India recaptures ship MV Ruen from Somali pirates

India's navy recaptured a ship from Somali pirates off the Indian coast yesterday, the military said, rescuing the crew and ending a three-month takeover of the Maltese-flagged bulk carrier MV Ruen.

The December hijacking of the ship was the first time since 2017 that any cargo vessel had been successfully boarded by Somali pirates.

"#IndianNavy thwarts designs of Somali pirates to hijack ships plying through the region by intercepting ex-MV Ruen," the navy posted on X.

Syria landmine blast kills 19 truffle hunters

Bahrain a welcoming place for expats, says MP Al Salloum

MP proposals spark heated discussions on social media

Recent proposals by MPs before the Council of Representatives may give the impression that the deputies are hell bent on getting expatriates out of the kingdom. But an MP who headed the bloc that came up with most of those proposals says expatriates are still welcome in the country.

As these proposals may potentially affect the works and lives of expatriates in the kingdom, it had led to heated discussions on social media. The Daily Tribune reached out to MP Ahmed Sabah Al Salloum, who heads a group of MPs called the Strategic Thinking Bloc (STB) at the Council of Representatives, regarding the recent proposals.

Citizens First

According to the STB, most



proposals are made by giving priority to citizens and does not reflect negatively on expatriates who contribute significantly to the national economy. The STB aims to provide strategic proposals for legislation prioritizing citizens until 2026.

"No one is against expats. Bahrain continues to be a welcoming place to live and work but it is our job to put citizens' interests first," MP Al Salloum told The Daily Tribune.

Highlighting the STB's efforts in the labour market, MP Al Salloum stated that the committee is further looking for legislations that make Bahrainis the first

choice for employment and a propeller for growth in coordination with the Ministry of Labour. "There is more to be done," he added.

The STB is purely working to analyse, research, develop and draft legislations that take care of the wellbeing of the citizens, the MP explained. To enhance significant outcomes on the welfare of citizens in the coming

The proposal regarding the driving licence was not the first but part of a long list of legislations that touched upon the work and life of expatriates in the country. Previously, MPs had unanimously approved a proposal to restrict expatriates from taking up positions in six fields - medicine, aviation, legal, accounting, banking and education.

Another proposal had suggested doubling the fees being levied for expatriate employees in administrative, vocational, and supervisory jobs. The MPs had even proposed stopping Bahrain's Labour Fund (Tamkeen) support to businesses that are fully owned by expatriates. Yet another proposal had suggested levying a 2% tax on expat remittances abroad and it was approved by the MPs despite strong opposition from the government.

Best Destination

However, it's important to acknowledge the significant contribution of foreign workers in the Kingdom. By the second quarter of 2023, the number of foreign workers employed in Bahrain had reached over 609,000, according to labour market indicators. This substantial workforce has demonstrably boosted the national economy, particularly in the real estate sector.

Bahrain's success in attracting expats is further underscored by its achievement in 2023, ranking 9th globally and 1st in the Middle East and North Africa as a destination for expatriates.

Demand for change

MPs call for Investigation into Bahrainisation in private sector to overhaul policies

A group of parliamentarians led by MP Hamad Al Doy, Jaleela Al Sayed, Bader Al Tameemi and Mohammed Al Baluchi, have requested the formation of a parliamentary investigation committee to examine Bahrainisation in the private sector.

MP Al Doy, one of the proposal submitters, said the committee would look into obstacles preventing Bahrainisation, ensuring commitment to relevant laws and regulations, and reasons for private sector preference of expatriates over citizens. It will also verify any loopholes exploited in this area and adherence of companies, especially public ones, to policies.

The committee will confirm conditions for non-Bahraini workers, understand why those jobs can't be nationalised, and assess fairness of employment processes in the private sec-

tor and effectiveness of government citizen prioritisation plans. It will investigate equitable promotion and grading of Bahrainis versus expats, as well as verifying credentials and competencies of foreign staff, he stressed.

The committee's memorandum outlined four main focuses: compliance of government and subsidiary firms as well as

large private companies with Bahrainisation laws; barriers hindering private sector nationalisation leading to a distorted labour market with more expats than citizens and high unemployment; application of relevant rules by concerned entities; and conditions for non-citizen workers to identify national substitutes for their roles.

HM King's support for human rights praised

Unstable weather

Fake LMRA Fb App!

