Bahrain calls for peaceful solutions to end conflicts

Washington
His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa emphasised Bahrain's firm commitment to peaceful solutions to conflicts and to strengthening relations between countries, religions and peoples.

He underscored that this approach is founded on dialogue, mutual respect and the principles of peaceful coexistence.

HM the King was speaking as he participated in the first meeting of the Board of Peace, held in Washington, DC, at the invitation of the US President Donald Trump.

A number of heads of state and senior officials, as well as representatives of countries and international organisations, also attended.

The American leader announced a financial support package for Gaza, along with contributions from several countries towards relief and reconstruction efforts, and reiterated the US' commitment to working with international partners to promote security and stability in the region.

Commitment

HM the King Hamad reiterated the Kingdom's commitment to supporting peace and security in the region, working to end the Palestinian-Israeli conflict to meet the aspirations of all peoples in the region, and contributing to the reconstruction of Gaza to secure a better future for its people.

His Majesty said the inaugural meeting of the Board of Peace marks an extraordinary and pivotal chance to envision peace.

Strategic trust

HM King affirms Bahrain-US partnership built on progress, security and mutual interests

His Majesty hosts reception in US

Washington

His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa has affirmed that Bahrain's partnership with the US rests on "enduring trust, common purpose, and a belief in progress."

He stressed that the two allies together can shape "a future defined by security, opportunity, and sustainable growth."

Speaking at a reception he hosted in Washington following a Ramadan iftar, HM the King underscored the depth of Bahraini-American ties and their expanding role in promoting regional stability and prosperity.

"The Kingdom of Bahrain and the United States share more than 130 years of friendship," His Majesty said.

Relationship

He noted that the relationship had evolved into a strategic partnership marked by the presence of the US Fifth Fleet and broad cooperation across defence, trade and diplomacy.

HM King Hamad added that

Bahrain was "the first Major Non-NATO Ally of the United States in the Gulf" and "the first in the region to sign a Free Trade Agreement with the United States."

He described these milestones as evidence of a steadily deepening alliance.

Commitment

Highlighting Bahrain's longstanding commitment to dialogue and coexistence, His Majesty stated: "Bahrain has always placed peace, coexistence and tolerance at the heart of its identity."

HM the King emphasised that the Kingdom is "not only participating in the digital economy, we are helping to shape it, and we invite you to join us on our journey."

He described the current moment as critical for the Middle East, saying: "We meet at a pivotal moment for the region — one that calls for courage and vision."

Peace

His Majesty added that progress towards peace had been made possible through "leadership and boldness."

The reception was held as part

of HM King Hamad's visit to the US to attend the first meeting of the Board of Peace, convened at the invitation of US President Donald Trump.

Discussions during the gathering focused on advancing the second phase of the Gaza ceasefire agreement and supporting reconstruction efforts.

Among those present were Kazakhstan's President Kassym-Jomart Tokayev, US Special Envoy to the Middle East Steve Witkoff, senior US administration officials, members of Congress, GCC foreign ministers and representatives of participating countries.

In his remarks, Jared Kushner welcomed His Majesty's visit, describing it as "important in further strengthening the strategic partnership between the two countries."

Role

He added that Bahrain has played "a significant role in supporting efforts to promote peace and reinforce security and stability at both regional and international levels."

Kushner also highlighted "the depth of Bahraini-American

relations and their continued development across various areas of cooperation in support of shared interests."

Several speakers at the reception commended the strength of bilateral ties and stressed

the significance of the inaugural Board of Peace meeting in advancing ceasefire implementation and reconstruction initiatives in Gaza, as well as

in fostering broader regional stability.

Trust breach

Court jails expat worker for BD4,633 embezzlement

A Filipina expat who handled petty cash at a catering business has been sentenced to six months' imprisonment after a court found she took BD4,633 by cycling company withdrawals through staff bank accounts and back to herself via a money transfer app.

The Lower Criminal Court also ordered her to repay the money, ruled the sentence should be carried out, and said she is to be deported after serving her term.

A second defendant, an Egyptian man accused of helping her and of obtaining company money by deception, was acquitted.

Responsibility

The court said the woman started work in April 2023 as an HR manager and was given responsibility for petty cash and running costs.

She was provided with a bank card linked to the company account to withdraw funds for business needs, subject to approval from the accounts department.

Judges found she withdrew sums from the company account, handed cash to employees, and told them to deposit it into their personal accounts before sending it on to her electronically using a money transfer app.

Account

Once the money reached her account, she transferred it onwards to other accounts linked to her, with the court pointing to bank records showing multiple transfers tied to the same phone number.

