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fter a day of recess, Bah-Arain's Everest team is back again and is on with taxing practice session in preparation for their final ascent.

The 16-member expedition team said they are practising some of the most dangerous climbs and crossings using lad-

"The team practised some of the most dangerous parts of the climb today, ladder crossing the crevasses which sometimes are 2,3 or 4 ladders tied together across the bottomless crevasses. It makes it harder wearing crampons and carrying all your equipment," the team wrote on social media.

Pictures posted showed team members, kitted fully, practising the ladder crossing, which is one of the most important for mountaineering in a snow
