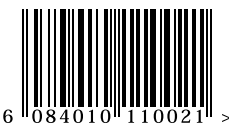
HM the King instructed the RHF to take the necessary measures to ensure the timely distribution of the disbursements, supporting families in meeting their needs during Eid Al Fitr.

# Subsidy strategy

Financial support for fuel, electricity, and other essentials will be paid directly to citizens

● Part of proposals to ensure aid is fairly distributed based on Bahrainis' income and needs

The planned "Citizen Account" is set to switch to direct cash payments for fuel, electricity, and other essentials, replacing scattered subsidies with a single system.

The move, aimed at making support more direct and structured, was central to a meeting yesterday between government ministers and lawmakers as they went through plans for the 2025-2026 budget.

Parliament Speaker Ahmed Al Musallam, Shura Council Chairman Ali Al Saleh, and Finance Minister His Excellency Shaikh Salman bin Khalifa Al Khalifa led the discussions, with ministers and members of both chambers weighing how to shape the system so it reaches those who need it most.

Al Musallam described the co-operation between Parliament and the government as a joint effort to steady the economy and improve people's lives.

He pointed to economic growth, steady finances, and better public services as key aims.

Shaikh Salman said more money would go into housing, schools, hospitals, and roads while also making sure public

funds were used more effectively.

He welcomed Parliament's input, saying the budget was built around long-term plans for growth and stability.

Al Saleh praised the government's breakdown of spending

and said the Council would draw on economic expertise to examine the budget in detail.

The meeting also looked at social care, with plans to open 19 new support centres across Bahrain.

Lawmakers and ministers went through proposals to tighten subsidy rules, ensuring aid is fairly distributed based on income and needs.

Parliament's Financial and Economic Affairs Committee will now go over the budget before final discussions take place in Parliament.

# Buy-back blunder

Investors sue real estate firm over unfinished homes and refunds

A real estate firm is facing legal action after failing to deliver homes it had promised to buyers under a buy-back arrangement.

Investors who had paid in full for residential units are now seeking to have their contracts cancelled and their money refunded, with BD161,675 at stake.

The cases, brought against the company and its owner, argue that the firm breached its agreements by neither completing the properties nor transferring ownership as required.

The claimants, three in total, had signed preliminary sale and purchase agreements with the company.

The first, along with his partners, bought an off-plan unit for BD72,000, fully paid.

On the same day, they also signed a resale agreement, under which the property was to be sold back to the company for the same amount.

## Sale contract

Construction was meant to be completed within a year. It wasn't. No final sale contract was signed either. A similar agreement was reached between the company and the second and third claimants, who together paid BD85,000.

Their unit, too, was never finished. The company also failed to make two months' rent payments totalling BD4,675 under a separate lease agreement.

Money that investors are requesting a refund for after fully paying for residential units.

With no progress and no sign of their money being returned,

the claimants took the matter to court.

The court examined the sale and purchase agreements, noting that they bore signatures attributed to both sides.

The company had raised no objections to the agreements nor challenged the fact that full payment had been made.

No evidence was presented to show any real steps taken towards completing the units or transferring ownership.

## Contractual obligations

The court found the company had broken its contractual obligations by failing to hand over the properties despite having received the full purchase price.

In the first case, the court ordered the company to return BD72,000 to the claimant, with legal interest set at 1 per cent per year from the date of the claim until full repayment.

It was also told to cover legal fees and court costs, including BD1,500 for legal representation.

## Bahrain's Gold Man Bids Farewell

Bahrain has lost a pioneering businessman with the passing of Lalchand Chaturbhujdas, Chairman of Chaturbhuj Mulchand & Sons. He passed away yesterday, leaving behind a legacy that shaped the country's gold trade and business landscape for generations.

## Business Legacy

With a family history in Bahrain dating back to the early 1850s, Mr. Lalchand played a pivotal role in expanding and diversifying the Chaturbhuj family's business empire.

Originally known for its presence in pearling, food-stuffs, and real estate, the family business evolved under his leadership.

In 1948, he introduced gold bullion trading to Bahrain, marking a turning point in the industry. He was also the first to bring Mexican and Turkish gold coins, along with sovereigns, into the Kingdom.

His impact extended far beyond trade.

As a pioneer in the gold industry, he revolutionised the market by introducing 24-car-

at 5 tola bars to goldsmiths, a move that helped shape Bahrain's gold manufacturing sector.

His influence was so profound that he became affectionately known as the 'Gold Man of Bahrain'.

In 1967, he took another significant step by opening the first gold retail store on Bab Al Bahrain road - a store that still stands as a testament to his vision.

His contributions were not limited to retail and trade. Recognising the cultural and historical significance of Bahraini craftsmanship, he established Gumaash Creations, a bespoke manufacturing unit specialising in natural pearl jewellery.

# Woman loses money to fake online clothing store

Another citizen became the victim of an online scam after falling prey to a fraudulent Instagram account.

The account, claimed to sell clothing and attracted attention for its variety of dresses, particularly for the upcoming Eid celebrations.

