US GDP growth misses expectations

US economic growth cooled more than expected in the final months of 2025, government estimates showed yesterday.

The world's biggest economy expanded at a 1.4% annual rate in the October to December period last year, the Department of Commerce said.

This was significantly below the 2.5% pace that analysts had forecasted for the quarter.

Bahrain airlifts 100 tonnes of urgent aid to Gaza

Coordinated by RHF with Operation 'Gallant Knight 3' and Emirates Red Crescent

The Royal Humanitarian Foundation (RHF) has dispatched an urgent 100-tonne consignment of essential relief supplies to Gaza, reinforcing Bahrain's continued humanitarian support for the Palestinian people.

The airlifted assistance is being delivered in cooperation with Operation "Gallant Knight 3" and the Emirates Red Crescent in the United Arab Emirates.

The shipment includes healthcare supplies dedicated to women and children, essential food items, medicines, and medical equipment aimed at alleviating the worsening humanitarian situation on the ground.

The initiative follows the directives of His Majesty King



Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, Honorary President of the RHF, and His Highness Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa, Representative of His Majesty the King for Humanitarian Work and Youth Affairs and Chairman of the Foundation's Board of Trustees.

RHF Acting Secretary-General Ibrahim Dalhan Al Doseri

said the urgent aid reflects Bahrain's steadfast humanitarian approach and translates the Royal vision of supporting the Palestinian people amid the se-

vere conditions they face.

He reaffirmed Bahrain's commitment to just causes, foremost among them the Palestinian cause, noting that the Foundation continues to fulfil its humanitarian mission in line with the Kingdom's longstanding policy of extending assistance to Gaza to

help ease difficult living conditions.

Al Doseri added that dispatching the aid during the holy month of Ramadan carries profound humanitarian significance, reinforcing the values of solidarity and compassion that define the Bahraini people.

Trump will travel to China from March 31 to April 2: White House official

US President Donald Trump will visit China from March 31 to April 2, a White House official confirmed.

Following a call with Chinese President Xi Jinping on February 4, the Republican leader said that the US relationship with the world's second-largest economy was "extremely good".

Turkey, Saudi sign major solar power deal

Saudi Arabia will help Turkey build solar plants capable of powering more than two million homes, under a deal the two countries signed Friday that aims to deepen energy cooperation between the key regional players.

The signing ceremony at an Ottoman-era palace by the waters of the Bosphorus Strait in Istanbul followed a \$2-billion inter-governmental energy agreement between the two countries during a landmark visit by Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan to Riyadh on February 3.

Under the agreement, Saudi firm Acwa will build two solar power plants in the provinces of Sivas and Karaman in central Turkey, with a combined capacity of 2,000 megawatts -- enough to meet the electricity needs of 2.1 million households, officials said.

Strong earthquake rocks eastern Afghanistan

Kabul, Afghanistan

A strong earthquake rocked eastern Afghanistan yesterday in the capital Kabul and Nangarhar province.

The 5.8-magnitude quake struck around 130 kilometres (80 miles) north-east of Kabul, the United States Geological Survey said. There were no immediate reports of casualties or damage. Residents in Bamiyan and Wardak provinces, west of the capital, also told AFP they felt the earthquake. Earthquakes are common in Afghanistan, particularly along the Hindu Kush mountain range, near where the Eurasian and Indian tectonic plates meet.

US aircraft carrier enters Mediterranean

The USS Gerald R. Ford aircraft carrier was seen entering the Mediterranean Sea yesterday, where it was ordered

by US President Donald Trump as part of a massive military buildup in the Middle East.

The carrier was seen transiting the Strait of Gibraltar -- which links the Atlantic Ocean

to the Mediterranean -- in a photo taken from the Gibraltar side of the strait.

Trump -- who had previously sent another carrier to the Middle East -- said Friday he is

"considering" a limited strike on Iran if negotiations fail to yield a replacement for the nuclear deal with Tehran that he tore up during his first term in office.

Push for new health centre in Al Busaiteen

Al Busaiteen (Al Sayah) could see the establishment of a new healthcare centre if a parliamentary proposal wins approval during Tuesday's session, despite reservations raised by the Ministry of Health.

The proposal, submitted by MPs Abdulwahid Qarata, Hamad Al Doy, Hisham Al Awadhi, Dr Hisham Al Ashiri and Abdullah Al Dhaen, has secured the backing of Parliament's Services Committee.

Lawmakers are advocating for a facility that would provide primary healthcare, vaccinations and routine medical check-ups, arguing that it would ease pressure on existing clinics serving the growing community.

MP Abdulwahid Qarata said rapid population growth in Al Busaiteen and rising demand for "integrated health services" make the project necessary. He added that the proposed centre would also create job opportunities for medical and technical staff.

However, the Ministry of Health told Parliament that primary care services in Muharraq Governorate are already delivered through six health centres, including two that operate 24 hours a day. The ministry noted that Halat Bu Maher Health Centre and Muharraq Health Centre are located near Al Busaiteen, indicating that establishing another facility in the same area may not be warranted.

Cost-of-living support payments in Bahrain totalled BD134 million in 2025, benefiting 137,481 people, the Ministry of Social Development has revealed.

In a written reply to Shura Council member Adel Al Maawda, the ministry said an additional BD23.9m was disbursed in social security assistance and BD25.3m in disability allowances during the same period.