Online users in Bahrain are being scammed by a fake LMRA page on Facebook that collects personal information by offering services such as renewal of CPR, driving licence, and visa.

Several cautious users have already reported the page to Facebook but they say no action is being taken by the online platform, prompting them to raise the issue in various social media forums such as Reddit so as to raise awareness about the page.

A Reddit user recently shared a post exposing the fake LMRA page on Facebook that was disseminating false information about Bahrain's free online CPR renewal, driving license renewal, and visa renewal.

The misleading message encouraged users to download the purportedly free LMRA app, claiming that it would facilitate a three-year visa renewal without any payment. It further promised to verify CPR details through the app.

The Daily Tribune reached out to the Reddit user who first brought attention to this scam. She expressed her concern, stating, "I came across this ad while browsing through Facebook stories, and I wondered if there was a way to report it to

the government."

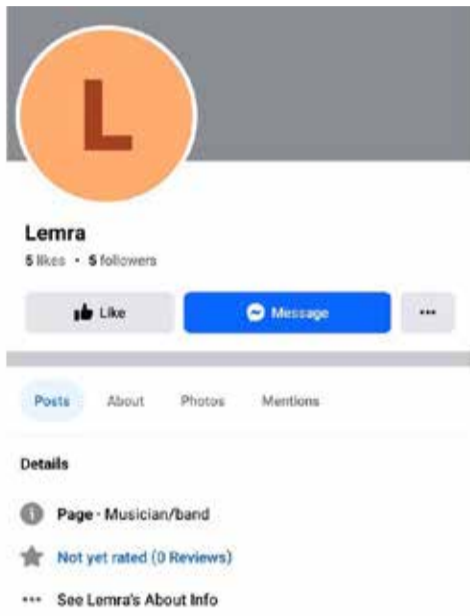
"I reported it initially as fraud and a scam, but the page was still live. So, I tried reporting it under 'pretending to be something' and selected the 'business' option, while reporting the official LMRA page. Unfortunately, I haven't received any response yet," she added.

Awareness Critical

Ahmed Saleh Al Balooshi, CEO of Fintech IT Consultations and a certified expert in Industry 4.0 Technologies, shared his insights with The Daily Tribune on what can be done in such a situation.

The expert emphasized the importance of raising awareness through community forums and social media groups when online platforms fail to take prompt action. By sharing screenshots and experiences, individuals can alert others and create a collec-

tive defence against such scams, he said.

Al Balooshi also suggested reaching out to local law enforcement and cybersecurity agencies to exert pressure on platforms to take immediate action against such fraudulent activities.

He further highlighted several red flags associated with such Facebook ads, including unsolicited contact, a sense of urgency, requests for personal or sensitive data, grammatical errors, and offers that seem too good to be true.

"Users are advised to scruti-

nize the legitimacy of pages, as genuine entities like LMRA possess verified profiles, a substantial following, and a consistent record of professional communication," the expert said.

Preventive measures

Al Balooshi proposed that Facebook should implement preventive measures such as robust AI systems capable of identifying and blocking scam ads, stringent verification processes for pages claiming to be from the government, and a dedicated team to respond swiftly to reports of scams, especially

those claiming to be related to the government.

He also suggested establishing a transparent report-feedback system to empower users by providing them with information on the outcomes of their reports. Bahraini organisations could leverage AI technology to enhance the content of their applications and improve user protection, he added.

Lastly, Al Balooshi stressed the importance of fostering collaborative partnerships between cybersecurity institutions and social media platforms.

"This alliance would facili-

tate the exchange of threat intelligence, the creation of educational materials, and the implementation of instant alert protocols to minimise the risks associated with online scams. Engaging certified cybersecurity experts who specialize in safeguarding online environments is also crucial for both public and private organisations," he stated.

As Bahrain continues to navigate the digital landscape, combating scams and protecting online users should remain a top priority for all stakeholders involved.

Court orders man to repay wife's BD22,050 financial contribution to marital home

The High Civil Court has ordered a husband to pay BD22,050 to his wife in recognition of her monetary contribution towards their shared marital residence.

In her filing, the plaintiff successfully argued that the expenses incurred equated to a debt amount agreed upon between the couple prior, which the husband had committed to repaying. However, due to disputes arising later in the marriage, he reportedly attempted to pressure her into divorce by withholding repayment of the funds owed.