The victim was browsing Instagram when she discovered the account and became interested in purchasing a dress.

She reached out to the seller through WhatsApp, where the account asked for her name, address, and other personal details.

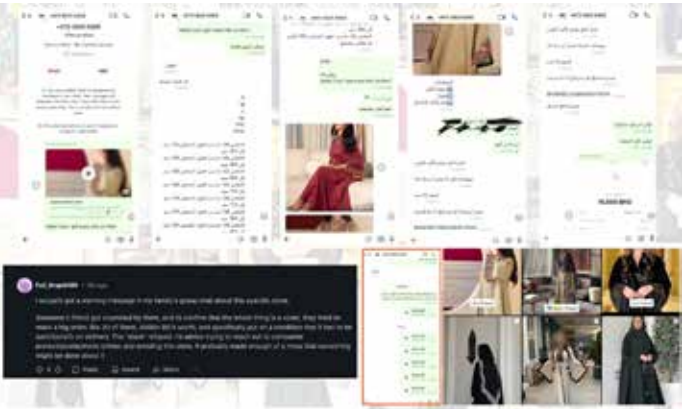
They then requested a prepayment of BD16 for the dress, which was supposedly to be delivered on the 17th of Ramadan at 4pm.

## Delivery

After making the payment through BenefitPay, the woman was informed that the order would be delivered the next day. However, the promised delivery never arrived.

She tried calling and messaging the seller multiple times, but her attempts were met with silence.

The WhatsApp number displayed "unable to receive calls," and her messages were marked with a single checkmark, indicating they were not delivered.

## Tips to Avoid Scams:

- 1-Verify the credibility of the website or seller before making a purchase.
- 2-Check customer reviews and ratings from previous buyers.
- 3-Avoid making upfront payments through untrust-

- ed methods.
  - 4-Use secure payment methods such as credit cards or cash on delivery.

## Seller

Taking matters into her own hands, the woman's daughter attempted to contact the seller from her own number, and to her surprise, the phone rang.

She also messaged the seller under the pretense of placing a new order, and this time, the seller responded immediately, asking for the same details and payment, this time via IBAN.

Confronting the account with proof of her mother's prior conversation, the daughter was met with the same treatment — her messages showed only one checkmark, and the seller's number was again "unable to receive calls."

## Communication

The scam is reportedly designed to steal money from un-

suspecting buyers before blocking them to prevent any further communication.

The account has a fake following, and comments are disabled to avoid detection.

The victim has since reported the incident to the Cyber Police, and investigations are underway.

## Experiences

Additionally, several others have come forward on Reddit, sharing similar experiences with the fraudulent account.

The family urges others to be vigilant and spread the word to prevent more individuals from falling victim to this scam.

The authorities are currently investigating the matter, and a call from CID was received just yesterday, confirming that the case is being handled.

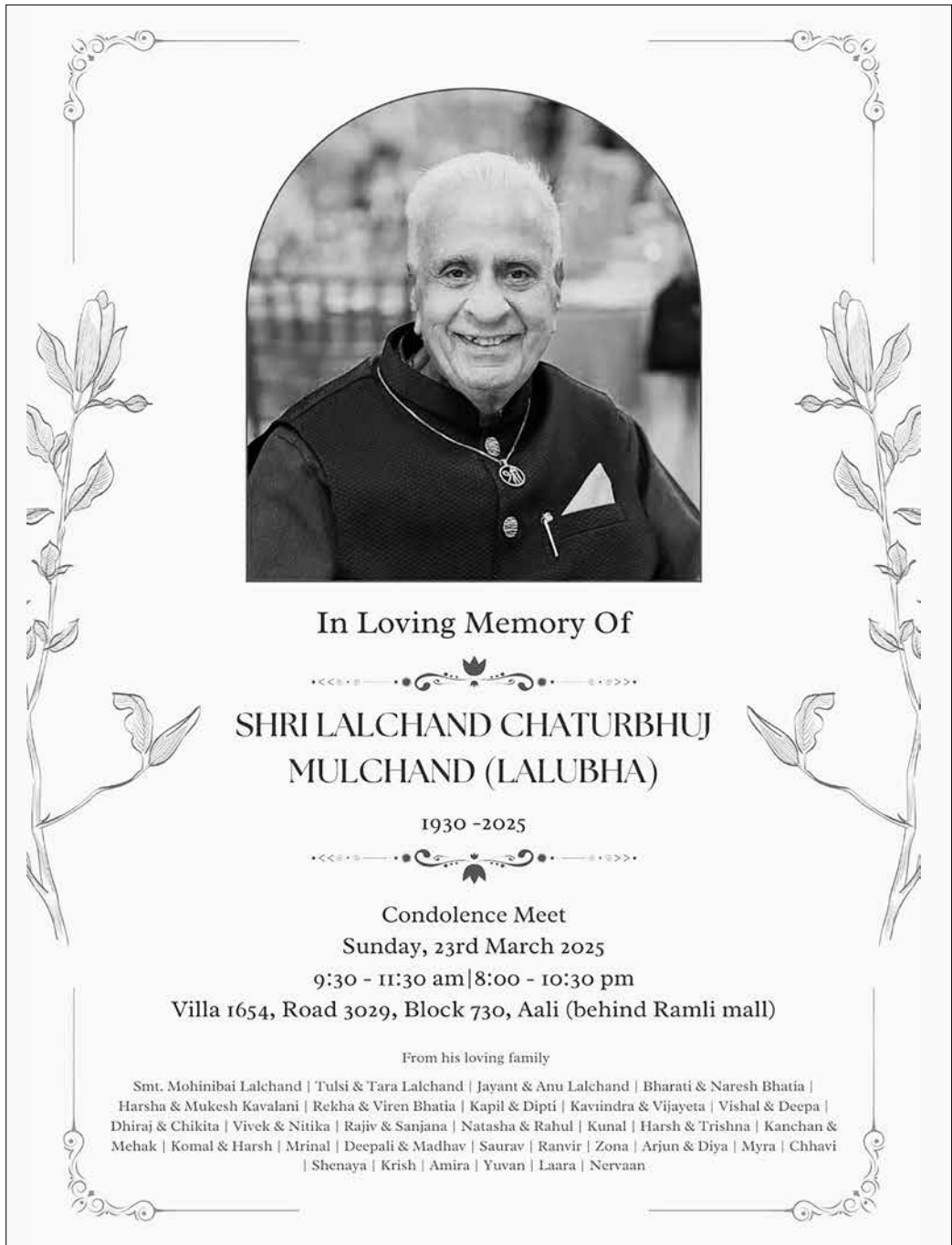
The Ministry of Education held a groundbreaking ceremony for a new government girls' school in Galali.

