**Won't back Hariri for PM**

Lebanon's largest Christian political party said yesterday it would not back the nomination of former Prime Minister Saad al-Hariri to lead a government to tackle a deep economic crisis, further complicating efforts to agree a new premier.

Hariri, who quit as prime minister last October in the face of nationwide protests, has said he is ready to lead a government to implement reforms proposed by France as a way to unlock badly needed international aid. (full story on page 6)

**Russia gets approval for COVID-19 vaccine trials in India**

The Russian Direct Investment Fund (RDIF) and Dr Reddy's Laboratories Ltd have received renewed approval to conduct late-stage clinical trials in India of the Russian COVID-19 vaccine, the sovereign wealth fund said yesterday.

Large-scale trials of the Sputnik V vaccine in India were first announced and then knocked back by Indian regulators, who said the scale of Phase I and II trials conducted in Russia earlier this year was too small, requesting that they be repeated.

**Ardern wins landslide in New Zealand's 'Covid election'**

Prime Minister Jacinda Ardern won a landslide victory in New Zealand's general election yesterday, leveraging success battling Covid-19 into an unprecedented majority she said gave her a mandate for progressive reform.

Ardern's centre-left Labour Party took 64 seats in the 120-member parliament with

49 percent of the vote, after the youthful and charismatic leader steered the nation through the upheaval wrought by the global pandemic.

"Thank you to the many people who gave us their vote, who trusted us to continue leading New Zealand's recovery," the 40-year-old told cheering supporters.

Ardern had dubbed the vote "the Covid election" and campaigned on her government's success in eliminating community transmission of the virus, which has caused just 25 deaths in a population of five million.

The pandemic is one of a string of emergencies that tested Ardern's leadership during a torrid first term, after she rode to an unexpected victory in 2017 polls on the back of a wave of

support dubbed "Jacinda-mania".

She displayed both empathy and decisive action on gun control after a white supremacist gunman killed 51 Muslim worshippers in the Christchurch mosques attack last year.

Ardern again found herself

comforting a shocked nation when a volcanic eruption at White Island, also known as Whakaari, killed 21 people and left dozens more with horrific burns.

"There's no doubt the strong, great leadership we've had from Jacinda Ardern has been a mas-

sive factor in all this," Labour Party president Claire Szabo said of her party's win on broadcaster TVNZ.

Saturday's vote marked the first time any leader won an absolute majority since New Zealand adopted a proportional voting system in 1996 and was the party's strongest showing since World War II.

**Embargo ends as Iran eyes deadly weapons**

United Nations' arms embargo on Iran ends today

● Iran gets freedom to purchase and sell weapons

● US warns it as threat to global security

With a decade-old UN embargo set to expire today, Iran has made clear that it is looking forward to buying and selling weapons with "many friends" putting the stability of the Middle East at risk. Washington has condemned the development "as a threat to global security."

Meanwhile, Tehran has started celebrating the newfound freedom with Iranian UN mission spokesman Alireza Miryousefi saying that his country had options beginning Sunday.

"In accordance with the timeline stated in resolution 2231, Iran will be relieved from arms restrictions as early as October 18. Naturally, from that date, we'll trade, on the basis of our national interests, with other countries in this field."

Rouhani has also said that from that day on "we will be able to sell our arms to anyone

we choose and we can purchase arms from anyone we choose."

The expiration date for the embargo is as per the 2015 nuclear deal that Washington withdrew from in 2018.

This situation, in theory, allows Iran to purchase and sell conventional weapons like tanks, combat aircraft, and heavy artillery.

Analysts, however, say, even Russia and China, which have both opposed Washington's campaign of "maximum pressure" on Iran, are likely to be reluctant to sell weapons to Tehran. A 2019 report by US Defense Intelligence Agency suggested that, after the expiration of the UN arms embargo, Tehran will try to purchase advanced fighter aircraft.

The US administration has repeatedly argued that should the embargo fail to be extended, it would strengthen Iran's capability to further arm its proxies in

the region and eventually destabilise the Middle East.

Washington also believes that Iran's ballistic missile programme is used by the regime to further its influence in the region and is not for "peaceful" purposes as Tehran claims.

**Chilling warning**

**Frozen food polluted by coronavirus could cause infection**

China's disease control authority said yesterday that contact with frozen food packaging contaminated by living new coronavirus could cause infection.

The conclusion came as the Chinese Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) detected and isolated living coronavirus on the outer packaging

of frozen cod during efforts to trace the virus in Qingdao.

The finding, a world first, suggests it is possible for the virus to be conveyed over long distances via frozen goods, it said.

Two dock workers in Qingdao who were initially diagnosed as asymptomatic infections in September brought the virus to a chest hospital during quarantine due to insufficient disin-

fection and protection, leading to another 12 infections linked to the hospital. However, the CDC does not show solid proof that the two workers caught the virus from the packaging directly, rather than contracting the virus from somewhere else and then contaminating the food packaging they handled, said Jin Dong-Yan, a virology professor at the University of Hong Kong.

A study by the Riyadh-based think tank International Institute for Iranian Studies (Rasanah) stated that nuclear deal alone was not enough to curb the dangers posed by Tehran to the region. It highlighted Iran's capabilities when it comes to missile production.