Representing the wife, her lawyer explained that at the request of her then-partner, she took out a bank loan to furnish and equip their home with appliances and other items needed. This included covering costs associated with the needs of their children. The total expenditures exceeded BD23,000, court documents revealed.

When seeking repayment after their relationship deteriorated, the husband refused. As a result, an impartial financial expert was appointed to thoroughly investigate the matter and settle accounts between both parties.

In his report submitted to the court, the expert deter-

mined BD18,029.9 were undisputedly spent on furnishings, appliances and other agreed-upon domestic items. An additional BD5,296.77 remained in dispute.

Witness testimony

After reviewing witness testimony that served to establish the prior agreement between the couple, as well as verified receipts of expenditures, the judge dismissed claims by the husband that purchases were made voluntarily without his knowledge or consent. The court preferred findings in the expert's report, deeming it was conducted with sound professional methodology.

Ultimately, judges ruled the man was liable for the undisputed BD18,029.9 debt amount, saying it had been sufficiently proven. With this outcome, the Civil High Court has upheld principles of equitable property division and financial accountability following divorce.

Agriculture Ministry takes steps to bolster local food production

The Ministry of Municipalities and Agriculture has introduced several measures to increase animal production in Bahrain as part of national food security efforts, announced Minister of Municipalities and Agriculture, His Excellency Wael Al Mubarak.

Addressing a parliamentary inquiry, Al Mubarak pointed to the success in expanding the operations of the Kingdom Poultry Company, now Bahrain's largest egg producer. In 2023, egg output rose 15% to reach 108.1 million eggs, representing a BD16.2 million annual increase in production value.

The Minister also stated that additional lands have been allocated to livestock farming, including an 830,000 square meter plot for broiler chicken projects and 340,000 square meters for cattle sheds for breeders.

According to Al Mubarak, plans are also in place to import slaughter animals from multiple countries, including sheep, goats, cows and camels, as well as chilled and frozen meats as per to quarantine standards safeguarding public health.

Domestic poultry meat production in 2023 totaled approximately 8,426 tons. Meanwhile, imports of slaughter stock reached around 161,325 tons of small ruminants and cattle.

Last year saw 13,594 tons of

chilled meat and around 12,000 tons each of frozen red meat and chilled poultry meat imported, in addition to 47,000 tons of frozen poultry, the Minister revealed.

Through facility expansion and regulated trade, officials aim to boost self-sufficiency and ensure adequate supplies for Bahrainis.

The Ministry of Municipalities and Agriculture remains committed to supporting the agriculture sector, said Mubarak.

Government approves new law allowing NGO investment in Bahrain

The government has expressed approval for a new Shura Council bill permitting non-profit organisations (NGOs) to enter secure commercial and financial investments.

It reviewed the draft law's objectives of empowering NGOs to invest surplus funds for self-generated revenue to achieve goals as stipulated by law and regulations.

Investments cannot result from risky speculation or instruments, and activities must remain within Bahrain's domestic market.

The proposal aims to legally allow NGO investment of available reserves after fulfilling purposes, through safe avenues avoiding high risks to generate financial returns optimising goals.

These addresses prohibiting NGO participation in financial markets under current legislation, barring involvement in high-risk tools.

The bill supports NGO development, sustainability and overcoming challenges through diversified income streams and strengthened financial stability - contributing to expanded services and beneficiary outreach while encouraging expanded programming.

Degree of deception

Student seeks compensation for damages in invalid PhD programme case

A PhD candidate has appealed to Bahrain's High Administrative Court seeking compensation for damages suffered after enrolling in an unlicensed doctoral programme at a private university in 2007.

The plaintiff stated he studied for three years before learning the institution lacked authorisation to offer degrees in his field. The court ascertained this was accurate after reviewing the case details and necessary technical reports.

It was ruled the university must pay BD12,000 - the tuition fees paid during study in addition to moral damages for failing to obtain a dissertation.

The claimant said he enrolled in the advertised academic programme based on the univer-

sity's documents, which the Higher Education Council also confirmed. He paid all associated registration and course fees, attending regularly until suspension two years later when legal status issues emerged.

Despite halting registration, the university continued accepting tuition while requesting four

more months to resolve matters. Final notice was then issued indefinitely stopping all degree programmes until further notice, with students still enrolled for consecutive years in violation of regulations.

