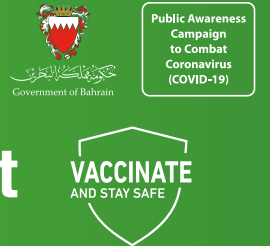

The Cabinet has reviewed the effectiveness of government programmes aimed at achieving fiscal balance and self-sufficiency as the first step towards the development and sustainability of national wealth and resources. This was part of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa's address at the opening of the National Assembly fifth legislative term's fourth session. The weekly Cabinet meeting

was chaired by Deputy Prime Minister, His Highness Shaikh Mohammed bin Mubarak Al Khalifa, yesterday at Gudaibiya Palace. It commended HM King's address and highlighted the national message it carried particularly in defining the future priorities and foundations for national action. The Cabinet highlighted His Majesty's praise for the continuous development of the government's performance and its

adoption of the latest administrative and technical practices, in particular the improved oversight of the quality of services provided to citizens and residents as well as raising the efficiency and fairness of the distribution of government support. It also includes the government's interest in improving the skillset of the national workforce, taking care of youth issues, and supporting the further empowerment of Bahraini women.

The Cabinet noted HM King's address on the success of the Alternative Sanctions Programme in achieving its objectives. It emphasised prioritising His Majesty's directives to start implementing the executive mechanisms and the necessary infrastructure for reform centres and open prisons. The Cabinet also stressed the importance of further strengthening cooperation with the legislative authority in reviewing priority legislation to contribute to securing an environment that supports development and achieves the citizens' aspirations. The Cabinet congratulated HM the King, and His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, and the citizens of Bahrain and the Arab and Islamic Ummah's on the anniversary of Prophet Mohammed's birthday. Human rights achievements

Royal directives to adopt open prisons programme praised

Cairo

Bahrain has attained many widely-recognised human rights achievements thanks to His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa's directives. This was emphasised by Arab Parliament Speaker Adel bin Abdulrahman Al Asoomi who highlighted the package of initiatives adopted by the kingdom to consolidate the human rights principles thanks to HM the King's direct support for the state of law and institutions. Al Asoomi was speaking while chairing the inaugural meeting of the second session of the third legislative term of the Arab Parliament, held at the AP's headquarters in Cairo yesterday. He indicated the steady development of the human rights system in the kingdom, in line with HM the King's directives to begin putting in place the necessary executive mechanisms to adopt the programme of reform-

and open prisons, which, he said, represents a pioneering quantum leap resulting from a civilised and enlightened mindset in the field of human rights. He also shed light on other initiatives currently implemented by the kingdom, such as the alternative sentencing system and the restorative justice for children, which are consistent with the highest international standards of human rights, and have a humanitarian dimension, which strengthens the kingdom's status in this field. MP Mamdooh Al Saleh, a member of the Arab Parliament, praised the progress witnessed by the AP, through the establishment of centres and mechanisms that support its work, as one of the main regional and international institutions. He lauded HM the King's directives to put in place the necessary executive mechanisms for the open prisons pro-

gramme, noting that the scheme represents a quantum leap in the field of human rights, and confirms Bahrain's leadership in it. MP Al Saleh affirmed that Bahrain attaches great importance to human rights, as reflected in the implementation of the alternative sentencing system and the adoption of the Restorative Justice for Children law, in addition to the quick response of Interior Minister, General Shaikh Rashid bin Abdulla Al

Khalifa, to the royal directives to set up the executive regulations for the open prison system. He said the protection of human rights is a national policy, and everyone is keen on its success and on the establishment of new humanitarian principles that reflect HM the King's fatherly and humane sense. The session also featured the inauguration of the Arab Centre for Combating Terrorism and Extremist Ideology.

3. A memorandum by the Ministerial Committee for Legal and Legislative Affairs regarding the government's responses to two proposals submitted by the Council of Representatives and a proposal for a law submitted by the Shura Council.

The Cabinet reviewed the fol-

lowing topics:

1. A memorandum by the Minister of Finance and National Economy regarding the preliminary performance indicators of the Future Generation Reserve Fund for the six months ending 30 June 2021. The indicators reflect the efficiency and effectiveness of the Future Generations Reserve's investment policy and its continued success despite the repercussions presented by the COVID-19 pandemic.

2. A memorandum by the Minister of Health regarding the Ministry's health and cli-

mate change pledges in line with the Kingdom of Bahrain's international commitments and its active role in climate action and the development of the national health system.

