Shura Council debate

Focus on advertising bill and child digital safety law

Advertising on public buildings, child safety online and the Future Generations Reserve Account are all on the Shura Council's agenda for its Sunday sitting.

Members will first consider

the Public Utilities and Environment Committee's report on a draft amendment to Article 12 of Decree-Law No. 14 of 1973 on the regulation of advertisements, attached to Decree No. 27 of 2025.

The amendment would give government bodies a legal basis to use vacant areas in public



buildings, or parts of buildings assigned to public services, as advertising space.

The terms, conditions and controls for this use would be issued by ministerial decision.

According to the committee, the proposal completes earlier work to reorganise the advertising sector in Bahrain.

The draft widens the scope for using public buildings for advertising purposes, and allows parts of service buildings to be used in this way, subject to rules issued by the minister.

The committee noted that the measure is expected to increase municipal income through advertising licence fees.

Protecting dignity

Vote set on housing expansion for divorced, single women

Parliament will vote on Tuesday on a request to raise the number of 'Masaken' flats reserved for women classed under category five in Bahrain's housing rules: divorced, abandoned, widowed and unmarried applicants.

The proposal was submitted by MPs Basema Mubarak, Dr Hisham Al Asheeri, Mamdouh Al Saleh, Ali Saqer Al Dosari and Jaleela Alawi.

It refers to Article 4 of Ministerial Decision No. 909 of 2015 on the housing system, which lists the category and the basis for eligibility.

Request

Supporters of the request say many applicants in this group face difficulty securing suitable housing because the number of flats allocated to them is limited.

The papers say the problem is sharper where family support is no longer available.

The Public Utilities and Environment Committee has recommended approval, with all members present backing the request on public-interest grounds.

Response

In its response, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Planning said the aim is already being met through projects delivered with the Supreme Council for Women.

It cited the first 'Masaken' building in Al Lawzi, which it said contains 68 flats, and said a second project, 'Masaken 2', is under construction in Al Hidd Housing City with 49 flats and is expected to be completed by the end of this year.

The Bahrain Women's Union supported the request, saying access to suitable housing for divorced, abandoned, widowed and unmarried women helps protect their dignity and sup-

ports social and psychological stability for them and their families.

The explanatory note attached to the proposal cites constitutional provisions on protecting the family and the state's duty to provide housing for low-income citizens.

It says the housing decision already grants category five applicants the right to housing, but argues that the limited number of flats reserved for the group remains an obstacle and calls for an increase to meet demand.

MPs propose intermediate school apprenticeships

Parliament will debate on Tuesday a proposal to bring apprenticeships into intermediate schools across public and private education, expanding a scheme that is currently limited to secondary students.

The proposal was submitted by MPs Dr Muneer Seroor, Mohammed Salman Al Ahmed and Lulwa Al Rumaihi.

It calls for an apprenticeship track at the intermediate stage to give pupils practical workplace experience alongside classroom study, with supporters saying this would help students form clearer career choices and ease the move into jobs later on.

The Services Committee has recommended backing the proposal, with all members present

agreeing to approve it.

Theory

Dr Seroor said apprenticeships link theory to practice and help students gain hands-on know-how earlier.

He said many intermediate students need guidance to shape their interests and future work paths, and argued that steering students based on their skills at a younger age can improve their chances of securing jobs.

He added that apprenticeships can build experience and self-confidence, while also supporting the economy through work-based training.

In its written reply to the committee, the Ministry of Education said it aims to equip students with the academic and knowledge skills linked to the job market, including those in intermediate schools, which it described as a key stage leading

into secondary education.

Experience

The ministry said it had kept the apprenticeship initiative at secondary level based on studies and the experience of countries that use similar systems, on the view that secondary school is more closely linked to work and that students at that age have greater readiness for field training after completing core courses and gaining basic skills.

It added that some private schools already offer programmes through which students can earn a vocational qualification alongside the general secondary certificate, depending on the system used and the choice made by the student and their parent or guardian.

Taxi driver robbed of BD220 in roadside attack

A taxi driver was attacked and robbed of BD220 and two mobile phones after a man stopped him on the road, forced his way into the vehicle and struck him with a stone, the High Criminal Court has heard.

Prosecutors say the driver was working when the accused approached, knocked on the window and, once it was opened, climbed into the car by force.

He is accused of taking two

phones and the driver's wallet, which contained BD220, before running off.