Several previous plaintiffs were also awarded BD1,000 provisional compensation each

through finalised rulings, establishing a contractual relationship between parties. Failing to graduate successful students after programme completion constitutes a breach obligating compensation for resulting damages if criteria are met.

ExxonMobil makes new oil discovery off Guyana

Georgetown, Guyana

US energy giant ExxonMobil on Friday announced a new offshore oil and gas discovery in waters off Guyana that are also claimed by neighboring Venezuela.

The oil and gas strike, the first of 2024, was in the Stabroek block. The so-called Bluefin well is in the southeast portion of the block and at a depth of 4,244 feet (1,294 meters). Some 30 discoveries made in Stabroek since 2015 have turned Guyana into an energy powerhouse with proven reserves of 11 billion barrels.

Drillers "encountered approximately 197 feet (60 meters) of hydrocarbon-bearing sandstone," Exxon said Friday.

"Our exploration program continues to improve our understanding of the block's potential to drive viable oil-and-gas development," Alistair Routledge, president of ExxonMobil Guyana, said in the release.

Guyana's rise as an oil and gas producer has intensified a century-old territorial dispute with Venezuela over a region known as Essequibo.

Tensions escalated in late 2023 to a point that triggered alarms of a possible armed conflict. Both governments eventually pledged not to use force.

Trump's son-in-law details property deals in Serbia, Albania

Belgrade, Serbia

Jared Kushner, son-in-law to former US president Donald Trump, announced Saturday plans to invest in luxury real estate in Serbia and Albania, including the old Yugoslav army headquarters site.

The deal was first revealed by a Serbian MP and New York Times article.

"Excited to share some early design images for development projects we have been creating for the Albanian coast and downtown Belgrade," Kushner wrote on X, formerly Twitter,

along with four images of the future complexes.

Green opposition MP Alek-

sandar Jovanovic claimed on Wednesday that the Serbian government had appointed Infrastructure Minister Goran Vesic to sign a "memorandum of understanding" with two firms linked to the family of Trump's son-in-law.

Jovanovic said the matter was no secret but nothing had yet been signed.

A sensitive topic in Serbia, the deal involves the former army headquarters, which was bombed several times in 1999 during US-led NATO air campaign that brought an end to the Kosovo war.

According to Jovanovic, who spoke about the project days ahead of the 25th anniversary of the beginning of the NATO strikes, the government will cede the building and land for a period of 100 years at no cost.

The army site was never reconstructed, but in 2005 was declared a protected "cultural asset".

According to the New York Times, the plan is to build a luxury hotel, 1,500 residential units and a museum.

Meanwhile, one part of the Albania project is to transform the southwest island of Sazan

-- once home to a secret communist military base -- into a luxury tourist destination.

Th New York Times noted that Kushner's business partner is Richard Grenell, a former acting national intelligence director who Trump also used as an envoy for peace talks between Kosovo and Serbia.

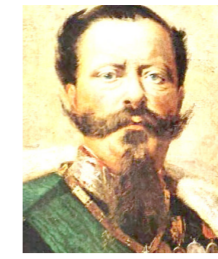

◆ **Police in Haiti** have conducted an operation in a capital neighborhood controlled by the notorious gang leader Jimmy Cheriez, known as "Barbecue," that left several criminals dead, an official said Saturday. National police units entered the Delmas neighborhood Friday evening with the aim of unblocking a road, said Lionel Lizarre of the Haitian police union. Several "bandits" were killed, he said, without providing more details. Another operation was underway Saturday morning as law enforcement officers attempted to regain control of the capital's main port, where gang members had looted several containers, a source at the port told AFP. The port has been shut since March 7 because of the violence.

North Korean leader Kim oversees paratroop drills

North Korea's Kim Jong Un oversaw paratroop drills aimed at showing his soldiers' ability to occupy an "enemy region at a stroke," state media said Saturday, days after the most recent annual US-South Korean military exercise.

Pyeongyang has shown particular sensitivity towards the joint air force exercises conducted by Washington and Seoul, with experts noting that the North's air force is considered to be the weakest link in its military. Pyongyang's latest training overseen by Kim was "aimed at inspecting the paratroopers' readiness to be mobilised for any operational plan in surprise wartime circumstances" and judging their capabilities, Pyongyang's official Korean Central News Agency reported. The troops demonstrated "their perfect combat capability to occupy the enemy region at a stroke once an order is issued", it added. Kim stressed the importance of "applying realistic and scientific training methods" for "achieving maximum fighting efficiency on actual battlefields as required by modern warfare", it added. The North Korean leader also showed "great satisfaction" as his airborne soldiers "occupied the simulated main enemy military targets at once", KCNA said.