The ministry noted that cost-of-living payments were increased in January 2026 by BD20 across all income bands. Current monthly payments stand at BD130 for households earning BD0-BD300, BD97 for those earning BD301-BD700, and BD75 for incomes between BD701 and BD1,000. Social security beneficiaries receive the payment automatically without the need to apply.

Social security assistance is provided as a top-up for families and individuals whose income does not meet basic living requirements. Since January 2022, minimum monthly payments under Law No. 32 of 2021 have been set at BD77 for a single person, BD132 for two people, and BD28 for each additional family member.

Recipients also benefit from electricity and water bill discounts ranging between BD10 and BD20.

Eligible groups under the law include widows, orphans, divorced women, women proven to have been abandoned by their husbands, and people aged over 60 with insufficient income or support. The scheme also covers families whose sole breadwinner is serving a final custodial sentence of more than one month, children up to 18 – or older if continuing edu-

cation until their first university degree – and unmarried daughters aged 18 to 60 without financial support. People with disabilities and individuals deemed medically unfit to work are also eligible.

Monthly disability allowances amount to BD200 for five categories – complete paralysis, cerebral palsy, autism spectrum disorder, severe intellectual disability and multiple disabilities – while other disability classifications receive BD100.

The ministry said it allocates BD1.2m annually to support civil society rehabilitation centres and BD71,124 per year to help fund mobile home-care and home rehabilitation services in partnership with civil society organisations.

17,725 social security beneficiaries and 15,535 disability allowance recipients. In addition, 192,530 people were receiving separate cash compensation linked to the removal of meat subsidies, with BD31.8m spent under that scheme in 2025.

Between 2023 and 2025, the ministry ran 444 training courses benefiting 7,980 productive family members and operated 45 production units used by 321 beneficiaries.

Looking ahead, the ministry said the government is finalising a comprehensive social survey to update assessments of minimum basic living needs and guide future policy.



Faulty new car sale backfires as court orders BD8,000 refund

Selling a faulty car has landed an authorised agent and a specialist car sales centre in trouble, with an appeal court ordering them to refund the customer BD8,000 and cancel the sale.

The court ruled that the vehicle suffered from manufacturing defects that were never properly repaired, overturning an earlier judgment that had dismissed the buyer's claim and ordered him to pay court costs.

According to the claimant's lawyer, Abdulrahman Khalifa, the buyer repeatedly returned the car to the maintenance centre affiliated with the authorised agent after noticing persistent problems. When the issues remained unresolved, he filed an urgent case to document the vehicle's condition, leading to the appointment of a court expert.

The expert report confirmed several defects, including a foul smell when the air-conditioning was switched on and vibration noises while the engine was running, affecting the roof and the exhaust system.

Although the lower court had rejected the case, the appeal court found that the defects had not been rectified and that the car had not been delivered in a condition fit for use. It ordered the contract rescinded and the parties restored to their pre-sale position.

Under the ruling, the buyer must return the vehicle, while the authorised agent and the owner of the sales centre are jointly liable to pay BD8,000, along with court costs at both levels of litigation and BD300 in legal fees.

Man who tried to set company alight goes on trial

A man who allegedly tried to set a company, where his brother works, on fire has appeared in the High Criminal Court.

The case has been adjourned to 24 February, with the defendant kept in custody.

Prosecutors said CCTV footage shows the defendant assaulting his brother, damaging the company cash safe, and pouring a flammable substance over the safe and company doc-

uments before attempting to ignite them. They called for the maximum sentence, saying the act endangered lives and property.

The complainant, the defendant's brother and work partner, said the attacker arrived in a state of extreme anger, struck him, and damaged the safe.

The defendant admitted hitting his brother but denied trying to start a fire or harming company property.

His lawyer said settlement talks are ongoing.

East Sitra's 1,269-home third phase set for allocation this year

Ministry outlines handovers, seniority rules and progress on applications

● 1,269 homes in the third phase of East Sitra are set for allocation in 2026, following 1,077 first-phase handovers and 531 homes now being delivered.

● Seniority remains key, with allocations primarily based on application date under the Housing System rules.

● Older applications addressed, with housing units, plots and mortgage options progressing across Constituency 10 and other projects.

Allocation of 1,269 homes under the third phase of the East Sitra housing project is set to begin in 2026, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Planning has said, as it outlined progress across the devel-

opment in a written reply to Parliament.

The ministry confirmed that 1,077 homes were handed over in the first phase at the start of 2024, while the second phase — comprising 531 homes — is currently being delivered to beneficiaries. In addition, 563 serviced housing plots within the project have been allocated.

Responding to MP Eman Shuwaiter, the ministry said allocations in housing cities are gov-

erned by Decision No. 909 of 2015 on the Housing System. Under Article 79, applications are prioritised mainly by seniority, provided eligibility conditions are met.

It noted that other factors may also be considered, including family residence details, recorded addresses with the Central Informatics Organisation, applicant preferences and any special circumstances assessed

by the minister.

Addressing older applications from Constituency 10 in the Capital Governorate, the ministry said no allocations were made for 2001 applications. For 2002, seven housing units were allocated; for 2003, 29; and for 2004, 64 — with no ownership apartments or plots allocated in those years.

It added that all nine applicants who opted for mortgage support and a financial grant have been served, along with 13 applicants from 2002 onwards who chose a housing plot with mortgage support.

Under the Land and Loan initiative in Hoorat Sanad, 251 plots are planned to meet applications dating back to 2004 and earlier, with allocation and handover expected in 2026 after infrastructure works are completed.

