Russia approves its third COVID-19 vaccine, CoviVac

Moscow

Russia yesterday approved a third coronavirus vaccine for domestic use, Prime Minister Mikhail Mishustin said on state TV, though large-scale clinical trials of the shot, labelled CoviVac and produced by the Chumakov Centre, have yet to begin.

"Today, Russia is the only country to have already three vaccines against COVID-19," Prime Minister Mishustin said. Unlike the Sputnik V vaccine, which uses a modified harmless cold virus that tricks the body into producing antigens to help the immune system prepare for a coronavirus infection, the CoviVac vaccine is a "whole-virion" vaccine.

Security matters

HH Shaikh Nasser, US National Security Advisor hold talks

The call came a day after Biden urged allies to work closely in dealing with Iran

Head of IAEA is due to visit Tehran

Bahrain and the USA yesterday held talks to enhance security coordination and strategic alliance, a day after the US President urged allies to work together to curb Iran's "destabilising" activities in the Middle East.

Joe Biden has told the Munich Security Conference that the United States would work closely with allies in dealing with Iran.

"The threat of nuclear proliferation also continues to require careful diplomacy and cooperation among us," Biden told fel-

low leaders via teleconference.

"That's why we have said we're prepared to reengage in negotiations with the P5+1 on Iran's nuclear program," he said, referring to the five permanent members of the UN Security Council and Germany.

"We must also address Iran's destabilising activities across the Middle East, and we're going to work in close cooperation with our European and other

partners as we proceed."

In yesterday's call to Major General HH Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the US National Security Advisor, Jake Sullivan, shared his views on boosting bilateral ties with the Kingdom.

He also expressed his appreciation of the advanced level of relations between both countries, wishing the Kingdom of Bahrain further growth and prosperity.

HH Shaikh Nasser, also the National Security Advisor and Royal Guard Commander, told Sullivan that the strong ties of the Kingdom with the US "reflect a long history of security coordination and strategic alliance."

"Bahrain is keen to further bolstering this cooperation between the two friendly countries," HH Shaikh Nasser said during the telephone call.

The conversation also focused on joint efforts to combat terrorism and safeguard regional stability.

In this regard, Shaikh Nasser highlighted the inauguration of the strategic dialogue between both countries, boosting the kingdom's status as a main security partner to the USA.

His Highness also reviewed the Kingdom's initiatives and achievements to promote peace, tolerance and stability in the Middle East, commending the US efforts in this regard.

Their discussions also focused

on other issues of common interest.

On Thursday State Department spokesman Ned Price said Washington had accepted an invitation by the European Union political director Enrique Mora for an "informal" meeting involving Iran.

Price said the meeting would "discuss a diplomatic way forward."

Meanwhile, Iran yesterday signalled its desire to end the impasse saying, "It believes the US sanctions will soon be lifted despite continuing "diplomatic wrangling".

The head of the International Atomic Energy Agency, Rafael Grossi, is due in Tehran this weekend to discuss ways to work with Iran in light of the possibility of scaling back cooperation.

Rabiei said the law "does not go against our commitment" to the agreement, nor is it "an obstacle to our appropriate response to American actions".

Perform PCR test 72 hours before travelling to UK

Bahrainis arriving in England, Wales and Northern Ireland should self-isolate for ten days, the Embassy of Bahrain in the United Kingdom tweeted.

The new norms are for travellers coming from countries outside the 'red list' including Bahrain, the embassy wrote on its official Twitter account.

All travellers must book and pre-pay for COVID-19 test kits by visiting the link (<https://bit.ly/3sq1mG7>). The kits are for use during the mandatory quarantine on the second and eighth day of arrival.

Passengers arriving directly into Scotland must book hotels via the website <https://quarantinehotels.ctmportal.co.uk>. Stay should be for ten days from the date of arrival.

Besides, all travellers arriving in the United Kingdom must undergo a pre-examination for COVID-19 virus (PCR) no later than 72 hours before departure.

Passengers are also required to fill out a "passenger locator form" through the online page designated for this by the British government.

Follow COVID-19 measure strictly: Public Security's Dr Shaikh Hamad

Adhere strictly to COVID-19 health measures to help Bahrain bring down its case-loads, a top public security official yesterday urged Bahraini citizens and residents.

"All must follow the instructions issued by the National Medical team to curb the spread of the virus," said Brigadier-General Dr Shaikh Hamad bin Mohammed Al-Khalifa, the Public Security Assistant Chief for Operations and Training

Affairs. He also stressed the importance of "staying at home" and going out only for urgent needs.

Bahrain is currently battling a renewed increase in cases by extending the COVID-19 restrictions introduced earlier this month by 21 more days.

