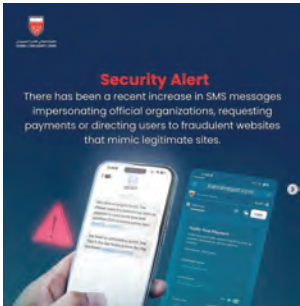


Bahrain greets Azerbaijan

Warning over rising text message scams

The National Cybersecurity Center has issued a warning about an increasing number of cyber fraud attempts targeting citizens and residents through text messages impersonating official entities.

Scammers are reportedly tricking recipients into paying fees or providing personal and banking information.

According to the center, these fraudulent messages often contain fake links designed to closely resemble official websites, with the aim of stealing sensitive information or gaining access to bank accounts.

Caution

Authorities stressed the importance of exercising caution and advised against interacting with such messages or clicking on suspicious links.

The center reiterated that government agencies never request personal or banking information via text messages.

Balancing Priorities

70-day maternity leave proposal gets rejected, reigniting debate on balancing work and family

● Proposal aimed to extend maternity leave to 70 days

● Officials cite economic and parity concerns

● Supporters moot hybrid model

Rejection of a proposal to extend private-sector maternity leave from 60 to 70 days by the government has reignited debate over how Bahrain should balance family welfare with workplace realities.

The proposal, tabled by MPs and inspired by neighbouring countries' reforms, was turned down on grounds that it could disrupt parity between the public and private sectors and burden smaller firms with added costs. Officials argued that the existing 60-day paid leave, set after medical and economic



studies, already strikes a fair balance between a mother's health needs and a company's operational requirements.

Equal footing

In its report to Parliament, the government said maintaining consistency across both sectors

was crucial to avoid creating uneven advantages. It warned that any increase without business support measures might discourage private companies from hiring women, undercutting long-term goals to raise female participation in the labour market.

Current law provides 60 days of paid leave and 15 additional days of unpaid leave, with job protection and nursing breaks included.

Regional balance

The proposed 70-day leave was modelled partly on Gulf

Bahrain's Labour Law (2012) guarantees 60 days of fully paid maternity leave (Article 32), plus up to 15 days unpaid.

peers such as Saudi Arabia, where extended provisions exist for mothers in specific sectors. Those in support of the 70-day leave plan point out that Bahrain could explore hybrid models that combine flexibility for employers with enhanced care time for mothers and newborns.

Government defends rights

Bill to bar domestic workers' job change rejected

The government says domestic workers are free to seek a new, independent work permit once their permit or contract ends.

It has told MPs a draft law to keep them in household service or send them home would breach rights in the Constitution and in treaties Bahrain has signed.

The bill would stop domestic permits being turned into other work permits. A worker would have to stay in a home job or leave the country.

Losses

Backers say this would spare citizens losses and stop staff being used in roles not agreed at the start.



Ministers say the plan sets a lasting ban on a whole class of workers even after they have met their duties under contract.

In their view, it limits the freedom to choose work and the freedom to contract. Both are protected by the Constitu-

tion and, they argue, may only be curbed in rare cases. Those grounds are not found here.

Notice

They add that ending or giving notice in a home job is often messy and hard to prove, unlike



the routine steps used in most workplaces.

That makes the draft model hard to use for this group.

Government data show that moves from domestic service into unlike trades are scarce.

Most happen after a permit or contract runs out, when the

worker stands in a new legal place and may lawfully seek an independent permit.

The paper also says the bill runs against the Labour Law for the Private Sector on equal treatment and non-discrimination, and against Bahrain's pledges under ILO Convention No. 111 on discrimination in work.

Warning

It warns of two sets of rules pulling in different directions between the Labour Market law and the Labour Law for the Private Sector, which would weaken efforts to keep the market fair, clear and workable.

The government closes by saying there is no clear need for new law here and that the draft places unjustified limits on work and job moves.

