Proposal calls for permanent job support scheme for workers with disabilities

proposal to create a fixed employment support scheme for people with disabilities in Bahrain's public and private sectors has been placed before Parliament.

The plan sets out full salary coverage for the first two years, followed by permanent state funding of 75 per cent of wages, even if the employee changes jobs.