Yemen rebels, Hamas discuss 'expanding confrontations' with Israel

Yemen's Iran-backed Houthi rebels discussed "expanding confrontations and encircling" Israel in a meeting in Lebanon with Hamas and other Palestinian factions, a Houthi official told AFP yesterday. Representatives from Hamas, whose October 7 attack on Israel triggered the war, the Islamic Jihad and the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine met last week with the Houthis in Beirut, the official said on condition of anonymity. Palestinian sources on Friday told AFP that the meeting had taken place, with one of them saying the representatives discussed "mechanisms to coordinate their actions of resistance" for the "next stage" of the war in Gaza, now in its sixth month.

Another Palestinian source, also requesting anonymity to share details of the meeting, told AFP that those present discussed the "complementary role of Ansar Allah (the Houthis) alongside Palestinian factions, especially in the event of an Israeli offensive on Rafah".

In a speech Thursday, Houthi leader Abdul Malik al-Houthi threatened to expand the group's attacks to target ships avoiding the Red Sea and Gulf of Aden by sailing south around Africa.

India to hold marathon national election from April

India announced yesterday that national polls would begin on April 19, with Prime Minister Narendra Modi strongly favoured to win a third term in the world's biggest democracy.

Nearly a billion people are eligible to cast ballots in what will be the largest exercise of the democratic franchise in human history, conducted over six weeks. Many consider Modi's re-election a foregone conclusion, owing to both the premier's robust popularity a decade after taking office and a glaringly uneven playing field. "We will take democracy to every corner of the country," chief election commissioner Rajiv Kumar said at a press conference in New Delhi announcing the voting dates.

"It is our promise to deliver a national election in a manner that we... remain a beacon for democracy around the world."

In Gaza, there are no more 'normal-sized babies': UN official

The humanitarian situation in Gaza is a "nightmare" for mothers and babies, with doctors reporting small and sickly newborns, stillbirths and women forced to undergo C-sections without adequate anaesthesia, a UN official said Friday.

"I'm personally leaving Gaza this week terrified for the one million women and girls of Gaza... and most especially for the 180 women who are giving birth every single day," Dominic Allen, UN Population Fund (UNFPA) representative for the state of Palestine, said in a video news conference from Jerusalem.

"Doctors are reporting that they no longer see normal-sized babies," Allen said after visiting hospitals still providing maternity services in the north of Gaza, where need is especially great. "What they do see though, tragically, is more stillborn births... and more neonatal deaths, caused in part by malnutrition, dehydration and complications."

The numbers of complicated deliveries are roughly twice what they were before the war with Israel began -- with mothers stressed, fearful, underfed and exhausted -- and caregivers often lacking necessary supplies.

"We have had reports of insufficient anaesthetic being available" for Caesarean sections, "which again is unthinkable." "Those mothers should be wrapping their arms around their children," he said. "Those children should not be wrapped in a body bag."

Israel has defended its policies as it pursues its stated goal of destroying Hamas, saying the UN should send more aid to the war-ravaged territory, pushing back on reports by the UN and NGOs that cumbersome Israeli inspections are blocking food and other essentials. Allen said Israeli authorities had refused to allow in some UNFPA supply shipments, such as kits for midwives, or had removed supplies like flashlights and solar panels. "It's a nightmare which is much more than a humanitarian crisis," he said. "It is a crisis of humanity... beyond catastrophic."

Fatal Ukrainian strikes rock Russia as vote cements Putin's grip

Ukrainian bombardments killed two people and set an oil facility ablaze in Russia on Saturday, the second day of shovpiece elections guaranteed to cement President Vladimir Putin's headline rule.

Presidential polls opened this week but voting has been marred by an uptick in fatal Ukrainian aerial attacks and a series of incursions into Russian territory by pro-Ukrainian sabotage groups. Fresh bombardments prompted authorities to close schools and shopping centres in the Belgorod region bordering Ukraine, undermining the Kremlin's efforts to isolate Russians from its two-year conflict with Kyiv.