Bahrain Backs Just Transition

H.E. Shaikh Salman leads Arab call at World Bank meetings for a just, jobs-driven clean energy transition

- Call for orderly clean energy shift
- Stresses job creation and social stability
- Seeks World Bank backing for Gaza

Bahrain has called on the World Bank to support a just and orderly transition to clean energy that safeguards job creation and social

stability, as the Kingdom led the Arab Group and the Maldives in addressing global economic challenges at the 112th Development Committee meeting in Washington.

Delivering the statement, His Excellency Shaikh Salman bin Khalifa Al Khalifa, Minister of Finance and National Economy, said many nations continue to face structural constraints that limit growth and opportunities, particularly for youth and women. H.E. warned that persistent educational poverty threatens to create a generation deprived of skills and prospects, while geopolitical instability in several regions has deepened these pressures.

Energy balance

The minister linked sustainable job creation to stable and affordable energy, reiterating the commitment to clean energy transitions in line with each country's national contributions. H.E. called for World Bank support for advanced energy projects, including natural gas as a transitional clean source, nuclear power for sustainable electricity, and carbon capture, utilisation and storage technologies to achieve climate goals.

H.E. Shaikh Salman said decent work and dignified living were central to human dignity, adding that employment was the foundation of social stability. His Excellency praised the World Bank Group's focus on job creation and welcomed the International Finance Corporation's efforts to mobilise private capital and introduce innovative securitisation instruments to support developing markets.

Private investment

The minister urged expanding innovative financing and investment models to enhance diversification, stressing that genuine growth is that which sustains employment while maintaining social and environmental

balance. H.E. underlined that the private sector remains the main driver of job creation and economic development.


His Excellency also warned that while modern technologies offer immense opportunities, failing to integrate them into public policy could widen inequality. H.E. called for harnessing innovation to advance human and economic progress rather than deepen divides.

Regional stability

H.E. Shaikh Salman welcomed global efforts toward peace and praised progress made toward ending the war in Gaza, describing it as a vital step toward regional security. His Excellency urged increased financial and technical assistance from the World Bank to the Palestinian Authority and coordination with international donors to ensure the success of Gaza's reconstruction phase.

H.E. said development and peace are inseparable, adding that humanitarian stability in Gaza is essential to achieving lasting regional peace.

Al Musallam calls for global recognition of Palestine

Council of Representatives Speaker Ahmed bin Salman Al Musallam has called on all member countries of the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU) to recognise the State of Palestine and to support the rights of the Palestinian people, including their right to self-determination and an end to the occupation.

Speaking during a meeting of the Arab Parliamentary Group in Geneva, Al Musallam stressed

the urgent need to deliver humanitarian and medical aid to Gaza, saying that international cooperation is vital to ease the suffering of civilians affected by the war.

He also underlined the importance of supporting peace efforts based on the two-state solution, in line with international resolutions.

Unified stance

Al Musallam said that Arab parliaments continue to work

together to build a unified stance that supports issues important to Arab countries and their people.

The meeting took place on the sidelines of the 151st General Assembly of the Inter-Parliamentary Union.

It was chaired by Sheikh Dr. Abdullah bin Mohammed Al Sheikh, Speaker of Saudi Arabia's Shura Council, and attended by Mohamed bin Ahmed Al Yamahi, Speaker of the Arab Parliament, along with other Arab

parliamentary leaders.

Commitment

Al Musallam reaffirmed Bahrain's firm position in supporting the Palestinian cause and its commitment to strengthening cooperation among Arab parliaments.

He added that discussions during these coordination meetings reflect a shared sense of responsibility to promote Arab causes and encourage joint decisions among global parliaments.

Fair treatment

MPs push for social insurance and pension rights for Bahraini trainee doctors

Parliament will on Tuesday consider a proposal calling on the government to register trainee doctors under the social insurance system and ensure pension contributions are paid throughout their training.

