Trilateral pact enters action phase with working groups

The United States, the Kingdom of Bahrain, and the United Kingdom have initiated working groups under the Comprehensive Security Integration and Prosperity Agreement (C-SIPA), marking a new stage in trilateral cooperation and signalling operational momentum.

The working groups are tasked with advancing C-SIPA's three core pillars - defence and security, economy and trade, and science, technology and network security. This reflects a shift from policy framework to joint action.

UK participation in C-SIPA took effect on June 19th, following the agreement's original signing by the US and Bahrain in September 2023. The expansion highlights the pact's open structure and growing strategic relevance.

To mark this development, U.S. State Department official Maura Namdar hosted Bahrain's Ambassador to Washington, H.E. Shaikh Abdullah bin Rashid Al Khalifa, and UK Deputy Head of Mission Lucy Ferguson. Their meeting highlighted growing diplomatic convergence.

Bahrain's push to solidify its role as a Gulf strategic partner took another step forward on Wednesday, with His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, meeting U.S. Vice President J.D. Vance at the White House.

The meeting highlighted

the political depth of the Bahrain-U.S. partnership, which had earlier been marked by major investment announcements and discussions on peaceful nuclear cooperation. It underscored the strategic scope of the visit, especially in light of regional tensions and the expanding role of the Comprehensive Security Integration and Prosperity Agreement (C-SIPA).

HRH described C-SIPA as a cornerstone for "collective deterrence against external threats". His Royal Highness also underscored its role in building economic and technological collaboration with like-minded allies, alongside reaffirming the importance of the UK's recent accession to the pact.

While the security agreement has been reported previously, its growing political symbolism

points to a shift in how Bahrain is positioning itself - not just as a participant, but as a strategic enabler of Gulf-Western defence

integration.

Extended engagement

Joining the delegation was His Highness Shaikh Isa bin Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, Minister of the Prime Minister's Court, whose presence reflected his participation in the high-level diplomatic visit.

During the meeting, HRH reiterated Bahrain's ambition to emerge as a regional hub for technology and industry, citing the Kingdom's legal, logistical, and infrastructural strengths. This vision has been a consistent element of Bahrain's development strategy and was reinforced during the visit.

Although previous headlines focused on the USD 17 billion investment package and Bahrain's emphasis on peaceful nuclear cooperation, Wednesday's

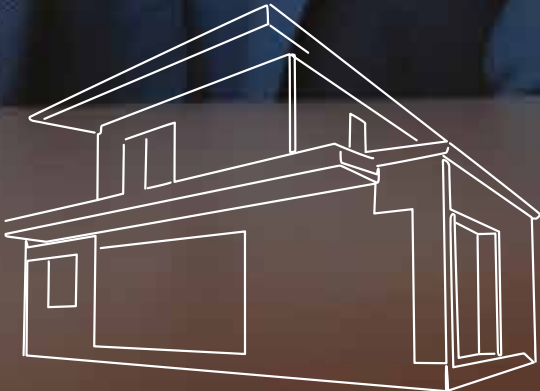
meeting brought these elements under one political umbrella, underscoring that they are not isolated topics but part of a long-term alliance.

HRH affirmed Bahrain's commitment to advancing these sectors through expanded collaboration and trust, pointing to shared development goals as the foundation of this multifaceted partnership. The meeting also touched on regional and global developments, with both sides reaffirming the importance of closer coordination to preserve regional peace and stability.

HRH the Crown Prince's direct meeting with Vice President Vance marks a deepening of the political dimension of Bahrain-U.S. ties, cementing the Kingdom's role in shaping the Gulf's evolving strategic architecture.

‘Diplomacy Boosts Economy’

Bahrain’s expanding diplomatic efforts are driving tangible economic and strategic outcomes, according to MP Dr Maryam Al-Dhaen.

She credited recent high-level visits by His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa to Italy and His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, to the United States, as key moves that reinforce Bahrain’s foreign policy vision rooted in balanced engagement and long-term cooperation.

Economic framing

Dr Al-Dhaen said such outreach is not only deepening historical ties with partners like Italy and the US, but also paving the way for major economic partnerships. She noted that Bahrain’s diplomatic presence strengthens its position as a reliable and forward-looking partner in the global arena.

UN seat endorsement

The MP also pointed to Italy’s praise for Bahrain’s election to the United Nations Security Council for 2026-2027 as renewed international recognition of the Kingdom’s growing role. She expressed pride in how the leadership’s approach to diplomacy is aligned with values of tolerance, stability, and prosperity.

Al-Dhaen framed the upcoming September visit to Rome as a strategic next step in consolidating bilateral growth and further economic agreements.