According to lawyer Siddiqa Al Mawali, the court accepted BD4,633 as the proven total, based on transfers made by employees.

That included BD3,520 sent by a company driver, BD873 sent by a cook who said she was asked for her bank card and PIN, and a further BD240 sent by another driver.

Witness

The ruling said the finding rested on witness statements, police enquiries, an accounting expert's report, and bank statements.

She denied the charge.

Her lawyer argued the complaint was brought out of spite after she filed a labour case, questioned the reliability of witnesses, and attacked the accounting report, but the court rejected those arguments and convicted her.

Muharraq historic city project first phase to finish this year

Muharraq's historic city development project is expected to be completed in its first phase by the end of 2026, with 300 Bahraini families set to benefit, Housing and Urban Planning Minister Amna Al Rumaihi has told Parliament.

In a written reply to a question from MP Hamad Al Doy, Al Rumaihi said construction of the project's new prototype homes had reached 92 per cent.

Restoration of existing homes was more than 60 per cent complete, she said, while work on the visitor centre had reached 82 per cent.

She said the first phase includes 300 homes alongside the restoration of 16 heritage buildings along the Pearlring Path.

Character

The buildings will be reused for tourism and cultural purposes as part of efforts to preserve the city's architectural character.

A second phase is expected to increase the total number of homes to about 2,000 through

a partnership with the private sector.

The wider scheme also covers 48 kilometres of walking and mobility routes, together with new parking spaces.

Plans include 72 green spaces with a combined area of 12,000 square metres and the planting of about 100,000 trees.

Upgrades

Five key streets will also undergo upgrades, including infrastructure works, façades and public seating and fixtures, she said.

The construction and resto-

ration of the 300 homes in the first phase have been divided into three batches, with the first expected to be handed over in the first half of 2026.

All three are due to be completed by the end of that year through phased construction.

Food security council proposal

A proposal to establish an independent government entity or a Supreme Council for Food Security is set for discussion during Tuesday's Twentieth Ordinary Session of the Fourth Annual Meeting of the Sixth Legislative Term.

The proposal was submitted by MP Hamad Farooq Al Doy, MP Bader Saleh Al Tamimi, MP Hassan Ibrahim Hassan, MP Mohamed Mohamed Al Rif-

faei and MP Mohamed Moosa Mohamed.

The MPs are seeking the creation of a specialised body tasked with overseeing national food security policies and strengthening strategic coordination across relevant sectors.

Priority

Food security has become an increasingly prominent policy priority amid global supply chain disruptions and fluctuating commodity markets.

Supporters of the proposal

argue that a dedicated authority or council would enhance preparedness, improve coordination between ministries and ensure long term sustainability in food supply management.

Tuesday's session will provide the formal platform for the proposal to be presented and reviewed, as Parliament continues to examine structural measures aimed at reinforcing economic stability and safeguarding essential commodities for the national market.

New CRISPR tool may roll back antibiotic resistance

Antimicrobial resistance is no longer a distant global concern, it is a daily reality in outpatient clinics, primary care centres, and family physician practices.

Scientists at UC San Diego have created a new CRISPR-based, second generation Pro-Active Genetics (Pro-AG) system called pPro-MobV that can fight antibiotic-resistant bacteria, or 'superbugs' in a completely new way.

Instead of just slowing them down, this tool removes the genes that make bacteria resistant to antibiotics.

The system works by targeting plasmids, tiny DNA pieces inside bacteria that carry resistance.

It inserts a small genetic 'cassette' that shuts down these

resistance genes, making the bacteria sensitive to antibiotics again. In essence, a CRISPR-based tool is a revolutionary, fast, and precise technology used by scientists to edit, alter, or regulate the DNA of living organisms, functioning like a molecular 'find-and-replace' tool for genetic code.

pPro-MobV can spread be-

tween bacteria, even within dense biofilms found on hospital surfaces, wastewater systems, farms, and fish ponds, enabling it to reach hard-to-target resistant microbes.

It can also be delivered via bacteriophages for precise, targeted action, and its inserted genes can be removed if necessary, adding a key safety safeguard.

Bounced cheques can now be enforced without court case

Holdings of dishonoured cheques can now move straight to enforcement through the national por-

tal, without filing a court claim, under a new decision issued by the Ministry of Justice.

Decision No. 6 of 2026 regulates the enforcement of cheques returned unpaid

and allows them to be executed directly through the "Execution Services" on bahrain.bh.

The cheque is treated as an enforceable instrument under amendments to the Commer-

cial Law, removing the need to begin proceedings before the civil courts.

