

Taliban pledge to step up security

Taliban authorities pledged to step up security at mosques as hundreds of people gathered yesterday to bury the victims of the second Islamic State suicide attack on worshippers in a week.

Islamic State claimed responsibility for the attack on the Fatima mosque in Kandahar that saw a group of suicide bombers shoot their way into the mosque before blowing themselves up among the worshippers during Friday prayers.

A health official said the casualty toll from the attack stood at 41 dead and 70 wounded but could rise further. "Some of the wounded are in a critical condition and we are trying to transfer them to Kabul," he said.

On Saturday, large crowds gathered to bury the white-shrouded victims in a mass grave in the southern city of Kandahar.

The head of Kandahar police said units would be assigned to protect the mosques which have so far been guarded by local volunteer forces with special permission to carry weapons.

A digital step to cashless future

The Central Bank of Bahrain introduces Bahrain Electronic Cheque System

● e-Cheques will come into force on Tuesday

Bahrain's transformation to a cashless society received a major impetus yesterday from the Central Bank of Bahrain in the form of electronic cheques or e-Cheque



services. The top bank introduced its e-Cheque service - an electronic counterpart of a paper cheque-making cheque writing and deposit processes online.

The move represents a breakthrough towards the transformation of Bahrain into a cashless society.

e-Cheque will come into force starting this Tuesday.

People could use it for making a payment for any transaction that a paper cheque can cover. Also, understand that the same laws that apply to paper cheques also protects e-Cheques.

Most importantly, the cost associated with issuing an electronic cheque is notably lower than those associated with paper cheques.

Experts point out that a tradi-

tional cheque may cost as much as \$1 to issue, while an electronic check costs \$0.10. Further, there are multiple levels of authentication to help ensure the proper routing of funds.

"This milestone achievement reflects the ongoing commitment of the CBB in providing the latest technologies in the industry and encourages the progression towards a cashless society that has access to all electronic payment solutions available," said Hesa Abdulla Al Sada, Executive Director of Banking Operations at CBB.

e-Cheque users, CBB statement said, will enjoy "special benefits" of paperless payment experience in their day-to-day business in addition to retaining all the functions and legalities of traditional cheques.

US offers payments, relocation to family of Afghans killed in botched drone attack

The Pentagon has offered unspecified condolence payments to the family of 10 civilians who were killed in a botched US drone attack in Afghanistan in August during the final days before American troops withdrew from the country.

The US Defence Department said it made a commitment that included offering "ex-gratia condolence payments", in addition to working with the US State Department in support of the family members who were interested in relocation to the United States.

The drone strike in Kabul killed as many as 10 civilians, including seven children. The Pentagon had said earlier that the Aug. 29 strike targeted an Islamic State suicide bomber who posed an imminent threat to US-led troops at the airport as they completed the last stages of their withdrawal from Afghanistan.

However, reports had emerged almost immediately that the drone strike in a neighbourhood west of Kabul's Hamid Karzai International Airport had killed civilians including children. Video from the scene showed the wreckage of a car strewn around the courtyard of a building.

Darwin family microscope to be sold at auction

A microscope Charles Darwin gave his son Leonard and which has remained in the family for nearly 200 years is headed for auction in December, and is expected to fetch up to \$480,000.

The instrument was designed by Charles Gould for the firm



Cary around 1825 and is one of six surviving microscopes associated with the British naturalist, according to auction house Christie's. The date of its manufacture coincides with the time when Darwin was studying zoophytes, organisms such as coral and sea anemone.

"It is just incredibly spine tin-

gling to look through this and see the microscopic world that Darwin would have seen in the 1820s and 30s," James Hyslop, Head of Department, Scientific Instruments, Globes & Natural History, at Christie's, said.

"Later in his life in 1858, there's a wonderful letter that he writes to his eldest son saying

young Lenny was dissecting at his microscope and he said 'Oh Papa, I should be so glad of this for my whole life'. It's wonderful to have that family connexion of Charles Darwin just before he becomes internationally famous." Darwin published his ground-breaking work "On the Origin of Species" in 1859.

When did the first cheque came?

