Bahrain's eGovernment services beat global satisfaction average

Then it comes to offering high-quality eGovernment services, Bahrain is second to none According to a new study, Bahrain has toppled many advanced economies with its eService satisfaction

The study released by the University of Bahrain says that eGovernment satisfaction ratings here are above the international average.

eServices here recorded a satisfaction rate of 81 per cent, comfortably beating the international average of 78.1pc.

In the United States of America, the eGovernment satisfaction level is 77pc.

An estimated 5,000 people, individuals, government employees and businesses persons from all governorates, took part in the study.

The study, based on 2018 statistics, was conducted by a specialised team from the Scientific Research Center in the University of Bahrain.


