NBB builds talent partnerships

**Asian arrested
for stealing
over BD7,000
from company**

The Criminal Investigation Directorate at the General Directorate of Criminal Investigation and Forensic Evidence has arrested an Asian national for stealing approximately BD7,600 from a company.

The Directorate launched an investigation into the received case that led to the identification and arrest of the suspect, who was found in possession of part of the stolen amount.

Legal proceedings have been initiated in preparation for referring the case to the Public Prosecution.

Community partnership

The Criminal Media Division highlighted the importance of community partnership in supporting security efforts to combat unlawful activities.

It urged businesses to ensure the functionality of surveillance cameras and alarm systems in shops and companies, which play a vital role in enhancing security and protection.

It also called on the public to report any information related to illegal activities by contacting the main operations room at 999, assuring complete confidentiality.

**Ukraine proposes
fresh talks with
Russia next week**

Kyiv has proposed to Moscow a new round of peace talks next week, Ukraine's President Volodymyr Zelensky said yesterday, hours after Russian strikes across Ukraine claimed more lives.

Two rounds of talks in Istanbul between Moscow and Kyiv have failed to result in any progress towards a ceasefire, instead yielding large-scale prisoner exchanges and deals to return the bodies of killed soldiers.

"Security Council Secretary Umerov... reported that he had proposed the next meeting with the Russian side for next week," Zelensky said in his evening address.

"The momentum of the negotiations must be stepped up," he added.

Flawed data used to justify the Gulf shrimp trawling ban should be urgently reassessed, according to fisheries consultant Dr Ibrahim Abdulqader.

Speaking at Bahrain's Professional Fishermen Society yesterday, Abdulqader argued that evidence against shrimp trawling, used to support prohibitions introduced by Bahrain in 2018 and Kuwait four years later, failed to match up with reality.

The fishing consultant presented decades-worth of figures from Bahraini and Saudi waters, challenging the often-cited claim that shrimp nets led to a 90 per cent drop in local fish stocks.

Rather, his evidence suggested far smaller impacts, with only minor numbers of commercially

valuable fish ending up as unintended catch.

Shrimp fishing in the Gulf took off in 1959 with Kuwaiti vessels, and the Bahraini fleet joined the boom in 1967.

Profits

Catches surged, generating profits from markets in the United States and Japan, sparking factory openings along the coast. Yet unregulated fishing

throughout the year gradually reduced yields, causing the collapse of industrial-scale shrimp fishing by the late 1970s.

Nevertheless, trawling carried on through smaller local vessels, maintaining productivity over the following decades.

Abdulqader cited recent field studies from Bahrain and Saudi Arabia showing minimal disruption to targeted fish species.

Only one commercially valua-



ble fish, the Imsalagh, accounted for less than one per cent of Bahrain's shrimp-related by-catch.

Species

In Saudi waters, three species, Imsalagh, Safi, and Shaari, made up around 20 per cent.

Far from a catastrophic ecological impact, these numbers indicated a much more limited influence on marine life.

Historical catch records backed up Abdulqader's claims.

Rather than sustained declines in key species, catches of Badh, Safi, and Shaari fluctuated over the years, suggesting they were influenced primarily by direct fishing practices rather than accidental catches by shrimp trawlers.

Harm

Even crab catches, which rose after shrimp fishing became common, showed little sign of harm linked to shrimp nets.

Abdulqader also pointed out unintended consequences of the shrimp ban.

Fishermen have reported no noticeable recovery in fish stocks since restrictions came into force.

Instead, illegal fishing has reportedly increased, driven partly by official shrimp seasons, which remain publicised despite gear restrictions.

Benefits

This contradiction fuels underground fishing and undermines the ban's intended environmental benefits.

He recommended lifting the current restrictions to allow for a controlled and modern shrimp fishing industry under improved environmental guidelines.

Alternatively, Abdulrahim suggested that authorities abandon public shrimp-season announcements altogether and strengthen enforcement against unlawful trawling.

Coma That Captured a Nation: Saudi 'Sleeping Prince' Dies at 36

Prince Al Waleed bin Khalid bin Talal bin Abdulaziz Al Saud, known as the 'Sleeping Prince', has passed away at age 36 after nearly 20 years in a coma.

The prince slipped into a coma after a severe brain injury in a car accident in London in 2005 while attending a military college. He was brought to King Abdulaziz Medical City in Riyadh, where he remained on life support and was tube fed.

Over the years, his father,

Prince Khalid bin Talal, declined doctors' advice to end treatment, stating that life and death rest solely in God's hands. In 2019, minor reflex movements, such as lifting a finger or turning his head, offered brief hope, but no full recovery followed.

Condolences

Funeral prayers will be held today after Asr prayer at Imam Turki bin Abdullah Mosque in Riyadh. Condolences will be received at the family palace for three days.