The ministry also highlighted projects delivered under the Government Land Development Rights programme in partnership with the private sector, including Suhail in Al Lawzi, Al Naseem in Madinat Salman, Al Wadi in Al Buhair and Danat Sanad, which together have served dozens of applicants, including 17 from Constituency 10.

'Under study' plots in Northern towns off-limits for housing, ministry says

Privately owned plots in Sadad, Malkiya and Karzakan (12th Constituency) marked "under study" cannot be used for housing until planning and traffic assessments are completed, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Planning has told MP Hanan Fardan.

In a written reply, the ministry said the "US" designation applies to private land affected by proposed changes in land use, road widening or other planning considerations. Final classification will be determined once the necessary technical reviews are completed. As the plots are privately owned, they cannot be allocated to government housing projects.

The ministry said land classification is governed by the National Strategic Master Plan 2030, adopted under Decree No. 36 of 2016, with zoning maps for each government-

rate issued by ministerial decisions in 2017. These maps set permitted land uses and building requirements and are updated when required by planning studies or government programmes.

It added that government land may be reclassified following technical studies and coordination with relevant authorities, while private owners must apply for changes through the electronic planning platform "Takhtee". Any approved amendment is issued by ministerial decision and published in the Official Gazette.

Responding to a request for details on plots designated for places of worship, parks and car parks in the constituency, the ministry said updated classification maps had been provided and referred to Ministerial Decision No. 93 of 2023, which outlines planning and building standards for those uses.

The ministry said it would continue coordinating with Parliament to support urban development and housing projects.

Over two decades on, hundreds of Muharraq families still await homes

● Only 15 of 61 Old Muharraq Housing Cases took BD40,000 Plot Option

Hundreds of families are still waiting for a home — more than two decades after first submitting their applications.

A total of 811 housing requests from Muharraq's Third Constituency remain pending, including 65 dating back to 2004 and earlier, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Planning said in a written reply to MP Mohammed Al Olaiwi.

Most of the backlog — 746 cases — involves applications for housing units, along with 17 requests for land plots and 48 for ownership flats.

The oldest unresolved applications are all for housing units: 18 from 2002, 17 from 2003 and 30 from 2004. Later years account for much of the queue, with dozens filed between 2011 and 2014 still

awaiting allocation.

For applicants with files from 2004 or earlier, 61 chose an alternative option of a housing plot plus BD40,000 in financing. So far, 15 have benefited, with the remaining cases to be processed in stages as projects are completed.

For those who applied from 2005 onwards, the ministry said it is expanding housing choices and working more closely with private developers under the Government Programme 2023–2026 to speed up delivery.

It highlighted financing schemes such as Tas'heel+ and Tumoo, which allows eligible homeowners to receive an additional BD20,000 in state-backed support 10 years after purchasing a flat to help them upgrade to a larger home.

New developments are also planned, including projects in Madinat Salman and Madinat Khalifa, aimed at easing waiting times and increasing supply.

Parliament to debate proposal for new national stadium in Muharraq

Parliament is set to discuss a proposal on Tuesday to build a national stadium in Muharraq Governorate.

The initiative, submitted by MPs Khalid Buanaq, Hisham Al Awadhi and Second Deputy Speaker Ahmed Qarata, aims to improve sports facilities, support local clubs, and allow Bahrain to host multiple com-

petitions simultaneously. MP Khalid Buanaq said Mu-

harraq "needs modern sports facilities that meet athletes' needs" and strengthen club performance in the domestic league. He added that a new stadium could attract local and international events, boost sports tourism, and expand competition venues across the kingdom.

The proposal highlights four main benefits: enhancing sports infrastructure, providing clubs with better training and com-

petition venues, attracting tournaments and tourism, and distributing sports facilities more evenly nationwide.

The Ministry of Youth Affairs welcomed the goals of the plan, noting sport's importance in Bahrain, but clarified that it is not responsible for implementing such projects.

Parliament's Services Committee recommended approving the proposal, with unanimous support from its members.

Independent body to oversee food security and strategic stockpile

Parliament will discuss on Tuesday a proposal to establish an independent government body—or supreme council—to oversee food security and manage Bahrain's strategic stockpile.

The motion, submitted by MPs Hamad Al Doy, Bader Al Tamimi, Hassan Ebrahim, Mohammed Al Rifaai and Mohammed Mousa, origi-

nally called for a government food security authority. It was later amended following discussions between the Services and Environment Committee and the sponsoring MPs.

MP Hamad Al Doy said the body would develop plans and strategies

shaping food and health policy while monitoring the stockpile. He described it as "an urgent necessity" to prepare for emergencies caused by wars, transport disruptions, or natural disasters.

The committee said the proposal serves the public interest by providing a clear framework to implement the food security strategy, ensure readiness for supply disruptions, and prevent shortages that could harm public health.

The Ministry of Municipalities Affairs and Agriculture, however, said current efforts already meet the proposal's goals through the government's approved food security initiatives, including the National Strategy

to Achieve Food Security, coordinated with other relevant authorities.



Bahrain has developed a National Food Security Strategy to coordinate government efforts, monitor strategic stockpiles, and enhance preparedness against supply disruptions from emergencies or natural disasters.

A proposed law imposing mandatory strategic stock requirements, jail terms and export bans is set for debate in Parliament on Tuesday – but the government has

urged lawmakers to reconsider, arguing that existing legislation already covers its objectives.