first,” he said. “Riders will need a valid licence, bikes will be inspected before use, and full protective gear including helmets, gloves, and boots will be mandatory.”

The project is expected to attract riders from across the governorate and beyond.

Al Doseri noted that with Bahrain’s National Sports Day held annually, the track could serve as a venue for related events.

## Three punished for illegal shrimp fishing

● Jailed, fined and ordered deported

Three Indian men have been jailed for a month and ordered out of Bahrain after being caught shrimp fishing with banned bottom trawl nets. One of them was also fined BD1,500.

Their boat, nets, and catch were seized.

The Coast Guard spotted the vessel carrying the three men and using the outlawed gear.

When approached, they tried to flee, but patrol officers pursued and stopped them.

On board, they found shrimp, a haul of small fish, and the prohibited fishing equipment.

### Investigations

Prosecutors questioned the suspects, who admitted to using the illegal nets. They were held in custody as investigations continued.

Their boat and gear were confiscated, while the catch was sold at auction, with the proceeds deposited accordingly.

The men were later sent to court, where they were sentenced to prison and ordered to leave Bahrain once their sentences were served.

# Man jailed for using brother’s ID to flee Bahrain

A man who fled Bahrain nearly a decade ago using his brother’s identity was sentenced to a year in prison after being caught upon his return.

The High Criminal Court found him guilty of assuming his brother’s identity, using his ID card to pass through border checks, and leaving the country while wanted by security services.

The case dates back to 2015, when the man, now in his thir-

ties, was summoned by the authorities.

Rather than face arrest, he chose to escape.

### Knowledge

He took his older brother’s ID from their home without his knowledge, travelled to the King Fahd Causeway, and handed it to a customs officer as though it were his own.

The deception worked. He crossed the border and disappeared.

For years, he remained abroad. He found work, settled in, and carried on as though nothing had happened.

Then, at the end of 2024, he decided to return. This time, he used his own passport and valid ID.

As soon as he arrived at the causeway, border officers stopped him. He was handed over to the Criminal Investigation Directorate.

Records showed he had left Bahrain on his own passport in

2012 and returned the next day.

### Suspicious

After that, there was no trace of him — until now. The gap in travel history raised suspicions, leading to the discovery of how he had slipped away unnoticed years earlier.

Questioned by prosecutors, he admitted what he had done. He said fear of being caught had driven him to flee.

The Public Prosecution charged him with working with a public employee, who had no

knowledge of the deception, to enter false details into a government database.

This was done at the King Fahd Causeway’s border records, under the General Directorate of Nationality, Passports and Residence Affairs (NPRA). By submitting his brother’s ID, he made the system register a false entry.

He was also charged with misusing another person’s identity card, which had allowed him to cross into Saudi Arabia unlawfully.



# Bahrain sees Gulf business licences soar by 524%

Bahrain ranked second in the Gulf for issuing business licences to GCC citizens, recording a 524 per cent increase since 2007.

Saudis accounted for three-quarters of these permits.

Meanwhile, property ownership by Gulf nationals in Bahrain reached 2,407 cases in 2023, with Emiratis making up the largest share at 33.7 per cent.

The figures come from the GCC Common Market report, published by the GCC Statistical Centre, which tracks economic ties across the bloc.