MP Demands Doctor Training

Lawmakers rally behind graduates

● **MP backs medical graduates**

● **BMS seeks mandatory training**

A growing wave of medical graduates in Bahrain are facing uncertain futures as job prospects remain scarce. This has prompted a renewed call from parliament to mandate private hospitals to train and absorb young doctors.

This call gained momentum during a meeting between Member of Parliament Munir Ibrahim Suroor and Dr. Amer Al Derazi,

President of the Bahrain Medical Society, where both sides agreed that subsidised healthcare support should come with clear obligations for private sector institutions.

Training obligation urged

MP Suroor expressed support for a proposal requiring private healthcare providers to accommodate and train medical graduates as a condition for receiving Labour Fund (Tamkeen) support.

He noted this would be a practical step toward solving the issue of unemployed doctors, which has become a source of growing concern.

The lawmaker also commended the Bahrain Medical Society for its role in promoting legislation related to the medical sector, encouraging public health dialogue, and contributing to

scientific research.

Oversupply concerns raised

Dr. Al Derazi emphasised that the root of the unemployment problem lies not only in limited training slots but also in the

large number of students graduating from unaccredited medical institutions.

He said private hospitals must be made more accountable in return for public support and added that public hospitals like

Salmaniya Medical Complex

should also expand their training capacity and funding.

He called for stronger public education about career choices in the medical field, especially given the mismatch between graduate volumes and labour market needs.

Liability law in focus

Discussions also touched on the pending Medical Liability Law. Dr. Al Derazi noted that the Society had submitted a comprehensive proposal that balances the rights of patients and practitioners, with inputs gathered from government and private stakeholders.

The two leaders concluded the meeting at the association's Juffair headquarters with a commitment to continue collaborating on legislation, workforce integration, and community health awareness.

Car imports into Bahrain up 15% in first half of 2025

Bahrain brought in 22,226 vehicles during the first half of 2025, according to official figures. That compares with 19,402 during the same stretch last year, marking a 15 per cent rise.

Several forces lie behind the climb. Trade has picked up, the population continues to grow, housing projects are on the rise, and banks have been more willing to lend, particularly in the car market.

This growth follows a pattern that has held since the end of the pandemic. Last year, 44,216 cars entered the country, the highest tally since 2017 when imports topped 47,000.

Busiest month

January saw the busiest month in over eight years, with 5,365 vehicles arriving.



Dealers credit the strong start to year-end discounts and favourable lending terms offered by banks and finance firms.

At the other end of the scale, May brought in just 2,453 vehicles. The slowdown is seen as seasonal, with school exams and summer holidays usually putting the brakes on buying

during that month.

The trend also hints at a widening pool of younger buyers and a pick-up in consumer confidence.

Goods

Court upholds fines for raising over BD26,000 without licence

Two former leaders of a professional society have been found guilty of gathering more than BD26,000 without official permission, after the Court of Cassation upheld previous rulings.

The court imposed a fine of BD100 each on the society's former chairwoman and the former financial secretary.

Judges also ordered the BD26,062 raised illegally to be seized by the authorities.

Prosecutors said the two defendants had breached fundraising regulations by collecting donations without securing the proper government authorisation.

Collection practices

The incident surfaced after the Minister of Social Development alerted prosecutors that civil society monitors in his department had discovered unlawful collection practices.

In her defence, the ex-chair-



woman insisted she never personally handled the BD26,062.

She maintained the funds were directly transferred to the bank account of an event management firm hired to organise a conference, under an agreement with her association.

Hotel expenses

From that sum, BD15,000 was reportedly spent settling hotel expenses, for which she provided invoices, with the remainder handed to the organising company.

However, the courts remained unconvinced by these claims, concluding the funds had been improperly raised without the mandatory approval.

Workplaces ordered to station first-aid trained staff

First-aid trained staff must now be present at every Bahraini workplace under new Health Ministry rules to stop injuries becoming fatal.

The decision, published in the latest edition of the Official Gazette, lays out new requirements for employers across the private sector.

Each site must be ready to deal with medical emergencies, and help must be called at once if someone is badly hurt or suddenly falls ill at work.

Names

One trained person is needed for every 20 workers, and their names must be kept in a log on site.

They must hold a recognised certificate showing they've completed at least one course in first aid.

Supplies

Another employee must be named to check supplies and deal with inspectors when needed.

Workplaces must keep first-aid boxes stocked with items listed in a table attached to the ministerial order.

These kits must be easy to find and checked regularly to make sure everything is usable.

One box is needed for every 100 workers or fewer.

Emergencies

Employers must also put together a plan for emergencies.

This should include ambulance contacts, maps showing the nearest clinic, and a layout of exits.

The order forms part of Min-

isterial Decision No. 16 of 2025, signed by Health Minister, Her Excellency Dr. Jaleela bint Al Sayed Jawad Hassan.

Rule

It replaces a 1976 rule on what first-aid boxes should contain.