Wound

Court papers say the driver chased him but was hit on the head with a stone, suffering a wound that needed stitches. He also sustained swelling and redness to his right ring finger.

The driver later recovered one of the phones and his wallet, but the cash had been taken and the second phone was not returned, prosecutors said.

During questioning by the

Public Prosecution, the defendant admitted assaulting the driver, according to the case file.

Video clips included in the papers are said to show the accused stopping the driver, opening the car door, taking a phone and beating him, with the victim's face covered in blood.

The prosecution has charged the man with theft by force, saying he used his hand and a stone to overpower the driver, seize the items and flee.

Judgment has been set for 24 February.

Man on trial over BD2,490 banking-app 'theft' from friend

A man accused of using a friend's phone line and a banking app to move BD2,490 while the account holder was

abroad will learn his fate on 24 February, the High Criminal Court was told.

Prosecutors say the complainant, a company owner, gave the defendant a limited power of attorney because he

was outside Bahrain.

The authorisation, they say, covered only some company matters and allowed the opening of bank accounts, but gave no right to use or move any money.

Court orders BD80,000 repayment in debt dispute

A court has ordered a defendant to pay BD80,000 after accepting a written debt acknowledgement challenged by the defence, and awarded BD1,000 in lawyers' fees along with court costs.

The claim was brought by a man who said the defendant had borrowed BD80,000 under a dated private document and then failed to repay the sum when it fell due.

His lawyer, Dr Mohammed Al Kowheji, told the court his client had suffered loss as a result and sought judgment for the full amount, with interest from the



due date until payment.

The defendant's lawyer denied the debt in full and said his client had never dealt with, or even met, the claimant.

Document

He also alleged the document

relied upon had been forged, arguing it was signed on a blank sheet and later completed.

The claimant's lawyer rejected the allegation of forgery and maintained the document was genuine, asking the court to uphold the claim.

Judges heard witnesses from both sides and ordered a specialist to examine the document.

Acknowledgement

The expert was asked to assess if the body of the acknowledgement had been written at a later time than the defendant's signature and stamp.

The report said the main text had been drafted in a later writing context.

After the report was filed, the claimant's lawyer submitted further written pleadings and attached messages which, he said, showed the defendant's representative had prepared the acknowledgement and its details.

Court clears man in BD800 bank cash dispute due to insufficient evidence

A man in his forties has been cleared of taking an extra BD800 from a bank payout after

a court found the evidence did not show he received more cash than he was due.

The Minor Criminal Court said the material before it, including CCTV and the cash-counting ma-

chine, did not prove the man left the counter with more than BD7,200, and that the inquiry did not reach the level needed for a conviction.

The case centred on a cheque

for BD8,000.

The defence said the man, described in court as the son of a company owner, deposited BD800 into his account and took BD7,200 in cash, which his law-

yer said matched the usual way the transaction is handled.

His lawyer, Entisar Al Asfour, told the court her client visits the bank each month to cash the wages cheque for company staff.

She said he did not count the money at the time because the bank counts cash using its machine, and he left believing the amount was correct.

OpenAI introducing advertisements to ChatGPT

OpenAI announced Friday it will begin testing advertisements on ChatGPT in the coming weeks, as the wildly popular artificial intelligence chatbot seeks to increase revenue to cover its soaring costs.

The ads will initially appear in the United States for free and

lower-tier subscribers, the company said in a blog post outlining its long-anticipated move. Premium Pro and Enterprise subscribers will remain ad-free.

The integration of advertising has been a key question for generative AI chatbots, with companies largely reluctant to interrupt the user experience with ads.

But the exorbitant costs of running AI services may have forced OpenAI's hand.

Only a small percentage of its nearly one billion users pay for subscription services, putting pressure on the company to find new revenue sources.

Since ChatGPT's launch in 2022, OpenAI's valuation has soared to \$500 billion in fund-

ing rounds -- higher than any other private company. Some expect it could go public with a trillion-dollar valuation.

But the ChatGPT maker burns through cash at a furious rate, mostly on the powerful computing required to deliver its services.

With its move, OpenAI brings its business model closer to tech

giants Google and Meta, which have built advertising empires on the back of their free-to-use services.

Unlike OpenAI, those companies have massive advertising revenue to fund AI innovation -- with Amazon also building a solid ad business on its shopping and video streaming platforms.

"Ads aren't a distraction from

the gen AI race; they're how OpenAI stays in it," said Jeremy Goldman, an analyst at Emarketer.

