shleigh Barty edged closer to a return to the top WTA ranking on Friday, reaching the WTA semi-finals as current number one Naomi Osaka retired with a knee injury. Barty, the Australian top seed,

engineered her second comeback in as many days, overhauling Maria Sakkari 5-7, 6-2, 6-0.

But the US Open alarm bells were ringing for Osaka less than two weeks before the start of her title defence at Flushing Meadows after a left knee injury saw her retire against Sofia Kenin -- sending the American into the semis with a 6-4, 1-6, 2-0 victory.

Osaka's left knee trouble was more of a concern, the Japanese star admitting it put a cloud over her upcoming US Open title defence.

"Last year I won the US Open and this year I'm trying to play the US Open," she said.

"I don't even really think about winning the tournament. I just want to have the chance to play it. now.
