

n Asian man, aged 30, was arrested at the Bahrain International Airport, attempting to smuggle half a kilogram hashish into the Kingdom.

The arrest and subsequent investigations would reveal that he was consuming drugs while driving, which had led to a number of red light violations.

According to court files, the defendant hid the drugs in his luggage and he told prosecutors that he brought the hashish with an intention to consume.

"I have been working in Bahrain as a truck driver since 2015. But I was on drugs. Due to their high prices in Bahrain, I decided to smuggle some from my country and I concealed the hashish in my luggage.

"Prosecutors inquired about the defendant's status in Bahrain, and it was found that he ran red light on five occasions. And he admitted that the reason behind this was that he was doped."
