The 36-year-old former French international left Bayern Munich as a free agent at the end of last season after 12 seasons with the German giants.

"Ribery? We like him a lot, but like all great players he is considering his options," Prade said after Fiorentina's 3-1 Coppa Italia win over Monza. "We want him and would

Barcelona's Philippe Coutinho has joined Bayern Munich on a oneyear loan worth 8.5 million euros (\$9.5 million) with an option to buy, the Spanish club confirmed yesterday.

"The agreement provides for an option for Bayern to buy at a 120-million-euro fee," Barcelona said.

The 27-year-old Brazilian joined Barcelona from Liverpool in January 2018 for an initial 120 million euros in a deal that included another 40 million euros in potential add-ons.