Tamkeen Cracks Down Hard

Inspectors uncover multiple violations

● 6,200 checks conducted

● 25 breaches identified

Tamkeen has launched a firm crackdown on abuse of its financial support programmes, revealing 25 violations following 6,200 inspections conducted in the first half of the year. The Labour Fund is stepping up its oversight to ensure public funds reach only those who qualify.

Widening net

The inspections covered enterprises benefiting from Tamkeen’s employment, career development, and enterprise

support programmes. Violations ranged from failure to comply with programme terms to suspected wage manipulation and illegal employment. Serious cases were referred to legal authorities for further action.

Tamkeen warned that enter-

prises found guilty could face recovery of misused funds, temporary suspension from future support, or both. It also retains the right to impose administrative sanctions once official decisions are issued by the authorities.

Level playing field

Tamkeen confirmed that it is actively upgrading its internal monitoring systems to reinforce compliance and close regulatory loopholes. The crackdown also aims to protect legitimate bene-

ficiaries by maintaining fairness and deterring abuse.

“These actions are not just about penalties, they’re about integrity,” Tamkeen noted in its statement. “Support must reach those who genuinely qualify.”

Public role critical

The Labour Fund credited whistleblowers and partner institutions for playing a key role in surfacing violations. It called on beneficiaries and the wider public to remain vigilant, encouraging the use of its dedicated reporting channels to flag any suspected misuse.

Tamkeen reaffirmed its call for full cooperation during inspections, and urged all recipients of support to provide accurate records and documentation.

Bahrain and Hong Kong are setting the stage for a new phase of cross-regional cooperation, as the Bahrain Chamber welcomed a high-level trade delegation from the East Asian powerhouse. The meeting underscored ambitions on both sides to build a stronger commercial bridge connecting the Gulf with Asia’s booming economies.

The visit was hosted by Atef Al Khaja, Chief Executive Officer of the Bahrain Chamber, who described the session as more than a courtesy call. “It’s a chance to deepen a relationship anchored in shared values like openness, free enterprise, and innovation,” he said. He also reaffirmed the Chamber’s commitment to supporting partnerships that align with Bahrain’s

long-term development strategy.

Sectoral committee members from the Chamber joined the dialogue, presenting Bahrain’s offerings in health, logistics, digital economy, industry, tourism, and exports. Their participation signalled Bahrain’s readiness to convert policy dialogue into actionable trade outcomes.

Representing the Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office in

Dubai, Director General Simon Chan spotlighted his city’s strategic value for Bahraini investors. He delivered a focused presentation on Hong Kong’s business environment and ongoing initiatives to draw Gulf investment into Asia.

Chan said the Dubai office was committed to helping Bahraini companies tap into East Asian supply chains through

Hong Kong’s well-established financial, legal, and logistical networks. He added that the city’s competitive advantages were designed to complement regional growth ambitions in the Gulf.

The gathering marked a deliberate step in positioning Bahrain as a regional base for outward investment and trade, and Hong Kong as a proven platform to access Asian markets. Both sides acknowledged the importance of converting diplomatic ties into direct business collaborations that generate value across sectors.

As global trade patterns shift and economies recalibrate toward multi-polar supply routes, Bahrain and Hong Kong appear keen to define their own niche in this evolving map. The Chamber said it would follow up with sector-specific initiatives to maintain momentum and explore concrete opportunities.

Cross-border kindness brings them home

A Pakistani family torn apart by deportation has been reunited and sent home, thanks to the combined efforts of Bahrain's Indian expatriate community and diplomatic support from the concerned missions.

In an act that bridged national divides, the Indian-run humanitarian organisation HOPE stepped in to assist the family after the father was jailed and later deported. With no means of returning home, the wife and three children stayed with relatives and struggled to make ends meet, even as the children

Quiet assistance

HOPE, a social service organisation led by Indian expatriates, began supporting the family with essential aid, including food kits. The family's situation remained unresolved, however, as two of the four members had expired passports and lacked the funds for travel.

Responding to HOPE's appeal,

the Pakistani Embassy issued

emergency out-passes to enable the family's travel before Tuesday's deadline.

Race against time

With travel documents secured, HOPE raised funds through community contributions to book air tickets for all four family members. Volunteers then accompanied the family to the airport and ensured they boarded their flight home to Pakistan.

The initiative was led by HOPE patron K.R. Nair, with President Shibu Pathanamthitta and Secretary Jayesh Kurup thanking all who supported what they described as "a mission of dignity and unity."

