A jury decided that Scott must pay events company, PJAM LLC, USD 382,932.79 after it sued the rapper in March 2018 claiming he declined to

perform at a concert in Minneapolis. In a

state ment to TMZ, Scott's attorney said, "The jury verdict of USD 383k is disappointing but far less than the seven-figure demands made by the promoters. We believe the verdict will be substantially reduced or overturned in subsequent proceedings."