Indoor gyms, sports halls and swimming pools will remain closed and social gatherings in homes to be limited to up to 30 people until 14 March.

Dr Shaikh Hamad said that it is mandatory to wear face

masks and ensure social distancing measures while in a public setting.

"Until now, the Ministry of Interior has recorded 49,321 cases for not wearing face masks in public places and shops, and 8,198 for not maintaining social distancing measures," said Dr Sheikh Hamad.

The ministry, Dr Shaikh Hamad said, carried out 5,863 awareness campaigns until this Thursday, in addition to carrying out 186,535 disinfection and sterilisation campaigns.

Buses pass the COVID test

Public transport passengers jump 150%

- Passenger number touches 45,000 during weekends, holidays

- The network now has new 300 stations

- Public buses will act as feeder services for Metro

The public transport system in Bahrain is making a big come back amid the coronavirus pandemic. More than 33 thousand passengers are using the buses per day now, which is an increase of 150%, compared to the prior year.

"This number jumps to 45 thousand during weekends and public holidays," said Sami Abdulla Ahmed Buhaza, the Undersecretary for Land Transportation and Post at the Ministry of Transportation and Telecommu-

Passenger numbers, Buhaza said, rose significantly following the introduction of upgraded buses in 2015. "The number of busses servicing various routes also doubled."

Even-though, the pandemic severely impacted the services, passenger footfall is rising again now, thanks to the stringent safety and security measures

followed.

Buhaza said the Bahrain Public Transport Company attaches great importance to this aspect.

Passengers are required to wear face masks at all times.

"We are also cleaning and sanitising frequently touched parts and switches throughout the day and is checking the temperatures of drivers and employees." An empty seat is left between

each passenger to follow social distancing measures.

"We had also suspended the use of paper tickets to reduce the need for touching objects on the bus," said Buhaza.

The company is also reviewing and rescheduling bus services according to the demand and connected important destinations in various part of the Kingdom.

The most prominent of them was connecting the network to the new terminal at Bahrain International Airport.

Buhaza further said they had developed more than 300 bus stations, 26 new air-conditioned stations, and more than 70 new bus stops to cover new areas in the network.

"The company is also operating a distinctive fleet of busses for the elderly and people with special needs."

Besides, buses are also equipped with free wireless internet and have special weekly and monthly offers for Go-Card holders.

Buhaza said they are also working on more plans to encourage people to use mass transport services.

"For this, the company is providing stops near residential areas, commercial markets and health centres."

The ministry, Buhaza said, is also working on the Bahrain Metro project, which will provide a new travel experience for people in the Kingdom. "Mass transit buses will act as feeder service to metro route in the future."

On punctuality, Buhaza said that the ministry is keen to set performance indicators.

"We are continuously monitoring the commitment of buses

to the timetables set and updates travellers continuously and realistically to reduce the waiting time."

All bus stops have a QR Code to find actual bus timing for the station itself.

Screens display the arrival time of buses in the main stations and Bahrain International Airport.

Buhaza said the ministry is working to develop more comprehensive plans to reduce waiting time. "We are currently in the process of identifying road lanes with high occupancy to grant them a priority."

Marine police arrested 145 violators last year

Bahraini authorities have taken legal actions against 145 anglers for violating maritime restrictions and employing illegal fishing methods during 2020.

The Undersecretary for Agriculture and Marine Resources at the Ministry of Works, Municipalities Affairs and Urban Planning, Dr Nabil Muhammad Abu Al-Fateh, said the actions follow campaigns organised by the Maritime Control Department.

"The efforts aimed at supporting national measures to raise the level of food security in the Kingdom," said Dr Al-Fateh.

Maritime Control Department seized 129 trawl shrimp fishing nets, 16 nylon nets, and four boats for violating foreign workers law during the year.

Al-Fateh said the agency is continuing its efforts with relevant authorities to control practices that hurt the fish stocks in the Kingdom.

"We consider workers in this sector as partners in preserving our maritime resource, which is key to achieving sustainable food security for the Kingdom."

The Undersecretary called on fishermen and hobbyists to abide by Decree No. 20 of 2002 to preserve the marine environment and replenish fish stocks in the Kingdom.

Cloud, rain bring down mercury

Sporadic rains kept the mercury in check in several areas here yesterday, with the temperature reaching as low as 13 degrees at night, the met office said.

Light to moderate rains occurred at many places in Bahrain, with the sky remaining cloudy or partly cloudy at many places.

The weatherman has forecast light to moderate rain at most places in the Kingdom, and strong surface winds.