**Reverse engineering**

"Iran can produce hundreds of sophisticated, reverse-engineered improvised missiles. Through black-market or top-secret unannounced purchases, Tehran is suspected of building a missile force capable of evading the radars of its neighbors with speed and in-flight maneuverability. Considering the short flight duration between its adversaries, the threats from Iran's government to the region cannot diminish with the existing nuclear deal as it does not cover Iran's missile capability," the study said.

**Proxy war**

Iran also has a long history of arming and financially supporting its network of proxies – militias across the Middle East – to further its influence in the region.

"Iran's reliance on its missile force makes it highly probable that it will face a high degree of escalation and pay severe retribution. It has [therefore] successfully managed threats

by deploying its missiles via its proxies in Lebanon, Iraq, and Yemen," the study adds.

"Reverse-engineered or locally assembled missiles" have been smuggled to Hezbollah in Lebanon, the Houthis in Yemen, and Shia militias in both Syria and Iraq.

"Drones have worked well for Iran, from Yemen to Iraq and Syria to Lebanon. A sanction-stricken country like Iran, without its many missiles and numerous drones, cannot project power and implement deterrence measures thousands of kilometers away."

After the embargo is lifted "Iran's arms shopping list will include missile defence systems, fighter jets and submarines."

**SCW says closely watching COVID situation**

**Reduce municipal fees for citizens in furnished housing: member**

A proposal has been tabled to reduce the Municipal fees of buildings and furnished apartment rented to Bahraini families in the Kingdom.

Raising this issue is Zeina Jassem, head of the Finance and Legal Committee in the Northern Municipal Council who also demanded to treat such families as "Bahraini families staying in housing owned by them."

As of now, Zeina said, citizens applying for such a reduction are turned back by the works ministry citing lack of provision

in the law.

Zeina, however, pointed out that the Municipalities Law per Article No. (49) of Clause (A) which deals with municipal fees on buildings and furnished rental apartments, and Item (B) on the percentage of fees cur-

rently do not excludes Bahraini families.

"So at present, it difficult to fulfil the desires of citizens."

"But, this is possible by amending some items in Articles (48) and (49) of the executive regulations.

As per the provisions of the Minister of Housing, Municipalities and Environment Resolution No. (3) of 1999 regarding the reduction of municipal fees, "unfurnished buildings and apartments rented to Bahraini families equates to Bahraini families living in housing owned by them." However, furnished buildings and apartments, whose monthly rent exceeds 200 dinars per month, and rented to Bahraini families, even if it is their only housing, are not covered by the decision to reduce the municipal fees, and therefore they are obliged to pay a rate of 7 per cent to 7.5pc.

**Proposal made to amend building permit law on facade**

Northern Governorate Municipal Member has come up with a proposal to amend the building permit requirements regarding front walls in housing units.

The proposal, Municipal member Abdullah Mubarak Al-Qubaisi said, is for allowing citizens to build a room (majlis) or public facilities from the front wall of housing units, as the current construction areas are insufficient to meet the needs of many Bahraini families. Al-Qubaisi is the head of the technical committee and the representative of the ninth district in the northern governorate.

The front wall of a building

is currently the boundary of a property according to ownership document or contract, he said, adding that there are spaces or unbuilt areas that are usable for the families staying there.

Most of the housing projects are years old and with families staying there now having grown-up children, forcing them to expand their living areas.

The municipalities, however, are still demanding them to remove the additions, considering them as violations.

This decision constitutes a burden on these citizens, claimed Al Qubaisi.

He said that the proposal is to amend the building permit requirement regarding the front wall in housing units to support these citizens.

We need to look at their demands with compassion, especially considering the housing crisis and request backlogs.

Multiple families are now staying in the same house, which are more than twenty years old.

They are hard-pressed to find more space to uplift their life.

It is noteworthy that the Municipal Council, in its third regular meeting, decided to amend the building and licensing requirements regarding its front wall, which would contribute to meeting the needs of the Bahraini citizen.

# COVID-19 made us more wasteful?

44pc of the total waste produced in the Kingdom during the eight months from January to September are household wastes

**H**as COVID-19 and lockdowns made us more wasteful?

Like it or not, statistics and reports say so.

The latest news supporting this hypothesis is out here from Bahrain.

According to the Works, Municipalities Affairs, and Urban Planning, Bahrain is now facing two challenges, not because of COVID, but because of increased waste production, especially the household kind.

"Forty-four per cent of the total waste produced in the Kingdom during the eight months from January to September is household waste," said Essam Khalaf, the Ministry of Works, citing new data.

The situation also brings into play another challenge - the management and operation of Askar landfill, which is bulging in size every given day.

The phenomenon, however, is not specific to Bahrain but seen all over the world.

Experts say staying at home measures have swiftly increased people's waste generation capacity, which also thwarts all efforts to reduce pollution.

The blame is on the panic buying of single-use products, its production and consumption.

The challenge now is dealing with the mounting household waste and recycling it.

**Things, however, are not bleak as it looks.**

Bahrain, the Minister said, has made great strides in implementing many practical initiatives to control this menace.

"The ministry seeks to expand projects for managing the household waste of all kinds through initiatives and strategies that enable the disposal of these wastes and make use of them in the best way," said the Works Minister.

**So, how big is the issue?**

In Bahrain, it's size between the period from January to September is 1,021.759 million tons.