The bill, backed by Parliament's Public Utilities and Environment Committee, would require suppliers to maintain

minimum reserves of essential goods and grant the Trade Minister emergency powers to restrict exports during shortages.

Under the proposal, suppliers must store strategic goods in warehouses that meet approved

standards and provide stock data within one week of any ministry request. The ministry would also be authorised to establish electronic links with suppliers to monitor quantities, categories and stock conditions.

In cases of acute shortages under exceptional market conditions, the Trade Minister could impose temporary export bans or restrictions on specific commodities, without prejudice to the Civil Defence law.

The draft law defines several criminal offences, including publishing false or confidential information about strategic stockpiles, submitting fabricated data, colluding to manipulate prices or restrict supply, and suspending production, sale or distribution of strategic goods without official approval.

Breaching supplier obligations could result in up to one year in prison and fines of up to BD5,000, or either penalty. More serious violations would carry a minimum one-year jail term and fines ranging from BD1,000 to BD10,000. Courts would also have the power to confiscate or destroy goods, suspend business activities, publish summaries of judgments at the offender's

expense, and revoke licences in repeat cases.

Separately, the bill grants the minister administrative powers to enforce compliance.

In its memorandum, the government said the proposal duplicates existing food-security measures and overlaps with provisions in the Commercial Law regulating public warehouses, as well as technical regulations governing the transport and storage of chilled and frozen foods. It also raised concerns about the drafting of criminal provisions, warning that vague terms such as "safe warehouses" and broadly defined offences related to reporting and collusion could create legal uncertainty.

The bill was referred to the committee in April 2024. After further study requested by the Council in March 2025, the committee returned with an amended report recommending approval in principle.

Bank guarantee rule for foreign partners faces parliamentary test

● **Two-year bank guarantee proposed for limited liability companies with foreign partners, with terms set by ministerial decision.**

Foreign partners seeking to establish a limited liability company (LLC) in

Bahrain could be required to provide a bank guarantee under a draft amendment set for debate in Parliament on Tuesday – despite government and business opposition.

The proposal would amend Article 264 of the Commercial

Companies Law to require an irrevocable bank guarantee for companies formed with any non-Bahraini shareholding. In its original form, the draft set a fixed BD30,000 guarantee to be held for the lifetime of the company.

However, Parliament's Financial and Economic Affairs Committee revised the clause. Under its version, the guarantee would apply only for two years from incorporation, with the

amount and rules to be set by the Minister of Industry and Commerce based on the company's capital and business activity.

Supporters say the measure targets low-capital firms that contribute little to the economy and would help ensure foreign investors are genuine, while protecting local traders from unfair competition.

The government has urged reconsideration, warning the amendment could restrict investment, conflict with Bahrain's open-market approach and be easily bypassed – for example, by transferring shares to a foreign partner after incorporation. It also called for economic impact studies before adopting any change.

Business groups echoed those concerns, arguing the proposal could deter investment and distort market competition.

Despite the objections, the committee has recommended the bill's approval in principle.

Trump vows 10% global tariff after stinging court rebuke

President Donald Trump vowed Friday to impose a 10 percent tariff on all imports into the United States after the Supreme Court handed him a stinging rebuke by striking down his signature economic policy.

The conservative-majority top court ruled six-three that a 1977 law known as the International Emergency Economic Powers Act (IEEPA) Trump has relied on "does not authorize the president to impose tariffs."

Trump, who had nominated two of the justices who repudiated him, responded furiously, alleging without any evidence that the court was influenced by foreign interests.

"I'm ashamed of certain members of the court, absolutely ashamed, for not having the courage to do what's right for our country," Trump told reporters.

Trump said he would use a separate authority to impose a uniform tariff of

10 percent -- after he spent the past year imposing various rates spontaneously to cajole and punish other countries.

The ruling did not impact sector-specific duties Trump separately imposed on imports of steel, aluminum and various other goods.

The court noted Friday that "had Congress intended to convey the distinct and extraordinary power to impose tariffs" with IEEPA, "it would have done so expressly, as it consistently has in other tariff statutes."

The Supreme Court's three liberal justices joined three conservatives in Friday's ruling, which upheld lower court decisions that tariffs Trump imposed under IEEPA were illegal.

Trump heaped praise on Brett Kavanaugh, the only justice he nominated who voted with him. Kavanaugh was joined in his dissent by fellow conservatives Clarence Thomas and Samuel Alito.



US trade partners cautiously welcome court tariff ruling

US trading partners on Friday cautiously welcomed a Supreme Court ruling striking down Trump's global tariffs, with hard-hit Canada saying the levies were always "unjustified."

Governments were weighing how the highly anticipated decision would impact commerce with the world's largest economy upended through Trump's use of executive authority to

shape global trade since he took office a year ago.

Here is a look at how governments around the world reacted.

Canada

While the conservative-majority Supreme Court found by a 6-3 majority that Trump was not authorized by the International Emergency Economic Powers Act (IEEPA) to impose tariffs, the ruling does not impact sector-specific duties that Trump

has separately imposed on imports of steel, aluminum and various other goods.

The Canadian Chamber of Commerce cautioned against viewing it as "a reset of US trade policy."

"Canada should prepare for new, blunter mechanisms to be used to reassert trade pressure, potentially with broader and more disruptive effects," the chamber's president, Candace Laing, said in a statement.

EU

EU trade spokesman Olof Gill said that the 27-nation bloc took note of the ruling and was "analyzing it carefully."