Officials said the Kingdom recorded northwest winds of up to 15 knots, which reached 18 to 22 knots at times.

The maximum temperature across the Kingdom was 21-degree Celsius, with it reaching as low as 13-degree Celsius during the night, the Meteorological Department at the Ministry of Transportation and Communications said.

"The highest bid submitted offered 4,522,000 dinars for the contract," said Director-Gener-

al of the Capital, Muhammad Saad Al-Sahli. "Private sector cooperation is key for sustainable development and municipal projects that improve the quality of services," Al Sahli added.

Past year, the municipality auctioned several types of advertisement opportunities, one of them being the electronic screen on King Faisal Street. "Besides, the municipality held three sets of auctions for lighting pole advertisements and one for mega commercials." Al-Sahli said the Capital secretariat is in the process of completing legal procedures for finalising three of the contracts for BD2,865,000 for five years.

Vaccines have no nationality

The conversation these days is all about the vaccination against COVID-19. The year started on a high note as people celebrated the arrival of many vaccines as the end of the virus. However that was not to be. Leaders have realized that until the number of vaccinated people reaches critical mass, we cannot consider the danger to be behind us. On that count, Bahrain has once again led the way by example. Not only are four types of vaccines approved for use here – the Sinopharm, the Pfizer, the Oxford AstraZeneca and the Sputnik – but the government has made getting vaccinated a state-of-the-art operation that every citizen can access by smartphone.

Quite rightly, the World Health Organisation (WHO) has praised Bahrain for being one of the first countries in the world to launch a digital COVID-19 vaccine passport. Yet, our leaders are not about to sit back on their laurels. HRH the Crown Prince-Prime Minister has pledged to continue to push for equitable access to vaccines. In Bahrain, you have to register for the vaccination and the whole process is online with a clear trail. There is no favouritism and all priorities are universally approved: frontliners and senior citizens getting priority.

What I fail to understand is the new and ill-informed line of argument taken by some about which vaccine to opt for. Instead of scientific reasoning, many people are calling out the advantages and disadvantages by the “nationality” of the jab! We need to understand that there is no such thing as a Chinese, Indian, UK, Western or Russian vaccine.

The medical biotechnology underpinning each vaccine is different and we have to get rational medical advice before we choose our vaccine. This is a time to step beyond the old prejudices and opt for a future state of mind that endorses the universality of the human condition.

Disease is a common problem and a pandemic of this proportion is something that can only be cured by complete scientific unity. Would that be too much to ask for the sake of our children?

Bahrain awarded BD55m contracts during 2020

● **Total bids received last year reached 539, of which 151 were from small and medium enterprises.**

Bahrain awarded contracts worth 55 million dinars last year, notwithstanding the economic impact of the coronavirus pandemic.

The data came as the tender board released its latest statistics, which sums up the total value of the tenders of 2020.

The Tender Board is the independent regulatory body charged with supervising government bidding and bidding practices.

Last year, the board awarded a total of 146 government tenders for various authorities and government bodies.

Total bids received reached 539, of which 151 were from small and medium enterprises. “This comes to around 7% of the total value of the tenders,” a tender board

statement said.

In 2019, the total number of tender and auctions awarded by the board reached 1,034, with a value of 1,847 billion Bahraini dinars. The total number of bids submitted for these tender during the year were 5,418.

According to a Cabinet decision, there is a 10% preference for small and medium enterprises in government tenders and auctions, which the chairman of the Tender

and Auctions Board, Shaikh Nayef bin Khalid Al Khalifa said, “would greatly benefit the national economy.”

In 2020, he said the council also held 13 training courses for contractors and suppliers. “The eight-week advisory sessions held over two months witnessed the participation of 1,119 suppliers and contractors, of which small and medium enterprises represented 60%.”

The sessions, he said, were for clarifying the procedures and raising the quality of the bids.

Laundry services for labour ministry

Separately, the board said it opened 14 bids received for three tenders submitted by various administrative bodies.

A tender by the Ministry of Labour and Social Development seeking laundry services for the ministry’s care and social rehabilitation centres attracted five bids.

Bids ranged between BHD 36,656.390 and BHD 79,629.220. Super Laundry & Dry Cleaning Co quoted the lowest amount.

Agency for Gulf air in UK

A Gulf Air tender said the company is looking for a General Passenger Sales Agency (GSA) in the United Kingdom and received six bids.

Finally, the committee opened a tender for the Bahrain International Circuit to provide hospitality and catering services for the Dana Theater for two years. The tender received three bids.

Ministry to rebuild walls of 13 public schools

The boundary walls of 13 public schools in the Kingdom will be rebuilt as part of a move to enhance security measures.