The first cheques started cropping up in the United States toward the end of the 17th century, and the first printed versions were introduced in 1762 by British banker Lawrence Childs. Before that, cheques were simply written out by hand, sort of like IOUs.

How does an electronic cheque work?

With an eCheck, the money is electronically withdrawn from the payer's account, sent to the payee's banking institution, and then electronically deposited into the payee's account. This is all done similar to paper check processing, just electronically.

editing, signing and depositing. All these are done electronically without the customer having to visit the bank.

Individuals can register electronically for e-Cheque through the BenefitPay application. As for companies, they can register through retail banks to obtain a

dedicated (e-Cheque) application to avail of online e-Cheque service.

Electronic cheque application allows companies to have multiple persons authorised to sign checks online while applying any limits on each authorised signatory.

Road capacity of 47th Street increased 350%

Capacity enhancement works of Road 47 in Arad had zoomed its capacity by 350% during peak hours.

The original capacity of the road was 12,400 vehicles per day.

The upgrading works in both directions now allow it to accommodate three times the peak time capacity or 3,100 vehicles per hour.

Before the development, the traffic volume in both directions



was 1,100 vehicles per hour. The BD5,685,000 first phase development of Street 47, located

This phase included expanding the street to three lanes in each direction to a 2 km distance from its intersection with Hatem Al Tai street in the east to Street 28 in the west.

A new intersection on Street 47 with Road 449 created will open after completing technical procedures and other works.

Bahraini sportswomen need to be encouraged

Now that the weather is getting noticeably cooler, we are seeing more and more people out walking in the walking paths that have been thoughtfully incorporated into our urban spaces by planners. The months of October to March are decidedly better to incorporate new exercise resolutions since the hot summer is waning at this time.

While I am happy to see people of all ages exercise, it is particularly good to note that women are now taking their health seriously. Once a taboo topic, outdoor exercise and organised physical activity classes for women have become quite accepted for women in Bahrain.

Indeed, the Kingdom has a history of getting involved in women's athletic activities and has regularly fielded women's teams in local, regional and international competitions, performing to varying degrees of success.

The women's national football team, formed in 2003, was the first national women's football squad in the Gulf region and in 2004, Bahrain participated in a football tournament in Amman and in 2005 took part in the West Asian Championship, also in the Jordanian capital. In field track, Bahrain produced champion Ruqayya Al Ghasra who became in 2004 the first athlete to take part in an Olympics wearing a hijab.

law in the private sector.

They also discussed the results of the second edition of the National Employment Programme and the efforts exerted by the ministry to provide decent job opportunities to the citizens, incentives for employers that include wage support, training and rehabilitation programmes. Discussions also focused on the roles played by the Labour Ministry LMRA for combating trafficking in persons.

Regarding social protection, Humaidan said the ministry is keen to support vulnerable segments and launch new initiatives for implementing the Restorative Justice Law for Children.

The meeting highlighted the key projects and initiatives launched by LMRA to protect workers' rights, including the Wage Protection System launched in May 2021. The system enables the Labour Market Regulatory Authority to know the extent of the commitment of private sector enterprises to paying wages as agreed and on time.

LMRA officials said the system would contribute to reducing wage-related labour issues and speeding up their settlement.

"For Cyprus, this electricity interconnection with Egypt, one of our valued strategic allies in the region, has the potential to constitute a cornerstone of our efforts to transition to a green economy," Natasa Pilides, Cyprus's energy minister, said at a signing ceremony with her Egyptian counterpart, Mohamed Shaker.

Earlier in the week, Greece and Egypt signed a similar agreement, which sets the stage for an under-sea cable that will transmit power produced by renewables from North Africa to Europe, the first such infrastructure in the Mediterranean.

Square CEO Dorsey says looking to build a bitcoin mining system - tweet

Square Inc Chief Executive Officer Jack Dorsey said on Friday the fintech firm is looking to build a bitcoin mining system based on custom silicon and open source for individuals as well as businesses.

This would add to Square's existing bitcoin-focused projects including a business to build an open developer platform, as well as a hardware wallet for the cryptocurrency.

"If we do this, we'd follow our hardware wallet model: build in the open in collaboration with the community," Dorsey said in a tweet.