Lawyer Jassim Al Issa said the measure 'shortens the route for rights-holders' and offers creditors a quicker path

to recover their dues.

"When users realise that a cheque will be enforced directly without the need to file a lawsuit, that raises the level of financial discipline in Bahrain's market," he told The Dai-

ly Tribune.

He added that it also strengthens the cheque as a tool of payment and limits misuse, which in turn supports trust in commercial and civil dealings.

Verdict set in drunk driving case

The High Criminal Court set March 31 to issue its verdict in a case involving a defendant accused of causing the death of one person and injuring three others in a traffic accident. The accident happened because he was driving under the influence of alcohol, exceeding the speed limit, and driving a car that was not registered and uninsured. The crash also caused damage to public and private property.

For causing the victim's

death and injuring three others due to drunk driving and speeding, the Public Prosecution charged the defendant.

He was driving at 75 km/h in a case where the speed limit was 50 km/h.

The defendant was also charged with driving without due care and attention, and driving a vehicle with an expired registration and no insurance.

The defendant hit another vehicle, causing it to lose control and crash into a car coming from the opposite direction.

BENEFIT Records BD 37.5 Billion in Electronic Financial Transactions Across All Transfer Services in 2025

BENEFIT, Kingdom's innovator and leading company in Fintech and electronic financial transactions service, announced the achievement of significant growth in online payments processed through the Electronic Funds Transfer System (EFTS) across all channels, including banking platforms and the BenefitPay app. The system encompasses Fawri, Fawri+, and Fawateer services, which together recorded 494.0 million transactions during 2025, representing an increase of 10.7% compared to 2024. The total value of these transactions reached BD 37.5 billion, reflecting a notable growth of 12.6% compared to BD 33.3 billion in 2024.

The company disclosed that a total of 466.0 million transactions, valued at BD 10.2 billion, were executed across all electronic funds transfer services (Fawri, Fawri+ and Fawateer) through the BenefitPay app. This represents an increase of 10.6% in transaction volume and a 9.5% rise in transaction value compared to the previous year, emphasizing the accelerating momentum of BENEFIT's electronic transactions ecosystem as a key driver of the Kingdom's FinTech sector.

BENEFIT further explained that the total volume of Fawri+ transactions on all channels reached 467.9 million transactions in 2025, marking an increase of 11.3% compared to 420.3 million transactions recorded in the previous year. The total value of Fawri+ transac-



tions increased from BD 8.6 billion to BD 9.7 billion in 2025, reflecting a growth of 13.6%. Transactions conducted via the BenefitPay app also recorded an 11.1% increase, reaching 455.3 million transactions with a total value of BD 8.7 billion.

Meanwhile, total Fawri transactions on all channels reached 14.3 million during 2025, representing an 8.3% increase compared to the previous year, with a total value approximating BD 26.4 billion, reflecting an 11.8% increase compared to BD 23.6 billion in 2024. In contrast, Fawri transactions conducted through the BenefitPay application recorded a slight decline, with transaction volume reaching 507.6 thousand transactions valued at nearly BD 1.0 billion, compared to approximately 586.0 thousand transactions valued at BD 1.1 billion in 2024.

In addition, total Fawateer transactions totaled 11.8 million transactions on all channels in 2025, compared to 12.6 million transactions in 2024. Despite the slight decrease in transaction volume, the total value of Fawateer transactions recorded a significant increase of 20.4%,

approximating BD 1.4 billion. Fawateer transactions conducted via the BenefitPay app amounted to 10.2 million transactions, compared to 11.0 million transactions in the previous year, while transaction value increased by 22.0% to reach BD 514.4 million, compared to BD 421.6 million in 2024.

Furthermore, the total number of verification processes conducted through the electronic (Know Your Customer) platform approximated 1.1 million transactions in 2025, compared to 790.5 thousand transactions in 2024, representing an increase of 37.8%.

The Bahrain Credit Reference Bureau, operated by BENEFIT, also issued 541.9 thousand credit reports during 2025, marking an increase of 4.0% compared to the previous year, during which 521.0 thousand reports were issued.



Laser-written glass can store data for millennia, Microsoft says

Thousands of years from now, what will remain of our digital era?

The ever-growing vastness of human knowledge is no longer stored in libraries, but on hard drives that struggle to last decades, let alone millennia.

However, information written into glass by lasers could allow data to be preserved for more than 10,000 years, Microsoft announced in a study on Wednesday.

Since 2019, Microsoft's Silica project has been trying to encode data on glass plates, in a throwback to the early days of photography, when negatives were also stored on glass.