The structural condition of the dilapidated walls in various schools had worsened and had reached 1,562 meters.

A tender launched for the project with an initial bond of BD1000 has a closing date of 28 February 2021, the Works Ministry said.

The Ministry of Works, Municipalities Affairs and Urban Planning and the Ministry of Education is jointly implementing the project.

The project will benefit Sukainah Bint Al Hussein Primary School for Girls, Al Rash-eed Primary School for Boys, Halima Al Saadia Preparatory School for Girls, West Riffa Primary School for Boys, Khaleej Al Arabi Primary School for Girls, East Riffa Secondary School for Boys, Muharraq Secondary School for Boys, Khadija Al Kubra Preparatory School for Girls and Zainab School Preparatory School for Girls, Tubli Primary School for Boys, Othman bin Affan Preparatory School for Boys, Sitra Preparatory School for Girls and Askar Primary School

for Boys.

The Works Ministry has also launched tenders for the general repair works of Al Nabih Saleh Primary Girls School, Al Jazeera Primary Boys School, Asker Primary and Intermediate Boys School, and Ahmed Al Fateh

Primary and Intermediate Boys School.

Works are for internal and external painting, cracks repair, repair of ceilings and floorings, repair and replacement of doors and windows and renovation of toilets, amongst other works.

Winning the Red palm weevil battle

Bahrain is winning the battle against the threat of red palm weevil, with average monthly incidents getting reduced to as low as 0.65% during 2020, said Works Minister.

Essam Khalaf, the Minister of Works, Municipalities Affairs and Urban Planning, said the ministry last year had a one-million-dinar budget to bring down the threat.

In 2020, the ministry examined more than 246 thousand palm trees and seedlings through 3,491 visits to 877 sites, including orchards, gardens, streets, home gardens and residential complexes in the various governorates of the Kingdom.

A total of 5,613 palm tree were



subjected to fumigation, spraying and injection of pesticides, as the work teams removed 889 of the infected palms.

“Workers took care not to spray

or inject pesticides on trees with ripe fruits,” said the minister.

Pesticides were sprayed on 25,300 palm trees and stem cells while also injecting 2,794 palm trees and stem cells as a precaution.

Pheromone traps kept on farms since 2017 had resulted in capturing about 50 thousand insects.

“The palm trees, like other crops in Bahrain, are infested with many agricultural pests. However, the red palm weevil infestation, discovered in the early nineties, is one of the most dangerous of all,” said the minister adding, “as severe infestation leads to the loss of palm trees.”

“However, quick intervention and precautionary measures have significantly reduced the threat,

which in some cases have reached zero,” said the minister

“For this, the ministry is cooperating with the Arab Organization for Agricultural Development for identifying strengths and weaknesses and proposals for improving performance.”

For 2021, Minister Khalaf said the ministry is seeking to strengthen cooperation with the National Space Science Authority to prepare a platform for managing geospatial agricultural data, collecting palm data, and developing an application for monitoring the infestations of the red palm weevil through mobile phones.

Plans are also on the anvil to replace traditional traps with more advanced M21 traps and introduce training programmes.

BIS virtual meeting

Bahrain India society yesterday held a virtual meeting on the “The Road to Recovery -Transforming risks to opportunities” with Jamal Fakhro, the Managing Partner of KPMG Bahrain. INOVEST yesterday reported a consolidated net loss attributable to the parent shareholders of US\$ 0.18 million for the three months ended 31st December 2020 in comparison to a net profit of US\$ 2.14 m for the same quarter of last year.

Loss Per Share for the quarter was US cents 0.06 as compared to Earnings Per Share of US cents 0.72 for the same period in 2019.

The decrease is primarily due to a decline in real estate sales and revenues, a drop in their relative values, and in revenues from management fees. Accordingly, the net operating profit amounted to a loss of US\$ 0.26 m compared to a profit of US\$ 2.10 m for the same period last year.

For the full year, the company reported a consolidated net profit attributable to parent shareholders of US\$ 5.03 m, representing a 30% decrease as compared to US\$ 7.15 m for last

year. This decline is the outcome of a decrease in the fair value of several investments, as well as a drop in associated management fees. Moreover, it stems from a decline in revenue from our contracting activities and a decrease in capital gain due to real estate exits.

Basic Earnings Per Share of the parent company amounted to US cents 1.69 as compared to US cents 2.40 in 2019.

Consolidated net operating profit decreased to reaching a loss of US\$ 0.7 m in comparison to a profit of US\$ 6.17 m in the year 2019.