This pile includes wastes from the household, construction, industrial and agricultural sector.

The majority of them, however, as said, are from households, which comes to around 444,755 thousand tons.

Second, in line is Commercial and industrial sector. The sector

contributed 275,480 thousand tons of waste or 27pc of the total waste.

Closely following are construction sector with 239,254 thousand tons, or 24pc and agricultural sector with 55,947 tonnes, or 5pc of the total waste.

Khalaf said efforts are also progressing to extend the life of the landfill as well as digitising its management.

The Ministry, he said, is working to recycle demolition and construction waste by crushing and separating them, establish a new landfill utilising modern technology, recycle waste and convert it into energy. Efforts are also progressing on a facility for recycling green waste and converting it into fertilisers and recycling tires.

"These initiatives together will contribute effectively in facing the challenge of increasing waste," the Minister said.

**700 thousand tons per year**

Highlighting the laws in force for transporting the waste, the Minister said the Kingdom is issuing licenses for transporting waste in a bid to protect the public from illegal disposal of waste. The installation of a digital payment system at the landfill is yet

another move.

"These strategic initiatives have contributed to recycling 45pc of the total waste received at Askar landfill, which amounts to nearly one million and 700 thousand tonnes per year," the Minister pointed out.

Bahrain's "integrated waste management" processes, the Minister said, is in line with international health, environmental and technical standards and best practices, which include

collection, sorting, management, awareness and other initiatives.

"We are managing waste as per the best environmental and municipal practices followed globally," the Minister said adding the move aims at reducing the waste received at the landfill by sorting, recycling and re-using them at the source.

"This help to achieve a material return for the state and reduce operating expenses,"

The strategy also aims at enhancing the contribution of the private sector to achieve the highest rates of environmental sustainability, the Minister said.

## Priority for students safety, says Al Gharib of Education Ministry

Education ministry guidelines for school reopening ensure top-notch safety for students

● Social distancing ensured in classes

● Students will be in small fixed groups

**T**he education ministry has issued guidelines to facilitate the smooth functioning of schools amid the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic.

The guidelines enabled administrative, educational and technical staff to return to work as the Education Ministry moves on with the preparation for returning students to schools, said Khaled Al Gharib, Ministry's Financial Resources and Services Assistant Undersecretary.

The guidelines, he said, deal

with all scenarios including emergencies as well as the formation of health teams, implementation of health procedures, setting controls for receiving staff and students including checking their temperatures, ensuring social distancing, and continuous disinfection and sterilisation of facilities.

The guidelines are to ensure a safe learning environment and to help respond quickly in the event of any suspected case of virus infection.

In the event of a student contracting virus, procedures will allow staff to notify the competent authorities, isolate infected students and communicate with their parents.

Beside, classrooms are in a way that the distance between each student is not less than a meter-and-a-half.

Ministry guidelines explain the requirement for operating the transportation services provided by the education ministry,

including that for social distancing and bus disinfection.

Gharib explained that the Ministry had set procedures to sanitise buildings and facilities in schools and educational institutions using products approved by the competent authorities in the Kingdom.

"All classrooms, educational facilities and toilets, with a focus on places where the possibility of contact increases, such as door handles, chairs and tables will be subjected to disinfection by the end of the school day."

The Ministry, he said, has also filmed awareness-raising films on precautionary measures and remote workshops to train staff on dealing with the spread of the coronavirus, methods of transmission, and means of prevention.

Necessary measures are in place to prevent students from grouping together as they return for in-person classes.

The Ministry, Khaled Gharib

said, will make sure that students are in small and fixed groups within the school as they return for in-person classes.

"This is one of the most important ways to prevent Coronavirus transmission, as in the event of discovering an infection inside the school this would ensure effective tracking and establishing quick control."

Students in a particular group will not be allowed to mix with other groups, with the Ministry also allowing separate toilets for each group of students.

The same strategy will be followed for other staffs and cleaning workers, while also not allowing them to mix with students. Each school will determine paths for students to allow them to go directly to their classrooms without mixing with others as they enter the school.

Students will also be allowed to exit the school in successive batches with specific intervals determined by the school administration based on the number of students in a particular school.

Moreover, Bahrain has a proud tradition of respecting human rights and in these difficult times, this is critical. The stories of expat workers having their safety net pulled from under their feet are increasingly common. Many are made to sign away their unpaid dues in return for the chance to go back home and others are forced to live in basic conditions because employers no longer respect their responsibilities towards them.

When times were good, our expat brethren helped us to lay the foundation for our future. Now that times are challenging, let us join hands and build yet another future with them – one that is created from hope and good faith.

# Visit visas extended free of cost

NPRA extends the validity of visit visas until 21 January 2021

It is good tidings for visit visa holders in the Kingdom. Bahraini authorities are extending the validity of such visas until 21 January 2021 free of cost. Holders of such visas here are not required to pay any money for the extension which would happen automatically, said the Nationality, Passports and Residence Affairs in a statement.

Visit visa holders are also not required to submit any renewal applications through Bahrain's eVisa websites or any other ways. The move is as per a decision of the Coordination Committee

chaired by His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince, Deputy Supreme Commander and First Deputy Prime Minister. The authority explained that the latest decision aims at allow-

ing people to correct the status of their residency permits, or to facilitate their departure when flight operations return to normality.