The system uses silica glass, a common material that is resistant to changes in temperature, moisture and electromagnetic interference.

These are all problems for energy-hungry data centres, which use fast-degrading hard drives and magnetic tapes that require backing up every few years.

In the journal Nature, Microsoft's research arm said Silica was the first glass storage technology that had been demonstrated to be reliable for writing, reading and decoding data.

However, experts not involved in the project warned that this new tech still faces numerous challenges.

How to write inside glass

First, bits of data are turned into symbols, which correspond to three-dimensional pixels called voxels.

A high-powered laser pulse then writes these minuscule voxels into square glass plates that are roughly the size of a CD.

"The symbols are written layer by layer, from the bottom up, to fill the full thickness of the glass," the study explained.

To read the data requires a special microscope that can see each layer, then decode the information using an algorithm powered by artificial intelligence.

The Microsoft researchers estimated that the glass could survive for more than 10,000 years at a blistering 290 degrees Celsius, which suggests the data could last even longer at room temperature.

However, the researchers did not look into what happened when the glass was deliberately smashed -- or corroded by chemicals.

Unlike data centres, the glass does not require a climate-controlled environment, which would save energy.

Another advantage is that the glass plates cannot be hacked or otherwise altered.

The Microsoft researchers emphasised that future storage is important because the amount of data being produced by humanity is now doubling roughly every three years.

Oil extends gains on US-Iran tensions, stocks retreat

Oil prices pushed higher yesterday on worries that nuclear talks between United States and Iran might not avert a new conflict that could threaten supplies.

On stock markets, a rally across Asia following gains by US tech heavyweights failed to bolster indices in Europe and the United States, where traders focussed on a string of corporate results.

The gains for oil extended a surge seen Wednesday, after the White House warned that Iran would be "wise" to do a deal with the United States.

US President Donald Trump once again hinted at a strike on Tehran on his Truth Social site, with a US military buildup underway in the Middle East.

"Oil is extending its gains, with Brent crude back above \$70 a barrel... as fears of a military confrontation between the US and Iran rattled energy markets," said Matt Britzman, senior equity analyst at Hargreaves Lansdown.

"Nuclear talks between the two sides appear to be going nowhere fast, and the geopolitical

premium is clearly back in play," he added.

The US benchmark oil contract WTI rose to a six-month high.

"The US has moved a stack of military assets into the region, and this is unnerving investors," said Trade Nation analyst David Morrison.

Wall Street's main indices moved lower at the start of trading in New York.

Morrison said the minutes of its last meeting of the Federal Reserve's monetary policy committee released late Wednesday were also affecting sentiment.

"These were viewed as more hawkish than expected, and this added some downward pressure on equities," he said.

He noted that some members indicated they want to wait to see inflation fall further before cutting rates again, while others indicated the next move could be a hike in rates.

Recent strong data on the US economy has suggested that the Fed might not need to cut rates any time soon.

Shares in Walmart rose 2.3 percent as traders focussed on solid fourth-quarter results and not its forecasts for slower

growth.

Major European indices were in the red, with shares in plane maker Airbus down six percent in Paris and Frankfurt after its annual results fell short of analysts' expectations.

Shares in French carmaker Renault fell 3.6 percent in Paris after it posted higher 2025 sales but warned of slipping profit margins from increased sales of electric and hybrid vehicles.

In London, disappointing earnings from mining giant Rio Tinto and energy group Centrica weighed on the blue-chip FTSE 100 index.

In Asia, Seoul's Kospi led gains, jumping more than three percent to a record high as it reopened after the Lunar New Year break, with chip giants Samsung and SK hynix once again the standout performers.

Tokyo also advanced while Hong Kong, Shanghai and Taipei remained closed for the Lunar New Year holiday.

Asian stocks are enjoying a strong start to the year as investors turn to the region's relatively cheaper tech plays after Wall Street's AI-fuelled surge over the past two years.

News in brief

Fourth impeachment complaint filed against Philippine VP Duterte ◆ Philippine Vice President and freshly declared presidential candidate Sara Duterte is facing a fourth impeachment case against her, documents yesterday showed. The complaint, which accuses Duterte of misusing public funds and cites "disturbing" allegations of undeclared wealth, was filed on Wednesday, hours after she had tossed her hat into the ring for the 2028 election. The daughter of former president Rodrigo Duterte was impeached by the House of Representatives last year, only to see the country's Supreme Court throw the case out over procedural issues.