The net profit of 2020 result-

ed mainly from the reversal of provision of USD 6 m against one of the accounts receivable. In line with this, the consolidated operating income decreased by 49% to reach US\$ 10.10 m in comparison to US\$ 19.9 m.

Saudi to invest more than \$20 billion in its military industry over next decade

Saudi Arabia will invest more than \$20 billion in its domestic military industry over the next decade as part of aggressive plans to boost local military spending, the head of the kingdom's military industry regulator said yesterday.

Saudi wants to develop and manufacture more weapons and military systems domestically, aiming to spend 50% of the military budget locally by 2030.

“The government has put a

plan that we will be investing in excess of \$10 billion in the military industry in Saudi Arabia over the next decade and equal amounts on research and development,” Governor of the General Authority for Military Industries (GAMI) Ahmed bin Abdulaziz Al-Ohali told a defence conference in Abu Dhabi.

He also said the kingdom plans to increase military research and development (R&D) spending from 0.2% to around 4% of armaments expenditure by 2030.

Bitcoin, ether hit fresh highs

Bitcoin hit a fresh high in Asian trading yesterday, extending a two-month rally that saw its market capitalisation cross \$1 trillion a day earlier. The world's most popular cryptocurrency rose to a record \$56,620, taking its weekly gain to 18%. It has surged more than 92% this year.

Bitcoin's gains have been fuelled by evidence it is gaining acceptance among mainstream

investors and companies, such as Tesla Inc, Mastercard Inc and BNY Mellon.

Ether, the second-largest cryptocurrency by market capitalisation and daily volume, hit a record \$2,040.62, for a weekly gain of about 12%.

Ether is the digital currency or token that facilitates transactions on the ethereum blockchain. In the crypto world, the terms ether and ethereum have become interchangeable.

White House says US not inviting Russia to G7



The Biden administration is not inviting Russia to join the G7 group of world leaders, White House spokeswoman Jen Psaki said, backing away from former President Donald Trump's push for Moscow's membership. Any invitation for Russia to join the G7 would be made in partnership with all of the group's members, she told reporters, speaking aboard Air Force One.

Kremlin critic Navalny loses appeal against jail term

Alexey Navalny appealed a ruling that turned a suspended sentence on embezzlement charges into real jail time

The judge shaved 6 weeks from Navalny's original sentence of two years and eight months

Kremlin critic Alexei Navalny lost his appeal yesterday against what he said was a politically motivated decision to jail him for nearly three years, but said his faith in God and belief in the rightness of his cause was sustaining him.

Navalny, President Vladimir Putin's most prominent critic, was jailed earlier this month for parole violations that he said were trumped up. Western countries have condemned the case and are discussing possible sanctions on Russia.

A Moscow court swiftly rejected Navalny's appeal yesterday, while shortening his original jail term by six weeks. The original term was 3-1/2 years.

But with the amount of time he had already spent under house arrest taken into account, it amounted to around two years and eight months. His lawyer said yesterday he would now spend a little over 2-1/2 years behind bars

and that his legal team would try to challenge the decision to reject his appeal.

Navalny responded sarcastically to the ruling, which paves the way for him to be transferred from an infamous Moscow jail to a prison camp. "They've reduced the sentence by 1-1/2 months. Great!" he said from a courtroom glass cage.

Navalny's allies reacted with anger.

"The court decision to keep Alexei in jail says only one thing. There is no law in Russia right

now," staff at Navalny's Anti-Corruption Foundation, who investigate alleged official corruption, wrote on Twitter.

Navalny, 44, had earlier told the judge he was not guilty of parole violations as a previous court had found.

He returned to Russia last month from Germany, where he had been recovering from a near-fatal poisoning in Siberia in August with what many Western nations said was a nerve agent.

He said he had been unable

to report to the Moscow prison service last year because he had been convalescing in Germany at the time.

"I don't want to show off a lot, but the whole world knew where I was," Navalny told the judge.

He said he had no regrets about returning to Russia, that his belief in God helped sustain him, and that "strength was in truth".

"Our country is built on injustice. But tens of millions of people want the truth. And sooner or later they'll get it."

US stops Trump's aid freeze to Ethiopia over dam dispute

The United States said it was no longer blocking aid to Ethiopia over its controversial mega-dam but voiced hope for a diplomatic solution involving Egypt and Sudan.

The administration of former president Donald Trump, a steadfast ally of Egypt's leader, in September suspended around \$272 million to Ethiopia, accusing it of intransigence as US-brokered talks on the Grand Ethiopian Renaissance Dam broke down.

President Joe Biden's administration is conducting a policy review on the project, which Egypt and Sudan consider an existential threat, but said it was no longer leveraging aid.