The proposal was submitted by MPs Hisham Al Ashiri, Jaleela Alawi, Mohsen Al Asboul, Mahmood Fardan and Hanan Fardan.

It follows concerns that Bahraini doctors in training, especially those supported through Tamkeen programmes, are missing out on years of service that ought to count towards retirement.

Data provided by the Health Ministry shows that out of 172 doctors trained between 2022 and 2024, only seven were registered with the Social Insurance Organisation (SIO).

Rights and stability

The Services Committee, which backed the proposal, said the move would help secure rights and stability for this group.

It cited Article 5(c) of the Constitution, which guarantees social protection in cases such as illness, unemployment and widowhood.

The committee said recording trainee years under the insurance system would ensure those years are included in end-of-service calculations.

Doctors already employed in hospitals or health centres are covered automatically.

Salaries

Their salaries are subject to deductions under the existing laws.

However, doctors placed under Tamkeen schemes are not formally employed and so are not enrolled unless they opt in voluntarily.

The Ministry of Health made this distinction clear in its sub-

mission, adding that the final position would be determined after all parties review the issue.

The Bahrain Medical Society said the problem lies with those on wage-support schemes.

These doctors receive fixed stipends and fulfil regular duties but remain outside the mandatory insurance framework.

Gap

The Society blamed the gap on the absence of a set budget and a lack of clarity over who is responsible for enrolling them.

The Social Insurance Organisation said coverage requires an employment contract.

It added that where training is structured to lead into work, the training period may be treated as part of that job.

In such cases, those doctors would fall under the Social Insurance Law. Even so, the Organisation said a separate legal arrangement would be needed to formalise this for all trainees.

Proposal

Dr Al Ashiri said the proposal seeks to prevent junior doctors

from losing time that should be counted towards their pensions.

He argued that their commitment to public healthcare deserves formal recognition.

He said the move would not only honour their work ethic but also provide a degree of stability that the profession demands.

Concerns

Eman Al Murabati, CEO of the Social Insurance Organisation, acknowledged the MPs' concerns.

She said the Organisation appreciated the reasoning behind the proposal but stressed that legislative amendments would be required.

A full reply is expected in the government's written response.

The Services Committee has urged the Council to support the proposal.

Lawmakers propose addiction clinic in Capital Governorate

Drug overdose

MPs have put forward a proposal for a specialised addiction clinic in the Capital Governorate, saying it would treat drug users and provide health care with psychological and social support to aid recovery and reintegration.

The Health Ministry says current services meet demand and a national centre is under study.

The proposal seeks to strengthen Bahrain's response to addiction by creating dedicated treatment sites able to handle cases, step in early and offer suitable rehabilitation, with the aim of protecting the individual, the family and the wider community.

Sponsors say such a clinic would run programmes that address medical, psychological and social needs.

Reply

In its reply, the Ministry of Health pointed to the Al Moayed Unit at the Psychiatric Hospital, established in 1987.

The unit provides treatment and rehabilitation through a mixed team of consultants, doctors, nurses, social workers, psychologists and therapists.

It runs outpatient clinics

Capital Police Directorate found a body of a 62-year-old citizen in the Salmaniya area, and initial information indicates that the cause of death was a drug overdose.

four days a week, with one day for women, and has a detox ward with 15 beds and a rehabilitation ward with 13 beds.

Activity figures show 980 outpatient visits in the first half of 2023, including 17 by women.

Data

In 2022, 108 patients were admitted, with bed occupancy of about 50 per cent. There are no waiting lists, with new patients seen within a week.

The ministry said the subject of the proposal is already covered by the Al Moayed Unit, which meets current treatment needs.

It also said the National Committee for Combating Drugs is studying plans for an advanced national centre for addiction treatment and rehabilitation to match population growth and strengthen prevention and care.

Civil service rules breach

Government rejects imam-muezzin cadre; pensions at risk

Pensions could be suspended, the government warns, as it rejects MPs' plan for a special cadre for imams and muezzins on the grounds it clashes with civil service rules.