The Cabinet took note of the ministerial reports, including the outcomes of the visit to Kazakhstan; 21st virtual ministerial meeting of the OPEC + group; the visit to the Middle East Rail 2021 exhibition and conference in the UAE; and participation in the World Health Organisation's 68th session of the Regional Committee for the Eastern Mediterranean.

The healthy doses of international news about Bahrain this month regarding its COVID-19 status is a remarkable testament to the Kingdom's efficacy in confronting the pandemic.

Ten days ago, the Nikkei's COVID-19 Recovery Index for September ranked Bahrain as the world's second-best country in terms of COVID recovery

by calculating a score between 0 and 90 based on nine factors divided into three categories – infection management, vaccine rollouts, and mobility. Bahrain scored 72%, only one point behind leader Malta.

On October 8, the Council of the European Union recommended that Bahrain should be added to the list of countries for which travel restrictions should be lifted

The recommendation by the Council was another testament to Bahrain's successful policy in confronting the pandemic.

On October 9, the German Ambassador to Bahrain Kai Boeckmann announced that "in view of the low numbers of infections in Bahrain, starting from 10 October 2021, 00.00 h, Germany will allow travellers from Bahrain who hold a valid visa to enter Germany for all normally permitted purposes, including tourism, and regardless of their vaccination status."

On October 14, Indonesia said that vaccinated tourists from Bahrain and 18 other countries can now travel to Bali and Riau Islands. Some of Indonesia's closest

neighbours were not on the list.

On October 15, Sweden said that it had amended its entry ban to exempt residents of Bahrain and the UAE. The Swedish government would enter into force on October 19.

Bahrain's multiple successes are attributed to the deep commitment of the leadership and people since the early days to facing a looming and ominous enemy with the sense that everyone should play their part in protecting and serving the nation.

The mission has been anchored in deep trust and full

Export of national products up 76%

The export of Made-in-Bahrain products jumped 76% during the third quarter of 2021, said the latest foreign trade report, which also reports a 99.8% improvement in the trade balance.

Third-quarter trade balance - the difference between exports and imports - recorded a deficit of BD1 million, compared to BD335 m in the same quarter a year ago.

National origin export rise

The data published by the Information & eGovernment Authority reports the value of exports of national origin as BD1.174 billion, compared to BD669 m for the same quarter of the previous year. The top 10 countries purchased from Bahrain accounted for 73% of the total value, with the remaining countries accounting for 27%.

Saudi ranked first by importing BD236 m worth of national origin products from Bahrain.

The United States of America was second with BD211 m and the United Arab Emirates third with BD108 m.

Unwrought aluminium alloys emerged as the top products exported at BD382 m, agglomerated iron ores and concentrates were second with a value of BD250 m, and Unwrought aluminium (not alloyed) third with BD63 m.

Imports increased 16%

Meanwhile, the value of imports increased by 16%, reaching BD1.349 bn during Q3, compared to BD1.166 bn in the year-ago quarter.

The top 10 countries accounted for 70% of imports and the remaining countries 30%.

Brazil ranked first with a total value of 214 m, China was second with BD167 m, and the United Arab Emirates was third with BD95 m.

Non-agglomerated iron ores

and concentrates emerged as the top product imported into Bahrain, with a total value of BD249 m. Aluminium oxide was second with BD80 m, and parts for aircraft engines were third with BD52 m.

Four-wheelers top re-exports

The third-quarter total value of re-exports increased by 22% to reach BD175 m, compared to BD143 m in the same quarter a year ago. The top 10 countries accounted for 84% of the re-exported value, while the remaining countries accounted for 16%. Saudi Arabia ranked first with BD53 m, the United Arab Emirates second with BD50 m, and Singapore third with BD11 m.

Four-wheel drive cars emerged as the top product re-exported from Bahrain with BD20 m, Gold ingots came in second place with BD17 m, and parts for aircraft engines came third with BD15 m.

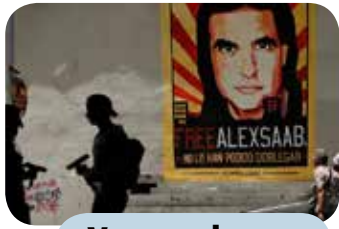

Texas trucker convicted in fiery, fatal crash in Rocky Mountains

A Texas truck driver who lost control of his semi-trailer along a Colorado mountain highway in 2019, ramming into stopped traffic and killing four people in a fiery crash, was convicted late Friday of vehicular homicide and related charges.