Anyone breaching the new rules may face punishment under Article 192 of the 2012 Labour Law or Article 129 of the Public Health Law, depending on the offence.

The decision takes effect the day after it appears in the Gazette.

First kindergarten to be built in Madinat Salman

Work on the first kindergarten in Madinat Salman is set to begin later this month, with Al Namal Contracting Group awarded the BD331,000 project in Block 581. The construction falls under an Eskan Bank programme that was put to tender earlier this year.

A second kindergarten is expected to follow before the year is out.

Coordination

Northern Municipal Council member Mohammed Saad Al Dossary said both projects were the result of repeated coordination with the relevant authorities.

At present, parents in Madinat Salman must travel to neighbouring towns to access nursery services.

Al Dossary said the two kindergartens would cater to hundreds of families and are part of a broader plan to expand educational services in the city.

He said discussions had also taken place with the Education Ministry regarding future primary, intermediate and secondary schools in the same block, with tendering still in progress.

Foundation stone

Separately, fellow councillor Basem Abu Idrees said the Education Ministry was preparing to lay the foundation stone for a new girls' secondary school in Madinat Salman.

The school will be built on a site overlooking the sea and

is to feature a modern design.

According to Abu Idrees, the school forms part of ongoing meetings with ministry staff and ties into efforts to improve public education across the board.

Growing trust

He noted that rising enrolment figures and growing trust among parents suggest that more families are now turning to government schools.

Idrees added that the project reflects national efforts to raise standards in teaching, learning material and school facilities, in line with directives from His Majesty King Hamad.

The work is part of a broader push led by the Crown Prince and Prime Minister to improve public services, particularly in education and healthcare.

New hope for glaucoma patients

Bahrain's glaucoma patients now have a chance to leave behind the hassle of lifelong eye drops, thanks to a new dual surgery performed at Dr. Haifa Eye Hospital.

The procedure, which combines cataract removal with Kahook Dual Blade (KDB) glaucoma surgery, offers a safer, minimally invasive option that lowers eye pressure significantly and improves vision in one sitting.

Vision without drops

For many, managing glaucoma means a lifetime of medications. But poor adherence and

long-term side effects such as eye irritation, allergies, and dryness often cause complications or disease progression.

Consultant Dr. Ahmed Almeer, who led the operation, said the dual procedure changes that outlook.

"Instead of waiting for the disease to worsen, this surgery offers early, effective relief," he said. "It helps patients reduce or eliminate the need for daily drops, and restores vision at the same time."

National milestone

This was not only a medical advancement but also a national one, marking Bahrain's first-ever successful dual KDB eye surgery.

The tool removes a small strip of tissue in the eye's drainage system, easing fluid flow and lowering pressure, while avoiding the risks associated with traditional glaucoma procedures.

Performed in conjunction with cataract surgery, the operation is especially effective for older patients who often suffer from both conditions.

It is also less invasive than

conventional methods, resulting in a faster recovery and fewer post-surgical complications.

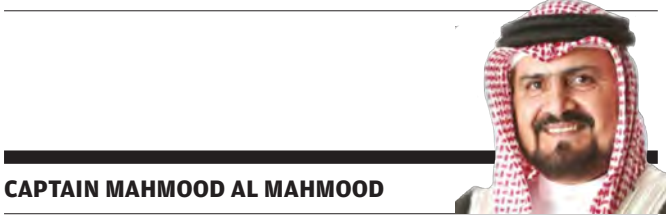

Bahrain-US ties: a commentary
on future stability

The visit to United States of America by HRH Crown Prince & PM, Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa has, by all accounts been an unequivocal success. His Royal Highness had a warm meeting with President Donald Trump and other top officials – meetings that paved the diplomatic and bilateral path for more cooperation and economic ties.

The bilateral landscape between USA and Bahrain is studded with heritage milestones that have shaped the Kingdom – the first non-Arabic school (Al Raja, established in 1899), the first modern medical facility (American Mission Hospital, established 1903) and a long and measured defense relationship which led to Bahrain being home to the US Fifth Fleet, which operates in the Middle East.

Bahrain also signed a key Free Trade Agreement with the US that was ratified in December 2005 and led to many lucrative business deals that shaped the economic trajectory of the Kingdom. The world has changed rapidly in the intervening years but the U.S.-Bahrain ties have withstood the test of this change, as the Kingdom's stance during the recent regional conflict showed.

During his recent visit, this was reflected in Bahrain's promise to partner with America in new economic growth with an investment of USD17 billion. The investment will see the purchase of US aircraft, jet engines and computer servers. More investments could be made in aluminium production and artificial intelligence. An important part of the relationship was an agreement, signed last Wednesday, to advance cooperation on civilian nuclear energy.

"We will put Americans first in all our actions and we will not tolerate international policies that infringe on Americans' speech, privacy or personal liberties," they said in a joint statement. Rubio and Kennedy disassociated the United States from a series of amendments to the International Health Regulations, which provide a legal framework for combatting diseases, agreed last year at the World Health Assembly in Geneva.