A building collapse caused by an explosion in Pakistan's southern megacity of Karachi killed at least 16 people yesterday, including children, officials said. More than a dozen people were injured in the incident in the Soldier Bazaar neighbourhood of Karachi at around 4:00 am, when Muslim families start preparing sehri, the pre-sunrise meal eaten during Ramadan. "Sixteen people, including women and children, have been killed and 13 others injured," the provincial rescue agency's spokesman Hassan Khan said.

Ex-S.Korea leader Yoon gets life in prison for insurrection ◆ A South Korean court sentenced ex-president Yoon Suk Yeol to life in prison yesterday after finding him guilty of leading an insurrection with his martial law declaration in 2024. Yoon abruptly declared martial law in a televised address in December 2024, saying drastic measures were needed to root out "anti-state forces" in South Korea's National Assembly. The 65-year-old hardline conservative was later impeached, arrested and charged with a litany of crimes ranging from insurrection to obstruction of justice.

UK police arrest ex-prince Andrew in historic blow to royal family

Britain's former prince Andrew was arrested yesterday on suspicion of misconduct during his time as a trade envoy, as UK police investigations into allegations emerging from the Jeffrey Epstein files gathered pace. The arrest of a royal family member is unprecedented in Britain's modern era, and within hours King Charles III issued a rare personally signed statement insisting "the law must take its course". It was a humiliating new blow for the ousted prince, who was last year stripped of his titles, and was marking his 66th birthday yesterday in custody. "I'm pleased ... he deserves that," lawyer Emma Carter, 55, told AFP in London. "He's been hiding behind his privileges... for too many years." Police said they were also searching two properties, with the BBC reporting one was Andrew's former home, Royal Lodge, on the monar-

chy's Windsor estate west of London. The other was his residence since the start of this month on the king's private Sandringham estate in Norfolk, eastern England, where his arrest occurred, according to British media. Widely-published images showed a fleet of unmarked cars, believed to be police vehicles, arriving there early yesterday. "We have today (19/2) arrested a man in his sixties from Norfolk on suspicion of misconduct in public office," Thames Valley police said, without naming the suspect, as is common practice in the UK. "The man remains in police custody at this time," the force added. Andrew's ties to convicted US sex offender Epstein have caused a spectacular years-long fall from grace. His arrest follows new revelations last week that the ex-searcher appeared to have sent potentially confidential documents during his time as a UK trade envoy.

US and Israel issue dire warnings to Iran

Trump gives Tehran 10 days to reach deal as US boosts military presence

- US deploys warships and jets
- Iran insists on enrichment rights
- Israel issues parallel warnings

US President Donald Trump said yesterday Iran must make a "meaningful deal" in its negotiations with Washington in the next 10 days or else "bad things happen", as he deployed warships, fighter jets and other military hardware in the region.

"It's proven to be over the years not easy to make a meaningful deal with Iran. We have to make a meaningful deal otherwise bad things happen," Trump told the inaugural meeting of the "Board of Peace", his initiative to secure stability in Gaza.

He warned that Washington "may have to take it a step further" without any agreement, adding: "You're going to be finding out over the next probably 10 days."

Trump's comments came shortly after Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu issued his own warning to Iran saying, "If the ayatollahs make a mistake and attack us, they will receive a response they cannot even imagine".

The warnings were issued days after the US and Iran held a second round of Omani-mediated talks, this time in Geneva, with the US seeking to prevent Iran from getting a nuclear bomb, something it says it is not pursuing, and Iran seeking relief from US sanctions. White House Press Secretary

Iran's atomic energy chief yesterday said "no country can deprive Iran of the right" to nuclear enrichment, following fresh US warnings that there were "many reasons" to strike the Islamic republic.

A previous attempt at negotiations collapsed when Israel launched surprise strikes on Iran last June, beginning a 12-day war

that Washington briefly joined to bomb Iranian nuclear sites. "Do not want war" CNN and CBS reported on

Wednesday that the US military would be ready to launch strikes against Iran as early as this weekend, though Trump has reportedly not made a final decision yet.

The Wall Street Journal meanwhile reported that Trump had been briefed on his military options with "all of them designed to maximise damage", including a campaign to "kill scores of Iranian political and military leaders, with the goal of overthrowing the government", unnamed US officials told the newspaper.

Iran's Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi said after the latest talks that Tehran had agreed with Washington on "guiding principles", but US Vice President JD Vance said Iran had not yet acknowledged all of Washington's red lines.

UN says Israeli actions raise 'ethnic cleansing' fears in West Bank, Gaza

Israel's increased attacks and forcible transfers of Palestinians "raise concerns over ethnic cleansing" in the Gaza Strip and West Bank, the United Nations said yesterday.