The decision takes into account the current extensional circumstance due to the deadly outbreak, which has either restricted or suspended flight operations in countries around the world.

NPRA clarified that it granted several facilities to visitors and residents who have been in the Kingdom of Bahrain since the start of the pandemic.

The authority said it extended residency permits as well as visa validity for foreigners stranded in the Kingdom.

The authority has also exempted them from paying administrative fees they incurred as a result of the situation from a humanitarian standpoint.

## Three in the dock for stealing bank cards, money

Police arrested three men for stealing ATM cards and then withdrawing money from it, with the help of their accomplices abroad.

The Director-General of the General Administration of Anti-Corruption and Economic and Electronic Security said the suspects aged between 29 and 36 years are all Arab nationals. Police learned about the fraud after one of the companies operating in the field of credit cards filed a case accusing fraudulent operations on cards.

The company told police that they detected suspicious activities on a card from outside the Kingdom.

Further investigation led to identifying and arresting the two suspects,

who confessed to their crimes.

Officials are currently coordinating the International Criminal Police Organization (Interpol) to arrest the fourth suspect who is outside the Kingdom.

## 108 missions, 10,218 evacuees

The General Directorate for Ports Security announced carrying out 108 missions to evacuate 10,218 citizens and residents from abroad, since the outbreak of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic.

The directorate also carried out 188 missions to repatriate 19,757 residents in Bahrain to their respective countries, said Administrative Affairs Liaison Officer First Lieutenant Rashid Hamad Al-Dosary.

He was speaking during "Al Amn", a weekly programme broadcast on Thursdays on Radio Bahrain.

"The authority conducted COVID-19 tests for 91,029 passengers arrived in Bahrain", he said adding, they are also working to raise

the number of airport passengers from 1000 to 2000 daily.

A designated area is there for medical examination at Airport's reception hall to collect information on arriving passengers and to hold tests, he added.

Regarding the resumption of traffic on the King Fahd Causeway, Al-Dosary said they took exceptional measures to facilitate the movement of passengers in line with the required health protocols, adding that a comprehensive study is underway to restore cruise ships movement at seaports.

Al-Dosary urged citizens and residents planning to travel abroad via Bahrain International Airport to ensure first the procedures and conditions enforced at their destinations.

## One more COVID-19 death

Bahrain's health Ministry yesterday announced one more COVID-19 related death raising the total toll here in the Kingdom to 293.

A 76-year-old Bahrain man is the Kingdom's latest casualty.

There are currently 79 coronavirus infected patients receiving treatment in the Kingdom, of which 46 are critically ill.

The ministry also reported new 420 recoveries yesterday, taking the total number of people cured of their infections in the Kingdom to 73,841.

Health Ministry also conducted 8,143 tests yesterday to detect 246 new cases.

Amongst the newly detected cases in the Kingdom, 60 are expatriate workers, 183 are contacts of active cases, and three travel related.

The new tests also raised the total numbers of tests carried in the Kingdom, since its first case in February to 1,607,692.

## Moody's downgrades UK as COVID-19 and Brexit hit debt outlook

Ratings agency Moody's cut the United Kingdom's debt rating on Friday over the huge economic hit from the coronavirus crisis, Brexit and the lack of clear budget plans from Prime Minister Boris Johnson's government.

Moody's lowered the rating to “Aa3” from “Aa2,” putting Britain on the same level as Belgium and the Czech Republic.

The world's sixth-biggest economy shrank by the most among Group of Seven nations in the second quarter and its public debt has topped 2 trillion pounds (\$2.6 trillion), surpassing 100 per cent of gross domestic product.

Moody's said Britain's growth had been “meaningfully weaker than expected and is likely to remain so in the future.”

Britain faced a sharper peak-to-trough contraction than any other Group of 20 economy due to the severity of its COVID-19 outbreak, the size of its services sector, hammered by social-distancing rules, and the risk of further outbreaks, it said.

The downgrade was another blow for Johnson who is under fire from opposition parties and lawmakers in his Conservative Party for his handling of the pandemic, which has killed more people in Britain than anywhere in Europe.

## Putin and Saudi crown prince discuss OPEC+ agreements and coronavirus

Russian President Vladimir Putin and Saudi Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman discussed energy markets and the implementation of agreements by the oil producers group known as OPEC+, the Kremlin said in a statement yesterday.

“Both sides have reiterated their willingness to continue close coordination in this area in order to maintain stability on the global energy market,” it said.

The two leaders also discussed cooperation in combating the spread of coronavirus infections and the prospect of using the Russian vaccine Sputnik V in Saudi Arabia.

## Turkey lifts Black Sea gas field estimate after new find: Erdogan

Turkey has raised the estimated reserves in a gas field off its Black Sea coast to 405 billion cubic metres after finding an additional 85 billion cubic metres, President Tayyip Erdogan said yesterday.

Erdogan said in August the field contained 320 billion cubic metres of gas, making it Turkey's biggest natural gas discovery.

The Fatih drill ship made the discovery about 100 nautical miles north of the Turkish coast. Even before Saturday's revision, analysts had said that the find represents a major discovery and was one of the largest global discoveries in 2020.

“Work in this borehole has been completed after reaching a depth of 4,775 metres as planned previously,” Erdogan said, speaking onboard the Fatih.