Humanity above borders

The episode stands as a testament to how community compassion and timely diplomatic support can come together to restore dignity and deliver relief across national lines.

Their return was made possible by the shared efforts of expat volunteers and embassy officials acting in unison.

New sewage network completed in Al Qurayyah

A new sewage network has been laid in Block 551 of Al Qurayyah, bringing the service to 63 properties.

The Ministry of Works said the job had been completed as part of its wider push to expand infrastructure across Bahrain.

Crews put in nearly 1.4 kilometres of main pipelines and a further 590 metres of smaller lines.

The work also involved 95 manholes, a pumping station, and a wastewater chamber

fitted with new pumps and valves.

Pace

The ministry said it aimed to keep up with the pace of new homes and buildings by linking them to the network, helping to maintain clean and safe surroundings.

It also thanked residents and visitors for keeping to safety measures during the works.

The contract, worth BD489,920, went to Afaaq Alkhalij Excavation & Building Equipment Rental Company following a Tender Board decision.

Healthcare achievement

In a new achievement reflecting the Ministry of Health's commitment to enhancing laboratory service quality and strengthening its global standing, Bahrain's National Influenza Centre, under the Public Health Laboratories, has received certification from the World Health Organisation (WHO) for successfully completing the External Quality Assessment (EQA) for detecting influenza and COVID-19 viruses.

The centre earned the highest score for the 12th consecutive year since 2013.

This accomplishment un-

derscores Bahrain's leading role in the Eastern Mediterranean Region's acute respiratory infection surveillance network and highlights its commitment to sharing data with global reference centres in line with the highest technical and laboratory standards.

Dr. Samia Ali Bahram, Assistant Undersecretary for Public Health, said that this international recognition underscores the competence of national teams in accurately detecting and analysing respiratory viruses, and emphasises the readiness of Bahrain's health system to respond swiftly to health emergencies and epidemics.

New mosques and prayer areas planned for Northern Governorate

- Council raises matter with Sunni Waqf Directorate

A new mosque will be built in Block 1038, Road 3827 in Sadat, while further prayer facilities are being planned across Hamad Town's ninth constituency, Northern Municipal Council members have confirmed.

Zainab Al Durazi, councillor for the twelfth constituency, said the Sadat site was chosen after repeated requests from residents.

The Council raised the matter with the Sunni Waqf Directorate, which began preparations to get the project going.

The new mosque is expected to ease pressure on existing prayer spaces and serve families in the surrounding area, which has grown faster than the services currently in place.

Al Qubaisi said Hamad Town was well-planned but needed more prayer space to match its rising population.

Parking is also proving difficult. Worshippers at the Fatima Al Zahraa Mosque in Block 1205 have asked for proper spaces to stop traffic build-up and random parking.

Al Qubaisi proposed turning a nearby garden into car bays.

A formal request will also go to the Ministry of Works for extra parking next to the Sayyida Khadija Grand Mosque on Road 564, while the Karim Ahl Al Bayt Mosque in Block 1207 is facing a similar shortage.

Plan

The plan there is to add nearby land to the site and level the ground behind the mosque with a layer of asphalt to make room for more cars. Al Durazi thanked Minister of Justice, Islamic Affairs and Waqf Nawaf bin Mohammed Al Maawda for backing the Sadat mosque and praised Dr Rashid Al Hajri, Chairman of the Sunni Waqf Council, for helping move the plans forward.

Zuckerberg settles lawsuit over Cambridge Analytica scandal

Meta chief Mark Zuckerberg and other company board members settled a shareholder lawsuit on Thursday concerning decisions made in the wake of the Cambridge Analytica privacy scandal.

A trial over the long-running

case had just begun on Wednesday, with defendants accused of overpaying the US government in 2019 when they engineered a \$5 billion settlement for alleged privacy violations in the scandal.

Sources familiar with the matter confirmed the settlement, without providing details.

The settlement comes the same day that Marc Andreessen, one of Silicon Valley's most influential venture capitalists and a board member of the company now known as Meta, was to take the stand.

Zuckerberg himself was expected in the Wilmington, Delaware courtroom on Monday.

Silicon Valley investor Peter Thiel and former Meta top executive Sheryl Sandberg were also expected to face questioning in the court.

Cambridge Analytica was a political consulting firm that was found to have improperly harvested personal data from millions of Facebook users

for targeted political advertising, particularly during the 2016 US election and Brexit referendum.

The scandal thrust Facebook and Zuckerberg in particular into a political firestorm, leading to major regulatory changes and public scrutiny of tech companies' data practices.