In written replies to the Council of Representatives, the government said the plan cuts across the civil-service incentive bonus system, which is meant to reward output and sound work. Paying more for qualifications alone, it added, would treat public staff unevenly.

It said the bill leaves basic points unclear, such as whether any bonuses would cover all fields of study or only religious studies. That lack of clarity, the government noted, would sit poorly with the bonus rules now in place and with fair chances for all.

The government said any arrangement for imams and muezzins should be set by the

executive, which can tweak rules as needs change, without new laws each time. That, it said, keeps the system flexible and helps manage staff.

It warned that moving this group into a new cadre could hit their pensions and contracts, including a stop to current pension payments, in breach of the law.

Job ladder

It also said standard shift patterns and the general job ladder do not fit work tied to prayer times and mosque duties, and would add paperwork that harms performance.

Common appraisal and disciplinary schemes, it argued, do not sit well with their spiritual and social roles.

The government called for support to be given through current executive routes so aims are met without cutting flexibility or creating overlap, and asked MPs to look again at the bill in light of its note.

Dream wedding turns into 'nightmare'

A Gulf national's dream of a perfect wedding night in Bahrain turned into a bitter shock when he discovered that the wedding planner he had hired was actually a convicted fraudster.

The groom had chosen a luxury hotel in Bahrain to celebrate his big day, sent out invitations to family and friends, and began the countdown to the much-anticipated event.

But just days before the wedding, he stumbled upon social media posts revealing that the planner had been sentenced to three years in prison and fined BD1,000 for fraud-related offenses.

Devastated

According to lawyer Taqi Hussain Taqi, the groom was devastated when he visited the hotel to finalize arrangements, only to discover that no booking had been made in his name

— despite paying the planner BD5,500 to organize the event.

What was meant to be a night of joy quickly turned into heartbreak, as the con-man's deception ruined the celebration before it even began.

In its ruling, the court stated that the contract clearly showed the defendant had agreed to organize the wedding and book the hall and facilities in exchange for the agreed amount. However, the defendant failed to fulfill his contractual obligations, as no reservation had been made.

Nullification

The court decided to terminate the contract, emphasizing that its nullification requires both parties to return to their pre-contractual positions.

Since the defendant had received BD5,500 and failed to appear in court or present any defense or proof of payment, the court ruled that he was liable to return the full amount to the plaintiff.

News in brief

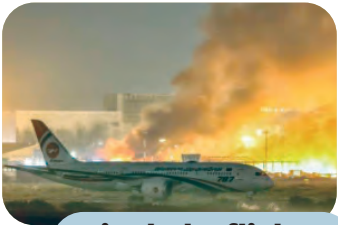
◆ A large fire swept through the cargo terminal of Bangladesh's main international airport in Dhaka on Saturday, forcing authorities to suspend all flights, officials said.

The main airport terminal was not affected, but thick black clouds of smoke swept across the runway. Fire Service spokesperson Talha bin Zaim said 37 firefighting units were battling the blaze, which broke out in the afternoon and later drew in reinforcements from the security forces. Airport authorities did not immediately answer telephone calls but The Daily Star newspaper, quoting airport officials, said that flights had been diverted to other airports. With firefighters tackling the blaze, the airport was expected to resume operations within hours. Moinul Ahsan, a senior official at the Directorate of Health, said at least four people had been taken to hospital with minor injuries.

◆ The United Nations' aid chief took stock of the monumental task of restoring dignity and hygiene to Palestinians clinging to life in Gaza's ruins yesterday, as Israel and Hamas exchanged more bodies. A convoy of white UN jeeps carried relief coordinator Tom Fletcher and his team through the twisted rubble of shattered homes to see a wastewater treatment plant in Sheikh Radwan, north of Gaza City. "I drove through here seven to eight months ago when most

of these buildings were still standing and, to see the devastation -- this is a vast part of the city, just a wasteland -- and it's absolutely devastating to see," he told AFP.