He said the vessel would start new operations in a different borehole in the same field, called Sakarya, next month after returning to port for maintenance. Another ship, called Kanuni, is also headed to the Black Sea for drilling opera-

tions, he said.

## 320bn

Erdogan said in August the field contained 320 billion cubic metres of gas, making it Turkey's biggest natural gas discovery.

If the gas can be commercially extracted, the discovery could transform Turkey's dependence on Russia, Iran and Azerbaijan for energy imports.

Turkey expects the first gas flow from field in 2023. One source close to the matter said an annual gas flow of 15 billion cubic metres was envisaged from 2025.

Ankara expects gas suppliers to offer more competitive pricing and flexibility if they want to

renew long-term contracts totalling 16 billion metres per year.

More than a quarter of Turkey's long-term gas contracts expire next year, including imports via pipeline from Russia's Gazprom and Azerbaijan's SOCAR and a liquefied natural gas (LNG) deal with Nigeria.

Turkey has also been exploring for hydrocarbons in the Mediterranean, where its survey operations in disputed waters have drawn protests from Greece and Cyprus.

Greece and Cyprus pushed for a tougher response to Turkey's natural gas exploration in contested waters at a European Union summit on Friday, but were essentially told to hold off until a meeting in December.

Erdogan said on Saturday that the EU had become “captive” to Greece and Greek Cypriots in the dispute over natural resources in the eastern Mediterranean and this had damaged the bloc.

“If the EU does not hold an unbiased stance in existing disputes in the eastern Mediterranean, this situation will be the official declaration of the end of the European Union,” he said.

## Jet Airways creditors agree to new owners after months of talks

India's Jet Airways would be acquired by an investor consortium under a multi-million dollar resolution plan approved by the carrier's creditors yesterday.

The plan submitted by a consortium of London-based Kalrock Capital and UAE-based businessman Murari Lal Jalan comes after months of talks over the airline's future and was confirmed in a regulatory filing, which gave no details of the deal.

A source close to the situation said the new owners had agreed to pump in 10 billion rupees (\$136 million) as working capital for the revival of the airline. Another 10 billion rupees will be given to creditors over a period of five years.

Financial creditors of the airline will also get 10 per cent stake in the company, the source said though the plan remains subject to approvals.

# Lebanon's biggest Christian party says won't back Hariri

Lebanon's largest Christian political party said it would not back the nomination of former Prime Minister Saad Al-Hariri to lead a government

● Hariri could still secure a parliamentary majority if Hezbollah and Amal endorse him for premier

Lebanon's largest Christian political party said yesterday it would not back the nomination of former Prime Minister Saad Al-Hariri to lead a government to tackle a deep economic crisis, further complicating efforts to agree a new premier.

Hariri, who quit as prime minister last October in the face of nationwide protests, has said he is ready to lead a government to implement reforms proposed by France as a way to unlock badly needed international aid.

But Hariri, Lebanon's most prominent Sunni Muslim politician, has failed to win backing from the two main Christian parties — the Free Patriotic Movement (FPM) and Lebanese

Forces. Parliamentary consultations to name a new prime minister were due to be held last Thursday, but President Michel Aoun postponed the discussions after receiving requests for a delay from some parliamentary blocs. The FPM, which is led by Aoun's son-in-law Gebran Bassil, said it could not back a political figure such as Hariri because French President Emmanuel Macron's proposal had called for a reformist government made up of and led by

"specialists." As a result, the party's political council "decided unanimously not to nominate... Hariri to lead the government," a statement said, adding that Aoun's week-long postponement would not lead the party to reconsider its position. Hariri could still secure a parliamentary majority if the powerful Shiite group Hezbollah and its ally Amal endorse him for premier. But the absence of support from either of the main Chris-



The absence of support from either of the main Christian blocs would hand him at best a fragile mandate to tackle Lebanon's gravest crisis since the 1975-1990 civil war.

The country has plunged into financial turmoil and the value of the Lebanese pound has collapsed. COVID-19 and a huge explosion at Beirut's port two months ago have compounded the crisis and pushed many Lebanese into poverty.

Hariri, who has served twice as prime minister, resigned two weeks after huge protests erupted exactly a year ago.

### Tanzania says Kilimanjaro blaze contained

Last May, Church leaders in Poland referred Janiak to the Vatican for judgement after a film by brothers Tomasz and Marek Sekielski purported to show that Janiak failed to take action against priests who were known to have abused children.

Officers went to an apartment in the city's Donaustadt district where they arrested a woman who had self-inflicted injuries.

### An International Criminal Court delegation is to

visit Sudan to discuss the cases of ousted president Omar al-Bashir and other former officials, the government said. The delegation, led by prosecutor Fatou Bensouda, will discuss "cooperation" with Sudan over the wanted men, the government said in a statement. The court said Bensouda and a delegation would be in Khartoum for a few days, for the court's first visit since Bashir was ousted.

## Biden edges Trump in TV ratings for dueling town halls

Former Vice President Joe Biden won a TV ratings battle with President Donald Trump as the two held competing town halls with voters just weeks ahead of the Nov. 3 election, according to Nielsen ratings data.

Biden averaged 15.1 million viewers during Thursday night's 90-minute discussion on Walt Disney Co's ABC broadcast network. Trump pulled in 13.5 million for his 60-minute event across Comcast Corp's broadcaster NBC and the company's MSNBC and CNBC cable channels.