Rare Gandhi portrait smashes estimate to sell for nearly £153,000 ♦ A rare painting of Mahatma Gandhi, believed to be the only oil portrait that the Indian independence leader ever sat for, has sold at auction in the UK for £152,800 (\$205,000). The 1931 painting by British-American artist Clare Leighton fetched more than twice the estimated price when the auction closed on Tuesday in London, Bonhams auction house has revealed. "Thought to be the only oil painting of Mahatma Gandhi which he sat for, this was a very special work, which had never before been offered at auction," said Rhyannon Demery, Bonhams' head of sale.

♦ The United States is moving to get weapons to Ukraine quickly under President Donald Trump's plan for Europe to buy arms, and is weighing selling Patriot air defense systems from its own stocks, Washington's envoy to NATO said yesterday. "We are all moving with haste to facilitate this and get this done, and, you know, I think things are actually moving very quickly," US ambassador to NATO Matthew Whitaker told journalists.

Bangladesh police arrest 20 after deadly clashes in ousted premier's hometown ♦ Bangladesh police said yesterday they had arrested 20 people, a day after clashes between supporters of ousted premier Sheikh Hasina and security personnel killed at least four people. The clashes erupted in Hasina's hometown of Gopalganj on Wednesday after members of her Awami League party tried to foil a rally by the National Citizens Party (NCP), made up of many students who spearheaded the uprising that toppled her government last year. Bricks, stones and shattered windows littered the area where the clashes occurred. More than 1,500 police, as well as soldiers and border guards, have been deployed in the district to enforce a curfew.

54 people killed in 24 hours of heavy monsoon rain in Pakistan

Heavy rains have been linked to 54 deaths in the past 24 hours in Pakistan, taking the toll to about 180 since the arrival of the monsoon in late June, the government's disaster agency said yesterday. Torrential rain has poured almost without pause across parts of Punjab province since Wednesday morning, causing urban flooding and houses to collapse. Rescue teams used boats to evacuate families from villages along the river further south in the morning, but the water had begun to recede by the afternoon. "Children were screaming for help, and women stood on rooftops, waving their shawls and begging to be rescued," said Tariq Mehboud Bhatti, a 51-year-old farmer in Ladian village. Residents living in low-lying areas near the Nullah Lai river that runs through Rawalpindi city, neighbouring the capital Islamabad, were ordered to evacuate after a sharp rise in

the water level. "Rescue teams are on stand-by for more evacuations," a spokeswoman for the disaster agency said. "Residents of vulnerable areas should prepare emergency kits with food, water, and essential medicines for three to five days in case of an emergency," the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) added in an alert. The Rawalpindi government declared a public holiday yesterday to keep people at home, with the national meteorological department warning that heavy rain would continue until Friday. Around 180 people have been killed, including 70 children, and about 500 injured since the start of the monsoon on June 26, according to the disaster agency. "In the last 24 hours, 54 people were killed and 227 injured across Pakistan, with the majority of fatalities reported from Punjab," the NDMA spokeswoman said, adding that the toll had been counted at 8:00 am (0300 GMT) yesterday.

Iraq mall fire kills 61

Newly opened shopping centre in Kut becomes site of deadly overnight fire

- Fire started on first floor
- AC explosion suspected cause
- Many suffocated in bathrooms
- No fire suppression system installed

A fire tore through a newly opened shopping mall in the eastern Iraqi city of Kut overnight, killing at least 61 people, authorities said yesterday, as grief-stricken families searched for missing relatives. Officials said many people suffocated in bathrooms, while one person told AFP that his five relatives died in an elevator. The blaze -- the latest in a country where safety regulations are frequently neglected -- broke out late Wednesday, reportedly starting on the first floor before rapidly engulfing the five-storey Corniche Hypermarket Mall. The cause was not immediately known, but one survivor told AFP an air conditioner had exploded. Several people told AFP they lost families including mothers and children who had gone to shop and dine at the mall, days after it opened in Kut -- around 160 kilometres (100 miles) south-east of Baghdad. showed people including children standing on the roof, calling for help. Ali Kadhim, 51, has been shuttling between the mall and the main hospital, where the victims were taken, looking for his cousin, who is missing with his wife and three children. Back at the mall, he waited anxiously as rescuers searched for victims in the wreckage, with an ambulance on standby. "We don't know what happened to them," he said. An AFP correspondent at the scene said the blaze had been contained and the front of the building was severely charred. The interior ministry said in a statement that "the tragic fire claimed the lives of 61 innocent citizens, most of whom suffocated in bathrooms, and among them 14 charred bodies yet to be identified." "We couldn't escape" INA news agency later quoted a medical source who put the toll at 63 dead and 40 injured. Wasit province governor Mohammed al-Miyahi told the official INA news agency the victims included men, women and children. A medical source in Kut said there were "many unidentified bodies". A correspondent reported seeing charred bodies at the province's forensic department.