Rogel Lazaro Aguilera-Mederos, 25, was convicted by a Jefferson County, Colorado, jury of four counts of homicide and more than two dozen other charges, including vehicular assault, reckless driving and careless driving resulting in death.

He will be sentenced on Dec. 13 and could face decades in prison.

Prosecutors said during the trial that Aguilera-Mederos knew his brakes were failing as he descended Interstate 70, west of Denver, on April 15, 2019. The prosecutors said he bypassed four runaway-truck ramps along the interstate and recklessly weaved in and out of traffic before crashing and triggering a 28-car pileup.

The tractor-trailer, which was hauling lumber, burst into flames, igniting a fireball that engulfed more than two dozen vehicles, and shut down Interstate 70, the main east-west highway through the Colorado mountains, for more than a day.

Aguilera-Mederos took the stand in his own defence, testifying that he was unable to control the rig once its brakes failed, and saying he tried to avoid hitting other vehicles.

He admitted that he had not driven in the Colorado mountains before, and said he "wished it had been me" who died instead of the victims.



No end in sight to volcanic

There's no immediate end in sight to the volcanic eruption that has caused chaos on the Spanish isle of La Palma since it began about a month ago, the president of the Canary Islands said yesterday.

There were 42 seismic movements on the island on Sunday, the largest of which measured 4.3, according to the Spanish National Geographical Institute.

"There are no signs that an end of the eruption is imminent even though this is the greatest desire of everyone," President Angel Vic-

Up to 17 US missionaries and family kidnapped in Haiti

As many as 17 American Christian missionaries and their families, including children, were kidnapped on Saturday by gang members in Haiti's capital of Port-au-Prince, US media reported.

The kidnapping happened after the missionaries left an orphanage in the crisis-engulfed Caribbean nation, the *New York Times* and *CNN* said.

The *Washington Post* reported that an audio from

the Ohio-based Christian Aid Ministries said "men, women and children" associated with the group were being held by an armed gang.

"The mission field director and the American embassy are working to see what can be done," the audio was quoted as saying. "Pray that the gang members will come to repentance and faith in Jesus Christ."

The victims included 14 adults and three minors, *CNN* said, citing an unnamed source in Haiti's security forces.

Draft 'Asterix' story revealed by author's daughter

The daughter of Rene Goscinny, one of the duo behind indomitable French comic-book star Asterix, has revealed that her father left a draft story featuring the Roman-bashing Gaulish warrior unfinished.

"I often think about it, it's 20 pages, half a comic book," Anne Goscinny told German weekly *Der Spiegel* in a week-end interview.

Typewritten by Rene Goscinny, the script titled "Asterix at the Circus" was found in the family archives, looked after by Anne.

But she said that completing the story without her father would be a "very complicated" task.

"We'd have to get a lot of



people around the table, immerse ourselves in the story and find (Rene's) voice again," she said, adding, "it's as if there were a hole in a painting by Goya".

"One day we'll give it a try, it would be an extraordinary adventure," Anne added.

Asterix -- defender of the last Gaulish village holding out against the Roman empire -- was dreamed up in 1959 by Rene Goscinny, who died in 1977, and Albert Uderzo, who died last year.

Convicted murderer Robert Durst is on ventilator

Real estate heir Robert Durst, who was sentenced this week to life in prison for murdering a friend in 2000, has COVID and is on a ventilator, his lawyer told the Los Angeles Times.
Durst, who appeared sickly

during his sentencing on Thursday, "looked worse than I've ever seen him," lawyer Dick De-

Guerin told the Times.
It was not clear where Durst, 78, is being treated. During his trial, he was being held in the USC Medical Center under the custody of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department.
Durst's sentencing for the 2000 murder of Susan Berman was long-delayed punishment for a man who mostly evaded the law for more than 39 years.
A multimillionaire whose grandfather founded one of New York City's premier real estate companies, Durst was long a suspect but never charged in the disappearance of his wife Kathleen McCormack, who went missing in New York in 1982.
Last month a jury found Durst guilty of shooting Berman, 55, in the back of the head at her Beverly Hills home. The jury also found him guilty of the special circumstances of lying in wait and killing a witness, which carry a mandatory life sentence without the possibility of parole.
Evidence from the trial indicated Berman helped provide Durst with a false alibi in McCormack's disappearance. Prosecutors alleged that Durst killed Berman because he feared she would reveal what she knew to authorities.