◆ Israel returned the bodies of 15 Palestinians to Gaza yesterday, bringing the total number handed over to 135, the health ministry in the Hamas-run territory said. Under a ceasefire deal brokered by US President Donald Trump, Israel was to turn over the bodies of 15 Palestinians for every deceased Israeli returned. Late on Friday, Hamas handed over the body of another Israeli hostage. Since the ceasefire began, Hamas has handed over the bodies of nine Israelis and one Nepalese student.

Gaza's civil defence agency said Israeli forces killed nine members of a single Palestinian family when they shelled a bus yesterday, after the military confirmed it had targeted a vehicle that crossed the so-called "yellow line".

"Our teams recovered the bodies of nine martyrs, including four children and two women, after Israeli occupation forces directly targeted the vehicle they were travelling in within the Zeitun neighbourhood," said Mahmud Bassal, a spokesperson for the agency operating under Hamas authority, in a statement to AFP on Saturday.

The Israeli military said a vehicle had been identified crossing the "yellow line", the boundary behind which Israeli troops are stationed under the ceasefire agreement with Hamas.

Bassal said Israeli forces had

US envoy Witkoff felt 'betrayed' by Israeli attack on Hamas in Qatar

Washington, United States

US envoy Steve Witkoff, President Donald Trump's chief negotiator on the Middle East, has said that he felt "betrayed" when Israel launched a strike targeting Hamas negotiators in Qatar last month.

In a CBS interview alongside Jared Kushner, Trump's son-in-law who worked with Witkoff on the brokering of a Gaza ceasefire deal between Israel and Hamas, the presidential envoy said he learned of the September 9 attack in Doha the morning after it happened.

"I think both Jared and I felt, I just feel we felt a little bit betrayed," Witkoff told the CBS news program "60 Minutes" in



excerpts released Friday. The full interview is scheduled to air on Sunday.

"It had a metastasizing effect because the Qataris were critical to the negotiation, as were the Egyptians and the Turks," Witkoff said.

"We had lost the confidence of the Qataris. And so Hamas went underground, and it was very, very difficult to get to them."

Lebanon health ministry says Israeli strike kills one in south

Beirut, Lebanon

An Israeli strike on a construction vehicle in southern Lebanon killed a man, the Lebanese health ministry reported yesterday.

"The Israeli enemy's airstrike on a vehicle in the town of Deir Kifa, in the Tyre district, resulted in one martyr", the health

ministry said in a statement. Lebanon's state-run National News Agency reported that it was a drone strike which "targeted an excavator with two missiles on the Kfar Dou-nine-Deir Kifa road".

The Israeli military said it was looking into the reports when asked for comment.

as their "remains were scattered due to the intensity of the bombardment".

According to Bassal, recovering the remains has been particu-

larly challenging because of the "difficult field and environmental conditions" in the area.

He added that the victims were members of the Shabaan family and were killed while "trying to check on their home" in the Zeitun neighbourhood.

"My daughter, her children and her husband; my son, his children and his wife were killed," said Umm Mohammed Shaaban, member of the family.

"What did they do wrong?... There is no truce," she added, and said that the children were between two and 12 years old.

Warning shots

The Israeli military said in a statement that "troops fired warning shots toward the suspicious vehicle, but the vehicle continued to approach the troops in a way that caused an imminent threat to them".

"The troops opened fire to remove the threat, in accordance with the agreement."

The ceasefire between Israeli forces and Hamas is now in its second week, but several incidents have been reported since it began, with the military saying its troops fired at individuals who approached or crossed the yellow line.

Hundreds of thousands of Palestinians have returned to northern Gaza in search of their homes since the truce began, often struggling to find them amid the sweeping devastation left by more than two years of war.

Several Gazans who spoke to AFP said they were unable to locate their houses, or even familiar landmarks, in neighbourhoods now buried under the rubble of collapsed buildings and debris.