The cumulative impact of Israel's military conduct during the war in Gaza and blockade of the territory, has inflicted living conditions "increasingly incompatible with Palestinians' continued existence as a group in Gaza", said the UN human rights office.

"Intensified attacks, the methodical destruction of entire

transfers, which appear to aim at a permanent displacement, raise concerns over ethnic cleansing in Gaza and the West Bank."

The report also pointed to "widespread" arbitrary detention and the "extensive unlawful demolition" of Palestinian homes. The aim, it said, was to "systematically discriminate, oppress, control and dominate the Palestinian people".

OpenAI's Altman tells leaders regulation 'urgently' needed

Tech leaders and world governments meet in New Delhi to address AI's risks and promise

● Modi, Guterres call for democratized AI

● UN chief proposes \$3 billion AI fund

The world urgently needs to regulate artificial intelligence, OpenAI head Sam Altman said yesterday at a summit in New Delhi to address the risks and opportunities posed by the fast-evolving technology.

Altman, CEO of the company behind ChatGPT, has called for global oversight in the past but last year warned that taking too tight an approach could hold the United States back in the AI race.

Frenzied demand for generative AI has turbocharged profits for companies while fuelling anxiety about the impact on society and the planet.

"Centralisation of this technology in one company or country could lead to ruin," Altman said yesterday.

"This is not to suggest that we won't need any regulation or safeguards. We obviously do, urgently, like we have for other powerful technologies."

The AI Impact Summit is the fourth annual gathering to discuss how to handle advanced computing power.

It is the largest yet and the first in a developing country, with India taking the opportunity to push its ambitions to catch up with the United States and China.

"We must democratise AI. It must become a medium for inclusion and empowerment," Prime Minister Narendra Modi told the gathering.

"We are entering an era where humans and intelligence systems co-create, co-work and co-evolve," he said. "We must resolve that AI is used for the global common good."

Gates cancels

Modi's comments were echoed by UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres, who said "AI must belong to everyone."

He called on tech tycoons to support a \$3 billion global fund to boost AI skills and makes computing power more affordable.

"The future of AI cannot be decided by a handful of countries -- or left to the whims of a few billionaires," he said.

Researchers and campaigners say stronger action is needed to combat emerging issues, from job disruption to online abuse and the electricity demands of

oversight of AI. "Europe is not blindly focused on regulation -- Europe is a space for innovation and investment, but it is a safe space," he said.

India expects more than \$200 billion in investments over the next two years, and US tech titans have unveiled new deals and infrastructure projects this week.

OpenAI and Indian IT giant Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) announced they would build hyperscale AI data centre capacity in India.

Google said it planned to lay subsea cables from India as part of an existing \$15 billion AI infrastructure investment.

Power-hungry AI data centres are under construction worldwide on a massive scale as companies race to develop super-intelligent systems.

Their heavy use of electricity, and water to cool hot servers, have sparked alarm at a time when nations have pledged to decarbonise grids to tackle climate change.

India leapt to third place last year in an annual global ranking of AI competitiveness calculated by Stanford researchers, although experts say it has a long way to go before it can rival the United States and China.

Leaders are expected to deliver a statement today about how they plan to handle AI technology.

One fear is disruption to the job market -- especially in India, where millions of people are employed in call centres and tech support services.

"We will prove that AI does not take away jobs. Rather, it will create new high-skilled work opportunities," Mukesh Ambani, head of India's Reliance Group, said yesterday.

Dozens of world leaders and ministers have joined tens of thousands of people from across the sector at the summit.

French President Emmanuel Macron, last year's host, said he was determined to ensure safe





Arteta urges Arsenal response

Arteta demands strong response after Wolves draw ahead of Tottenham clash

● Arsenal draw 2-2 with Wolves

● Two-goal lead squandered late

● Title race gap narrows

Arsenal manager Mikel Arteta has urged his side to use the "pain" of a shock 2-2 draw with Wolves when they look to revive their Premier League title challenge against arch-rivals Tottenham Hotspur.

The Gunners were on course for a routine win on Wednesday after goals from Bukayo Saka and Piero Hincapie put them 2-0 up at Molineux.

But bottom of the table Wolves hit back through Hugo Bueno and Tom Edozie.

The draw left Arsenal, bidding to end a 22-year-wait to be crowned champions of England again, just five points clear of second-placed Manchester City.

It was the second match in a row where Arsenal had dropped points following a draw with Brentford and meant they have now won just twice in their last seven league games.

City, who have a game in hand, twice chased Arsenal down to win the Premier League in both the 2022/23 and 2023/24 seasons and their April clash with

the Gunners could prove pivotal to the title race.