For the one-hour period that both Trump and Biden were on the air, Biden averaged 14.3 million to Trump's 13.5 million. The primetime town halls were scheduled after cancellation of a debate that had been set for the same time. Trump pulled out of the debate after it was changed to a virtual format.

## Tens of thousands of Thais protest in defiance of ban

Tens of thousands of Thai pro-democracy protesters rallied across Bangkok yesterday, defying an emergency decree banning gatherings for a third consecutive day to demand the resignation of the prime minister and reform of the powerful monarchy.

Police had used water cannon against peaceful demonstrators on Friday but protesters said they were not cowed by the escalation in tactics.

"I'm concerned for my safety but if I don't come out, I have no future," said business student Min, 18, equipped with a helmet and gas mask as she arrived in Bangkok's northern Lat Phrao district yesterday, one of several protest venues across the city.

Flooding a massive intersection, protesters raised a three-finger salute adopted from the dystopian "Hunger Games" films as passing vehicles honked in support and flashed a thumbs-up at the mostly black-clad protesters.

## French police arrest nine after teacher beheaded in street

French police have arrested nine people after a suspected extremist beheaded a school teacher on the street of a Paris suburb on Friday, police sources said.

Investigators were trying to establish whether the attacker, who was shot dead by police, had acted alone or had accomplices. French media reported that he was an 18-year-old of Chechen origin.

His victim, a history teacher, had earlier this month shown his pupils cartoons of the Prophet Mohammed in a civics class on freedom of expression.

President Emmanuel Macron called the incident a "terrorist attack."

Four relatives of the attacker, including a minor, were detained in the immediate hours after the attack in the middle-class suburb of Conflans-Sainte-Honorine, the police sources said.

Five more were detained overnight, among them two parents of pupils at the College du Bois d'Aulne where the teacher was employed.

Muslim leaders condemned the killing, which many public figures perceived as an attack on the essence of French statehood and its values of secularism, freedom of worship and freedom of expression.

Tareq Oubrou, the imam of a Bordeaux mosque, denied the killing marked a clash of civilizations.

# Azerbaijan vows retaliation for deadly strike on civilians

Azerbaijan says 12 civilians killed by shelling in Ganja, accuses Armenia

More than 40 were wounded in the missile attack

Azerbaijan's President Ilham Aliyev vowed yesterday to take revenge on Armenia after a missile strike killed 12 sleeping people in the city of Ganja, a dramatic escalation in the conflict over the disputed Nagorno-Karabakh region.

The early hours attack, which also saw a strike on the nearby strategic city of Mingecevir, came hours after Azerbaijani forces shelled Stepanakert, the capital of the ethnic Armenian separatist region.

The explosions in Ganja levelled a row of houses and left at least 40 people injured in an attack Aliyev described as "a war crime".

He said his army would "take revenge on the battlefield" and promised to capture Karabakh by driving out Armenian forces "like dogs".

## 'Our pain is deep'

As the sun rose over the devastation in Ganja, Mayil Shakhnazarov, 36, said it was impossible to identify some of those killed.

"What can we say? Our pain is deep. Really deep," he told AFP.

The seeming tit-for-tat attacks further undermine international efforts to calm a resurgence of fighting between Christian Ar-

menians and Muslim Azerbaijanis and avoid drawing regional powers Russia and Turkey into a conflict that has killed hundreds of people.

An AFP team in Ganja saw rows of houses in Ganja turned to rubble by the strike, which shattered walls and ripped roofs off buildings in the surrounding streets.

People ran outside in shock and tears, stumbling through dark muddy alleys in their slippers, some wearing bathroom robes and pyjamas.

agreed between Armenia and Azerbaijan in Moscow last week "must be fully respected without delay".

"The European Union deplores the strikes on the Azerbaijani city of Ganja during the night of 16-17 October resulting in civilian loss of life and serious injury," said a spokesperson for EU foreign affairs chief Josep Borrell.

"All targeting of civilians and civilian installations by either party must stop."

The attack came six days after a missile struck another residential part of the city of more than 300,000 people, killing 10 civilians and leaving many on edge.

## India's DGCA warns travel agents to refund flyers

Indian government warned travel agents not to delay giving refunds to passengers in cases where the money has been paid back by airlines to them. Also in such cases, agents have been directed not to give travel vouchers for future use to passengers.

If agents still resort to these malpractices, then the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) will initiate action against them for violation of the Supreme Court's October 1, 2020, judgment on re-refunds for flights cancelled during the pandemic, say officials.

The regulator on Friday issued an order saying that as per the SC directives, "it is the obligation of travel agents to immediately transfer refund to passenger once the same is received by such travel agent from airlines. Withholding of such refunded amount, by travel agents, in any manner what-so-ever, would amount to gross and blatant violation SC directions."

The DGCA notes that "in certain cases airlines have already refunded fare amount to travel agent(s) but travel agent(s) are withholding the said refund amount and are not re-

funding the same to the passengers... certain travel agents though have received the refund from airline but instead of refunding it to passengers, are issuing vouchers to such passengers on their own and thus indirectly withholding the refund amount with them."

While travel agents do not directly come under the DGCA, it can report violation of SC order and initiate action for contempt of court against the ones flouting the same. To avoid this situation, the regulator has asked travel agents and all other stakeholders to strictly comply with the Supreme Court's October 1, 2020 judgment on airfare refunds. The apex court directed DGCA to ensure strict compliance of its directions.