A team led by Square's hardware lead, Jesse Dorogusker, will investigate requisites for Square to take on the project to build a bitcoin mining system.

In his Twitter thread, Dorsey also said that silicon design or chip design is too concentrated into a few companies, leading to supply constraints.

Shares of Square were up about 1% in extended trading.

Australian police seize record \$104 mln heroin shipment



Australian police said on Saturday they seized the largest heroin shipment ever detected in the country, worth an estimated A\$140 million (\$104 million), and arrested a Malaysian national over the importation of the illicit drug. The 450-kg (990-pound) shipment - as heavy as a grand piano - was detected in a sea freight container of ceramic tiles sent from Malaysia and addressed to a Melbourne business, the police said in a statement.

A former governor of Iran's Central Bank, Valiollah Seif, was sentenced on Saturday to 10 years in prison on corruption charges involving the mismanagement of millions of dollars, the judiciary said. Seif and two of his deputies, who also received jail terms, were found guilty of "disturbing the foreign exchange market, the country's economic climate and mismanagement," a judiciary spokesman was quoted as saying by state media.

Earthquake of magnitude 4.8 strikes Bali, kills three



An earthquake of magnitude 4.8 struck Indonesia's Bali island on Saturday morning, killing at least three people, Indonesia's search and rescue agency said. The quake affected the Karangasem and Bangli districts on the eastern side of the tourist island and a search has been concluded, the agency said in a statement, but authorities were continuing to monitor situation. A landslide triggered by the quake killed two of the victims, the agency said. A third, a three-year old girl, was killed by falling debris.

The Taliban will announce a framework that allows girls to attend school in Afghanistan 'soon,' a senior United Nations official said, after four weeks in which Afghan boys have been allowed a secondary education but girls have not.

UN says Taliban to announce plans for girls' education 'soon'



"The de facto minister of education told us that they are working on a framework, which they will announce soon, that will allow all girls to go to secondary school, and we are expecting that to happen very soon," UNICEF deputy executive director Omar Abdi said at the United Nations in New York.

Canadian Arctic city confirms 'exceedingly high levels' of fuel in water supply



The Canadian city of Iqaluit in the country's northern territory said lab results confirmed that fuel had entered its water supply, officials announced on Friday. Analysis of samples from one of the city's water tanks found "exceedingly high levels of various fuel components," Amy Elgersma, Iqaluit's chief administrative officer, said, adding it was likely diesel or kerosene. Residents in Iqaluit, the capital of Canada's northernmost territory Nunavut, which borders Greenland, reported fuel odors in the water over the weekend, but the source was not clear.

NASA's asteroid hunter Lucy soars into sky with diamonds

NASA launches first space probe to study Jupiter's Trojan asteroids

Spacecraft with name inspired by a skeleton and the Beatles, and with lab-grown gems, starts 12-year quest

A NASA spacecraft named Lucy rocketed into the sky with diamonds Saturday morning on a 12-year quest to explore eight asteroids.

Seven of the mysterious space rocks are among swarms of asteroids sharing Jupiter's orbit, thought to be the pristine leftovers of planetary formation.

An Atlas V rocket blasted off before dawn, sending Lucy on a roundabout journey spanning nearly 4 billion miles (6.3 billion kilometers). Researchers grew emotional describing the successful launch — lead scientist Hal Levison said it was like witnessing the birth of a child. "Go Lucy!" he urged.

Lucy is named after the 3.2 million-year-old skeletal remains of a human ancestor found in Ethiopia nearly a half-century ago. That discovery

got its name from the 1967 Beatles song "Lucy in the Sky with Diamonds," prompting NASA to send the spacecraft soaring with band members' lyrics and other luminaries' words of wisdom imprinted on a plaque. The spacecraft also carried a disc made of lab-grown diamonds for one of its science instruments.

In a prerecorded video for NASA, Beatles drummer Ringo Starr paid tribute to his late colleague John Lennon, credited for writing the song that

inspired all this. "I'm so excited — Lucy is going back in the sky with diamonds. Johnny will love that," Starr said. "Anyway, if you meet anyone up there, Lucy, give them peace and love from me."