"We remain in close contact with the US Administration as we seek clarity on the steps they intend to take in response to this ruling," he added. "Businesses on both sides of the Atlantic depend on stability and predictability in the trading relationship."

German industry group BDI

was upbeat, saying it sent a "strong signal for the rules-based trading system."

UK

Britain's government said it plans to continue working with Washington to see how the decision will affect the trade deal reached last year between the two countries.

Global repercussions

While Trump has long used

tariffs as a lever for pressure and negotiations, he made unprecedented use of emergency economic powers under IEEPA upon returning to the presidency last year to slap new duties on virtually all US trading partners.

These included "reciprocal" tariffs over trade practices that Washington deemed unfair, alongside separate sets of duties targeting major partners Mexico, Canada and China over illicit drug flows and immigration.

Kyiv says halted Russian plan to kill top officials



Kyiv said yesterday that 10 people were arrested in Ukraine and Moldova on suspicion of planning to assassinate senior Ukrainian political figures on Moscow's orders, with payouts of up to \$100,000. Kyiv has previously accused Russia, which invaded Ukraine four years ago, of plotting to kill several senior officials, including President Volodymyr Zelenskyy and the head of Ukraine's intelligence service. "As part of the work of a joint investigative team of Ukrainian and Moldovan law enforcement officers, an organized group has been exposed that was preparing contract killings of well-known Ukrainian citizens and foreigners," Ukrainian Prosecutor General Ruslan Kravchenko said in a statement.

The estate of convicted US sex offender Jeffrey Epstein

has agreed to pay up to \$35 million to settle the outstanding legal claims of potentially dozens of victims, according to a court filing Thursday. The agreement must be approved by a federal judge in New York before it can become final. The settlement is related to victims who said they were "sexually assaulted or abused or trafficked by Jeffrey Epstein between Jan 1, 1995, and through Aug 10, 2019," the date of the disgraced financier's death in prison, the proposed plan said.

Epstein estate agrees to settle victim claims for up to \$35 mn



NASA conducts successful rehearsal of Artemis 2 lunar launch



NASA on Thursday said it successfully rehearsed the launch of its massive SLS rocket, which will send astronauts around the Moon for the first time in over 50 years. Technical problems in early February cut short an earlier so-called wet dress rehearsal of the launch of the Artemis 2 mission. But on Thursday, the US space agency reported that things proceeded as planned, concluding at "T-29 seconds" in the countdown.

Florida airport to be renamed after US President Trump

An airport in Florida will soon be renamed after US President Donald Trump, after a bill proposing the change was approved by the state's legislature on Thursday.

Trump, a real estate mogul who has plastered his name on buildings around the world, has sought to leave his mark on the country in an unprecedented image and building campaign.

Florida's Republican-led legislature approved a bill to rename the Palm Beach International Airport as the "President Donald J. Trump International Airport," state records show. Governor Ron DeSantis, once a Trump opponent, is expected to sign the measure into law.

The airport in Palm Beach, a town known for its sandy beaches and luxurious estates, is just minutes away from Trump's Mar-a-Lago residence.

The airport renaming will also require the approval of the Federal Aviation Administration.

It would then become the

latest institution to be renamed after Trump.

The president's handpicked board of the Kennedy Center, an arts complex and memorial to late president John F. Kennedy in Washington, voted in December to rename itself the "Trump-Kennedy Center."

The same month, the State Department added Trump's name to the US Institute of Peace.

Trump has also sought to rename New York's Penn Station and Washington's Dulles International Airport after himself, according to US media reports, although those efforts were rebuffed.

The Treasury Department has confirmed reports that drafts have been drawn up for a commemorative \$1 coin featuring Trump's image, even though there are laws against displaying the image of a sitting or living president on money.

On Thursday, a large blue banner featuring Trump's face was draped across the headquarters of the Justice Department, an agency traditionally seen as outside the reach of political influence.

Hamas demands end to Israeli aggression

Hamas says reconstruction must begin with lifting the blockade

● Hamas insists on Palestinian right to self-determination

● Israel demands Hamas disarm first

Hamas said any discussions on Gaza must begin with a total halt to Israeli "aggression" as Donald Trump's "Board of Peace" maps out the territory's future, with Israel insisting on the group's disarmament before reconstruction starts.

Trump's board met for its inaugural session in Washington on Thursday, with a number of countries pledging money and personnel for rebuilding, more than four months into a fragile ceasefire between Israel and Hamas.

But the board meeting offered no timeline for Hamas to lay down its weapons or for Israel's army to withdraw from the shattered enclave.

"Any political process or any arrangement under discussion concerning the Gaza Strip and the future of our Palestinian people must start with the total halt of aggression," Hamas said in a statement late Thursday.

The Palestinian group also said arrangements for Gaza's future

must start with the "lifting of the blockade, and the guarantee of our people's legitimate national rights, first and foremost their right to freedom and self-determination".

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has insisted that Hamas must disarm before any reconstruction begins.

The Israeli leader did not attend the Washington meeting but was represented by his foreign minister Gideon Saar.

Hamas and Israel have frequently accused each other of violating the terms of the ceasefire, which came into effect last October after two years of war triggered by a Hamas attack on Israel in 2023 that killed 1,221 people, according to an AFP tally based on official Israeli figures.

Since then at least 72,069 people have died in Gaza in an Israeli military offensive, according to the territory's health ministry, whose figures are considered

reliable by the United Nations.

Israel has maintained a military presence in over half of the Gaza Strip since the truce took hold and retains control of all entry points into Israel and Egypt.