## Republican Senator appears to mock Kamala Harris' name at Trump rally

Republican US Senator David Perdue appeared to mock Kamala Harris at a rally for President Donald Trump in the battleground state of Georgia on Friday, repeatedly mispronouncing the vice presidential nominee's name.

Harris, a US senator from California, is the daughter of immigrants from India and Jamaica. Former Vice President Joe Biden named Harris as his running mate in August, making her the first Black woman and first Asian American to join a major party's presidential ticket.

She has said her name should be pronounced "com-ma-la."

Perdue, who is in a closely fought battle for re-election to the senate against Democrat Jon Ossoff, spoke ahead of Trump in the central Georgia city of Macon on Friday evening.

Video of his speech shows Perdue repeatedly making exaggerated attempts to pronounce the name before saying, "I don't know, whatever." The crowd responds with laughter.

Ossoff tweeted that Perdue would not have mocked a fellow senator who was male or white.

Sabrina Singh, a spokeswoman for Harris, took to Twitter on Friday to respond. "Well that is incredibly racist," she wrote.

## Trump slams Republican critic who warned of November 'bloodbath'

US President Donald Trump yesterday attacked a long-time congressional critic who warned this week that his handling of the coronavirus pandemic and authoritarian leaders could cause a "Republican bloodbath in the Senate" in the Nov. 3 elections.

US Senator Ben Sasse is the least effective of the 53 Republican senators, Trump wrote on Twitter, calling him "a liability to the Republican Party, and an embarrassment to the Great State of Nebraska. Other than that, he's just a wonderful guy."

Sasse criticized Trump in a town hall with constituents on Wednesday, and questioned whether the president would ultimately drive the country further to the left.

Trump "kisses dictators" and has "flirted with white supremacists," according to a transcript of the virtual town hall. Trump's leadership through the COVID-19 pandemic has not been "reasonable, or responsible, or right," Sasse said.

He added that Trump refused to take the coronavirus seriously for months and had treated it

like a news cycle rather than a multi-year public health challenge.

Sasse is a frequent critic of Trump, and said before the 2016 election he would not endorse him. However, he has voted in line with Trump's positions in Congress nearly 87% of the time, according to a tally of votes through Sept. 24 by the

Senate Republicans are battling to keep their 53-47 majority in the election. Recent polling by Reuters/Ipsos shows Democratic challenger Mark Kelly pulling far ahead of Republican incumbent Martha McSally in Arizona, one of 10 states where Republican incumbents are vulnerable to being un-seated.

**Ibrahimovic's quickfire double gives Milan 2-1 derby win**

AC Milan's Zlatan Ibrahimovic, recently recovered from a COVID-19 infection, scored an early brace to secure a 2-1 win over neighbours Inter in the Serie A derby yesterday.

The 39-year-old Swedish striker put Milan in front after 13 minutes, tapping the ball in from the rebound after his penalty was saved by Samir Handanovic, and struck again three minutes later to give his side their first league win over their neighbours since January 2016.

Romelu Lukaku pulled one back for Inter in the 29th minute, the first Serie A goal Milan have conceded this season, and had a penalty revoked by VAR for offside in the second half.

Milan have won all four games in Serie A this season and lead with 12 points while Inter have seven after their first defeat.

The first half was an end-to-end affair but the pace dropped considerably in the second half as mis-takes crept in and the match became increasingly niggly.

# Liverpool denied derby win by VAR as Chelsea held in six-goal thriller

Liverpool denied by Everton and VAR in wild Merseyside derby draw

Liverpool were denied a cathartic victory against Premier League leaders Everton by VAR and Chelsea drew 3-3 with Southampton on another day of breathless drama in the English top-flight yesterday.

Manchester City beat Arsenal 1-0 as Pep Guardiola got the better of former assistant Mikel Arteta, while misfiring Manchester United prepared to take on Newcastle in the late kick-off.

Jurgen Klopp's champions were desperate to atone for their 7-2 mauling against Aston Villa before the international break but were forced to settle for a 2-2 draw after Jordan Henderson's late strike was chalked off for offside.

Everton, who have not beaten Liverpool since 2010, remain three points clear of their Merseyside rivals at the top of the table after a number of controversial calls went their way at

Goodison Park.

But Klopp was mystified that Henderson's potential winner in added time against 10-man Everton was ruled out for a barely perceptible offside decision against Sadio Mane.

He was also at a loss to explain how Everton goalkeeper Jordan Pickford had not been dismissed and had not conceded an early penalty for a knee-high challenge on Virgil van Dijk.

"There were a number of big moments in the game," said a baffled Klopp. "The only situation I saw back is the Henderson goal and I didn't see offside. The picture I saw is no offside, but it

was off-side because somebody decided it."

Everton manager Carlo Ancelotti was delighted with his side's performance, even though they were denied a fifth straight Premier League win.

"We competed with them," he said. "We were 1-0 down and equalised, 2-1 down and equalised. It was a good test and I have a good feeling."

"To know we can compete with the champions of the last season it gives us more confidence for the future."

Sadio Mane, who missed the Villa Park mauling after testing positive for coronavirus, put

Liverpool ahead in the third minute.