"If ChatGPT turns on ads, OpenAI is admitting something simple and consequential: the race isn't just about model quality anymore; it's about monetizing attention without poisoning trust," he added.

◆ Indonesian authorities

are searching for a small passenger plane after contact was lost on Saturday with the aircraft carrying 11 people, rescue officials told AFP. The Indonesia Air Transport turboprop plane left from Yogyakarta and was headed for the city of Makassar on Sulawesi island, with three passengers and eight crew members on board, according to the Makassar search and rescue agency. Contact was lost shortly after 1:00 pm (0600 GMT). Muhammad Arif Anwar, the head of the local search and rescue agency, said teams were deployed to a mountainous area of Maros Regency, which borders Makassar, near the last known location of the plane. The search on land and by air involved the air force, police and volunteers, he added. Andi Sultan, operations chief at the Makassar search and rescue agency, said a helicopter and drones were being used to find the plane.

◆ Egyptian president thanks Trump for offer to mediate on Ethiopia dam

Egyptian President Abdel Fattah al-Sisi thanked his US counterpart Donald Trump on Saturday for offering to serve as a mediator with Ethiopia over sharing water from a Nile mega-dam at the centre of more than a decade of tensions. Trump had said on Friday that he was "ready to restart US mediation" to resolve the question of water sharing along the Nile, upon which Egypt relies for 97 percent of its water needs. Sisi said he welcomed "Trump's attention to the central importance of the Nile River issue for Egypt, as it represents the lifeline of the Egyptian people" in a post on X. He added that he had a desire to cooperate with other countries along the river "without harming any party". Inaugurated in September, the Grand Ethiopian Renaissance Dam (GERD) is the largest in Africa, at 1.8 kilometres (1.1 miles) long and 145 metres (475 feet) tall.

◆ US President Donald Trump has invited Turkish counterpart Recep Tayyip Erdogan to join the so-called Board of Peace that will oversee post-war Gaza, Turkey said Saturday. Erdogan received the proposal in a letter sent Friday by Trump inviting him to "become a founding member" of the board, Turkish presidential communications director Burhanettin Duran posted on social media.

Former UK leader Blair back in limelight with Gaza role

Former British prime minister Tony Blair, whose legacy was heavily tarnished by the 2003 war in Iraq, has long been a contentious figure in the Middle East.

The 72-year-old political veteran was Friday named by US President Donald Trump as a member of a fledgling "Board of Peace" to help oversee Gaza.

He said Saturday he was "honoured" to have been tapped by Trump to join the board, adding he looked forward to working with "other colleagues in line with the president's vision to promote peace and prosperity".

He also welcomed as "a massive step forward" a Palestinian committee headed by former Palestinian Authority deputy minister Ali Shaath, which began work in Cairo on Friday to govern post-war Gaza. "It gives hope to people in Gaza that they can have a

future different from the past and to the Israelis that they may have a neighbour which does not threaten its security," Blair said in a statement.

Blair has been credited in some media reports with helping craft the US leader's 20-point Gaza plan alongside Trump's son-in-law and adviser Jared Kushner.

Blair has plenty of experience in the region, spending eight years as the envoy for the Middle East Quartet of the European Union, United Nations, United States and Russia.

But social media users were quick to point to his role in backing false evidence of Iraqi chemical weapons to justify the 2003 invasion.

Trump has already declared himself the chair of the board and on Friday announced its full membership will include Blair as well as Kushner, Secretary of State Marco Rubio and Steve Witkoff, Trump's business partner turned globe-trotting negotiator.

Iranian authorities have blamed the United States for fuelling a "terrorist operation" that they say hijacked peaceful protests over the economy.

Trump, who backed and joined Israel's 12-day war against Iran in June, had repeatedly threatened new military action against Tehran if protesters were killed.

'American conspiracy'

Khamenei on Saturday lashed out at Trump, accusing him of being "guilty for the casualties, damages and accusations he has levelled against the Iranian nation".

"This was an American conspiracy," he said, adding that "America's goal is to swallow Iran... the goal is to put Iran back under military, political and economic domination".

While Washington has appeared to have stepped back, Trump has said he has not ruled out military options and made clear he was keeping a close eye on whether any protesters were executed.

Alarm has mounted over the reported death toll during the crackdown, as verifying cases remains difficult under severe internet restrictions.

