Sandra Bullock insists dealing with stalkers isn't a 'one off'

Sandra Bullock admits being stalked her turned her home into her “fortress”.

In 2014, the 61-year-old star was left terrified after a mentally unwell stalker broke into her house while she was there, and she’s still affected by the incident over a decade later.

She told Vanity Fair magazine: “It makes me think, Do I really have to go outside and navigate the world?”

“There’s the cases where they got into the house, the cases where they’re outside the house, the cases where you’re on a film set and they figured out where you are, and the cases that no one hears about.”

“It’s ongoing. It’s not a one-off. And it does create a mindset where your home also unfortunately becomes your fortress.”

Sandra’s close friend Jennifer Aniston, 56, was at home in May this year when a 48-year-old man - who has been accused of stalking, which he has denied - allegedly drove into her gate.

The Friends actress said: “People are out of their minds. Who wants to put that energy out there.”

She insisted her security team is “not glamorous in any way”, instead

describing it as “a necessity”. Sandra admitted the two friends encourage each other to leave the comfort of their own homes.

She admitted: “There’s a motivation of going, ‘Okay, we need to go somewhere. Where are we going?’”

Jennifer quipped: “I’m desperately trying not to Howard Hughes myself.”

The duo also try to help each other get over their fear of flying, as Sandra joked the pair look “pathetic” when they’re on a plane together.

She joked: “The two of us on a plane—it’s the most pathetic thing to look at. Usually it’s us grabbing each other’s arms from across the table with our heads down.”

For Jennifer, her own fears subside when her friends are scared in the same moment.

She revealed: “All of a sudden, my fear falls away and I get to take care of them.”

“When there’s someone in need of being calmed, I have such empathy for it that all of a sudden my fear goes out the window.”

Chris Hemsworth banned from surfing 40-foot wave

Chris Hemsworth was banned from surfing a 40-foot wave for his new TV show over fears he would drown.

The actor has filmed a follow-up to his 2022 National Geographic series Limitless - titled Limitless: Live Better Now - in which he takes on challenges including learning drums to perform with Ed Sheeran at a concert, training with Special Forces in South Korea to tackle his back pain and climbing 600-foot dam in the Swiss Alps - and Chris has now revealed he initially wanted to include a surfing stunt but it was deemed too risky.

He told The Hollywood Reporter: “I was going to attempt to surf

a 40-foot wave and train with big wave specialists, but we couldn’t get it through the ranks.

“The risk assessment, basically, was too far gone, so I ended up climbing a 200-meter dam wall.”

“They both have a fair amount of risk attached to them, but [the dam climb] got past the risk assessment team. So there definitely was [concern]: ‘No, we need him to go off and shoot Thor next. We can’t have him drown while filming a big wave episode’.”

George Clooney doesn't care if people think he only plays himself

George Clooney doesn’t “give a s***” about criticism of his acting.

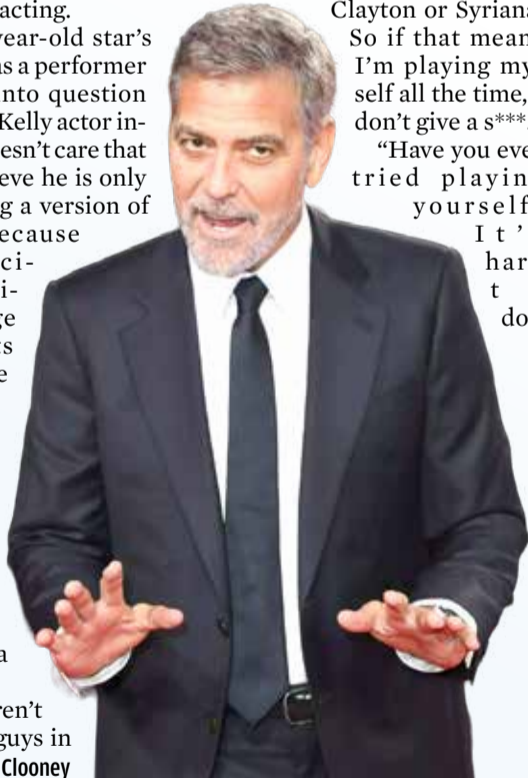
The 64-year-old star’s versatility as a performer has come into question but the Jay Kelly actor insisted he doesn’t care that people believe he is only ever playing a version of himself because he appreciates the diverse range of projects that come his way.

He told Vanity Fair magazine: “Do people say that I only play myself? I don’t give a s***.”

“There aren’t that many guys in

my age group that are allowed to do both broad comedies like *O Brother [Where Art Thou?]* and then do Michael Clayton or *Syriana*. So if that means I’m playing myself all the time, I don’t give a s***.”

“Have you ever tried playing yourself? It’s hard to do.”

Sharon Stone doesn't think Basic Instinct brought her 'respect'

Sharon Stone doesn’t think she received “respect” because of her infamous *Basic Instinct* scene.

The 67-year-old actress can be seen in one scene in the 1992 exposing her private area as her alter ego Catherine Tramell crosses her legs in front of Michael Douglas’ character Detective Nick Curran and other cops whilst she is interrogated, and while she noted the controversial moment “made [her] an icon”, she has mixed feelings about it.

She told *Business Insider*: “It made me an icon, but it didn’t bring me respect. But would I do it again? We don’t get to make these choices in life. I don’t participate in the fantasy world in this way.”

Sharon alleged in her 2021 autobiography, *The Beauty of Living Twice*, that she was

tricked into removing her underwear for the scene and hadn’t seen the footage until a screening of the movie, but she now understands why director Paul Verhoeven was “scared” to show it to her.

She said: “I very much believe that none of us knew at the time what we were getting in regard to that shot, and when Paul got it, he didn’t want to lose it, and he was scared to show me. And I get that.”

And despite her initial unhappiness, Sharon was happy to keep the scene in the movie because she understood its value.

She explained: “Once I had time to calm down, I didn’t make him take it out of the movie when I had the legal right to.”

“So I did have the chance to do it differently, and I didn’t because once I had the chance to step back, I understood, as the director, not the girl in the film, that that made the movie better.”

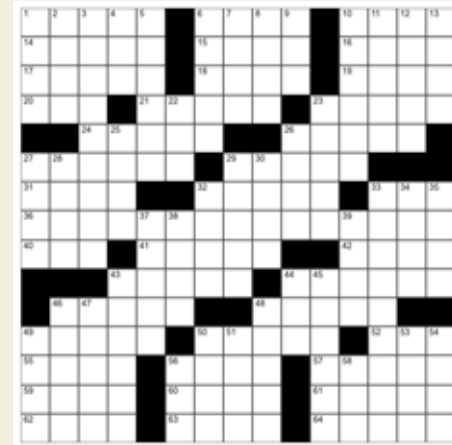