"The United States has decided to delink its temporary pause on certain assistance to Ethiopia from the United States policy on the Grand Ethiopian Renaissance Dam, or GERD," State Department spokesman Ned Price told reporters.

"We continue to support collaborative and constructive efforts by Ethiopia, Egypt and Sudan to reach an agreement on the GERD," he said.

Indonesian capital slammed by monsoon floods, more than 1,000 forced to evacuate

Severe flooding across several areas in the Indonesian capital forced more than a thousand people to flee their homes yesterday, with the country's meteorology agency warning the conditions were set to continue for the next week.

Some 1,380 Jakarta residents were evacuated from southern and eastern areas of the city, home to 10 million people, after flood waters reached up to 1.8 meters high in some areas, said Sabdo Kurnianto, the acting head of Jakarta's disaster mitigation agency in a statement. He said no casualties had been reported.

People posted photos on social media of residents wading through shoulder-high muddy waters, cars almost entirely submerged, and search teams evacuating elderly residents in rubber dinghies in the peak of the monsoon season.

"Two hundred neighbourhoods have been affected, according to the latest data," Jakarta Governor Anies Baswedan told local television early yesterday, adding that more than two dozen evacuation centres have been prepared across the city.

"The rain has stopped, but water from other areas is still affecting Jakarta. Hopefully it won't hit the city centre and when the water recedes people can resume

(BMKG) has warned the heaviest rain of the season may fall in and around the densely populated capital in the coming days, with extreme weather, including heavy rain, thunder and strong winds expected throughout next week.

"These are critical times that we need to be aware of," said Dwiko rita Karnawati, the head of BMKG.

"Jakarta and its surrounding areas are still in the peak period of the rainy season, which is estimated to continue until the end of February or early March."

The BMKG said Jakarta would be on alert for the next four days with data from the meteorology agency showing intense rainfall in the past 24 hours with the area of Pasar Minggu, in Jakarta's south recording 226 millimeters of rain since Friday.

Two killed as Myanmar police disperse protesters

Two people were killed in Myanmar's second city Mandalay yesterday when police fired to disperse protesting opponents of a Feb. 1 military coup, emergency workers said, the bloodiest day in more than two weeks of demonstrations. Protesters took to the streets in several cities and towns with members of ethnic minorities, poets and transport workers among those demanding an end to military rule and the release of elected leader Aung San Suu Kyi and others.

But tension escalated quickly in Mandalay where police and soldiers were confronting striking shipyard workers and other protesters.

Some of the demonstrators fired catapults at police as they played cat and mouse through riverside streets. Police responded with tear gas and gun fire, though it was initially not clear if they were using live ammunition or rubber bullets.

"Twenty people were injured and two are dead," said Ko Aung, a leader of the Parahita Darhi volunteer emergency service agency.

One man died from a head wound, media workers including Lin Khaing, an assistant editor with the Voice of Myanmar media outlet in the city, and a volunteer doctor said.

Ko Aung and the doctor said a second man was shot in the chest and died later of his wound.

Police were not available for comment.

The demonstrations and a civil disobedience campaign of strikes and other disruptions show no sign of dying down. Opponents of the coup are sceptical of the army's promise to hold a new election and hand power to the winner.

Naypyitaw, the first death among anti-coup demonstrators.

The army says one policeman died of injuries sustained in a protest.

'Sadness'

Yesterday, young people in the main city of Yangon carried a wreath and laid flowers

at a memorial ceremony for the woman, Mya Thwate Thwate Khaing, while a similar ceremony took place in Naypyitaw.

"The sadness from her death is one thing, but we've also got courage to continue for her sake," said student protester Khin Maw Maw Oo in Naypyitaw.

The demonstrators are demanding the restoration of the elected government and the release of Suu Kyi and others. They have also called for the scrapping of a 2008 constitution that has assured the army a major role in politics since nearly 50 years of direct military rule ended in 2011.

The army seized back power after alleging fraud in Nov. 8 elections that Suu Kyi's National League for Democracy swept, detaining her and others. The electoral commission had dismissed the fraud complaints.

Nevertheless, the army says its action is within the constitution and is supported by a majority of the people. The military has blamed protesters for instigating violence.

Earlier yesterday, several thousand protesters gathered in the northern town of Myitkyina and confronted lines of police before dispersing.

UK's Prince Philip set to remain in hospital until early next week

Britain's Duke of Edinburgh, Prince Philip, is likely to remain in hospital until next week, a royal source said, adding that doctors were acting out of an abundance of caution and the duke remains in good spirits.

Queen Elizabeth's 99-year-old husband was admitted to hospital on Tuesday as a precautionary measure after feeling ill with an ailment that is not related to COVID-19.