US envoy urges accountability

For church attack in West Bank village

The US ambassador to Israel yesterday visited a Christian village in the occupied West Bank and urged accountability for an attack on an ancient church, which residents have blamed on Israeli settlers.

In early July, the village of Taybeh was hit by an arson attack in the area of the ruins of the Byzantine-era Church of Saint George, which dates back to the fifth century.

Residents blamed settlers for the assault, which comes as violence

soars in the West Bank and last week saw an American-Palestinian man killed near Ramallah.

Ambassador Mike Huckabee, an evangelical Christian and staunch advocate for Israel, said his trip to Taybeh aimed to "express solidarity with the people who just want to live their lives in peace, to be able to go to their own land, to be able to go to their place of worship".

"It doesn't matter whether it's a mosque, a church, a synagogue,"

he told journalists.

"It's unacceptable to commit an act of sacrilege by desecrating a place that is supposed to be a place of worship."

"We will certainly insist that those who carry out acts of terror and violence in Taybeh or anywhere be found, be prosecuted, not just reprimanded. That's not enough," he said.

"People need to pay a price for doing something that destroys that which belongs not just to

other people, but that which belongs to God."

In the villages and communities around Taybeh, Palestinian authorities reported that settlers had killed three people and damaged or destroyed multiple water sources in the past two weeks alone. Israel has occupied the West Bank since 1967 and violence has surged in the territory since the Hamas attack of October 7, 2023 triggered the Gaza war.

Since then, Israeli troops or settlers have killed at least 957 Palestinians, including many in the West Bank, according to health ministry figures.

Over the same period, at least 36 Israelis, including soldiers, have been killed in Palestinian attacks or during Israeli military operations, according to official figures.

Huckabee, who has for years been an outspoken supporter of Jewish settlement in the Palestinian territories, on Tuesday demanded an aggressive investigation and consequences after settlers beat to death a Palestinian-American in the West Bank. It was a sign of rare public pressure against US ally Israel by President Donald Trump's administration.

Gaza civil defence says Israeli fire kills 26 near two aid centres

Gaza's civil defence agency said yesterday that Israeli fire killed 26 people and wounded more than 100 near two aid centres, in the latest deaths of Palestinians seeking food.

Deaths of people waiting for handouts in huge crowds near food points in Gaza have become a regular occurrence, with the territory's authorities frequently blaming Israeli fire.

But the US- and Israel-backed Gaza Humanitarian Foundation (GHF), which has replaced UN agencies as the main distributor of aid in the territory, has accused militant group Hamas of fomenting unrest and shooting at civilians.

Civil defence agency spokesman Mahmud Bassal said the deaths happened near a site southwest of Khan Yunis and another centre northwest of Rafah, both in the south, attributing the deaths to "Israeli gunfire".

One witness said he headed to the Al-Tina area of Khan Yunis before dawn with five of his relatives to try to get food when "Israeli soldiers" started shooting.

"My relatives and I were unable to get anything," Abdul Aziz Abed, 37, told AFP. "Every day I go there

and all we get is bullets and exhaustion instead of food."

Three other witnesses also accused troops of opening fire.

'Warning shots'

In response, the Israeli military said it "identified suspects who

approached them during operational activity in the Rafah area, posing a threat to the troops".

Soldiers called for them to turn back and "after they did not comply, the troops fired warning shots", it said, adding that it was aware of the reports about casu-

alties.

"The incident is under review. The shots were fired approximately one kilometre (more than half a mile) away from the aid distribution site at nighttime when it's not active," it said in a statement.

