## Panic as strong quake shakes Athens

Athens, Greece

Astrong 5.1-magnitude earth-quake jolted Athens on Friday, knocking out phone connections, damaging buildings and causing power outages, as panicked residents rushed into the streets.

State TV ERT reported that at least two people were lightly hurt -- a pregnant tourist and a young boy -- and at least two abandoned buildings in the capital collapsed, while several more suffered damage.

"It was a very intense quake, we were terrified, everyone after a July 7 election. started coming out (of the building)," a young woman named where she works.