Air India probe of Boeing 787 fuel control switches finds no issues

- Fuel switch inspections complete
- No locking mechanism issues found

Air India's inspection of the locking feature on the fuel control switches of its existing Boeing 787 aircraft found no issues, an internal communication circulated within the airline said. The switches have come under scrutiny following last month's crash of an Air India jet that killed 260 people after a preliminary probe by Indian investigators found that they had flipped from run position to cutoff shortly after takeoff. India's aviation regulator earlier this week ordered the country's airlines to investigate the locking feature on the switches of several Boeing models. The order came after Boeing notified operators that the fuel switch locks on its jets were safe.

But it was in line with a Special Airworthiness Information Bulletin (SAIB) issued by the US Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) in 2018, which recommended inspection of the locks to ensure they could not be moved accidentally. Air India's probe, however, found no problems with the locking mechanism. "Over the weekend, our Engineering team initiated precautionary inspections on the locking mechanism of Fuel Control Switch (FCS) on all our Boeing 787 aircraft," the airline's flight operations department said in a communication to its pilots. "The inspections have been completed and no issues were found," the communication said, noting that it had complied with the regulator's directives.



Syria troops quit Druze region

Syria cedes security to Druze leaders after Israeli strikes force troop withdrawal

Syrian troops pulled out of the Druze heartland province of Sweida yesterday on orders from the government, leaving bodies strewn on the street, journalists reported from the provincial capital.

The southern province has been gripped by deadly sectarian bloodshed since Sunday, with hundreds reportedly killed in clashes pitting Druze fighters against Sunni Bedouin tribes and the army and its allies.

In a televised speech, Islamist interim President Ahmed al-Sharaa said community leaders would resume control over security in Sweida after the deployment of government troops on Tuesday fuelled the sectarian bloodshed and prompted Israeli military intervention.

Government troops told AFP that the order to withdraw came

shortly before midnight (2100 GMT Wednesday) and they completed their pullout from the province at dawn.

A photographer counted 15 bodies on the street in the centre of Sweida yesterday after government forces pulled out.

The Syrian Observatory for Human Rights has said more than 370 people have been killed

in sectarian clashes in the city since Sunday.

Israel had pounded government troops with air strikes during their brief deployment to the southern province and also struck army headquarters in Damascus, warning that its strikes would intensify until the government pulled back.

Sharaa announced in a tele-

vised address that "responsibility" for security in Sweida would be returned to community leaders "based on the supreme national interest".

Promise of 'protection'

Sharaa, whose interim government has had troubled relations with ethnic and religious minority groups since it toppled



veteran leader Bashar al-Assad in December, also pledged to protect the Druze.

"We are keen on holding accountable those who transgressed and abused our Druze people, as they are under the protection and responsibility of the state," he said.

March saw massacres of more than 1,700 mostly Alawite civilians in their hub on the Mediterranean coast, with government-affiliated groups blamed for most of the killings.

Government forces also battled Druze fighters in Sweida province and near Damascus in April and May, leaving more than 100 people dead.

Israeli strike on Gaza's only Catholic church kills three

An Israeli strike on Gaza's only Catholic church killed three people yesterday, the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem said, as Israel said it "never targets" religious sites and regretted any harm to civilians.

Pope Leo XIV said he was "deeply saddened" by the loss of life, which a witness said was the result of a tank shell hitting the church.

AFP footage showed those injured being treated at Gaza City's Al-Ahli Hospital, also known as the Baptist Hospital, with one receiving oxygen and blood while lying under a foil blanket.

Mourners knelt next to two white body bags laid out on the floor.

"In the morning a tank shell targeted us and hit the church and a number of civilians were killed and wounded," said Shadi Abu Daoud, a displaced man whose 70-year-old mother was killed in the strike.

The Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem named the dead as Najwa Abu Daoud, Saad Issa Kostandi Salameh and Foumia Issa Latif Ayyad.

"This morning, at approximately 10:20 am (0720 GMT), the Compound of the Holy Family in Gaza... was struck by the Israeli army," it said in a statement.

"As of this hour, three individuals lost their lives as a result of the injuries sustained and ten others were wounded," including the community's parish priest, Father Gabriel Romanelli, it added, revising a previous toll of two.

An AFP photograph showed Father Romanelli with a bandage around his lower leg at Al-Ahli Hospital.

