain Darts Masters title

BIC, Sakhr – Michael van Gerwen from the Netherlands was this evening crowned champion of the 2026 Bahrain Darts Masters, which came to a close at Terminal 4 by Beyon in Exhibition World Bahrain.

Van Gerwen, the World Number four and a three-time World Champion, secured the title in the Kingdom for the first time after defeating fellow-countryman and World Number three Gian van Veen 8-6 in a hugely thrilling all-Dutch final, played in front of a large and energetic crowd of supporters, many of whom were in colourful fancy dresses and costumes.

Van Gerwen was competing in the Bahrain Darts Masters for only the second time,

and he improved on his runner-up finish in the 2024 edition of the event.

Following the title-decider, which was played best-of-15 legs, van Gerwen was presented with the tournament's glittering champion's trophy, molded in the form of a palm tree. Bahrain International Circuit (BIC) Chief Executive Shaikh Salman bin Isa Al Khalifa and CBX Managing Director Roy Boutagy were on hand for the awarding.

The 2026 Bahrain Darts Masters was organised by BIC, the Professional Darts Corporation (PDC), and sports promoter CBX, and was supported by Bahrain Tourism and Exhibitions Authority.

Van Gerwen joins last year's winner Stephen Bunting, reigning back-to-back World Cham-



pion and 2024 winner in Bahrain Luke Littler, and 2022-23 World Champion and the first-ever victor in the Kingdom Michael Smith as title winners in the Bahrain Darts Masters.

This year's event marked the fourth edition of the prestigious competition, which was held as the first round of the 2026 PDC World Series of Darts.

In this evening's final, van

Gerwen took a 3-0 lead but van Veen won the next two legs to narrow the deficit. Van Gerwen got back on track by taking the sixth leg to complete half the job in his tile ambitions. He

then won the next two legs for a commanding 6-2 advantage, but van Veen battled back with three straight to make it 5-6. The pair then split the next two legs to set up a dramatic finish, and with van Gerwen leading 7-6, he made the most of the opportunity to seal the crown.

Earlier in the evening, Van Gerwen was first to secure his place in the title affair after defeating 2020-21 World Champion Gerwyn Price 7-2 in the best-of-13 legs semi-finals. In the other contest of the last four, van Veen beat former World Matchplay champion Nathan Aspinall 7-4 to book his place in the championship match.

In the best-of-11 legs quarter-finals, a pair of stunning outcomes kicked off the programme, with Littler losing to Price 2-6 and Bunting being ousted by van Gerwen 4-6. Aspinall followed suit with a 6-3 victory over 2023-24 World Champion and current World Number two Luke Humphries, and then van Veen completed the semi-final cast with a 6-1 triumph against Dutch darts star Danny Noppert.

Bahrain open Asian handball championship with emphatic win

Bahrain made a comfortable start to their 22nd Asian Men's Handball Championship campaign yesterday, cruising to a convincing 32-21 win over Jordan in their opening Group B match at the Saad Al Abdullah Sports Hall in Kuwait City. The result gives the kingdom an ideal platform in the continental tournament, which serves as a qualifier for the 2027 IHF Men's Handball World Championship in Germany.

Robert Hedin's men asserted control from the opening minutes, racing into an early lead through Salman Al Showaikh, who was instrumental through-

out the contest. The Bahrainis' defensive discipline and quick transitions troubled the Jordanians, allowing them to steadily build an advantage and go into the break with a commanding 17-10 lead.

Jordan attempted to respond early in the second half, but Bahrain quickly regained momentum. Al Showaikh continued to lead the attack, while Mohammed Ahmed Habib, Mohamed Nasser, Ali Alasheer, and Qasim Qambar all contributed crucial goals as Bahrain stretched their lead further. The Bahrainis remained composed in the final stages, efficiently closing out the match to secure an 11-goal victory and underline their credentials as one of the tournament favourites.

Al Showaikh was deservedly named Man of the Match after delivering a standout performance, scoring six goals and orchestrating Bahrain's offensive play with authority and composure. Following the match, Bahrain international Mohammed Habib highlighted the importance of the opening win. "We achieved the most important thing at the start of the tournament," he said. "Opening matches are always difficult, but we were ready for the challenge and managed to overcome a match that was not easy at all."

He added: "Every game in this championship is tough. This win gives us strong motivation for what's coming. We didn't come here just to participate, we are taking it step by step and treating

Verstappen motivated as Red Bull braces for F1 changes

Four-time world champion Max Verstappen said he's keen to get to grips with the new car Red Bull unveiled on Thursday for a 2026 Formula One season of massive change.

The team unveiled the livery for their new cars before a few hundred guests at Detroit's Michigan Central Station less than two months before the season opens in Melbourne on March 7.

New rules for 2026 see aerodynamic changes to make cars lighter and smaller along with modifications to engine specifications to make for a greater contribution from electric power in the hybrid units.

"There is a lot of unknown, there are big changes in the engine, in the car," Verstappen said. "Initially I'll take time to adjust during test days. The motivation is very high."

"It always takes a bit of time to get used to things," he added. "You need to understand where the most performance is to be found, get comfortable in the car."