Monitor Netblocks said on Saturday that internet connectivity in Iran rose "very" slightly, more than 200 hours into the nationwide internet shutdown.

Norway-based rights group Iran Human Rights (IHR) says 3,428 protesters have been verified to have been killed by security forces, but warns the actual toll could be several times higher.

Other estimates place the death toll at more than 5,000 -- and possibly as high as 20,000, IHR said.

Iran's supreme leader yesterday said authorities "must break the back of the seditionists", blaming US President Donald Trump for "casualties" after a deadly crackdown on protests against the country's clerical leadership.

Iran was rocked by weeks of demonstrations sparked by anger over economic hardship that exploded into the biggest protests against the Islamic republic in more than three years.

But demonstrations have subsided after the crackdown that rights groups say left thousands dead under an internet blackout that lasted more than a week.

Authorities have said demonstrations they condemn as "riots" are under control, with state-aligned media reporting thousands of arrests and officials vowing swift punishment for those detained.

"By God's grace, the Iranian nation must break the back of the seditionists just as it broke the back of the sedition," Khamenei told supporters during an address marking a religious holiday com-

Trump invites more leaders to join Gaza 'Board of Peace'

US President Donald Trump's so-called "Board of Peace" for postwar Gaza began to take shape yesterday, with the leaders of Egypt, Turkey, Argentina and Canada asked to join.

The announcements from those leaders came after the US president named his Secretary of State Marco Rubio, former British prime minister Tony Blair, and senior negotiators Jared Kushner and Steve Witkoff to the panel.

Trump had already declared himself the chair of the body, as he promotes a controversial vision of economic development in the Palestinian territory, which lies in rubble after two-plus years of relentless Israeli bombardment.

The moves came after a Palestinian committee of technocrats meant to govern Gaza held its first meeting in Cairo which was

attended by Kushner, Trump's son-in-law who has partnered with Witkoff for months on the issue.

In Canada, a senior aide to Prime Minister Mark Carney said he intended to accept Trump's invitation, while in Turkey, a spokesman for President Recep Tayyip Erdogan said he had been asked to become a "founding member" of the board.

Egypt's Foreign Minister Badr Abdelatty said Cairo was "studying" a request for President Abdel Fattah al-Sisi to join.

Sharing an image of the invitation letter, Argentine President Javier Milei wrote on X that it would be "an honor" to participate in the initiative.

In a statement sent to AFP, Blair said: "I thank President Trump for his leadership in establishing the Board of Peace and am honored to be appointed to its Executive Board."

The medal is not the prize

The Nobel Peace Prize is inseparable from the person who won it, the Nobel Committee said Friday, a day after this year's winner gave her medal to US President Donald Trump.

Venezuelan opposition leader Maria Corina Machado said she had "presented" her Nobel medal to Trump, in a bid to win over the US president who had sidelined her since ousting Nicolas Maduro.

But the Nobel Committee's statement from Oslo said: "Regardless of what may happen to the medal, the diploma, or the prize money, it is and remains the original laureate who is recorded in history as the recipient of the prize."

"Even if the medal or diploma later comes into someone else's possession, this does not alter

who was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize," it added.

The committee said it would make no comment "on Peace Prize laureates or the political processes that they are engaged in".

There were no restrictions on what laureates did with the medal, diploma and money they received as part of the prize, it added.

It listed several instances in which laureates had sold or given away their medals.

Machado won hers for "for her tireless work promoting democratic rights for the people of Venezuela and for her struggle to achieve a just and peaceful transition from dictatorship to democracy", according to the award citation.

Trump had campaigned hard to win last year's Nobel Peace Prize for what he says are his efforts to stop eight wars.





UN chief Guterres warns 'powerful forces' undermining global ties

Guterres' term as secretary-general ends on December 31 this year

UN chief Antonio Guterres yesterday deplored a host of "powerful forces lining up to undermine global cooperation" in a London speech marking the 80th anniversary of the first UN General Assembly.

Guterres, whose term as secretary-general ends on December 31 this year, delivered the warning at the Methodist Central Hall in London, where representatives from 51 countries met on January 10, 1946, for the General Assembly's first session.

They met in London because the UN headquarters in New York had not yet been built.

Guterres paid tribute to Britain for its decisive role in the creation of the United Nations and for continuing to champion it.

But he said 2025 had been a "profoundly challenging year for international cooperation and the values of the UN".