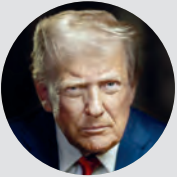

Tomahawk plea misfires

Trump tells Zelensky to ‘make a deal’

Donald Trump told Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky on Friday to make a deal with Russia, pouring cold water on Kyiv's hopes for Tomahawk missiles as the US leader renews a push to settle the war.

Trump said as recently as last month that he believed Ukraine could take back all its territory -- but a day after agreeing to meet Russian President Vladimir Putin for a new summit, the American had changed his tune, though Zelensky did not rule out Trump changing his mind again in the future.

"It's good that President Trump didn't say 'no,' but for today, (he) didn't say 'yes'" to providing Kyiv with Tomahawks, Zelensky told US broadcaster NBC on Friday.

After meeting with Zelensky at the White House, Trump said on social media that their talks were "very interesting, and cordial, but I told him, as I likewise strongly suggested to President Putin, that it is time to stop the

killing, and make a DEAL!"

"They should stop where they are. Let both claim Victory, let History decide!" he posted online, while flying to his Florida estate.

Upon landing, he told reporters that Ukraine and Russia should "stop right now at the battle line."

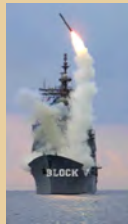
"Go by the battle line wherever it is or else it gets too complicated," he added.

Zelensky meanwhile said after the meeting that Russia was "afraid" of the US-made long-range Tomahawk cruise missiles, and that he was "realistic" about receiving the weapons from Washington.

He told reporters that while he and Trump discussed long-range weapons they "decided that we don't speak about it because... the United States doesn't want escalation."

Protesters turn out for anti-Trump 'No Kings' rallies across US

Huge crowds are expected to hit the streets yesterday from New York to San Francisco to vent their anger over President Donald Trump's hardline policies at nationwide "No Kings" protests slammed by Republicans as "Hate America" rallies.

More than 2,700 demonstrations are planned coast to coast, from big cities to small towns, and even near Trump's Mar-a-Lago residence in Florida, where he is spending the weekend. Organizers say they are expecting millions to attend.

Those numbers would match the massive turnout at similar events on June 14, Trump's birthday and the day of a giant military parade in the US capital, in outrage over the Trump administration's crackdown on undocumented migrants and its deployment of National Guard troops to Los Angeles.

Since then, Trump -- who

returned to the White House in January -- has ordered National Guard troops into Washington and Memphis. Planned deployments to Chicago and Portland, Oregon have so far been blocked in the courts.

Demonstrators are also up in arms over Trump's attacks on the media, prosecutions of his political opponents and a

host of other actions they see as authoritarian.

"The president thinks his rule is absolute. But in America, we don't have kings and we won't back down against chaos, corruption, and cruelty," the "No Kings" movement -- which brings together some 300 organizations -- says on its website.

Thousands flee Philippine coast as storm makes landfall

Thousands of residents fled their homes along the Pacific seaboard of the Philippines yesterday as Tropical Storm Fengshen made landfall, triggering warnings of coastal flooding.

The storm barrelled into the municipality of Gubat at the southeastern tip of the main island of Luzon late afternoon, with gusts of up to 80 kilometres (50 miles) an hour, the government weather service said.

Authorities said there were no immediate reports of serious damage or casualties, with evacuations already carried

out in hazard-prone areas and low-lying communities.

"We had heavy rain and wind gusts, though they were not that strong," Gubat rescuer Ryan Estrellado told AFP by telephone.

Fengshen will likely intensify before making a second landfall in central Luzon on Sunday, the weather office said.

The weather bureau warned of a "minimal to moderate risk" of coastal flooding, with waves reaching up to two metres (six feet). Some 27,000 residents of the province of Albay and nearby Catanduanes island moved to safer ground, local disaster officials said.