"Following consultation with his doctor the Duke of Edinburgh is likely to remain in hospital for observation and rest over the weekend and into next week," the source said.

"As we have said previously the doctor is acting with an abundance of caution. The Duke remains in good spirits."

Both Philip and the 94-year-old queen received their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine in January.

The Duke was admitted to the private King Edward VII's Hospital in central London after feeling unwell for a short period, Buckingham Palace said on Wednesday.

Mars rover beams back selfie from moment before landing



NASA's Perseverance rover descends to touch down on Mars in a still image from a video camera aboard the descent stage

NASA scientists presented striking early images from the picture-perfect landing of the Mars rover Perseverance, including a selfie of the six-wheeled vehicle dangling just above the surface of the Red Planet moments before

touchdown.

The colour photograph, likely to become an instant classic among memorable images from the history of spaceflight, was snapped by a camera mounted on the rocket-powered "sky crane" descent-stage just above the rover as the car-sized space vehicle was being lowered on



The first high-resolution, color image to be sent back by the Hazard Cameras (Hazcams) on the underside of NASA's Perseverance Mars rover after its landing

Thursday to Martian soil.

The image was unveiled by mission managers during an online news briefing webcast from NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL) near Los Angeles less than 24 hours after the landing.

The picture, looking down on the rover, shows the entire vehicle suspended from three

cables unspooled from the sky crane, along with an "umbilical" communications cord. Swirls of dust kicked up by the crane's rocket thrusters are also visible.

Seconds later, the rover was gently planted on its wheels, its tethers were severed, and the sky crane - its job completed - flew off to crash a safe distance

away, though not before photos and other data collected during the descent were transmitted to the rover for safekeeping.

The image of the dangling science lab, striking for its clarity and sense of motion, marks the first such close-up photo of a spacecraft landing on Mars, or any planet beyond Earth.

Kim Kardashian files for divorce from Kanye West

Sources close to the situation say the split between the couple, who was married for nearly seven years and share four kids together, is amicable

Kim Kardashian has filed for divorce from her husband Kanye West after nearly seven years of marriage, Fox News can confirm. Sources close to the situation say it's amicable. TMZ obtained docu-

ments on Friday that reveal the reality TV queen, 40, is asking for joint legal and physical custody of the couple's four kids: North, 7, Saint, 5, Chicago, 3, and Psalm, 1. West, 43, is reportedly not objecting. Kardashian's lawyer, Laura Wasser, filed the docs and there's no date of separation listed but there is a prenup in place which both are expected to honor. Wasser is a well-known divorce attorney in Hollywood and frequently oversees starry splits, commonly known as the "Disso Queen." Reports of reasoning for the divorce have varied, with sources previously claiming that their politics, lifestyle, Calabasas home and even the rapper's surprisingly brief attendance at her lavish birthday party last year have all been points of contention. News of the stars' split first broke back in January. When the reports initially surfaced in Jan., E! News reported that Kardashian had not yet filed divorce paperwork because she wanted to ensure that she

was "making the right decision for the kids," according to an insider. TMZ also reports the two have been living separately for a few months and that their relationship was "in deep trouble for the last half of 2020," with the pair reportedly in marriage coun-

seling. In Jan., a source told Page Six that "Kim got Kanye to go up there [to Wyoming] so they could live separate lives and quietly get things sorted out to separate and divorce. She's done." West owns a ranch in Wyo., while Kardashian remained with her family in Calif. In the same rant, he also shaded Kardashian's past Playboy spread and claimed that the reality star's mother, Kris Jenner, was no longer allowed to see his children. "Every time I drive home I am filled with anxiety fearing that Hearle will be there waiting for me, and he usually is. After I pull into the driveway and get out of the car, I can hear Hearle talking to himself in an ominous voice, which increases my anxiety level even more," she wrote. Billie further claimed, "Whenever Hearle sees me he always says something to me or makes a sign or a gesture directed to me... For example, he recently made a throat slitting gesture to me as I was backing my car into my driveway. I interpreted this as Hearle wanting to violently harm me in some way." The 19-year-old songstress wrote that Hearle's "constant presence and harassment causes me substantial anxiety, fear, and emotional stress," even when her security team is present.



Japan’s Naomi Osaka claims victory over the 22nd-seeded Jennifer Brady

● **Japan’s Naomi Osaka has won four Grand Slam titles**

Japan’s Naomi Osaka dismissed Jennifer Brady in straight sets to win the Australian Open and underline her growing hold on women’s tennis on Saturday.