Bahrain issued 27,300 business licences, making it the second most active country in the region after the UAE, which granted 30,600.

Across the Gulf, the total num-

ber of licences surged to 81,200, compared to 14,600 in 2007, an increase of 455.6 per cent.

The report also sheds light on intra-GCC trade, where Bahrain recorded \$9.9 billion in exports, placing it behind the UAE and Saudi Arabia.

### Private sector

Meanwhile, Gulf citizens working in other member states numbered 32,400, with two-thirds employed in the private sector, which saw a rise of 18.6

per cent compared to 2007.

Gulf citizens’ property purchases in other member states grew by 25.7 per cent in 2023, with Bahrain and the UAE seeing the most deals.

In Bahrain, Emiratis made up 33.7 per cent of buyers, followed by Saudis (29.9 per cent), Kuwaitis (27.3 per cent), Qataris

(7.8 per cent), and Omanis (1.4 per cent).

Bahrainis topped the list of Gulf investors in Qatar, accounting for 37.6 per cent of all purchases. In Saudi Arabia, they were the second largest group, making up 10.3 per cent of 1,996 transactions, while Kuwaitis accounted for 74.4 per cent.

In Kuwait, Bahrainis ranked behind Saudis, who dominated 89.3 per cent of 214 transactions, while Bahrainis held a 7.5 per cent share.

Bahrain remains a hub for regional investors, with 40 publicly listed companies open to Gulf nationals.

These firms hold a combined capital of \$17.5 billion, with 52,700 Gulf shareholders.

Saudi investors made up 51.4 per cent of foreign shareholders in Bahrain’s stock market, followed by Kuwaitis at 26.2 per cent.

Across the GCC, 737 public companies are open to Gulf investors, holding \$520.4 billion in capital, with 522,200 shareholders.

Saudi Arabia had the largest share, with 226 companies and \$210.9 billion in capital, drawing 11,400 Gulf investors.

## Solar energy system installation



His Excellency Kamal bin Ahmed Mohammed, President of the Electricity and Water Authority (EWA), announced the completion of a solar energy system installation at the Khalifa City water distribution station, making it fully powered by renewable energy with the capacity to export surplus electricity to the national grid. Khalifa City station is the eleventh EWA facility to be equipped with solar energy systems, reflecting the authority’s commitment to sustainability and operational efficiency. The project includes the installation of 2,032 solar panels on the station’s underground reservoir rooftops, with a maximum production capacity of 1,400 kilowatts of clean electricity, ensuring full operation on renewable energy. The system is equipped with a self-cleaning mechanism for the solar panels and is integrated with monitoring and control devices.

# Two years in prison for human traffickers

Three Asian men who trafficked a woman into Bahrain under false pretences and forced her into sex work have been jailed for up to five years.

A court also fined them BD2,000 each, ordered them to cover her repatriation costs, and ruled they be deported once their sentences are served, the Public Prosecution said.

The case came to light after a report from the Anti-Trafficking in Persons Department at the General Directorate of Criminal Investigation and Forensic Evidence.

It stated that the woman had been recruited in her home country with the promise of work in a women’s salon.

But when she arrived in Bahrain, she was met at the airport, housed, and moved between locations before being forced into sex work against her will.

Prosecutors launched an inquiry as soon as the report was received.

The woman was interviewed, and arrangements were made for her to stay at a shelter run by the National Committee for Combating Trafficking in Persons.

Seef Properties held its Ordinary Annual General Meeting at Al Liwan Cinema to review and approve key agenda items.

Operating profit for the financial year ended 31 December 2024 reached BD 12.32 m, marking an 11.70% decrease from BD 13.95 m in the previous year.

The Ordinary Annual General Meeting saw the election of a new Board of Directors, with nine members elected for a three-year term, and the remaining position appointed by the Social Insurance Organization.

Essa Mohammed Najibi, Sattam Sulaiman Al Gosai, and Mohammed Ebrahim Al Bastaki were re-elected, Anwar Mohamed Ali Murad, Zayed Ali Rashed Al Amin, Majed Abdulla Al Khan, Ahmed Habib Ahmed Kassim, Sara Khalil Nooruddin, and Ahmed Al Mutawa were elected, while Sahar Rashed Al Mannai was appointed by the Social Insurance Organization.

News in brief

◆ **US envoy Steve Witkoff** said technical discussions on a possible deal to end the Russia-Ukraine war will begin Monday in Saudi Arabia, predicting a ceasefire agreement could come as soon as “a couple of weeks.” “I believe on Monday we actually have the technical teams going” to the kingdom, Witkoff told Bloomberg Television early Wednesday as he expressed confidence in ongoing negotiations following a telephone call the previous day between US President Donald Trump and Russian counterpart Vladimir Putin. “They agreed on a pathway to some ceasefire conditions... and to a full-on ceasefire that will be negotiated over the coming days. I actually think in a couple of weeks we’re going to get to it,” he said. Witkoff, who is also Trump’s special envoy to the Middle East, did not provide details on the upcoming talks in Saudi Arabia. But he said it was time “for the technical teams to dot the i’s and cross the t’s, and everybody is committed to that process.”