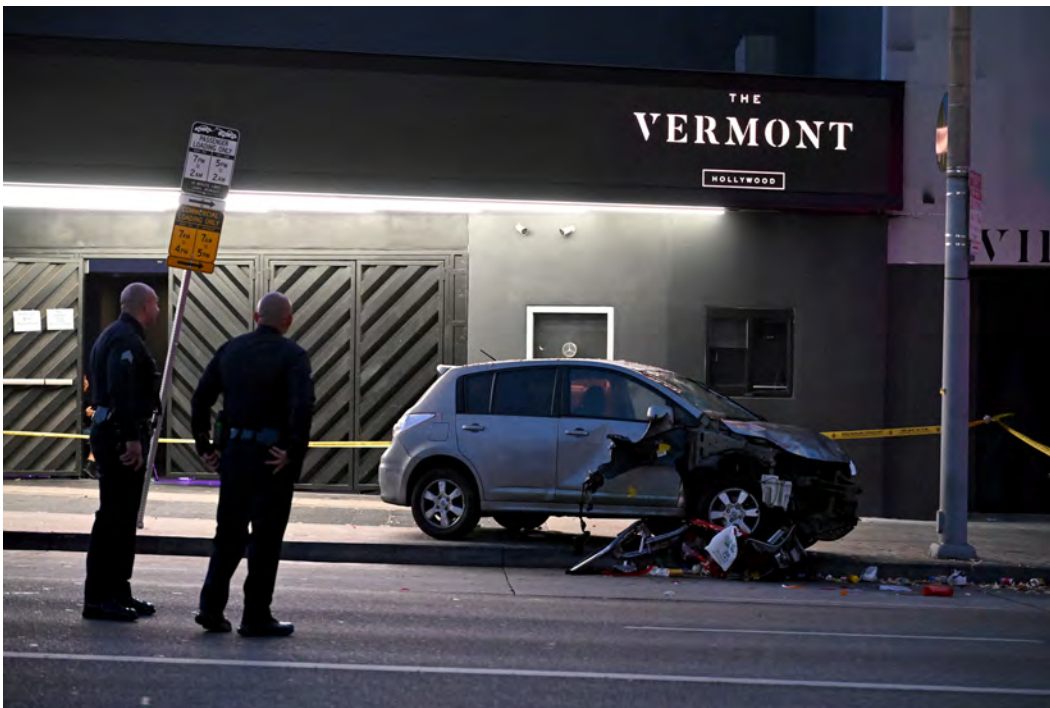
Car rams Los Angeles crowd, injuring 28

Los Angeles, United States

An "unknown vehicle" drove into a crowd in Hollywood in the early hours of Saturday, injuring 28 people, the Los Angeles Fire Department said, without providing information on the cause of the incident.

More than 100 firefighters responded to the scene in East Hollywood assisting three patients in critical condition, six in serious condition and 19 listed as fair, the Fire Department said.

An earlier report from officials had listed four to five people in "at least critical condition." ABC News quoted a Fire Department official saying that preliminary investigations pointed to a driver losing consciousness and ramming a large crowd outside a nightclub. However, this could not be immediately verified. The area where the incident occurred

Malaysia border control glitch hits travellers

Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia

A glitch in Malaysia's self-service border control machines has hit tens of thousands of travellers, the immigration department estimated Saturday, causing delays at the capital's airport and land crossings.

Among major gateways affected since Friday afternoon are Kuala Lumpur International Airport's two main terminals, as well as southern land crossings with Singapore.

"It should be more than tens of thousands of travellers who have to wait longer at the manual counters to clear immigration," estimated Zakaria Shaaban, director-general of Malaysia's Immigration Department.

Zakaria was unable to give a precise number of people affected when asked by AFP.

"We don't have many manual counters over in Johor because we have converted most of them into autogates," Zakaria said, referring to the southern state neighbouring Singapore.

28 dead, dozens missing as Ha Long Bay tourist boat capsizes

AFP | Hanoi, Vietnam

At least 28 people have died and dozens are missing after a tourist boat carrying more than 50 capsized Saturday in Vietnam's Ha Long Bay, state media said.

The vessel was carrying 48 passengers and five crew members when it capsized because of sudden heavy rain as it toured the UNESCO World Heritage site, the Dan Tri news site said.

"Border guards rescued 12 people and recovered 18 bodies," said a report on the VNExpress news site.

Most of those on board were families visiting from the capital Hanoi, with more than 20 children among the passengers, VNExpress said.

Ha Long Bay is one of Vietnam's most popular tourist destinations, with millions of people visiting its blue-green waters and rainforest-topped limestone islands each year. Last year 30 vessels sank at boat lock areas in coastal Quang Ninh province along Ha Long Bay after being pounded by strong wind and waves brought by deadly Typhoon Yagi.

Lula slams US sanctions on Brazilian judges in Bolsonaro case

Brazilian President Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva yesterday denounced US visa sanctions on judges in the coup case against former leader Jair Bolsonaro, a right-wing Donald Trump ally.

"My solidarity and support go to the justices of the Supreme Federal Court, who have been affected by yet another arbitrary and completely baseless measure by the United States government," Lula said in a statement posted on X.

"The interference of one country in another's justice system is unacceptable and

violates the basic principles of respect and sovereignty between nations."

Bolsonaro is on trial for allegedly seeking to stay in power by overturning the 2022 election won by Lula.

Supreme Court judge Alexandre de Moraes ruled Friday that Bolsonaro must wear an electronic monitoring device, stay home at night and stay off social media as he awaits a verdict.

Hours later the United States revoked the visa for Moraes and his "allies" on the court, as well as their immediate family members.

China starts construction of Tibet mega-dam

AFP | Beijing, China

China started building a mega-dam yesterday on a river running through Tibet and India, with Premier Li Qiang attending the commencement ceremony, state media said.

Beijing approved the project in December on the river -- known as Yarlung Tsangpo in Tibet and Brahmaputra in India -- linking it to the country's carbon neutrality targets and economic goals in the Tibet region.

"The electricity generated will be primarily transmitted to other regions for consumption, while also meeting local power needs in Tibet," state news agency Xinhua reported after the groundbreaking ceremony in southeastern Tibet's Nyingchi.

