The Coast Guard patrols successfully apprehended five individuals and confiscated a boat and a vehicle along the Damistan coast in a move to enforce fishing regulations and combat violations.

The arrests were made in connection with the possession of 210 kilograms of shrimp, a prohibited catch during the current period as per ministerial directives.

The Coast Guard Command disclosed that the apprehended vessel was found equipped with bottom trawl nets (carafes), highlighting additional violations related to public safety, residency laws, and labour market regulations. Legal proceedings are underway for referral to the Public Prosecution.