"We see powerful forces lining up to undermine global cooperation," he said, adding: "Despite these rough seas, we sail ahead."

Guterres cited a new treaty on marine biological diversity as an example of continued progress.

The treaty establishes the first legal framework for the conservation and sustainable use of marine diversity in the two-thirds of oceans beyond national limits.

"These quiet victories of international cooperation -- the wars prevented, the famine averted, the vital treaties secured -- do not always make the headlines," he said.

"Yet they are real. And they matter."

India slaps \$2.45 mn fine on IndiGo for mass flight cancellations

India's civil aviation regulator yesterday imposed a fine of \$2.45 million on IndiGo, the country's biggest airline, for poor roster planning that led to large-scale flight cancellations in December.

Airports across India were thrown into disarray late last year, with the private carrier admitting "misjudgement and planning gaps" in adapting to a new policy of pilot rest.

Over 4,000 mostly domestic flights were either cancelled or delayed for over a week across the country, stranding hundreds of thousands of passengers.

The operational meltdown came even though IndiGo had two years to prepare for the new rules aimed at giving pilots more rest periods

in between flights to enhance passenger safety.

The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) said it was levying the penalty for several lapses, including "failure to strike (a) balance between commercial imperatives and crew members' ability to work effectively".

The regulator ordered IndiGo to relieve its senior vice president of its operations control centre of his responsibilities, according to a statement released Saturday.

It also issued warnings to senior officials at the company, including CEO Pieter Elbers "for inadequate overall oversight of flight operations and crisis management".

There was no immediate response from IndiGo to the fine.




KMCC Bahrain hosts 2nd International Chess Tournament



Real Madrid overcome Bernabeu boos to record Arbeloa's first win

Angry Real Madrid fans jeered their own team before they went on to beat Levante 2-0 in La Liga on Saturday to record new coach Alvaro Arbeloa's first win at the helm.

Arbeloa's debut after replacing Xabi Alonso ended in a humiliating Copa del Rey defeat in midweek at second-tier Albacete, but second-half goals from Kylian Mbappe and Raul Asencio secured three vital points at the Santiago Bernabeu.

Madrid cut the gap on leaders Barcelona to one point before the in-form Spanish champions visit Real Sociedad on Sunday.

Star players Vinicius Junior and Jude Bellingham came in for ire from the home fans after a disastrous week. Mbappe also started but was spared the jeers.

The French forward had been expected to return for the Champions League game against Monaco next week as he manages his recovery from a knee sprain.

"Today was a very important day, play-

ing in front of our fans, we wanted to turn around the situation," Asencio told Real Madrid TV.

"What happened at Albacete should not have happened, we felt guilty and we wanted to make things better.

"The team gave a good account of themselves, above all in the second half."

It was Arbeloa's 43rd birthday and he was eventually able to celebrate with a victory, although his team lacked energy and spark in the first half.

That was not the case in the stands as a significant part of the crowd harangued their own team, showing they were upset at the club's situation.

In a wild week, Los Blancos lost the Spanish Super Cup

final to rivals Barcelona in Saudi Arabia on Sunday, parted ways with Alonso on Monday and then crashed out of the cup on

Wednesday.

Some fans also chanted for president Florentino Perez to resign in a sour atmosphere in the Spanish capital.

Mbappe, who appeared in pain in the warm up after a collision with team-mate Dean Huijsen, had the best chance of a flat first half against the team in 19th in La Liga.

Reaching a long ball the French superstar met it with a volley that flew wide of the post.

A step forward

Home fans jeered their side in at the break and Madrid emerged for the second half with more impetus, with Arbeloa bringing on Franco Mastantuono and Arda Guler.

Mbappe drew a foul in the area from Adrian de la Fuente to earn a

penalty, which he dispatched for his 19th league goal of the campaign.

Mbappe has scored 50 goals in 53 La Liga games, taking only a little longer than Real Madrid's all-time top goalscorer Cristiano Ronaldo to reach the milestone.

The Portuguese managed it in 51 appearances.

Asencio doubled Madrid's advantage with a header into the top corner from Guler's corner as the hosts took control.

Bellingham came close to adding a third but Mathew Ryan parried his header from Fede Valverde's cross and then saved Vinicius's effort after a darting run from the Brazilian.

Ryan thwarted Bellingham again as tensions calmed by the end, with the crowd temporarily sated by the victory. Unless

Madrid can build on it, the jeers and whistles will return.