But Arteta said: "I'm going to be the first one to be close with them (the players) because it has nothing to do with attitude or desire, it is completely the opposite."

"It's part of football. Where it could've gone wrong today, it went wrong."

"If you look at the way we conceded the two goals today without conceding any other situations, it is very rare but it happens. And it happened for

a reason and we need to react.

"If you are at the top you have to win and win, that's nothing new."

Arsenal are away to struggling Tottenham in a north London derby on Sunday, with Arteta saying: "We need to go through the pain and go through it looking in the mirror and understand what the game requires now and the next action is Sunday. We need to keep all that in our tummies to show it on Sunday."

Meanwhile Saka told Arsenal.

"It's pretty flat. We're pretty disappointed with the result, it's the only way to describe it. "I think it's a game of two halves. In the first half we started so well but in the second half we dropped the level and got punished for it." Looking ahead to the derby match, the England international added: "It was already a big game and now it's still a big game...It's still in our control so we just need to focus on that, fix the issues we're having now and get back to winning ways."

Riffa Thrash Budaiya to Stay in Title Hunt

Matchday 15 of the Nassr Bin Hamad Premier League continued last night with Riffa producing a comfortable 3-0 win over Budaiya at Bahrain National Stadium, matching the scoreline from the reverse fixture and keeping their title charge firmly on track.

Fresh from their Khalid bin Hamad Cup final triumph, Mohamed Mashaan's side carried momentum into the contest but were initially wasteful. Rodrigo Yuri dragged an effort inches wide in the 11th minute and then missed again in the 26th, firing a close-range half volley off target after a rebound fell kindly inside the box.

Budaiya, led by Sayed Hassan Isa, thought they had earned a penalty in the 23rd minute for

a suspected handball on Sayed Mahmood AlMoosawi, only for VAR to overturn the decision after a lengthy review.

The breakthrough arrived three minutes before the in-

terval. Following another VAR check, Budaiya's defender was penalised for handball while sliding to block a cross, his trailing arm catching the ball inside the area. The decision sparked furious protests from the Budaiya bench, resulting in a red card for an official. Yuri stepped up and converted confidently to hand Riffa a deserved lead.

Riffa goalkeeper Dziugas Bartkus preserved the advantage with a superb point-blank save in first-half stoppage time, ensuring his side went into the break ahead.

The contest swung decisively in the closing stages. Substitute Ebrahim Al Khattal doubled the lead deep into stoppage time after Sayed Hashim Isa latched onto a header, dummied his marker cleverly and slipped the ball into Al Khattal's path for a simple finish.

Budaiya's frustrations then boiled over as Ali Khalil was shown a red card, initially for a last-man challenge and subsequently for dissent after arguing with the referee. Riffa capitalised immediately. Al Khattal turned provider, squaring for Ali Hassan Saeed to tap in a third as the final act of the match.

The win lifts Riffa to 33 points in third place, level with Al Khaldiya and Muharraq, while holding a game in hand. Budaiya remain sixth on 18 points.

Elsewhere, Al Shabab stunned A'ali 1-0, with Daniel Omokhoa converting a 73rd-minute penalty to secure just their second victory of the season. Matchday 15 continues tonight as Al Ahli face Al Najma at Khalifa Sports City, and Muharraq meet Bahrain Club at Shaikh Ali bin Mohammed Stadium, with both matches kicking off at 9pm.

Antonelli dominates again

Kimi Antonelli leads day two times in Formula 1 Aramco Pre-Season Testing 2026 at BIC

● Italian star puts Mercedes atop timesheet for second straight day in Sakhir

Kimi Antonelli powered Mercedes to the top of the timesheet for the second successive day this week in Formula 1 Aramco Pre-Season Testing 2026, which continued yesterday at Bahrain International Circuit (BIC), 'The Home of Motorsport in the Middle East', in Sakhir.

Antonelli was quickest under lights on day two of the tests' final three-day session in the Kingdom, posting a best lap time of 1min 32.803secs during this evening's running around BIC's 5.412-kilometre track.

Antonelli set the pace for the second time after five days of tests. His mark tonight was also the best so far of the pre-season at BIC – showcasing the capabilities of Mercedes's F1 W17 car.

Antonelli finished the day with a narrow 0.058secs gap from McLaren's Oscar Piastri, behind the wheel of his MCL40, on the final classification. Both front-runners were in their cars during the later session.

Max Verstappen followed in third, testing the full day for Red Bull Racing in their RB22. He was 0.359secs off the pace as he racked up the highest number of laps for the day of 139.