The paleoanthropologist behind the fossil Lucy discovery, Donald Johanson, had goose bumps watching Lucy soar — "I will never look at Jupiter the same ... absolutely mind-expanding." He said he was filled with wonder about this "intersection of our past, our present

and our future."

"That a human ancestor who lived so long ago stimulated a mission which promises to add valuable information about the formation of our solar system is incredibly exciting," said Johanson, of Arizona State University, who travelled to Cape Canaveral for his first rocket launch.

Lucy's \$981 million mission is the first to aim for Jupiter's so-called Trojan entourage: thousands — if not millions — of asteroids that share the gas giant's expansive orbit around the sun. Some of the Trojan asteroids precede Jupiter in its orbit, while others trail it.

New crew docks at China's first permanent space station

Chinese astronauts began Saturday their six-month mission on China's first permanent space station, after successfully docking aboard their spacecraft.

The astronauts, two men and a woman, were seen floating around the module before speaking via a live-streamed video.

The new crew includes Wang Yaping, 41, who is the first Chinese woman to board the Tian-gong space station, and is expected to become China's first female spacewalker.

"We'll co-operate with each other, carefully conduct maneuvers, and try to accomplish all tasks successfully in this round of exploration of the universe," said Wang in the video.

The space travelers' Shenzhou-13 spacecraft was launched by a Long March-2F rocket at 12:23 a.m. Saturday and docked with the Tianhe core module of the space station at 6:56 a.m.

The three astronauts entered the station's core module at about 10 a.m., the China

Manned Space Agency said.

They are the second crew to move into China's Tian-gong space station, which was launched last April. The first crew stayed three months.

The new crew includes two veterans of space travel — Zhai Zhigang, 55, and Wang. The third member, Ye Guangfu, 41, is making his first trip to space.

The mission's launch was seen off by a military band and supporters singing "Ode to the Motherland," underscoring national pride in the space program, which has advanced rapidly in recent years.

The crew will do three spacewalks to install equipment in preparation for expanding the station, assess living conditions in the Tianhe module, and conduct experiments in space medicine and other fields.

ASEAN excludes Myanmar junta leader from summit in rare move

Southeast Asian countries will invite a non-political representative from Myanmar to a regional summit this month, delivering an unprecedented snub to the military leader who led a coup against an elected civilian government in February.

The decision taken by foreign ministers from the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) at an emergency meeting on Friday night, marks a rare bold step for the consensus-driven bloc, which has traditionally favoured a policy of engagement and non-interference.

Singapore's foreign ministry said on Saturday the move to exclude junta chief Min Aung Hlaing was a "difficult, but necessary, decision to uphold ASEAN's credibility".

The statement cited a lack of progress made on a roadmap to restore peace in Myanmar that the junta had agreed to with ASEAN in April.

US Capitol Police officer charged with telling rioter to destroy evidence



Azarenka books spot in Indian Wells final against Badosa

Victoria Azarenka, who is hoping to become the first three-time WTA winner in Indian Wells, punched her ticket to Sunday's final by rallying to beat former French Open champion Jelena Ostapenko 3-6, 6-3, 7-5 on Friday.

Two-time Australian Open winner Azarenka continued her solid play in the California desert as she goes for her first title of 2021 and 22nd of her career.

The 32-year-old arrived in the semi-finals without dropping a set and after losing the first one to Ostapenko on Friday night she settled in and found her form.

Azarenka will face Spaniard Paula Badosa, who defeated Ons Jabeur in straight sets 6-3, 6-3.

Azarenka is seeking to win the tournament for the third time after victories in 2012 and 2016.

She is the only former champion left in either the women's or men's field, and with another victory can separate herself from the list of women who have won the trophy twice -- which includes Martina Navratilova, Serena Williams and Maria Sharapova.

Azarenka clinched victory on her first match point when Ostapenko slammed a forehand into the net.

This was the second career meeting between the two but the first on hardcourt, so it took Azarenka time to feel her opponent out and figure out

That started a run of five straight games to take a 5-2 lead. Ostapenko held serve once more but Azarenka served out the set to level the match.

Azarenka raised her level another notch in a hard-fought third set, winning the final three games to get to the final where she will face Badosa for the first time.