Gaza civil defence spokesman Mahmud Bassal confirmed that three people were killed in an

Israeli strike on the church in Gaza City, with which the late Pope Francis kept regular contact through the war.

Cardinal Pierbattista Pizzaballa, the Latin Patriarch of Jerusalem, told Vatican News that: "What we know for sure is that a tank, the IDF says by mistake, but we are not sure about this, they hit the Church directly".

'Serious act'

The patriarchate, which has jurisdiction for Catholics in Israel, the Palestinian Territories, Jordan and Cyprus, said it "strongly condemns this strike and this targeting of innocent

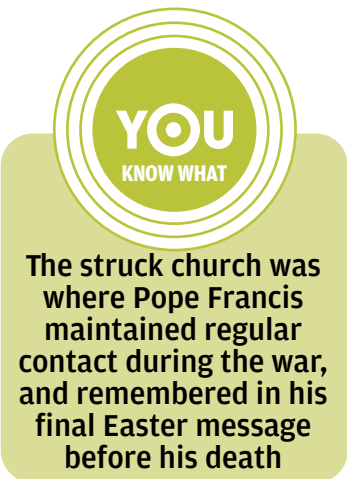
civilians".

The site was sheltering around 600 displaced people, the majority of them children and 54 with special needs.

"The people in the Holy Family Compound are people who found in the Church a sanctuary -- hoping that the horrors of war might at least spare their lives, after their homes, possessions and dignity had already been stripped away," a statement read.

It came as Gaza's civil defence agency reported that Israeli strikes elsewhere across the Palestinian territory killed at least 22 people.

Israel expressed "deep sorrow"



over the damage and civilian casualties, adding that the military was investigating, as foreign leaders, including from France and Italy called the strike "unacceptable".

"Israel never targets churches or religious sites and regrets any harm to a religious site or to uninvolved civilians," the Israeli foreign ministry said on X.

Out of the Gaza Strip's population of more than two million, about 1,000 are Christians. Most of them are Orthodox but according to the Latin Patriarchate, there are about 135 Catholics in the territory.

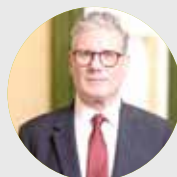
Pope Francis repeatedly called for an end to the war which erupted in October 2023 and in his final Easter message, a day before his death on April 21, he condemned the "deplorable humanitarian situation" in the Palestinian territory.

Monsignor Pascal Gollnisch, the head of Catholic charity l'Oeuvre d'Orient, said the raid was "totally unacceptable".

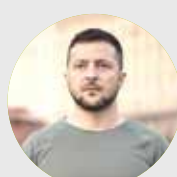

Unreleased Beyonce songs and other sensitive documents have allegedly been stolen from a rental car.

Last week - less than 48 hours before the Crazy In Love hitmaker started her four-night residency at the Mercedes-Benz Stadium in Atlanta during her ongoing Cowboy



Carter tour - thieves allegedly broke into a rental car which had been hired by the singer’s choreographer, and one of her dancers.

As detailed by The Hollywood Reporter, an incident report alleges that the theft occurred on July 8, with the suspect taking

hard drives containing “water marked music, some unreleased music, footage plans for the show and past and future set lists”.

Choreographer Christopher Grant and dancer Diandre Blue are said to have told authorities that they parked up at a parking deck just after 8pm.

When they returned to the vehicle an hour later, it’s alleged someone had broken into the car through the boot, and taken two suitcases.

As well as the hard drives, it’s said the thieves also took clothes, MacBooks and AirPods Max headphones, which belonged to members of her team.

As reported by Atlanta’s ABC station WSB-TV, police have issued an arrest warrant for a suspect.

The Atlanta Police Department told the outlet in a statement: “Preliminary investigation revealed a Jeep Wagoneer was broken into at the location and two suitcases had been stolen.

“Investigators with the Atlanta Police Department’s Larceny from Auto Unit led the investigation and have subsequently secured an arrest warrant for a suspect.”

Officers dusted the rental car for prints, finding two sets, while footage was caught on a security camera.

The incident report obtained by The Hollywood Reporter noted that officers were able to track the location of the AirPods and laptops using the Find My feature on Apple devices.

