Trump ally gets 40 months prison

Donald Trump's long-time ally Roger Stone was sentenced yesterday to 40 months in prison for impeding a congressional investigation, in a case that ignited a firestorm over the US president's political interference in the justice system

Stone, a veteran Republican operative and one of Trump's oldest confidants, was convicted in November of lying to Congress, tampering with a witness and obstructing the House in-