100 F-35 jets, made by Lockheed Martin Corp, but the US removed Turkey from the programme in 2019 after it acquired Russian S-400 missile defence systems.

The decades-old partnership between the NATO allies has gone through unprecedented tumult in the past five years over disagreements on Syria policy, Ankara's closer ties with Moscow, its naval ambitions in the eastern Mediterranean, US charges against a state-owned Turkish bank and erosion of rights and freedoms in Turkey.

Ankara's purchase of the S-400s has also triggered US sanctions. In December 2020, Washington blacklisted Turkey's Defence Industry Directorate, its chief, Ismail Demir, and three other employees.

Since then the US has repeatedly warned Turkey against buying further Russian weaponry. But Erdogan has indicated Ankara still intends to buy a second batch of S-400s from Russia, a move that could deepen the rift with Washington.

The request for the jets will likely have a difficult time getting approval from the US Congress, where sentiment towards Turkey has soured deeply over recent years.

There is bipartisan support in US Congress to push the Biden administration to put further pressure on Ankara, primarily over its purchase of Russian weapons and its human rights track record.

Grand Mosque in Mecca drops social distancing

The Grand Mosque in the holy city of Mecca in Saudi Arabia operated at full capacity yesterday, with worshippers praying shoulder-to-shoulder for the first time since the coronavirus pandemic began.

Workers removed floor markings that guide people to social distance in and around the Grand Mosque, which is built around the Kaaba.

"This is in line with the decision to ease precautionary measures and to allow pilgrims and visitors to the Grand Mosque at full capacity," reported the official Saudi Press Agency.

Pictures and footage yesterday morning showed people praying side by side, making straight rows of worshippers that are formations revered in performing prayers, for the

first time since the Covid-19 pandemic took hold last year.

While social distancing measures were lifted, the authorities said visitors must be fully vaccinated against coronavirus and must continue to wear masks on mosque grounds.

Also, the Kaaba remained cordoned off and out of reach.

Saudi Arabia announced in August it will begin accepting vaccinated foreigners wanting to make the umrah pilgrimage.

The umrah can be undertaken at any time and usually draws millions from around the globe, as does the annual hajj, which abled-bodied Muslims who have the means must perform at least once in their lifetime. In July, only around 60,000 inoculated residents were allowed to take part in a vastly scaled down form of the annual Hajj.

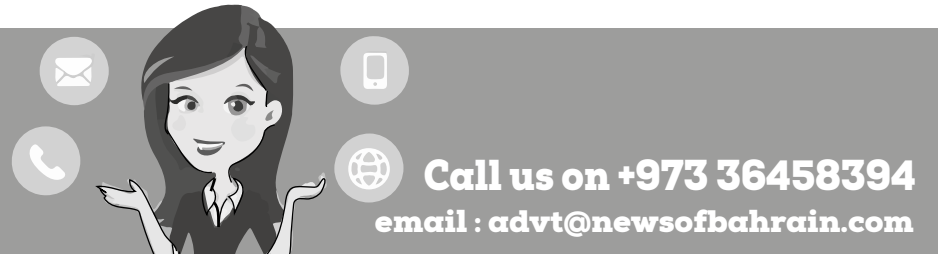

film will be dropped at DC FanDome on Saturday, October 16.

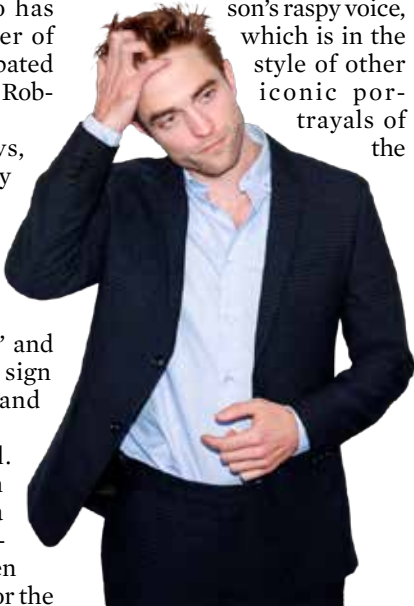
Several fans took to Twitter and shared their reactions, particularly to Pattinson's raspy voice, which is in the style of other iconic portrayals of the character.

Tuchel backs 'unselfish' Lukaku to end goal drought

Thomas Tuchel insists Chelsea striker Romelu Lukaku will end his worrying goal drought because he is so unselfish.