**US envoy predicts Ukraine ceasefire in ‘couple of weeks’**

◆ **Taiwanese troops** will simulate possible scenarios for a Chinese invasion in 2027 during the island’s annual war games, the defence ministry said yesterday, as Beijing maintains military pressure on Taipei. China insists self-ruled Taiwan is part of its territory and has threatened to seize the island by force. Officials in the United States -- Taipei’s main

backer and biggest arms supplier -- have previously cited 2027 as a possible timeline for a Chinese invasion of Taiwan. Taiwan’s “Han Kuang” exercises, which the ministry said would be held from July 9-18, are conducted every year across Taiwan to simulate defending the island against Chinese attacks. In a report submitted to parliament on Wednesday, the ministry said this year’s scenarios would be based on China’s “grey-zone” intrusions and “possible actions of the Chinese Communist military’s invasion of Taiwan in 2027”.

◆ **Israel’s resumption** of strikes on the Gaza Strip is a major step in the wrong direction after its ceasefire with Palestinian militant group Hamas earlier this year, French President Emmanuel Macron said Wednesday alongside Jordan’s King Abdullah II. “The resumption of Israeli strikes yesterday (Tuesday), despite the efforts of mediators, represents a dramatic step backwards,” Macron said ahead of talks in Paris with Abdullah. “It’s dramatic for the Palestinians of Gaza, who are again plunged into the terror of bombardment, and dramatic for the (Israeli) hostages and their families who live in the nightmare of uncertainty.” Israel earlier this week carried out its deadliest bombing of Gaza since a fragile ceasefire began in January between Israel and the Palestinian territory’s Islamist rulers Hamas.

Long lines of fleeing civilians filled the roads of Gaza Wednesday as Israel kept up its renewed bombardment of the territory for a second day despite a chorus of calls from foreign governments to preserve a fragile January ceasefire.

The war death toll updated daily by the health ministry in the Hamas-run territory showed an increase of 970 in the space of 48 hours, though AFP could not confirm how many of them were recorded as casualties from the strikes. Families with young children fled northern Gaza for areas further south, fearing

UK teen who planned school massacre jailed for life

A UK teenager who killed three family members and planned to outdo notorious US massacres to become “the world’s most famous school shooter of the 21st century” was on Wednesday jailed for a minimum of 49 years.

Nicholas Prosper, 18 at the time of the killings, used a shotgun to kill his mother Juliana Falcon, 48, sister Giselle, 13, and brother Kyle, 16, who also received more than 100 knife wounds, at their home in Luton, north of London, in September 2024.

“Your ambition was notoriety. You wanted to be known posthumously as the world’s most famous school shooter of the 21st century,” judge Bobbie Cheema-Grubb said on Wednesday as she sentenced the now 19-year-old.

Prosper told police upon his arrest of his “Friday the 13th” plan to also kill dozens of four- and five-year-old pupils and

two teachers at a nearby primary school that he had previously attended, then himself.

He said his aim was to conduct an attack more deadly than the US Sandy Hook and Virginia Tech massacres, but that the plan was interrupted when his mother woke up before he could kill his family in their sleep.

The noisy struggle alerted neighbours, who called the police.

After killing her he placed a novel with the title “How to Kill your Family” on her body.

“You explicitly sought to emulate and outdo Adam Lanza, the 20-year-old American who shot dead 20 children and six adults at Sandy Hook Elementary School in Newton, Connecticut in 2012,” the judge said.

“You aimed for 34 deaths, one more than the deadliest school shooting of recent times in the United States of America, at Virginia Tech in 2007,” she added.

Prosper had drawn diagrams of the classrooms at Luton’s St Joseph’s Catholic Primary School and written a note next to it reading “kill all”.

“You filmed yourself acting out the killing in the kitchen,” said the judge.

Russia, Ukraine swap 372 POWs: Russian defence ministry

Russia and Ukraine have exchanged 372 soldiers in a prisoner swap brokered by the United Arab Emirates, the Russian defence ministry said Wednesday.

The Kremlin announced the swap on Tuesday, following talks between US President Donald Trump and Russian counterpart Vladimir Putin.

Moscow returned 175 Ukrainian POWs, as well as “22 seriously wounded prisoners of war in need of urgent medical assistance”, while Kyiv returned 175 Russian troops, the Russian defence ministry said.

Russia said it returned the Ukrainian wounded prisoners as a “gesture of goodwill”.

“All the Russian soldiers are in Belarus, where they are being provided with the necessary psychological and medical assistance and given the

opportunity to contact their relatives,” it added.

**Zelensky warns against slowing aid against slowing aid Helsinki, Finland**

President Volodymyr Zelensky warned Wednesday against heeding a Kremlin call to halt military aid for his country and announced he would speak with US President Donald Trump later within hours.

“I do not believe that we should make any concessions in terms of assistance for Ukraine but rather there should be an increase in assistance for Ukraine,” Zelensky said.