Further violence was reported yesterday, with Israel's military saying it had "eliminated" an armed fighter in southern Gaza who crossed the so-called Yellow Line separating areas controlled by Israel and Hamas.

X files? Trump says he's ordering release of data on UFOs and aliens

US President Donald Trump said Thursday he is ordering federal agencies to begin "identifying and releasing" government files related to UFOs and aliens, a move sought for decades by some Americans.

"Based on the tremendous interest shown, I will be directing the Secretary of War, and other relevant Departments and Agencies, to begin the process of identifying and releasing Government files related to alien and extraterrestrial life, unidentified aerial phenomena (UAP), and unidentified flying objects (UFOs)," Trump posted on his Truth Social platform.

While he did not specify whether classified documents would be released to the public, Trump added that the files should include "any and all other information connected to these highly complex, but extremely interesting and important, matters."

Earlier in the day the Repub-

lican president claimed that one of his Democratic predecessors, Barack Obama, had revealed "classified" information in his recent viral podcast remarks about the existence of extraterrestrial life.

"They're real, but I haven't seen them and they're not being

kept in... Area 51," Obama told host Brian Tyler Cohen, referring to the top-secret US military facility in Nevada at the heart of many UFO conspiracy theories.

"There's no underground facility. Unless, there's this enormous conspiracy and they hid it from the president of the United

States." Asked on Thursday about the comments, Trump told reporters that Obama "gave classified information, he is not supposed to be doing that."

The president did not specify what part of Obama's remarks were classified, but claimed "he made a big mistake."

For his own beliefs about aliens, Trump, 79, said "I don't know if they are real or not."

No evidence has been produced of intelligent life beyond Earth.

Interest in UFOs and UAP has been renewed in recent years as the US government probed numerous reports of seemingly supernatural aircraft, amid worries that adversaries could be testing highly advanced technologies.

In March 2024, the Pentagon released a report saying it had no proof that UAP were alien technology, with many suspicious sightings turning out to be merely weather balloons, spy planes, satellites and other normal activity.



AI summit statement delayed to 'maximise' signatories: India

India expects more than 80 nations to sign the New Delhi AI declaration today

Dozens of national delegations at an artificial intelligence summit in India will issue their statement on how the world should handle the technology today, a day later than expected, the host country said.

"There is huge consensus on the declaration. We are just trying to maximise the number," India's IT minister Ashwini Vaishnaw told reporters at the AI Impact Summit in New Delhi

yesterday.

"The declaration and its contours will be shared transparently tomorrow," he said, adding it had more than 70 signatories so far but he hoped the figure would cross 80.

Vaishnaw thanked participants of this week's event that was attended by tens of thousands of people, including world leaders and tech CEOs.

The summit was the fourth annual international meeting to discuss the implications of fast-evolving AI technology, and the first hosted by a developing country.

Hot topics at the summit included the societal benefits of multilingual AI translation, the threat of job disruption and the heavy electricity consumption of data centres.

But analysts said that the broad focus, and vague promises made at its previous editions in France, South Korea and Britain, would make concrete commitments unlikely.

'Less hype, less fear'

The next AI summit will take place in Geneva in 2027.

In the meantime, a UN panel on AI would start work towards "science-led governance", the global body's chief Antonio Guterres said yesterday.

"We are barreling into the unknown," he said. "The message is simple: less hype, less fear. More facts and evidence."

The UN General Assembly has confirmed 40 members for a group called the Independent International Scientific Panel on Artificial Intelligence, Guterres said.

It was created in August, aiming to be to AI what the UN's Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) is to global environmental policy.

However, the head of the US delegation warned against centralised control of generative AI, highlighting the difficulties of reaching a consensus.

"As the Trump administration

has now said many times: We totally reject global governance of AI," White House technology adviser Michael Kratsios said at the Delhi summit.

The United States did not sign last year's summit statement, and it released its own bilateral declaration with India yesterday.

The two countries agreed to "pursue a global approach to AI that is unapologetically friendly to entrepreneurship and inno-

vation".

India has used the summit to push its ambition to catch up with the United States and China in the AI field, including through large-scale data centre construction, and new nuclear power plants to power them.

Delhi expects more than \$200 billion in investments over the next two years, and US tech titans unveiled a raft of new deals and infrastructure projects in the country this week.

Sam Altman, head of ChatGPT maker OpenAI, has called for oversight on AI in the past but said last year that taking too tight an approach could hold the United States back.

"Centralisation of this technology, in one company or country, could lead to ruin," he told the summit on Thursday.

"This is not to suggest that we won't need any regulation or safeguards. We obviously do, urgently, like we have for other powerful technologies."

UK police search property as royals reel from Andrew's arrest

Police were yesterday searching the former home of ex-prince Andrew for a second day, as his sensational arrest tipped the British monarchy into a crisis unprecedented in its modern era.

The disgraced royal, now known as Andrew Mountbatten-Windsor, was "released under investigation" late Thursday after hours of questioning, as police probe misconduct claims over his links to the late US sex offender Jeffrey Epstein.

During around 11 hours in custody, officers raided his current home on the private Sandringham Estate belonging to his brother, King Charles III, and his previous residence in Windsor, west of London.

Footage aired yesterday showed officers back at Mountbatten-Windsor's former Royal Lodge home on the Windsor estate, with large black unmarked

vans believed to be police vehicles on site.

