## Modi says Trump did not mediate Pakistan ceasefire

The US president had claimed conflict ended after a long-night of talks

- Officials from **Islamabad and New** Delhi confirmed the ceasefire on May 10
- The last time Modi and Trump spoke was just after the April 22 attack on tourists
- Trump is expected to visit India for the next Quad alliance

ndian Prime Minister Narendra Modi told Donald Trump that the ceasefire between New Delhi and Pakistan last month was worked out directly, a top Indian diplomat said yesterday.

The US president had said that the two nuclear-armed neighbours had agreed to end a fourday conflict on May 10 after "a long night of talks mediated by the United States".

It was their worst standoff since 1999, with more than 70 people killed in missile, drone and artillery fire on both sides.

Officials from Islamabad and New Delhi confirmed the ceasefire on May 10, minutes after Trump posted the announcement on his Truth Social net-