Zelensky said an increase in aid would “signal that Ukraine is ready for any surprises from the Russians”.



# Home at last

Smiles, thumbs ups and a safe return for ‘stranded’ NASA astronauts

After an unexpected nine-month stay in space, a pair of NASA astronauts finally returned to Earth on Tuesday, concluding a mission that captured global attention and became a political flashpoint.

A SpaceX Crew Dragon spaceship carrying Butch Wilmore and Suni Williams -- alongside fellow American Nick Hague and Russian cosmonaut Aleksandr Gorbunov -- streaked through the atmosphere before deploying parachutes for a gentle splashdown off the Florida coast at 5:57 pm (2157 GMT).

Ground teams erupted in cheers as the gumdrop-shaped spacecraft named Freedom, charred from withstanding scorching temperatures of 3,500 degrees Fahrenheit (2,000 degrees Celsius) during re-entry, bobbed steadily on the waves beneath a clear, sunny sky.

“What a ride -- I see a capsule full of

grins,” said Hague. As fast boats raced to the capsule for initial safety checks -- an unlikely escort arrived in the form of a playful pod of dolphins.

Soon after, a larger recovery vessel hoisted Freedom aboard. Teams opened the hatch, and one by one, the astronauts were helped out onto mobility aids, waving and flashing thumbs-up signs.

Next, they will be flown by helicopter to Houston, where they will be able to meet their families in another day or two, and begin a physical rehabilitation program.

“PROMISE MADE, PROMISE KEPT,” the White House posted on X, repeating a contentious claim that President Donald Trump’s administration had accelerated the recovery timeline.

‘Unbelievable resilience’

The quartet left the International Space Station early Sunday, beginning

their 17-hour journey home after final farewells and hugs with the remaining crew.

Wilmore and Williams, both ex-Navy pilots and veterans of two prior space missions, flew to the orbital lab in June last year, on what was supposed to be a days-long roundtrip to test out Boeing’s Starliner on its first crewed flight.

However, propulsion issues rendered the spacecraft unfit for their return, forcing it to return empty.

They were subsequently reassigned to NASA’s SpaceX Crew-9 mission, which arrived at the ISS last September with a reduced crew of two -- rather than the usual four -- to accommodate the pair, who had become widely referred to as the “stranded” astronauts.

With Crew-10 docking Sunday, Crew-9 was finally cleared to depart. Wilmore and Williams’ 286-day stay exceeds the typical six-month ISS rotation but ranks sixth among US records. Frank Rubio

Italy finds six bodies, 40 missing after migrant shipwreck

Six people died and 40 are missing after a migrant shipwreck in the Mediterranean, the United Nations said Wednesday, as Italian authorities searched for survivors off the island of Lampedusa.

“Still too many dead in a new shipwreck in the Mediterranean,” Chiara Cardoletti, the Italy representative of the UN refugee agency UNHCR, said on X.

An inflatable dinghy carrying 56 people had left the Tunisian port of Sfax on Monday before getting into trouble, she

said.

“After a few hours of sailing, the dinghy began to deflate and take on water. Six bodies recovered. 40 missing,” she wrote.

Italy’s coastguard and police pulled 10 people to safety -- six men and four women -- a UNHCR spokesperson told AFP, adding that they are scouring the area for survivors.

Those rescued said there had been 56 people on board from the Ivory Coast, Mali, Guinea and Cameroon.

## Ghostly lunar sunsets shot by private lander

A private US lander has captured eerie high-definition images of a lunar sunset, which NASA hopes will help unravel the mystery of a strange haze first observed on the Moon in the 1960s.

Texas-based Firefly Aerospace, which published the pictures on Tuesday, became the first private company to land a robotic spacecraft upright on the Moon earlier this month. Its Blue Ghost lander -- roughly the size of two rhinos side by side -- touched down on March 2 at Mons Latreille, a volcanic feature within Mare Crisium on the Moon’s north-eastern near side, and operated until March 16 when it powered down with the onset of the lunar night.

One of the new images shows the Sun glowing just above the horizon, its halo tinged with green. Above it, a small dot marks Venus, while Earth’s bright reflection appears almost as large as the Sun at the top of the frame. Another view reveals the setting Sun bathed in a green glow, as seen from a west-facing camera.

“We are taking time to have scientific specialists go over all the imagery,” said Joel Kearns, deputy associate administrator for exploration at NASA’s Science Mission Directorate.

“One of the things they will be looking for is to see if they can identify ‘horizon glow’ or a mechanism called ‘dust lofting.’”

Scientists believe lunar dust particles may become electrically charged due to ultraviolet radiation from the Sun, causing them to levitate above the surface. The phenomenon was first spotted by NASA’s Surveyor probes in the 1960s and later observed by Apollo astronauts.

Kearns noted that scientists will compare the images with complementary readings from Blue Ghost’s instruments, including electromagnetic field and radiation sensors, to refine existing theories.

“The images themselves are beautiful, they’re really aesthetic,” he said.