APakistani team created a first-class cricket record when they won a two-inning match after setting their opponents a paltry 40 to win.

Pakistan Television (PTV), the President Trophy holders, led by just 39 after their second innings but bowled out Sui Northern Gas (SNGPL) for a meagre 37 to win by two runs on day three of the four-day game.

The previous record was set at Lord's Old Ground in London in 1794 when Oldfield successfully defended a target of 41 to beat MCC to win by six runs.

"I am delighted with my team's world-record effort," PTV's head coach Mohammad Waseem, a former Pakistan player, told AFP.

"My team's motto is to never give up, fight till the last ball.

"We have won all our three matches coming from well behind by remaining positive in all situations."

After PTV made 166 in their first innings, SNGPL hit 238.

PTV then made just 111 but bowled out the star-studded SNGPL batting order, led by Pakistan Test captain Shan Masood, in 19.4 overs.

Only one batter, Saifullah Bangash, reached double figures with 14. Masood was out without scoring.

Mohammad Ali made six and spinner Sajid Khan just three. Both are Test players.

The winners used only two bowlers in the second innings. Left-arm spinner Ali Usman wrecked the batting with 6-9 and pacer Ahammad Butt took 4-28. SNGPL's head coach is former Pakistan Test skipper Misbah-ul-Haq with another former captain Azhar Ali their batting coach.

Skipper Martinez fires Inter past Udinese and six points clear

Lautaro Martinez made sure that Inter Milan put pressure on their Serie A title rivals with the only goal in Saturday's 1-0 win at Udinese, which extended his team's league lead to six points.

Martinez expertly poked home the winner in the 20th minute in Udine to continue Inter's nine-match unbeaten run in Italy's top flight.

Inter were the better team from start to finish, putting pressure on Udinese high up the pitch as Cristian Chivu wants his team to do.

"What we're displaying on the pitch is a testament to the desire of these players, because it's not easy to change habits," said Chivu to DAZN.

"We defend high up the pitch and we start with pressure from the forwards and it comes from their work, the desire for our midfielders to win duels and from the courage of our defenders in maintaining a high line."

Inter have collected 25 points from a possible 27 since losing the Milan derby at the end of November and again showed a ruthlessness in dealing with the smaller sides that both AC Milan and Napoli have lacked.

Napoli take on Sassuolo in Saturday's next fixture after three straight draws have left the champions in third, nine points off the Scudetto pace.

Second-placed Milan host Lecce on Sunday with a six-

point gap separating them from local rivals Inter even though the seven-time European champions haven't lost since the opening day of the season.

Massimiliano Allegri's side have dropped a host of points to teams they should beat, starting back in August against Jamie Vardy's Cremonese who remain the only team to get three points from Milan.

Inter meanwhile have the opposite problem, with a poor track record in matches against high-profile opposition, a weakness which will be tested by Premier League leaders Arsenal on Tuesday in the Champions League.

Four straight wins at the start of the league phase of the competition were followed up by two defeats which have left direct qualification for the last 16 in doubt.

Juventus, in fourth, trail Inter by 10 points but have been improving under Luciano Spalletti and are heavy favourites to win at Cagliari in Saturday's late match.

Al-Attiyah claims sixth Dakar car crown as Benavides edges bike title

Al-Attiyah, at the wheel of a Dacia, only had to avoid a final day slip-up

Qatar's Nasser Al-Attiyah secured his sixth Dakar Rally car title in Saudi Arabia yesterday with Luciano Benavides scraping home by two seconds to claim the bike title.

Al-Attiyah, at the wheel of a Dacia, only had to avoid a final day slip-up to top the podium after bringing his career tally of stage wins to 50 on Friday.

The 55-year-old, who took clay pigeon shooting bronze at the 2012 London Olympic Games, was adding to his previous Dakar wins in 2011, 2015, 2019, 2022 and 2023.

With Belgian co-driver Fabian Lurquin, Al-Attiyah took control of

the overall standings early on in the motorsport marathon.

After placing ninth on the 13th and final stage in Yanbu on the Red Sea he had almost 10 minutes in hand over second-placed Nani Roma (Ford).

Roma's Swedish teammate Mattias Ekstrom won the final stage to complete the car podium in third overall.

Last year's champion, Saudi Yazeed Al Rajhi, was forced to pull out with mechanical problems last week.

Earlier, Argentina's Luciano Benavides took the bike honours by a mere two seconds.