Putin, who cast his vote online, has vowed a harsh response to the assaults and accused Ukraine of trying to "disrupt" his bid for another six-year mandate. The governor of the Belgorod region said air defence systems had downed eight Ukrainian missiles but two residents were killed and others injured. "A man was driving a lorry when a shell hit him, after which the vehicle crashed into a passenger bus. The people on it were not injured," Vyacheslav Gladkov wrote on social media.

Another woman was killed in a parking lot where she and her son came to feed the dogs. Medics are fighting for her son's life," he added. In a separate post, Gladkov announced that schools and shopping centres in the city of Belgorod and some surrounding districts would close temporarily over the coming days, the second time this month.

Russia's defence ministry earlier said it had downed rockets, missiles and drones in the border regions of Belgorod and Kursk that have suffered an uptick in fatal attacks in recent weeks. Ukrainian attacks on Russia have extended well beyond border regions too with Kyiv's forces targeting oil facilities deep inside Russian territory over recent weeks. The governor of the Samara region that lies around 800 kilometres (500 miles) from the front lines said Saturday that Ukrainian drones had targeted two oil refineries, igniting a blaze at one of them.

An defence source in Kyiv told AFP the attack was planned by the SBU security services as part of "a strategy to disrupt the economic potential of Russia".

Inferno destroys prestigious Arab film studio in Cairo

A major fire in Cairo destroyed one of the Arab world's most prestigious and oldest film production houses, founded 80 years ago, an AFP journalist said.

Flames overtook the Al-Ahram Studio in Cairo's Giza district, burning everything inside and spreading to three surrounding buildings which were evacuated before the blaze reached them.

Residents of the neighbouring buildings were still sleeping on the ground in nearby streets at dawn on Saturday, the AFP journalist reported. Deadly fires are a common hazard in Egypt, where fire codes are rarely enforced and emergency services are often slow to arrive.

In this case, security sources said there were no deaths, though some people suffering smoke inhalation were treated at the scene.

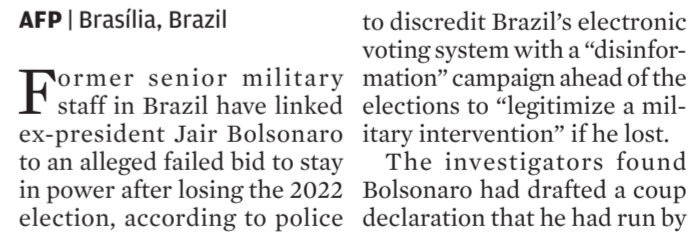
Local media reported that the fire broke out 24 hours after filming finished for a Ramadan television series. The Muslim holy fasting month of Ramadan, which began last Monday, accounts for peak viewership in Egypt and the rest of the Arab world.

The cause of the fire is still unknown, and firefighters needed more than six hours to extinguish it, according to the security sources. Yusif Mohammed, a neighbour who witnessed the fire, told AFP that flames "reached the surrounding buildings before fire trucks arrived".

"No one knows what really happened" to cause it, he said. Al-Ahram Studio was founded in 1944 and built on 27,000 square metres (290,625 square feet) containing three production stages, a screening room and an editing suite. Countless Egyptian films and television series were produced there.

In the 1950s Egypt was the third-biggest film producer in the world. Today, mired in the worst economic crisis of its history, Egypt accounts for three-quarters of the Arab world's cinematic production.

Ex-military staff in Brazil link Bolsonaro to failed coup bid

Former senior military staff in Brazil have linked ex-president Jair Bolsonaro to an alleged failed bid to stay in power after losing the 2022 election, according to police statements released Friday. As part of an operation dubbed "Tempus Veritatis" -- Latin for "Hour of Truth" -- police carried out dozens of search and seizure raids and arrested several Bolsonaro allies who wanted to stop the reelection of leftist Luis Ignacio Lula da Silva. The details were made public Friday by order of federal Supreme Court justice Alexandre de Moraes. Investigators allege months of anti-democratic maneuvers by Bolsonaro, including a plan to discredit Brazil's electronic voting system with a "disinformation" campaign ahead of the elections to "legitimize a military intervention" if he lost. The investigators found Bolsonaro had drafted a coup declaration that he had run by senior military officials at a meeting on December 7, 2022, three weeks before Lula was sworn in. In his statement to police, the then army chief Marco Antonio Freire Gomes acknowledged that he had taken part in a meeting at Bolsonaro's presidential residence in Brasilia, in which an adviser spelled out the legal basis for the planned coup. He told police that he made it clear the army would not take part in reversing the democratic process.