Signed in a club record £98 million (\$134 million) deal from Inter Milan, Lukaku looked unplayable as he scored four times in his first four games for the Champions League winners.

Basilashvili, Norrie set up Indian Wells final without Top 25

Britain's Cameron Norrie dominated Grigor Dimitrov 6-2, 6-4 on Saturday to book a title clash with Nikoloz Basilashvili at the ATP Indian Wells Masters.

The 26-year-old Norrie overpowered Dimitrov in their semi-final to become the first British finalist since 2009.

Norrie kept Dimitrov off guard with a strong serve, blasting four aces and hitting a number of precision forehands and backhands in the one hour, 27 minute match on the main stadium court in Southern California.

"I am so happy," said Norrie. "Unfortunately he didn't bring his best today.

"I was very solid. I went a lot to his backhand he was getting frustrated with that. I managed to serve well and in the big moments I executed when I needed to."

Several Brits have reached the final in the California desert without success, including Andy Murray, who lost to Rafael Nadal in 2009.

Tim Henman lost two finals in 2002 and 2004, and Canadian-born Briton Greg Rusedski was runner-up in 1998.

Norrie was born in Johannesburg, South Africa and grew up in New Zealand before becoming the No. 1 college player in America while attending university in Texas. He has represented Great Britain since 2013.

Norrie is seeking his second career title after winning earlier this year in Los Cabos.

"I'm looking forward to the match tomorrow and really looking forward to going out

and enjoying it again," he said.

He broke through in Los Cabos following a string of runner-up heartbreaks, including earlier this year in Estoril, Lyon and London.

"I've had some opportunities there to make the second week of a slam, but it's not gone my way," said Norrie who has never gone past the third round of a Grand Slam. "It's all been great learning for me.

"Hopefully with these results I can put myself in a higher seeding and maybe have some more chances."

Dimitrov was coming off a couple of upsets over top 10 seeded players. The Bulgarian battled back from a set down to beat top seed Daniil Medvedev

4-6, 6-4, 6-3 in the fourth round and outlasted eighth seeded Hubert Hurkacz in the quarter-finals 3-6, 6-4, 7-6 (7/2).

There were no players ranked in the top 25 in the world in the men's semi-finals. Norrie, at 26, was the highest ranked semi-finalists.

Norrie easily won the first set by breaking Dimitrov on three of four service games. He got the early break in the second then held to serve to wrap up his 46th win of the season.

Norrie clinched the match on the first match point when Dimitrov hit a backhand into the net.

Norrie is going up against another surprise finalist in the 29th seeded Basilashvili, who defeated American Taylor Fritz 7-6 (7/5), 6-3 to post one of the biggest wins of his career.

Basilashvili, of Georgia, is gunning for his third ATP title of the season after earlier triumphs in Doha and Munich.

Beijing flame to be lit in a vacuum in Olympia

The Olympic flame will once again be lit in an empty stadium on Monday as it starts its truncated journey to Beijing for the Winter Games in February.

Like the ceremony in March 2020 to light the flame for Tokyo, and like those Games, which were put back a year, Monday's ceremony is a victim of coronavirus restrictions.

"Due to the situation created by the Covid-19 pandemic, the Lighting Ceremony will be held in strict compliance with local health protocols," the Hellenic Olympic Committee announced in September.

The ceremony is conducted at the ruins of the Temple of Hera in Olympia, site of the ancient Greek games from eighth century BC to the fourth century AD.

Clear skies are forecast for 11.30 local time (0830 GMT) when the flame is due to be lit by the rays of the sun concentrated in a concave.

Priestess Xanthi Georgiou will light the torch from the flames.

Before the pandemic, the flame had been lit behind closed doors once, in 1984, when Greek organisers wanted to protest against the decision of the Los Angeles organisers to accept sponsorship of stretches of the torch relay in the United States.

This time the ceremony will be held in front of an audience

limited to the members of the

Olympic committees as well as the president of Greece, Katerina Sakellariopoulou, and vaccinated members of the media.

While Greek skiers will run the first and last legs, and a Chinese participant will also carry the torch in a brief relay, organisers have decided to skip the usual journey round the country.

"There will be no Torch Relay on Greek soil and following the Lighting Ceremony in Ancient Olympia the Olympic Flame will be transferred to the Acropolis where it will stay overnight," they said on October 12.

They said that on the next morning it would be carried to the Panathenaic Stadium in Athens, a second-century arena used in both the 1896 and 2004 Games, and handed over to the delegation from Beijing 2022 to be flown to China.