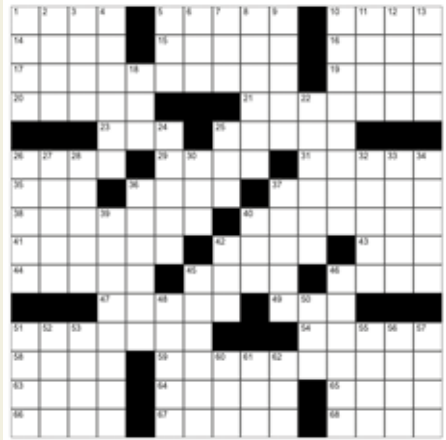

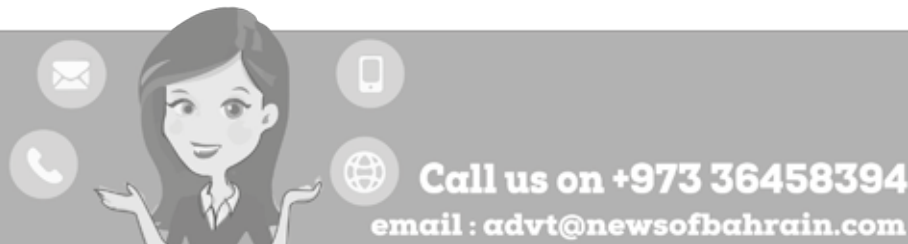

On Saturday, Bahrain’s national volleyball team will open their campaign at the West Asia Championship on home soil, entering the tournament as clear frontrunners. Fresh off their title-winning run at the AVC Men’s Volleyball Nations Cup last month, the squad is back in action with sights set on a second consecutive triumph. According to team captain Nasser Anan, the momentum has carried straight into camp. “The preparation is the same for each championship,” said Anan ahead of Bahrain’s opener against Lebanon. “There was a short time between the first Asian Championship and this one, but the guys are ready, inshAllah.” Anan also confirmed that middle blocker Ibrahim, who missed the AVC final, has returned fully fit. “Ibrahim was the winner of the last championship, and alhamdulillah he’s back — stronger than be-fore.” With Bahrain once again playing host, Anan didn’t shy away

from the weight of expectation. “Of course, our ambition is first place. This is a strong competition — the crowd, the association, and the people of Bahrain want it. InshAllah, we will win.”

Final tune-ups

The national team closed out its preparations with two friendly wins over Saudi Arabia, the most re-cent coming Tuesday night, winning 3-1 (27-29, 25-19, 25-19). Both matches served as useful tune-ups for head coach Arnaud Gosserand, who will lead Bahrain into their second major event in as many months. “When you win an Asian Cup, the only goal is to win the next

competition,” Gosserand said after the match.

Delegations arrive

Teams from around the region, like Qatar and Jordan, began arriving at Bahrain International Airport yesterday, with players and officials greeted by representatives of the Bahrain Volleyball Association and the West Asia Federation. Speaking at the opening of the tournament, President of the

West Asia Volleyball Federation, Ali Ghanem Al Kowari, emphasized the importance of the new championship. “The Western Asia Games are very important for the International Federation, and not just for Asia,” he said. “There’s been a lot of interest at the global level in growing competitions in every region.” “These games should fall under the International Federation’s umbrella and serve as qualifiers to the next level. The teams that qualify here move on to Asia, and eventually, the World Cup — and this is the most important thing.” “All of the teams are officially registered through the VIS sys-

tem, and participation affects international rankings. If you don’t compete, you lose points and even funding. That’s why we want everyone to benefit, and I’m confident the Bahrain edition will set the standard.”

Tournament outlook

This tournament is the first senior men’s championship organized by the West Asia Volleyball Association (WAVA), which is aiming to establish a permanent presence on the international calendar. Bahrain will open against Lebanon tomorrow night, followed by Jordan on Sunday and UAE on Mon-day. All group matches will be played at Isa Bin Rashid Arena at 7PM. The host nation comes in with a strong core that just last month delivered the AVC title — a run that saw standout performances from Abdulla Mohammed (MVP & Best Outside Hitter), AlAfyah Mahmood (Best Setter), Khamis Ali (Best Opposite), and Haroon Ayman (Best Libero). With chemistry intact and a growing reputation across the region, Bahrain now look to defend their crown in front of home fans expecting nothing less.

Bahrain fall to NK Istra in Slovenian friendly

Bahrain's unbeaten run at the 44th William Jones Cup continued yesterday morning, with Voras' men outclassing Qatar B 81-47 at the Xinzhuang Gymnasium in New Taipei City.

The Kingdom improved to 6-0 in the tournament, adding this dominant performance to earlier wins over Japan U25 (85-69), Chinese Taipei White (71-63), Malaysia

(81-29), Australia United (106-91), and the UAE (77-71).

This latest win featured Bahrain's most disciplined defensive effort yet, holding Qatar to just 28.3% shooting from the field and forcing 25 turnovers. The game was close early, but Bahrain's 22-4 second quarter created a separation that Qatar never recovered from.

