

59 injured in clashes after Colombia football final

↑ t least 59 people were in-**A**jured in clashes between football fans during Colombia's cup final in the city of Medellin on Wednesday night, authorities said.

The unrest broke out at the end of the match which saw Atletico Nacional beat fellow Medellin side, Deportivo Independiente Medellin 1-0.

Images of the rioting shared on social media showed dozens of supporters from both sides invading the pitch in Atanasio Girardot stadium, hurling pro-

Ecuadorean footballer Mario Pineida shot and killed

Quito, Ecuador

Ecuadoran footballer Mario Pineida was shot and killed in the port city of Guayaquil on Wednesday, his team said.

Guayaquil has become a hotspot for gang violence linked to drug trafficking and several football players in Ecuador have been targeted in recent months.

Pineida, 33, was part of Ecuador's national team for the 2018 and 2022 World Cup qualifiers, but was not selected for the squad for the 2022 finals in Qatar. He also played for Fluminense in 2022.

In a post on X, his club, Barcelona SC, said it "regrets to inform, with deep sorrow, that it has been officially notified of the death of our player Mario Pineida, an event that occurred following an attack against him" in Guayaquil.