Ferrari's Lewis Hamilton came fourth in his SF-26 0.605s from the top, while reigning F1 Drivers' World Champion Lando Norris made it two McLaren's in the top five going 0.650s from Antonelli with the fastest time of yesterday's morning runs.

Alpine's Franco Colapinto in his A526 ranked sixth 1.015s back, while completing the top 10 were Nico Hulkenberg in his



Audi R26 1.184s off the pace, George Russell for Mercedes 1.308s behind his teammate, Esteban Ocon of Haas 1.398s behind in his VF-26, and Liam Lawson of Racing Bulls 1.729s in his VCARB 03.

Rounding out the day two classification from 11th to 16th, respectively, were Alexander Albon (+1.752s) testing the while day for Williams in their FW48, Gabriel Bortoleto (+2.460s) with Audi, Oliver Bearman (+2.476s) for Haas, Sergio Perez (+2.566s) for Cadillac in their CA01, Fernando Alonso (+4.669s) in Aston Martin's AMR26 testing the entire day, and Valtteri Bottas (+7.390s) for Cadillac.

F1 Aramco Pre-Season Testing 2026 continues today with the sixth and final day of running in Sakhir, setting the stage for this year's FIA F1 World Championship, which flags off in Melbourne, Australia from 6 to 8 March.

BIC will be welcoming fans on

Friday, with gates scheduled to open at 11am and close at 7pm.

Also today at BIC, those who attended testing enjoyed a fan-engagement experience in a F1 Pit Lane Walk. Scores of F1 enthusiasts took part in the activity, which is a favourite with members of the public.

Fans coming to testing on Friday will be able to join another F1 Pit Lane Walk. It is scheduled from 2.05pm to 2.50pm and all ticket holders will get to enjoy the experience at no extra cost.

Fans should note that, due to teams working on the cars during the testing period, some of the garages may be screened off on the pitlane side.

Williams 'on the back foot' after missing Barcelona: Albon

Williams driver Alexander Albon fears missing the Barcelona shakedown last month has left his team clawing to make up lost ground to its main rivals in the build-up on the new Formula One season.

With all teams scrambling to conform to the sweeping overhaul of engine and chassis regulations, Williams were behind the pace and so skipped the shakedown, preferring to do virtual track testing with Albon and his teammate Carlos Sainz.

Williams did take part in last week's testing in Bahrain and are back on track again this week but the Thai-British driver is concerned that they may have lost some serious ground to Mercedes, Red Bull, McLaren and Ferrari.

"Obviously it was frustrating

to miss out in Barcelona," Albon, 29, told AFP on Wednesday.

"Clearly we missed an opportunity to learn. We are a little bit on the back foot compared to our rivals up and down the grid.

"And we've realised just there's so much learning to do in these days. Every day has become so valuable.

"Even just looking at ourselves, how much we've improved from the first day of testing last week to where we are now is huge."

Team principal James Vowles has already said he is determined Williams should do at least as well as their fifth place in the constructors' standings in 2025, their joint-best finish in 10 years.

"I share the same vision as James," said Albon.

"I feel that it would always be nice to be even more, even closer

to the top teams and pulling away from the midfield fight.

"Realistically, I think it's going to be a big challenge for us to be able to be there.

"We are as a team very ambitious. Unfortunately we found some bottlenecks and so we are on the back foot.

"We're not where we want to be for now. That's not to say we can't get back to the top five in the constructors and have a good season, but we have some catching up to do."

'Special' Thailand

The London-born driver, who announced his engagement to Chinese LPGA golfer Lily He last month, is just the second driver in 75 years of Formula One to race under the Thai flag.

"I feel very much Thai in who I am," Albon said.

"I am Buddhist and I feel very

close to Thai people, Thai culture. I resonate much closer to Thailand than I do anywhere else. So it means a lot.

"What meant a lot to me was my first podium in Formula 1 to

see the Thai flag behind me. It was very special."

That passion for his mother's country - his father is the British racing driver Nigel Albon - has also stoked a desire to create a

Grand Prix in Thailand.

"One of my biggest goals is to try to make this happen," he said. "I think that would be amazing for the country. We're speaking almost every day about how we can make this work. So it's a big goal of mine.

"I think it has the infrastructure and hospitality and the friendliness to have it."

Albon also believes Thailand can position itself as the motor-sport capital of the region.

"There is not really the structure apart from Japan in motor-sport for Southeast Asia.

"There needs to be one. And I would love it to be Thailand.

"I'd say there needs to be a culture and a structure where we need to make it happen.

"Also it would be amazing for me to be able to say that Thailand is almost the Asian home of motorsport or Formula 1."