Once built, the dam could dwarf the record-breaking Three Gorges Dam on the Yangtze River in central China -- and have a potentially serious impact on millions of people downstream in India and Bangladesh.

The project will entail constructing five hydropower stations, with the total investment estimated to be around 1.2 trillion yuan (\$167.1 billion), Xinhua said.

Ford unveils all-electric Bronco

The New Energy SUV model is for Chinese market

The Ford Bronco, one of America's most iconic SUVs, is now going electric. Ford has officially revealed the Bronco New Energy, an electrified version of the off-roader, which will initially be available only in China.

The Bronco New Energy will be offered with two powertrain options – a fully electric (EV)

and an extended-range electric vehicle (EREV). Unlike the ladder-frame original, the Bronco EV adopts a larger unibody design and features battery technology supplied by BYD.

This new five-seater SUV measures 5,025 mm in length, 1,960 mm in width, and 1,815 mm in height, with a wheelbase of 2,950 mm. Design-wise, it bears resemblance to the Bronco Sport and includes a tail-gate-mounted spare tyre.

The fully electric version

houses a 105.4 kWh battery pack, offering a claimed range of 650 km under the CLTC cycle. It features an all-wheel-drive setup powered by dual electric motors that generate a combined output of 311 BHP and a top speed of 170 km/h.

The extended-range version combines two electric motors with a 1.5-litre petrol engine producing 147 BHP. As an EREV, the engine does not drive the wheels but serves as a generator to recharge the 43.7 kWh

battery or support the motors. This version can travel 220 km on electric power alone, with a total range of up to 1,220 km when factoring in the petrol engine.

The Bronco New Energy will be built by Jiangling Motors Corporation (JMC), Ford's local joint venture partner in Jiangxi province. The SUV is expected to hit the Chinese market in the fourth quarter of this year.

Tokyo Drift's Mazda RX-7 sells for £911,000

A 1992 Mazda RX-7 FD from The Fast and the Furious: Tokyo Drift has sold for an eye-watering £911,000 (\$1.2 million). Driven by Sung Kang's character Han, it's one of two cars used in the 2006 film and was mainly featured in static and close-up shots.

Fitted with a Veilside body kit, the RX-7 is 7.9 inches wider than stock, retaining



only the original roof and tail-gate. It wears a pearlescent

orange finish, 19-inch Andrew Racing wheels, and 12-inch wide rear Pirelli P Zero tyres. Marks from camera

mounts and "#71 HANS" labels remain intact.

The car's twin-rotor turbo engine was rebuilt by RE-Amemiya, with only 5,000 miles added since. Total mileage stands at 66,785.

This sale surpasses Paul Walker's Supra, which sold for \$550,000 in 2021, but falls short of his Skyline GT-R R34, which fetched \$1.35 million in 2023.

Stellantis pulls plug on hydrogen fuel cell vans

Jeep-maker Stellantis said it was pulling the plug on plans to build light vans using hydrogen fuel cells, saying it saw no prospects for it to be commercially viable.

The company, whose stable of brands also includes Peugeot, Citroen and Fiat, had planned to begin serial production of commercial vans equipped with hydrogen fuel cells this summer at sites in northern France and southern Poland.

"The hydrogen market remains a niche segment, with no prospects of mid-term economic sustainability," said Jean-Philippe Imparato, Stellantis's chief operating officer for the European region.

The company cited limited availability of hydrogen refuelling infrastructure, high

capital requirements, and the need for stronger consumer purchasing incentives.

"We must make clear and responsible choices to ensure our competitiveness and meet the expectations of our customers with our electric and hybrid passenger and light commercial vehicles offensive," Imparato added.



Hydrogen fuel cells produce electricity by combining hydrogen and oxygen—and their only byproduct is pure water. In fact, astronauts on NASA space missions have used hydrogen fuel cells not only for power but also to drink the water they produce!

China moves to tame 'irrational competition' as EV price war persists

Chinese officials are seeking to tame the country's swelling electric vehicle industry with policies to prevent "irrational competition", state media said, as a brutal price war ensnares top automakers. Beijing has poured vast state funds into the EV sector, supporting the development and production of less polluting battery-powered vehicles.

But a price war has left many startups bust as firms flood the domestic market with low-cost cars and trade-in schemes, offering huge discounts to customers to give up their old auto for a new one.

Domestic criticism has mounted in recent months

against intra-industry "involution" -- a popular tag used to describe the race to out-compete that ends up nowhere.

A meeting of top officials in Beijing -- chaired by Premier Li Qiang -- called Wednesday for tighter price monitoring and improving long-term regulation of competition in the sector, state news agency Xinhua said.

Officials called for stronger order in the new energy vehicle market to "curb irrational competition" and spur more healthy development, Xinhua said. "It is necessary to... strengthen industry self-discipline" and help companies enhance their competitiveness through technological innovation, the agency quoted officials as saying.