But the pivotal moment in the match came when Van Dijk was on the receiving end of a dangerous late lunge from Pickford inside the box minutes later.

However, no penalty was awarded after a VAR review because Van Dijk had been marginally off-side and Pickford was lucky to avoid a red card.

The Dutchman was substituted and his towering presence was missed at the other end as Michael Keane equalised in the 19th minute.

Mohamed Salah put Liverpool back in front 18 minutes from

time but Dominic Calvert-Lewin netted his 10th goal of the season to pull Everton level again.

Richarlison was shown a straight red card for a dangerous tackle on Thiago Alcantara in the 90th minute and Everton were grateful for the intervention of VAR in the final seconds.

Chelsea looked to be in total control after cruising into a 2-0 lead against Southampton at Stamford Bridge, courtesy of new signing Timo Werner's first Premier League goals.

But a goal from Danny Ings shortly before half-time and a second-half strike from Che Adams wiped out their lead.

Frank Lampard's side rallied immediately to regain the lead, Werner teeing up Kai Havertz for a neat dinked finish to make it 3-2.

But Southampton were not to be denied and Jannik Vestergaard bludgeoned home an added-time equaliser for Saints from a free-kick that Chelsea failed to clear.

Lampard said his side had to tighten up at the back after conceding three goals for the second time this season.

"We are seeing lots of goals across the league and no manager is happy" he said.

"I don't know why it is. There are attacking players in this league and maybe pre-season and lack of working time plays a part. But we have to get better at it."

## Dhawan hits first IPL ton to keep Delhi top of the table

Shikhar Dhawan hit his first Indian Premier League century yesterday as Delhi Capitals beat Chennai Super Kings to go back top of the table.

South African veteran AB de Villiers produced another blistering batting display meanwhile to take Royal Challengers Bangalore to victory over Rajasthan Royals and keep them in the playoff race.

India opener Dhawan batted through the Delhi innings as they chased Chennai's 179-4 in which Faf du Plessis made 58 and Ambati Rayudu an unbeaten 45.

Dhawan made 101 off 57 balls with 14 fours and one six but his partners Shreyas Iyer (23) and Marcus Stoinis (24) hit the boundaries that kept Delhi in the hunt. The surprise IPL contenders needed 15 off the last over and it was spin bowler Axar Patel who blasted three sixes to secure the win with a ball to spare.

"It feels very special," said the 34-year-old.

"At the start of the season also I was hitting the ball well but I wasn't converting those 20s into 50s. Once you do that, you take that confidence into the next game."

Delhi now lead reigning champions Mumbai Indians by two points while M.S. Dhoni's three-time winners Chennai have only three wins from nine games and are slumbering in

seven wicket victory that kept Virat Kohli's side in fourth place and the final playoff spot.

The 36-year-old's latest power hitting left both sides in awe. He hit three straight sixes off the penultimate over by Jaydev Unadkat and overtook the target 177-6 with another six off Jofra Archer with two balls to spare. Bangalore made 179 for three with Kohli also making 43.

"I said to a few of the Rajasthan boys, I know you lost but sometimes it doesn't matter which side you're on, you can only go wow," said de Villiers' South African teammate Chris Morris.

India coach Ravi Shastri said this week that de Villiers should

come out of his international retirement. After a 55 off 24 balls in a win over Mumbai and a devastating 73 off 33 balls against Kolkata, de Villiers now has the IPL's best strike rate and only Sanju Samson is up with his 19 sixes.

De Villiers said he was always "very nervous" going into such a run chase. "I try to hide it. I get very stressed. I'm proud of my performances. Want to perform for my team, have an impact to win games."

Bangalore coach Simon Katich called de Villiers a "freak" but knows he will need more sixes from the South African if the team are to win their first IPL title.

## Lewandowski, Mueller doubles send Bayern second with Bielefeld win

Robert Lewandowski and Thomas Mueller both scored twice as Bayern Munich banished their early-season blues with a thumping 4-1 win over Bundesliga minnows Arminia Bielefeld yesterday after a "crazy" first half.

Treble winners Bayern started the day in mid-table following a shock defeat to Hoffenheim last month, but victory in Bielefeld was enough to propel them back up to second place.

The champions burst out of the blocks and had an early penalty appeal turned down

before Mueller bundled in the opener on eight minutes.

Spanish champions Real Madrid suffered a shock 1-0 loss at home to promoted Cadiz yesterday, their first La Liga defeat in over seven months.

Honduran forward Anthony Lozano put Cadiz ahead in the 16th minute, darting between Madrid defenders Sergio Ramos and Raphael Varane to meet a cushioned header from Alvaro Negredo and lifting the ball over keeper Thibaut Courtois into the net.

Madrid coach Zinedine Zidane made four substitutions at halftime in a bid to turn the game around and brought on Luka Jovic later on, the Serbian striker soon putting the ball in the net but seeing his effort ruled out for a clear offside.

Vinicius Jr missed the target with a free header, while Karim Benzema struck the bar

from the edge of the area and Cadiz clung on to claim their first league win over Madrid since 1991 and their first ever away win against them.

The shock victory took Cadiz up to second in the league, level on 10 points with Madrid, who visit Barcelona next week in the 'Clasico'.

## Abdouraguimov takes on Glismann in the co-main event of BRAVE CF 44