Meanwhile Mountbatten-Windsor -- who was marking his 66th birthday when arrested -- was nowhere to be seen, hunkering down within the sprawling grounds of Sandringham in Nor-

folk, eastern England.

King Charles III issued a rare, personally signed statement Thursday insisting "the law must take its course" and sought to project a business-as-usual air, carrying out public duties including opening London Fashion

Week.

But royal commentators were in no doubt the first arrest of a senior royal in centuries signalled a profound crisis.

"It's a hugely significant moment for the British monarchy," royal expert Ed Owens said, noting much remained unclear including whether Mountbatten-Windsor would be criminally charged.

"It's the unknown elements in this particular instance that I think pose so much concern and arguably a threat to the monarchy."

'Bad apple'

Almost all Britain's newspapers carried on their front pages a photograph of the disgraced royal, looking haggard and wild-eyed as he left a Norfolk police station in a vehicle.

"Downfall", headlined the Daily Mail headline.

The Sun tabloid noted that, like anyone arrested, Mountbat-

ten-Windsor would have had a DNA saliva swab taken along with his finger prints and a photograph.

Once a Falklands War hero and reportedly the late Queen Elizabeth II's favourite son, Mountbatten-Windsor is now deeply unpopular with Britons.

"I'm really pleased that nobody's above the law," Jo Mortimer, 64, who lives in the Norfolk town of Aylsham where Mountbatten-Windsor was held in custody, told said yesterday.

Fellow local Jacob Twomey, 27, noted he was "young enough that I've only ever heard him as a headline" in newspapers.

The retail store worker added he still "liked" the royals and thought the ex-prince was just "one bad apple".

A YouGov poll conducted after Mountbatten-Windsor's arrest showed 82 percent believed he should be removed from the line of succession. He remains eighth in line to the throne.

Tens of thousands join for Ramadan's first Friday prayer in Jerusalem

Tens of thousands of worshippers prayed at Al-Aqsa Mosque in Israeli-annexed east Jerusalem for the first Friday prayer of this year's Ramadan, with no notable incidents reported by Israeli police.

Many entered Jerusalem's Old City through Damascus Gate to reach the mosque, Islam's third holiest site, with hundreds of people heading in the same direction under the watchful eye of Israeli police.

Thousands stood shoulder to shoulder in the mosque's compound as the prayer resonated on speakers, prostrating themselves on prayer mats under a sunny sky with their backs to the

shrine's iconic golden dome, according to a journalist at the scene.

While most worshippers live in east Jerusalem or Israel proper, some crossed Israeli checkpoints to reach the mosque from the occupied West Bank, including at Qalandia, the main passage point between Jerusalem and Ramallah.

A journalist witnessed a large crowd waiting to be allowed in by Israeli soldiers, while troops in riot gear stood by. The Islamic Waqf, the Jordanian-run body that administers the site, reported that 80,000 worshippers came to the compound for the prayer.

Israel deployed thousands of extra police officers in Jerusalem to watch over the holy city for the length of Ramadan, and issued the same travel

restrictions as last year for Palestinian residents of the West Bank -- which Israel has occupied since 1967.

Israel announced it was issuing just 10,000 permits for Palestinians living in the occupied West Bank wishing to attend weekly Friday prayers at the Al-Aqsa Mosque during Ramadan, only available to women over 50, men over 55, and children under 12.

Um Awad, a West Bank Palestinian woman who applied for a permit that was denied, was not allowed to cross the checkpoint into Jerusalem.

"They are only allowing a small number to obtain permits. We tried and applied, some obtained permits, while others were denied. It is wrong for them to prevent us from praying," she said.

"Even if they prevent us from going today, I will come next Friday and the Friday after that, God willing, because no one except God can prevent us from going to Al-Aqsa," said Jihad Bisharat, a Palestinian man who was denied entry to Jerusalem at Qalandia checkpoint. Jerusalem police's spokesman said in a statement that "the prayer concluded without incident."





Matchday 15 of the Nass-Bin Hamad Premier League saw Muharraq respond emphatically to their Khalid bin Hamad Cup final disappointment, thrashing Bahrain Club 7-0 at Shaikh Ali bin Mohammed Stadium. Portuguese head coach Fernando Manuel de Jesus Santos got the performance he demanded, moving the Red Wolves to 36 points, three clear of Al Khaldiya and Riffa, with a game in hand. Al Khaldiya can reclaim top spot on head-to-head if they defeat Malkiya tonight at Khalifa Sports City at 9pm.

Santos' side set the tone immediately, scoring three quickfire goals inside the first 13 minutes. Algerian winger Sami Frioui opened the scoring in the fifth minute, finishing low from outside the box after a swift combination with Alkhalasi. Edimar Ribeiro da Costa doubled the lead four minutes later, reacting fastest to a rebound after his initial header from Elliot Simoes' cross was saved. Simoes then completed the early treble in the 13th minute, finishing low from Alkhalasi's pass after orchestrating the move himself.

The reigning champions' dominance continued. In the 38th minute, Simoes struck from a cleverly rehearsed freekick, the ball bouncing into the far corner to beat Bahrain Club's defence. Just before halftime, Frioui set up Soufiane Mahrouk for a simple finish, making it five and cementing the Red Wolves' control.

The second half brought further clinical finishing. In the 62nd minute, Simoes burst

down the left wing and delivered a low ball to the far post, where Malian winger was on hand Abdoul Diarra to tap in. The goal came moments after scenes of retired Brazilian striker Leandson Dias da Silva, better known as Rico, rallying the crowd and chanting to support his former team. Argentinian Facundo Tobares capped the scoring in the 82nd minute with a sensational strike from distance, bending the ball into the bottom corner and completing a dominant 7-0 display.