Pakistan to hold talks with Afghanistan in Qatar after latest strikes

Pakistan and Afghan officials were due to meet in Qatar on Saturday, a day after Islamabad launched air strikes that killed at least 10 people in Afghanistan and broke a ceasefire that had brought two days of calm to the border.

The strikes targeted what Pakistan security sources said was a militant group linked to the Pakistani Taliban in the Afghan border areas, following an attack that killed Pakistani paramilitary troops in North

Kabul accused Islamabad late on Friday of violating the truce, which had briefly paused nearly a week of cross-border clashes that killed dozens of troops and civilians on both sides.

"The talks will focus on immediate measures to end cross-border terrorism against Pakistan emanating from Afghanistan and restore peace and stability along the Pak-Afghan border," Pakistan's foreign ministry said in a statement.

Iran says no longer bound by 'restrictions' on its nuclear programme

Iran said yesterday that it was no longer bound by restrictions on its nuclear programme as a landmark 10-year deal between it and world powers expired, though Tehran reiterated its "commitment to diplomacy".

The 2015 deal -- signed in Vienna by Iran, China, Britain, France, Germany, Russia and the United States -- saw the lifting of international sanctions against the Islamic republic in exchange for restrictions on its nuclear programme.

But the pact had already been in tatters after Washington unilaterally withdrew during President Donald Trump's first term, with Iran later pulling back from its commitments.

The reimposition last month



of UN sanctions at the urging of three of the deal's European signatories rendered the accord effectively moot.

From now on, "all of the provisions (of the deal), including the restrictions on the Iranian nuclear programme and the related mechanisms are considered terminated", Iran's foreign ministry said in a statement on the day of the pact's expiration.

"Iran firmly expresses its commitment to diplomacy," it added.

The Bahraini squad includes Ahmed Karrar, Salman Haidar, Sabt Qassim, Hussain Abadi, Mohammed Tarrada, Sayed Majeed Al-Muhafda, Ahmed Eid, Ahmed Abdullah, Mahdi Ali, Ali Al-Mahroos, Ahmed AlSamahiji, Mahmood Ahmed, Abuthar Yateem, Ali Hasan, and Aad-am M.

Al Hidd Stage Stunning Comeback Against Al Najma

Al Hidd produced a breathtaking turnaround to win 3-1 against Al Najma at Shaikh Ali bin Mohammed Stadium yesterday, reaffirming their credentials as genuine contenders in the Nasser bin Hamad Premier League.

Al Najma had taken the lead through Achraf Douiri's superb 35th-minute opener. The winger expertly controlled Hussain Al Riffai's floated delivery, let the ball drop, and guided it with composure into the bottom corner past Mohamed ElGharaby — a finish worthy of lifting the hosts' spirits.

Karl Namnganda put Sitra ahead after 24 minutes, latching onto a long pass from Judá Aguiar da Silva. BRAVE Combat Federation is coming home this November for a major double-header at Khalifa Sports City in Isa Town. BRAVE 100 on November 7 and BRAVE 101 two days later will celebrate the promotion's 100th event, returning to where it all began.

Speaking to The Daily Tribune, BRAVE CF President Mohammed Shahid shared what bringing the 100th event back to Bahrain means.

"BRAVE 100 being back in Bahrain symbolizes everything we stand for: vision, unity, and giving athletes a platform that

represents nations, not just promotions," he said. "It's a full-circle moment."

Return of Mokaev

Shahid spoke at length about Muhammad Mokaev, noting the significance of the flyweight's title fight taking place in Bahrain. "Mokaev has been one of the best flyweights in the world for a long time, and to see him back in Bahrain competing for the first world title here is special," Shahid said. "He represents everything BRAVE stands for, talent, hard work, and the global reach of this platform. He's fought in multiple countries, faced top competition, and now he has a chance to make history in front of the fans who first watched him grow."

He added that the fight shows how BRAVE has become a launchpad for international talent.