Porsche warns workers of cost-cuts amid 'serious' situation

German sportscar-maker Porsche told employees Friday to prepare for another round of cost-cutting in the latest blow to the country's embattled auto sector.

Any further steps would come on top of the 1,900 job cuts the company announced in February while Volkswagen, Porsche's parent group, is already in the



process of cutting 35,000 jobs by 2030.

"Our business model, which sustained us for many decades, no longer works in its current

form," Porsche management said in a letter to employees, excerpts of which were shared with AFP. "Our operating conditions have deteriorated dramatically in a short period of time," the letter read.

Negotiations are expected in the second half of the year "to assure the long-term future of the company", the letter added without going into specifics of possible measures.

Fierce competition in China from domestic players, tariffs imposed by US President Donald Trump and the dollar weakening versus the euro were all weighing on Porsche, bosses said.

The cost of ramping up electric vehicle production amid tepid demand was also hurting the company, they added.

"The situation remains serious and the sector is evolving very dynamically," the letter said

Pogacar extends lead

Arensman climbs to Tour de France stage win

After three days in the Pyrenees the riders next have a hilly stage 15 over 169.3km from Muret to the medieval fortified town of Carcassonne.

Dutch rider Thymen Arensman climbed to victory on the grueling stage 14 of the Tour de France in the Pyrenees on Saturday as defending champion Tadej Pogacar extended his overall race lead.

Double Olympic champion Remco Evenepoel, who had been third overall, pulled out of the race on the day's first climb of the daunting 2180m altitude Tourmalet.

The Belgian Soudal Quick-Step rider appeared exhausted after Friday's uphill time trial.

Arensman attacked on the third of four mountains on a colossal climb day while Slovenian Pogacar outsprinted Jonas Vingegaard for second just over a minute behind the winner. Crossing the line in

the mist at 1840m altitude, Arensman flung himself to the ground exhausted after taking a first win on this Tour for British team Ineos.

The 25-year-old produced a virtuoso climb amidst suffocating packs of near hysterical fans who had waited all day for the peloton to pass.

Behind him Pogacar fought

off a string of attacks from his arch rival Vingegaard on a day the Slovenian never looked like attacking for the win.

Winner of the past two stages Pogacar pounced for the line from 50 metres with his trademark kick gaining another six seconds on the Dane.

Pogacar, overall race win-

ner in 2020, 2021 and 2024, now leads Vingegaard by 4min 13sec with Florian Lipowitz moving into third place at 7min 53sec.

German Lipovitz of Red Bull rode on Pogacar's wheel until Dane Vingegaard, who won back-to-back Tour titles in 2022 and 2023, had attacked late on.

Bahrain's tournament ends with a 6-2 record

Bahrain's 2025 William Jones Cup campaign came to a close on Saturday with a 92-68 defeat to the Philippines' Strong Group Athletics, the defending champions and group leaders heading into the final day.

The match was Bahrain's eighth game in as many days and followed a heavy loss to hosts Chinese Taipei the day prior. Despite showing fight through the first three quarters, Bahrain were held to just four points in the fourth, which is the lowest scoring quarter by the team in the tournament.

Total control

Strong Group Athletics led from the opening tip, establishing a 30-23 advantage in the first quarter and extending it to 54-43 by halftime. Bahrain narrowed the gap slightly in the third, but the Philippines used a decisive

run in the final quarter to seal the result.

Philippines' Andre Roberson led all scorers with 25 points and 14 rebounds on 12-of-16 shooting. Tajuan Agee added 19 points and 8 rebounds, while Javier Gomez de Liano contributed 12 points off the bench. The Filipinos shot 49.3% from the field, including 41.4% from beyond the arc, and won the rebounding battle 49-25.

For Bahrain, Subah Azzam had 14 points on 6-of-10 shooting. Abdulqader Mohamed added 12 points (3-of-4 from three), and Mohamed Hamoda and Ahmed Haji each scored 10. Bahrain shot a solid 44.4% from three but struggled inside (37.8% on two-pointers) and managed only four offensive rebounds.

Tournament Overview

The result concludes Bah-

rain's first William Jones Cup campaign since 1978. They leave with a 6-2 record, registering wins over Japan U25, Chinese Taipei Development Team, Malaysia, Australia United, the UAE, and Qatar B. Their only two losses came against Chinese Taipei (93-50) and the Philippines (92-68).

Bahrain now shift focus to the 2025 Arab Basketball Championship, which begins this Friday and runs through August 2. The draw will take place this Monday.



The William Jones Cup, named after basketball promoter Renato William Jones, is one of Asia's oldest and most prestigious international basketball tournaments. Held annually in Taiwan since 1977, it has often served as a testing ground for national teams ahead of major events like the FIBA Asia Cup and the Olympics.