The west-facing image, in particular, shows soil in front of the lander illuminated by light reflected from mountains behind it. The picture’s level of detail could help scientists refine models of how light scatters on the lunar surface.

# Echoes of tradition: Ramadan drummers awaken Kashmir's streets

● Tradition dates back centuries, from Central Asia

## ● Drummers brave freezing temperatures for duty

## ● Community rewards drummers after Ramadan

**A**s the holy month of Ramadan envelops Kashmir, the pre-dawn hours come alive with the resonant beats of drums. In the quiet bylanes of Shalimar, on the outskirts of Srinagar, brothers Muneer and Tauseef take on the sacred duty of waking their community for sehri, the pre-dawn meal before fasting begins. While Muneer beats the drum, Tauseef holds a torch and calls out, “waqt-e-sehar,” echoing a tradition that has defined Ramadan in the valley for centuries.

## A Legacy of Faith and Dedication

The siblings are newcomers to the role of “sahar khan,” or Ramadan drummers, inspired



by their uncle Ghulam Hassan, who walked these same streets for years. "Since childhood, we watched him wake the faithful for sehri," says Muneer. Across Kashmir, each neighbourhood has its own sahar khan, a human alarm who marches through towns and villages, drum in hand, to ensure no one misses

the spiritual preparation for the day-long fast.

## Spiritual Satisfaction in Service

In Ganderbal, 60-year-old Abdul Rasheed has been a sahar khan for four decades. "This role gives me immense spiritual satisfaction," he says with a smile. Similarly, in Shopian, Nazir

Ahmad Mir rises at 2 a.m. to beat his drum, even from within his home's premises. For these drummers, the task is more than a duty—it's a connection to their faith and community.

## A Community's Lifeline

For many Kashmiris, the drummers' beats are an essen-

tial part of Ramadan. "It's hard to wake up in the middle of the night, but the drummers make it easier," says Shaista Akhter, a homemaker from Srinagar. Her children, she adds, refuse to rise for sehri until they hear the familiar drumbeat. This deep trust in the drummers' timing underscores their importance in a region where modern alarms coexist with ancient traditions.

## Centuries of Tradition and Craft

The tradition of sahar khan dates back centuries, with roots tracing to Central Asia. Zareef Ahmad Zareef, a cultural expert, notes that during medieval times, people relied entirely on these human alarms. Today, drummers like Mohammad Jaffar from Budgam continue the legacy, braving freezing temperatures as low as  $-12^{\circ}\text{C}$  to fulfill their role. Many drummers craft or purchase their drums from Lolab village in north Kashmir, known for its quality instruments, which cost between Rs. 3,000 and Rs. 5,000.

## Rewards of Devotion

At the end of Ramadan, the drummers are rewarded by their communities. Moving door to door on Eid, they collect cash, rice, and other gifts, earning between Rs. 15,000 and Rs. 20,000

for their month-long service. This tradition not only sustains the drummers but also strengthens the bond between them and their communities.

## A Tradition That Endures

In a rapidly modernizing world, Kashmir's Ramadan drummers stand as living reminders of a rich cultural and spiritual heritage. Their beats, echoing through the valley's cold, dark nights, continue to unite communities and preserve a tradition that has withstood the test of time.

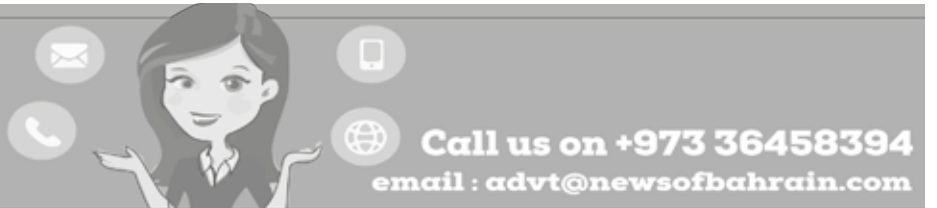

## Djokovic player union launches legal blitz against governing bodies

Tennis union co-founded by Novak Djokovic on Tuesday announced a series of legal actions aimed at the sport's governing bodies, alleging "anti-competitive restraints and abusive practices".

The Professional Tennis Players' Association (PTPA) said it was suing both tour organisers, the Association of Tennis Professionals (ATP) and the Women's Tennis Association (WTA).

The International Tennis Federation (ITF), and International Tennis Integrity Agency (ITIA) were also named as defendants in a series of actions in the United States, United

Kingdom and the European Union.

Both the ATP and WTA responded by vowing to defend themselves against the claims with the men's tour saying the PTPA has "consistently chosen division and distraction through misinformation over progress".

The PTPA was set up by Djokovic and Canadian Vasek Pospisil in 2020. Some 20 players were named as part of at least one of the actions.

"The lawsuits expose systemic abuse, anti-competitive practices, and a blatant disregard for player welfare that have persisted for decades," said the PTPA statement.