Ramadan Recipe

Chorba

Servings: 6
Time: 90 mins

In Morocco, chorba refers to a soup that hasn't been thickened with flour or cream, giving it a light and wholesome consistency. Traditionally, it's enjoyed during winter and during Ramadan to break the fast. There are many versions of chorba, but this hearty, mostly hands-off version features lamb, chickpeas, potatoes and noodles seasoned with turmeric and saffron for a cozy and aromatic one-pot meal. The lamb adds loads of complex flavour but feel free to use beef instead.



Ingredients

- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- ¾ pound boneless lamb stew meat (preferably shoulder or leg) cut into 1-inch pieces
- 2 medium yellow onions, halved and finely sliced
- 2 teaspoons ground turmeric
- Small pinch of saffron, about 3 threads
- 1 teaspoon fine salt, plus more to

- taste
- ½ teaspoon black pepper, plus more to taste
- 1 (14-ounce) can chickpeas, rinsed and drained
- 2 medium tomatoes, grated on the large holes of a box grater (or ½ 14-ounce can crushed tomatoes)
- 1½ tablespoons tomato paste
- 2 medium russet potatoes (9 ounces each), peeled and diced
- 4 ounces spaghetti, broken into 1-inch pieces
- 3 tablespoons chopped fresh parsley, plus more for garnish

Method:

1. In a large pot, warm the olive oil over medium high. Add the

2. lamb, onions, turmeric, saffron, salt and pepper. Cook, stirring occasionally, until the lamb is lightly browned and the onions are softened, about 7 to 10 minutes.
3. Add 7 ½ cups of water and bring to a boil over high heat. Reduce the heat to medium-low, cover with a lid and leave to simmer gently for about 1 hour or until the lamb starts breaking apart and is almost cooked.
4. Add the chickpeas, grated tomatoes, tomato paste and potatoes and increase the heat to bring to a boil. Reduce the temperature to low, cover with a lid and leave to simmer gently for 8 to

- 10 minutes or until the potatoes are almost cooked and start to soften.
5. Add the broken spaghetti pieces and parsley and increase the heat to medium-low. Simmer uncovered until the spaghetti and potatoes are cooked, stirring occasionally to prevent sticking, adjusting the cook time according to the package instructions. Don't hesitate to add a ladle of water in case too much evaporates during the cooking process in order to obtain the desired soup consistency.
6. Season to taste with salt and pepper and serve immediately with more parsley on top.

'Extraordinary' Vinicius strikes twice as leaders Madrid thrash Osasuna

Vinicius Junior inspires Real Madrid to dominant 4-2 victory over Osasuna

Vinicius Junior struck twice to earn Real Madrid a commanding 10 point lead at the top of La Liga in a 4-2 rout of Osasuna yesterday.

The Brazilian forward mesmerised for Los Blancos and reached 18 goals across all competitions this season, while Dani Carvajal and Brahim Diaz also found the net in an entertaining romp for Carlo Ancelotti's side.

Madrid were without top goalscorer Jude Bellingham, completing a two-match suspension but, with Vinicius in full flow, barely missed the England international at El Sadar in Pamplona.

"I congratulated him, he had an extraordinary game, he made good decisions, he moved very well without the ball, that's where's he's improved the most," Ancelotti told reporters.

"With the ball he's always efficient and without it he's spectacular at the moment, he's so fast."

Vinicius' name made headlines this week after Real Madrid filed a legal complaint over alleged racist insults

aimed at the Brazilian by Atletico Madrid and Barcelona fans, but on the pitch the forward's quality continues to speak for itself.

The 23-year-old dispossessed Alejandro Catena, who was dawdling on it, ran through and calmly rolled the ball past Sergio Herrera to break the deadlock after four minutes.

Osasuna were quickly back level through Ante Budimir, who finished from close range after Jorge Herrando nodded a corner back into his path.

Vinicius should have restored Madrid's lead moments later after being sent in on goal again by Antonio Rudiger, but this time Herrera denied him,

keeping his balance well as the forward tried to throw him off with step-overs.

Madrid captain Carvajal put his side in front again in the 18th minute, finishing sublimely with the outside of his boot after Fede Valverde cleverly hooked the ball into his path in the box.

Madrid goalkeeper Andriy Lunin made a good save at full stretch to push away a fierce Jose Arnaiz effort from the edge of the box.