Zimbabwe qualify for first Rugby World Cup since 1991

Zimbabwe qualified for the 2027 Rugby World Cup with a 30-28 victory over Namibia in the Africa Cup final on Saturday.

This will be Zimbabwe's first appearance in the rugby by showpiece since 1991.

The door is still open for Namibia to book their ticket to what would be an eighth consecutive World Cup.

They face the United Arab Emirates in a play-off ahead of final qualifiers in Dubai in November.

The last time Zimbabwe made it to the finals, they lost their three matches against Ireland (55-11), Scotland (51-12) and Japan (52-8).

Australia host the 2027 World Cup.

Alfred stuns with 200m victory, Lyles edged in 100m at London Diamond League

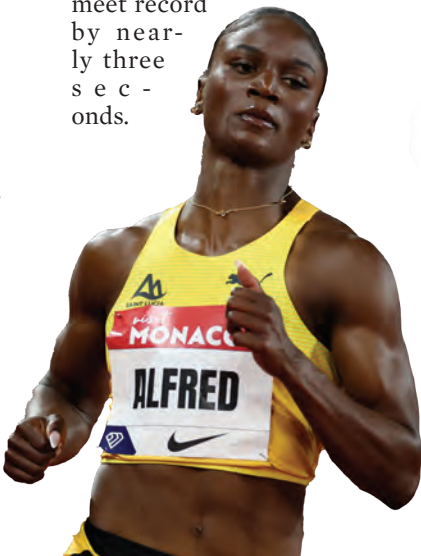
Julien Alfred delivered a statement performance at the London Diamond League, winning the women's 200m in a world-leading 21.71 seconds — a meet record that places her joint ninth on the all-time list. The St Lucian sprinter, fresh off her Olympic 100m gold in Paris, powered through the opening 150m and held strong to the finish at the sold-out London Stadium. "Races like this give me a lot of confidence as we get closer to Tokyo," she said, referring to the world championships in September.

In contrast, Olympic 100m champion Noah Lyles had a sluggish start in his season opener and finished second behind Jamaica's Oblique Seville, who clocked 9.86 seconds. Still, Lyles called it his "fastest ever season opener" and said he felt "extremely healthy" after recovering from an ankle injury.

The meet also saw dominant displays across disciplines. Dutch star Femke Bol earned her 29th straight Diamond League victory, storming to a 52.10 win in the 400m hurdles. Kenya's Emmanuel Wanyonyi narrowly missed David Rudisha's 800m world record but claimed a meet record of 1:42.00. Fellow Kenyan Phaniel Koech broke the 1500m meet record with 3:28.82, ahead of world champion Josh Kerr.

Britain's Charles Dobson set a personal best of 44.14 to win the men's 400m, overtaking Matthew Hudson-Smith late. Georgia Hunter Bell won the women's 800m with a season-best 1:56.74, and Morgan Lake cleared 1.96m to take the high jump ahead of Olympic and world champion Yaroslava Mahuchikh.

In the field, Lithuania's Mykolas Alekna threw 71.70m in discus for a new meet and Diamond League record. Ethiopia's Gudaf Tsegay clocked 4:11.88 in the mile, shattering Sifan Hassan's 2018 meet record by nearly three seconds.



Pacquiao, Barrios make weights for Vegas showdown



Manny Pacquiao is the only boxer in history to win world titles in eight different weight divisions—a record that may never be broken. Starting as a 106-pound flyweight, he climbed all the way up to win a title at 154 pounds, showcasing incredible versatility, speed, and power across weight classes. Beyond boxing, he's also served as a Senator in the Philippines, making him a rare combination of sports legend and national lawmaker.

Filipino star Manny Pacquiao comfortably made the weight for his comeback world title fight against Mario Barrios on Friday, tipping the scales at

just under the 147-pound welterweight limit.

The 46-year-old eight-division world champion -- who is returning to the ring after a four-year absence -- weighed in at 146.8 lbs during a packed

ceremony at the MGM Grand Garden Arena.

Pacquiao's opponent in Saturday's fight, reigning World Boxing Council (WBC) welterweight champion Barrios, was also inside the weight limit at

146.2 lbs.

"I'm so happy I'm back because boxing is my passion and I missed boxing," Pacquiao said after making the weight.

The Filipino star -- whose last victory came against Keith Thurman in 2019 -- is aiming to pull off an upset victory in Saturday's bout.

Pacquiao (62-8-2, 39 knockouts) announced his return to boxing in May, taking advantage of a WBC rule that allows former champions to request a direct title shot when coming out of retirement.

He will be facing the much younger Barrios, who will take a 29-2-1 record in Saturday's contest.

Barrios, 30, said he was unfazed by the prospect of taking on living legend Pacquiao, who could become the first fighter to win a major world title after being inducted to boxing's Hall of Fame.

"I'm approaching this the same way I have all my other fights -- I treat it as just another title defense," Barrios said. "Manny has accomplished so much, but it's my time now."
