Parasite: the lower depths rise with a vengeance

A destitute family occupies a wealthy household in an elaborate scheme that goes comically — then horribly — wrong

'Parasite' is one of the best movies of the year thanks to its riveting directing, a great ensemble cast, and the thrillingly unpredictable plot
