



'Fraudster' brothers face trial TDT | Manama Ali Tarif

T wo brothers face trial for illegally collecting over BD one million dinars under the pretext of investing in forex trading.

The First Major Criminal Court has decided to adjourn the case of Bahraini brothers aged 43 and 39, who are accused of deceiving nearly 38 from Bahrain and other Gulf countries.

According to prosecutors, the brothers took money from their victims without obtaining a proper licence from the Central Bank of Bahrain (CBB).

Many approached the brothers after seeing an advertisement on social media and other online networks, the prosecutors added.