Second-quarter shutout

Both teams traded buckets early and were level 17-17 at the end of the first quarter, but Bahrain's pressure defense took over in the second frame. They outscored the Qataris 22-4 in a near-flawless stretch, creating transition chances off steals and converting high-percentage looks.

That gave Bahrain a 39-21 lead at halftime, and they stayed in control the rest of

the way. Another 22-point third quarter stretched the gap even further, and a composed fourth quarter capped off the win.

Hamoda, Bindayneh lead

Mohamed Hamoda led the way again, scoring 11 points on 62.5% shooting while also pulling down four rebounds. Ahmed Bindayneh was clin-

ical as well, finishing with a team-high 19 points on 6-of-10 shooting, including 2 triples and 5-of-6 from the line.

Mahmood Khalifa added 11 points in 20 minutes, and Subah Azzam posted 7 points, 7 rebounds, and 2 steals in an all-around performance. Devon Chism quietly grabbed 10 boards to go with his 8 points.

Bahrain's defense tallied 16 steals, including 2 each from Azzam and Abdulqader Mohamed, while Jakarr Sampson added a block and 7 points.

All 11 players who saw court time scored, with Mustafa Rashed the only one left out of action (DNP).

Sterner Tests Ahead

Bahrain return to action today at 2PM, facing tournament hosts Chinese Taipei, who might present the Kingdom's toughest challenge yet.

Messi's multi-goal streak ends as Cincinnati beats Miami 3-0

Lionel Messi's Major League Soccer-record streak of multi-goal games ended at five on Wednesday as his Inter Miami squad was blanked 3-0 at FC Cincinnati.

The 38-year-old Argentine star forward had scored a brace, two goals, in five consecutive matches for Miami, giving him 16 goals on the season as Inter managed four wins and a draw in the run.

Pogacar retakes Tour de France lead in crushing mountain win

Tadej Pogacar reclaimed the leader's yellow jersey at the Tour de France with an imperious stage 12 triumph on the Hautacam mountain in the Pyrenees yesterday.

Pogacar skipped away on an 11km solo ascent of the fabled climb to finish 2min 10sec ahead of key rival Jonas Vingegaard while overnight leader Ben Healy wilted to a 13min deficit on the day.

French president Emmanuel Macron was on hand at the mountaintop finish to congratulate the Slovenian Team UAE rider.

Olympic champion Remco Evenepoel dug deep after being dropped on the first of three climbs to claw back level,

before eventually losing 3min 35sec on the day's 180.6km ride from Auch, finishing seventh.

In the overall standings Pogacar now leads the Tour de France by 3min 31sec over Denmark's Vingegaard while Evenepoel is third at a daunting 4min 45sec.

Worse for any pretenders hoping to stop the defending champion is that Friday's stage 13 comes in the shape of an up-hill individual time-trial that the Slovenian said this week he was looking forward to.

Overnight leader Healy took a beating on his second day defending the yellow jersey as the EF rider slipped off the pace on the first climb, while doggedly trying to limit his losses.

He is now eleventh, over 13 minutes behind Pogacar.

'Proud' Litton lauds Bangladesh's T20 triumph in Sri Lanka

Bangladesh skipper Litton Das says his team's first ever T20 series win in Sri Lanka has been "huge" for his leadership and made the cricket-crazy fans back home happy.

Bangladesh hammered Sri Lanka by eight wickets on Wednesday in Colombo to clinch the three-match series 2-1 and cap off their tour of the island nation on a high.

Chasing a modest 133 for victory, Bangladesh rode on opener Tanzid Hasan's unbeaten 73 to achieve their target with 21 balls to spare at the R. Premadasa Stadium.

Spinner Mahedi Hasan set up victory with figures of 4-11 to restrict Sri Lanka to 132-7 after

the hosts elected to bat first. "It is a proud moment for me as a captain," Litton said.

"I am happy that the fans are

also happy seeing us win a T20 series in Sri Lanka."

Litton, who was named Bangladesh T20 skipper until next

year's World Cup in India, led the T20 team in the absence of Najmul Hossain Shanto last year in a 3-0 series sweep in the West Indies.

"Both series wins are huge for me," said Litton, who was named player of the series for his 114 runs in the three matches.

"Beating the West Indies in their back yard is massive. They are a strong team in their conditions. It is the same in Sri Lanka. They are a balanced team too."

Sri Lanka, led by Charith Asalanka, won the ODI series 2-1 followed by victory in the opening T20 before they lost two straight matches by big margins.

"We are bitterly disappointed," said Asalanka.