# Bahrain chase miracle in Saitama

Bahrain seek a shock win against high-flying Japan in a crucial World Cup qualifier

- **Bahrain take on Japan today at Saitama Stadium 2002**
- **Bahrain is fifth in the group, one point behind second**
- **Bahrain hopes to capitalize on Gulf Cup momentum**

Bahrain's footballers head to Saitama Stadium today with a shot at derailing Japan's World Cup qualification party. Hajime Moriyasu's side can become the first team to book their spot at the 2026 finals with a win, but Dragan Talajic's men, riding high after picking up the Gulf Cup, are determined to upset the script and keep their own hopes alive in Group C.

### Japan's Juggernaut Looms

Japan have been dominant in the AFC qualifiers, collecting 16 points from six games with 22 goals scored. Their only dropped points came in a draw with Australia. A win today guarantees a top-two finish in Group C, securing their place alongside hosts USA, Canada, and Mexico at the finals. Japan have lost just twice in their last 28 home qualifiers, and Bahrain have felt the pressure with four straight defeats, including a crushing 5-0 loss in Riffa last September. "It's about playing to our strengths and securing the win," Moriyasu said last week.

His squad is packed with talent, including Kaoru Mitoma and Takefusa Kubo. With 22 wins in their last 25 international matches, Japan's form is imposing, but Bahrain still have hope.

### Bahrain's Moment of Magic?

Talajic's side are not just here to make up the numbers. Sitting fifth in the group with seven points, they are just one point behind Australia in second and level with Indonesia, Saudi Arabia, and China. Their single win in six qualifiers does not tell the full story. They have won four of their last five matches across all com-

petitions, including a 2-1 Gulf Cup comeback against Oman. Mohamed Marhoon, the hero of that final, will lead the attack, supported by a defence that has kept six clean sheets in seven away qualifiers. "Every match is a final, we've got belief", Mahdi Humaidan told The Daily Tribune. Japan have not conceded more than a goal at home since 2016, making Bahrain's challenge a difficult one, but not impossible.

### Key Men in the Mix

Bahrain's hopes rest on Marhoon's creativity in attack, with Waleed Al-Hayam and Amine Benadi holding firm at the back.

Abdulla Al-Khalasi's pace could stretch Japan's defence. On the other side, Mitoma's speed, Kubo's vision, and Ayase Ueda's goal-scoring ability, now back from injury, pose a serious threat. The return of Hiroki Ito strengthens Japan's defence. This is a battle between Bahrain's resilience and Japan's firepower, where one moment could change everything.

### Group C's Crunch Time

Beyond Japan's lead, the group remains tightly contested. Australia take on Indonesia in Patrick Kluivert's coaching debut, while Saudi Arabia host

China in another crucial match. Bahrain know that securing a result today keeps them in the mix, but Saitama is a tough place to earn points. Japan have netted 46 goals in the last two rounds, while Bahrain have managed just seven in this stage. With four games left, a surprise result today could reshape the race for qualification.

### The Big Call

Japan, who stunned Germany and Spain in the 2022 World Cup, enter as clear favourites. Bahrain enter the match with confidence, knowing that football is full of surprises. A strong performance could turn the tide, keeping their World Cup dreams alive; a draw

would make a strong statement, but a win would be a huge boost to their qualification hopes. Saitama awaits, and time will tell if Bahrain can rise to the occasion.

## Endo says Japan won't be satisfied just to reach World Cup

Liverpool's Wataru Endo said Japan's sights are set higher than just qualifying for next year's World Cup as they look to become the first team to clinch their place today. A draw could also be enough for them to qualify if other results in the group go their way. Captain Endo said qualification is just the start for a team that hope to make a splash at next summer's competition in the United States, Mexico and Canada. "Everyone understands that the third round of Asian qualifiers is not easy but we are aiming higher and not one of us is satisfied at this point," the midfielder told reporters yesterday.

"It's because we have the targets that we do that this team has become what it is now." Japan have won five and drawn one of their six games in the third qualifying phase and have a nine-point lead over second-placed Australia. If they fail to clinch qualification against Bahrain they have another chance to get the job done at home to Saudi Arabia next week, and two more games after that. "I'm excited to be playing at home," said Endo, who was an unused substitute in Liverpool's League Cup final defeat to Newcastle on Sunday. "The team is very motivated and so am I personally. We haven't had much time to prepare but we're in good shape."

## Son says fit and firing as South Korea close on World Cup spot

Son Heung-min dismissed concerns about his form and fitness yesterday as he looks to forget his Tottenham woes by firing South Korea to the World Cup. The 32-year-old attacker has struggled for both during a difficult season with a Spurs team under Ange Postecoglou who are 14th in the Premier League. Previously one of the first names on the Tottenham team-sheet, Son had a hamstring problem late last

year and has come under pressure from fans of the London club for his displays. The Spurs skipper has scored only seven Premier League goals this season and not played the full 90 minutes in the last five league matches. Speaking to reporters on the eve of a home World Cup qualifier against Oman, South Korea's captain admitted to some "difficult and challenging" moments with Tottenham.