"This fight isn't just about two athletes competing. It's about giving fans the chance to see someone who started with us

rise to a world championship," Shahid explained. "It's proof that if you have talent and commitment, nationality doesn't matter. BRAVE gives everyone a stage."

Kooheji's Homecoming

Bahrain's own Hamza Kooheji headlines BRAVE 100 for the bantamweight title. Shahid emphasized the significance of seeing a fighter who has been with BRAVE since the beginning compete for gold on home soil.

"Hamza is a true pioneer for us," Shahid said. "He's been part of BRAVE since day one. To see him fighting for a world title in front of his home crowd is something special. The fans know his journey, and now they get to celebrate it with him. It's a story of loyalty, perseverance, and dedication."

He framed the matchup as both a personal and professional milestone.

"He's facing a world champion (Borislav Nikolic) in hostile territory, and that's what makes

this matchup meaningful," Shahid added. "It's not just about winning a belt. It's about representing Bahrain on a global stage. The energy in the arena will be electric, and I expect the fight to reflect the skill and heart Hamza has shown over his career."

BRAVE's Global Reach

Shahid reflected on BRAVE CF's expansion, noting that the promotion has now staged 97 events in 37 countries across five continents, and he credits the success to focusing on talent first.

"The defining factor is a focus on pure talent," he said. "We've discovered fighters from Africa to Europe, Southeast Asia to South Asia. Names like Jamza Jumayah, Ilya Chapuria, Johnny Walker. These are athletes who rose because we provided a global stage. That's our legacy."

Diversity, Shahid stressed, remains a core mission.

"Nationality, religion, race, gender, none of that matters.

Talent alone is what counts," he said. "At BRAVE 100, fans will see a celebration of that diversity, showcasing athletes who may not compete in the traditional big markets but are world-class nonetheless."

Vision For The Future

Shahid highlighted the importance of having a disciplined team and structured organization to support global growth.

"We've built a system to scale globally, working with national organizations, co-promoters, and managers, all aligned to the singular vision of elevating MMA worldwide," he said. "If your team doesn't believe in that vision, even the best skills aren't enough."

He added what fans can expect from the event itself.

"When the lights go off on November 7, I want fans to celebrate everything we've done in the last nine years and 100 events, while also seeing what's ahead for the sport," Shahid said. "It's about sharing both the past

and the future. Fights, lights, music, atmosphere, and a little chaos, because that's MMA. We want everyone to be entertained and feel part of BRAVE's journey."

Shahid also stressed the local engagement leading up to the homecoming.

"We're bringing BRAVE to everyone, schools, ministries, organizations, so when November 7 arrives, fans won't just watch fights. They'll celebrate a global journey that began right here in Bahrain," he said.

Finally, he returned to the philosophy behind BRAVE CF.

"All you need is talent, a brave heart, and a committed team. If you have those, anything is possible. That's the story BRAVE 100 tells, and BRAVE 101 will continue," Shahid said.

BRAVE CF has built a reputation for one thing, which is launching fighters into the spotlight. Nine years in, and this November it comes back to Bahrain. Home turf, big fights, and Bahrain fans are in for a front-row look at the action that's shaking up MMA.

Verstappen Wins US Sprint as McLarens Crash Out

Max Verstappen reignited his Formula One title campaign with a commanding win in the US Grand Prix sprint race on Saturday, after a dramatic early crash forced both McLaren drivers out of contention.

The race took a chaotic turn at the first corner when championship leader Oscar Piastri was clipped by Nico Hulkenberg, sending his McLaren spinning



into teammate Lando Norris. Both drivers suffered termi-

Starting from pole position, Verstappen capitalized on the incident to pull away from the field and secure a crucial victory, cutting Piastri's lead in the drivers' standings to 55 points ahead of Sunday's main Grand Prix in Austin.

The Dutchman's dominant display sets the stage for a tense showdown as the season nears its final rounds.