Osaka edged a tight first set but controlled the second to win 6-4, 6-3 in 77 minutes in front of 7,381 fans at Rod Laver Arena.

Third seed Osaka preserves her 100 percent record in Grand Slam finals after winning the 2018 and 2020 US Opens and the 2019 title in Melbourne.

The reigning US Open champion, who beat her idol Serena Williams in the Melbourne semi-finals, has now won two of the last three Grand Slams as her status and reputation soars.

“We played in the semis of the US Open a couple of months ago and I told everyone that you’re going to be a problem,” Osaka told Brady at the trophy presentation.

“And I was right. It’s really incredible to me to see your growth over the past few months, it’s really cool for me to see.”

Osaka, 23, is only the third player after Monica Seles and Roger Federer to win their first four major finals, and will now rise to second in the world rankings.

She saved two match points in the fourth round against Garbine Muguruza and swept past Williams in straight sets in the

On Saturday, Osaka wore down fellow big-hitter Brady, and then lifted her racket above her head in celebration of her win as the crowd roared.

After sealing back-to-back Slam titles twice, Osaka has won half the majors she’s contested since beating Williams to win her first in 2018.

“Thank you for coming and watching, it feels really incredible for me,” she told the crowd, which was capped at half-capacity over coronavirus concerns.

“I didn’t play my last Grand Slam with fans so just to have this energy really means a lot.”

The Japanese survived a seesaw start to gain control, reeling off six straight games en route to the title.

It was a rematch of last year’s epic US Open semi-final, described by some as the best

match of 2020, but Osaka triumphed far more comfortably on this occasion.

Before the match, Osaka had pinpointed her return as the key, but she was helped out by a shaky Brady who lost her serve in the fourth game after two double faults.

But Brady, the 22nd seed, hit back with a break and she continued to pile pressure on Osaka’s serve.

A brilliant lob winner, showcasing her trademark athleticism, gave a pumped-up Brady a break point in the ninth game, but Osaka held on.

Brady then played a sloppy game on serve to hand over the set to Osaka, who had a 20-0 record at Melbourne Park when winning the first set.

Osaka gained a stranglehold with an early break in the second set and fired down an ace to skip out to a 3-0 lead, followed by a roar of “C’mon!”.

Brady attempted a late rally, but a calm Osaka was not to be denied.

Brady’s resilient run ended after serving 14 days’ hard quarantine before the tournament, unlike other players who were allowed out of their hotel rooms to train.

Phoenix sends Abueva to Magnolia in shock trade

Explosive guard Calvin Abueva feels surprised yet excited after being sent by Phoenix Super LPG Fuel Masters to Magnolia Hotshots in a shock off-season trade in the Philippine Basketball Association (PBA).

Bahrain bowed to unbeaten Lebanon 87-102 last night in their penultimate Group D game of the FIBA Asia Cup 2021 qualifiers being held in the Kingdom.

The Bahrainis put up a spirited fight for much of the contest, but committed nearly 30 turnovers and rushed possessions in the final quarter, which allowed the Lebanese to build a double-digit lead towards the final buzzer.

"I give Lebanon a lot of credit; they came with a little bit of a depleted group, but still brought enough strength to play a really tough game," Bahrain head coach and 1986 NBA champion Sam Vincent said during the post-match conference. "They executed very well and made some big shots.

"On our side, too many turnovers and a lot of unforced errors really led to fast-break oppor-

tunities for Lebanon, and they scored easy baskets.

"I know we can play better. We're a young team in terms of being together. The focus for us is to keep on working and to keep on getting better."

The game had no bearing on the two teams' standings in their qualification group, as they both have already secured

their berths in this year's FIBA Asia Cup. Bahrain dropped to a 3-2 win-loss record with last night's result and have one game to play against Iraq tomorrow, while Lebanon maintained their pristine record after five games. They take on India in their last game.

Meanwhile, India edged past Iraq 81-78 in yesterday's other Group D contest after Vishesh Bharguvanshi heaved in a desperation three-pointer from near half-court as time expired.

The result kept India's hopes alive of qualifying for the FIBA Asia Cup, as the result assured

The home team were careless throughout the contest, committing 27 turnovers which led to 36 points. Lebanon also dominated Bahrain in the paint, outscoring their rivals there 60-38.

Nowrooz led the Bahrainis with 20 points, including four three-pointers. Mohammed Hussain and Kuwayed each contributed 13, while Mohammed Ameer chipped in with 12 and

Dark Power comes close to repeat victory in Saudi Cup event

Representing Al Adiyat Racing and John Gosden while saddled by Dettori, Global Giant completed the 1,800m ride on a dirt track in 1:54.1.