Elsewhere yesterday, Al Ahli secured a 1-0 victory over Al Najma at Khalifa Sports City. Fabrice Onana scored a stunning long-range goal in the first half, curling the ball off the post and into the top corner, which proved enough to decide the match. The win lifts Al Ahli to eighth place with 18 points, just three points clear of seventh-placed Al Najma. Matchday 15 wraps up on Monday, with Al Hidd hosting Sitra at Bahrain National Stadium at 9pm, as the standings continue to take shape.

Arteta urges Arsenal to 'write own destiny' after title wobble

Mikel Arteta challenged spluttering Arsenal to start writing their "own destiny" in Sunday's north London derby at Tottenham after losing control of the Premier League title race.

Arteta's side held a commanding lead in their bid to win a first English title since 2004, but the leaders have allowed second-placed Manchester City to close within five points of top spot.

City, who face Newcastle on Saturday, have a game in hand over Arsenal and will host the Gunners in a crucial clash in April.

If Pep Guardiola's team win their remaining 12 matches, they will take the title regardless of Arsenal's results in their last 11 games.

It is a painful scenario for Arteta, who presided over Arsenal's blown leads in title races won by City in 2023 and 2024.

The Gunners have finished as runners-up for the last three seasons and their latest untimely stumble has raised pointed questions about their ability to cope with the pressure of the title race.

Ferrari's Leclerc sets Testing pace

Charles Leclerc ends F1 pre-season testing in Bahrain as fastest man from all six days

● Ferrari superstar clocks blistering lap time of 1min 31.992secs to top the timesheet on final day of second week of tests at BIC

● F1 Aramco Pre-Season Testing 2026 sets stage for start of F1's 'new era', flagging off with season-opening race in Australia next month

● F1 Gulf Air Bahrain Grand Prix to take BIC by storm from 10 to 12 April as fourth round of 2026 F1 season

Bahrain International Circuit (BIC), 'The Home of Motorsport in the Middle East', wrapped up six exciting days of Formula 1 Aramco Pre-Season Testing 2026 yesterday evening as Ferrari's Charles Leclerc blazed to the top of the timesheet.

Leclerc set a blistering fastest lap of 1min 31.992secs in his Ferrari SF-26 – the quickest overall time of the tests and the only mark to go sub-1:32.000. He went quickest during yesterday's afternoon session, which concluded under lights and with a thrilling practice start along BIC's main straight – giving spectators a very brief preview of the



spectacular action to come in the F1 Gulf Air Bahrain Grand Prix 2026 this 10 to 12 April at BIC.

Leclerc was in the car for a full day's running yesterday, logging a total of 132 laps as one of the busiest men of the field. He was classified 0.879s ahead of reigning F1 Drivers' World Champion Lando Norris, who took over for McLaren teammate Oscar Piastri, who tested their MCL40 in the morning.

Four-time F1 Drivers' World Champion Max Verstappen was third-fastest for Red Bull Racing, clocking 1.117s from the top in their RB22. George Russell followed for Mercedes 1.205s back in their F1 W17, while Pierre Gasly in Alpine's A526 ranked fifth 1.429s adrift.

Completing the top 10 were Oliver Bearman (+1.495s) for Haas in their VF-26, Gabriel Bortoleto (+1.763s) for Audi in their R26,

Kimi Antonelli (+1.924s) testing in the morning for Mercedes, Arvid Lindblad (+2.157s) in Racing Bulls's VCARB 03, and Carlos Sainz (+2.350s) for Williams in their FW48. Lindblad racked up the highest number of laps for the day with 165.

Six other drivers were a part of the final day's running at BIC. Classified 11th through 16th, respectively, were Piastri (+2.360s), Esteban Ocon

(+2.502s) for Haas, Isack Hadjar (+2.519s) for Red Bull Racing, Valtteri Bottas (+3.298s) in Cadillac's CA01, Nico Hulkenberg (+4.027s) for Audi, and Sergio Perez (+8.850s) for Cadillac.

Also yesterday at BIC, all those attending testing were able to enjoy a fan-engagement experience for the second day in a row with the F1 Pit Lane Walk.

Scores of F1 enthusiasts took

part in the activity, which is a favourite with members of the public, who got to see their favourite F1 teams up close as they were hard at work in their garages along the F1 pit lane.

The six days of F1 Aramco Pre-Season Testing 2026 was the first opportunity for fans from around the world to witness in person the next generation of F1 cars in action on track ahead of the start of the 2026 FIA F1 World Championship.

The tests marked the sixth consecutive year that Sakhir hosted F1's most important preparation period ahead of the new campaign. Testing was first held in Bahrain in 2009 and then again in 2014. They have since taken place in Bahrain each year from 2021.

The 2026 season is scheduled to get underway in Melbourne, Australia, from 6 to 8 March. The F1 battles will then continue with grands prix in China and Japan before heading to the Kingdom for the F1 Gulf Air Bahrain Grand Prix 2026 – the fourth round of the 24-race world championship.

There are only very limited grandstand tickets remaining for the Kingdom's F1 spectacle as they are very close to completely selling out. Fans who have yet to secure their seats are advised to do so immediately to avoid missing out on Bahrain's biggest sporting and entertainment event of the year.