Second in the 13th and closing stage was enough for the 30-year-old KTM rider to deny Honda's

American two-time champion Ricky Brabec and secure a debut Dakar crown.

'Glimmer of hope' 'I've dreamed of this mo-

ment my whole life," said the winner.

Brabec, winner in 2020 and 2024, was

target for a third title but lost time when he went the wrong way close to the finish of the 105km ride around Yanbu.

"Even yesterday, it seemed impossible, but I still felt it could happen, and today Ricky took the wrong line and I took the right one," Benavides said.

"It was a glimmer of hope. I saw it was him and that he had to pull a U-turn to get back on the right line because crossing between the two was impossible. I saw the opening and I went for it."

Edgar Canet won the bike stage, with Spain's Tasha Schareina (Honda) finishing third and also taking the num-

ber-three spot in the overall standings.

Benavides's older brother Kevin won the marathon race in 2021 and 2023.

Benavides said he had given his all "from start to finish today".

"I'd told everyone before the start that this Dakar was mine," he added.

"Nine years in the Dakar and my first win. My brother and I are making history.

"He won by 43 seconds and I've won by two. I think I have him beaten on that front! It's a dream come true."

The Dakar Rally is one of the world's toughest motorsport events, covering thousands of kilometres across extreme terrain such as deserts, dunes and rocky tracks, and is open to motorcycles, cars, trucks and side-by-sides. Originally run from Paris to Dakar, it has been held in Saudi Arabia since 2020.

Man Utd dominate Man City in dream start for Carrick

Manchester United gave Michael Carrick the dream start to his interim tenure as manager on Saturday, beating Manchester City 2-0 to deal a huge blow to their local rivals' Premier League title aspirations.

The Red Devils dominated at Old Trafford and were only made to wait until the final 25 minutes to seal victory by the inspired Gianluigi Donnarumma and because they had three goals ruled out for offside.

Bryan Mbeumo marked his return from the African Cup of Nations (AFCON) by firing home the opening goal before Patrick Dorgu sealed just a second win in eight games for United.

Victory lifts Carrick's men into the top four, but their win will be celebrated just as much in north London as Arsenal close in on a

first league title in 22 years.

Mikel Arteta's men can open up a nine-point lead at the top when they visit Nottingham Forest later on Saturday.

Carrick's bold team selection paid off as both the in-form Benjamin Sesko and Matheus Cunha made way for the return of Mbeumo and Amad Diallo from their international duties at AFCON.

Harry Maguire also returned for his first start in two months and should have scored inside the first two minutes.

The centre-back rose highest to meet Bruno Fernandes' corner but crashed his header off the crossbar from point-blank range.

City are set to seal a deal for Crystal Palace captain Marc Guehi, but ravaged by injuries in defence, Pep Guardiola named inexperienced duo Max Allegre and Abdulkodir Khusanov at cen-

tre-back.

City's makeshift back line struggled to keep United at bay all afternoon and would have been embarrassed but for the brilliance of Donnarumma in goal.

The Italian's first major intervention came midway through the first half to parry Dorgu's effort.

Donnarumma was twice beaten before the break but both Diallo and Fernandes strayed offside before rounding the goalkeeper to score.

Guardiola tried to awaken the visitors with a double substitution at half-time, introducing Nico O'Riley and Raya Cherki.

But City's title challenge has faded fast in a four-game winless run in the Premier League since the turn of the year.

Donnarumma continued to defy the home side until beyond the hour with a stunning double save from Diallo's powerful strike and Casemiro's follow-up effort.

City played a big part in their own downfall when the opening goal finally arrived 25 minutes from time.

Cherki's poor

free-kick allowed United to sprint forward in numbers and Fernandes' pass was perfectly weighted for Mbeumo to fire low and hard beyond Donnarumma's long levers.

Cunha came off the bench to make the second as Dorgu caught Rico Lewis sleep-

ing to steal in at the back post.

Guardiola appeared to waive the white flag as he replaced Erling Haaland 10 minutes from time to reserve the Norwegian's energy with City still fighting in four competitions.

Diallo nearly sealed a stunning individual display when he hit the post in the 90th minute.

Mason Mount then rolled in Cunha's cross with his first touch after replacing Fernandes only for VAR to come to the visitors' rescue again for offside.

But the damage had already been done to City's title aspirations, making victory all the sweeter for Carrick on his return to the Theatre of Dreams.
